THE GAME: Moravian looks to win its second straight game of the 2010 Centennial Conference season at McDaniel College. Kickoff is slated for 2:00 p.m. at Scott S. Blair Stadium in Westminster, Maryland.

THE COACHES: Scot Dapp (West Chester '73) enters his 24th season at Moravian, with a career record of 138-99-1 (.582), the winningest football coach in Moravian history. He entered the season in the top 50 in winning percentage among NCAA Division III active coaches. Dapp, who served as the president of the American Football Coaches Association in 2005, has earned Coach-of-the-Year honors from the MAC three times including Co-Coach of the Year in 1997 and has led the 'Hounds to two appearances in the NCAA playoffs, the ECAC Southeast Bowl game in 2002, the ECAC Southwest Bowl game in 2004, 2005 and 2008, winning the title in 2005.

McDaniel coach Tim Keating (Bethany '75) is in his 18th season at McDaniel with a 104-70-3 record (.596), and Keating is in his 23rd overall season with a career coaching mark of 130-93-3 (.582).

THE SERIES: Saturday's meeting will be the 15th in the series with Moravian holding a 10-4 advantage. The Greyhounds have won the three initial Centennial Conference meetings, 43-14 in Bethlehem in 2007, and 42-3 in 2008, and 21-16 in Bethlehem last fall with all three games being the conference openers for both squads. McDaniel was formerly known as Western Maryland College but the name changed in 2002.

GREYHOUNDS IN THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE: Moravian joined the Centennial Conference as an associate member in the sport of football in 2007. The Greyhounds were selected eighth in the Centennial Conference preseason coaches and sports information directors poll while McDaniel was selected seventh.

CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE WEEKLY HONOR ROLL: Sophomore running back Rocco Del Priore (Center Valley, PA/Southern Lehigh HS), junior kicker Ian Heck (Easton, PA/Easton HS) and sophomore defensive back Travis King (Wilmington, DE/Concord HS) of Moravian were named to the Centennial Conference Weekly Honor Roll for their performances in the Greyhounds' 12-6 conference victory over Susquehanna University Saturday afternoon to open the 2010 Centennial Conference season. Del Priore led the Moravian rushing attack in his first career start with 76 yards on 24 carries including a five-yard touchdown run in the game. He also had one reception for six yards. Heck connected on a 25-yard field goal with 1:25 remaining in the first half to give Moravian a 10-3 halftime lead. He also averaged 58.7 yards per kickoff with one touchback. King made seven tackles with four solo stops and had one tackle for loss for two yards in the victory. King's biggest play was an interception with 2:55 remaining on Susquehanna's final possession.

BALANCED & EXPERIENCED 'HOUNDS: Of the 83 players on the Moravian roster, 34 are freshmen, 20 are sophomores and 15 are juniors. There are 14 seniors on this season's squad, and the Greyhounds return 42 letterwinners and 14 starters.

ON THE AIRWAVES: For the 14th straight year, the Greyhounds' games will be on the radio. Moravian's games will be aired on WSAW 1470 AM The Fox for the seventh straight year. Phil May calls the play-by-play call with color commentary from Craig Barnes and technical assistance from John Elliott. The pre-game show starts one hour prior to kickoff.

kickoff 18 yards to set the Moravian offense up at its own 32-yard line. However, **King**, who entered the game leading the Centennial Conference in kickoff return average, was injured on the play and did not return. On the Greyhounds first offensive play, running back **Ryan Rempe** ran for 16 yards, but he too was injured and missed the rest of the game. Facing a third-and-ten, **Panasuk** completed his first pass for 11 yards to tight end **Brian Dencker** and a first down. Two plays later, **Panasuk** hit a wide open **Sylvainus** behind the McDaniel defense for a 38-yard scoring pass. Kicker **Ian Heck** (Easton, PA/Easton HS) made hit first-ever collegiate extra-point to tie the game at 7-7 with 10:36 left in the first quarter. McDaniel would pick up a first down on its next drive but would eventually punt with punter **Jake Nichols** punt rolling dead at the Moravian four-yard line. The Greyhounds put together a 14-play, 96-yard drive to take the lead. **Panasuk** had two first downs by passing, and Moravian picked up a third first down on a McDaniel penalty to move the ball to the Green Terror-48-yard line. However, the Greyhounds faced a fourth-and-six and lined up to punt. Linebacker **Stephen Kircher** (Manasquan, NJ/Manasquan HS) would take a direct snap on the play and run for 14 yards and a first down. Two plays later, **Panasuk** connected with **Sylvainus** again, this time from 30 yards to five Moravian a lead it wouldn't relinquish. On the extra-point attempt, a bad snap rolled to **Heck's** feet, leaving the score at 13-7 Moravian with 22 seconds left in the first quarter. The Green Terror would get a 46-yard pass completion from quarterback **Tom Massucci** to wide receiver **Matt Cahill** on the first play of the second quarter to get into the red zone, but the drive would stall with Moravian's defense stuffing running back **Ray O'Hara** a yard short of the first down at the Greyhound 10-yard line. Moravian put together another long scoring drive, this time 90 yards on nine plays. On the second play of the drive, **Panasuk** hit running back **Phillip Redline** (Jim Thorpe, PA/Jim Thorpe HS) with a 39-yard completed, and **Panasuk** connected on a 15-yard completion to **Dencker** on the next play. A roughing the quarterback call would move the Greyhounds into the red zone. Facing a third-and-four, **Panasuk** found wide receiver **Alex Hersch** (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS) with a seven-yard completion for a first down at the four-yard line. The first down was Moravian's 12th and final first down of the game. Three plays later, running back **Anthony Falco** scored his first touchdown of the season on a three-yard carry. Moravian went for a two-point conversion with **Panasuk** finding **Dencker** wide open off the left side to give Moravian a 21-7 lead with 8:47 to go in the first half. On McDaniel's next drive, the Greyhounds forced a turnover when linebacker **Evan Bauer** (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) hit **Massucci** on a blind side blitz and forced a fumble. Defensive lineman **Jacob Millen** recovered the ball for Moravian. The Greyhounds only ran three plays before giving the ball back to the Green Terror. McDaniel defensive back **Travis Weinrich** stepped in front of a **Panasuk** pass for an interception. **Weinrich** returned 41 yards to the Moravian 21-yard line. Three plays later, **Develin** scored from five yards out to cut the score to 21-13 with 4:39 remaining in the first half. On **DeLuca's** extra-point attempt, **Millen** pushed through the middle of the line to block the kick. Moravian running back **Langston Ross** (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) would set the Greyhound offense up at the McDaniel 32-yard line with a 52-yard kickoff return, however; Moravian turned the ball over on downs when **Panasuk's** fourth down pass attempt to **Dencker** was broken up by linebacker **Mike Weick**. Each team would punt on its next possession. The Green Terror

MILESTONE WATCH: The Greyhounds have one player closing in on milestones for his career. Senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** (Nazareth, PA/Nazareth HS) currently has 1,121 yards on 76 career receptions, and he needs just 279 yards to crack the top ten in school history and 24 receptions to become the seventh player in Moravian history to catch 100 career passes.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET: In Bethlehem last fall, quarterback **Steve Panasuk** completed 12 of 22 passes for 175 yards and a pair of first half touchdown passes to wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** while linebacker **Anthony Carney** forced a key fumble with just 50 seconds remaining to lead Moravian to a 21-16 victory over McDaniel College in the 2009 Centennial Conference opener for both schools at a rainy Rocco Calvo Field. Moravian, which was limited to 85 yards passing and just 225 yards on total offense in its season opening loss at Susquehanna with **Panasuk** out with an injury, had 237 yards including 167 through the air and 12 first downs on 40 plays in the opening half against McDaniel. The second half was a different story as the Greyhounds ran just 19 plays in the final 30 minutes for minus 13 yards and no first downs. The start of the game looked ominous for Moravian as Greyhound defensive back **Travis King** (Wilmington, DE/Concord HS) was hit from behind by McDaniel defensive back **Tim McLister**, fumbling the ball. The Green Terror took over at the Moravian 21 yard line and needed just four plays including three rushes from running back **T. J. Develin** to score. Kicker **Nick DeLuca** made the extra-point to give McDaniel a 7-0 lead just 1:16 into the game. **King** would return the ensuing

took over at the Moravian 47-yard line with 43 seconds remaining in the first half and were moving the ball when Greyhound defensive back **Brad Bodine** intercepted a **Massucci** pass at the Moravian nine-yard line to essentially end the half with the Greyhounds leading 21-13. McDaniel received the opening kickoff of the second half and would pick up a pair of first downs to move to the red zone. Faced with a fourth-and-13 from the Moravian 23-yard line, **DeLuca** lined up for a 40-yard field goal attempt and drilled it to cut Moravian's lead to 21-16 with 10:44 to go in the third quarter. Moravian wide receiver **Eric Woodruff** looked to give the Greyhounds good field position with a long kickoff return, but a holding penalty on the run back forced Moravian to start at its own 33-yard line. **Panasuk** would be intercepted for the second time in the game on the third play of the drive as McDaniel defensive back **Chris Kolb** cut inside **Hersch** to grab the ball at the McDaniel 40-yard line. The Green Terror picked up two first downs before punting after a penalty set McDaniel up with a first down and 21. Moravian, starting from its own ten-yard line managed just three plays and six yards before punting. McDaniel would punt on the first play of the fourth quarter as the teams traded punts on the next four possessions. The Green Terror eventually took over at the Moravian 43 yard line and picked up two first downs while moving into the red zone. McDaniel would bring **DeLuca** on to attempt a 29-yard field goal on a fourth-and-seven play, but a bad snap on the attempt gave Moravian possession at its own 22-yard line. Once again, Moravian had just three plays on offense before punting for the fifth time in the game. McDaniel started what would be its final drive on its own 48-yard line. The Green Terror picked up a first down on a fourth-and-two play when **Massucci** hit quarterback/wide receiver **Kevin White** with an eight-yard pass, and McDaniel moved to the Moravian 22-yard line on a five yard pass from **Massucci** to tight end **Woody Butler**. On the next play, **Massucci** found **Develin** with a swing pass to the Moravian 21-yard line, and with **Develin** fighting for extra yardage, **Carney** hit **Develin** from behind and forced the ball loose. Moravian defensive back **Daniel Burley** grabbed the ball and returned it to the Moravian 30-yard line, giving the Greyhounds possession with 50 seconds to play and McDaniel having just two timeouts. The Greyhounds would run out the clock to seal the victory. **Redline** led the Moravian rushing attack with 43 yards on 17 carries as the Greyhounds ran for just 49 yards on 37 carries. **Sylvainus** caught four passes for 74 yards with his two scores while **Dencker** had three receptions for 32 yards. **Hersch** grabbed three passes for 27 yards while **Redline** had two receptions for 42 yards. **Develin** turned in a career high 148 yards and two touchdowns on 25 carries to lead McDaniel while **O'Hara** added 18 yards on six carries. **Cahill** led nine different Green Terror players catching a pass with four receptions for 85 yards while **Butler** had four receptions for 36 yards. Moravian linebacker **Derek Protasiewicz** led the Moravian defense with ten tackles while **Burley** had seven stops with a tackle for loss and his fumble return. Linebacker **Jake Hildebrand** (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS) also had seven stops while **Bauer** made six tackles with his sack and forced fumble. Linebacker **Phillip Bortz** (Allentown, PA/Parkland HS) added six stops with two pass break-ups while defensive back **Kyle Krupa** had five tackles with three passes defended including one that may have gone for a touchdown if **Krupa** had held onto the ball. **Carney** made four tackles including his game-ending forced fumble. **Kolb** led the Green Terror defense with a game high 11 tackles to go with his

interception while **Weick** had nine tackles with half a tackle for loss. Linebacker **Tommy Prazenica** added eight tackles with a tackle for loss and a fumble recovery on the opening kickoff while defensive lineman **Mike Ford** had six tackles with three and a half sacks and four and a half tackle for loss all in the second half.

THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE STATISTICAL RANKINGS: The Centennial Conference statistics are located at the end of the release. The weekly rankings section will begin next week once all of the teams have played at least one game.

SCOUTING McDANIEL: The Green Terror enter the game with a 1-0 record after a 3-0 victory over Juniata College in Centennial Conference action last Saturday. Junior quarterback **Tom Massucci** leads McDaniel on the field and has completed 18 of 36 passes for 158 yards and an interception this season, and he has been sacked six times. Sophomore wide receiver **CJ Billera** has been the top target, catching six passes for 59 yards while senior wide receiver **Matt Cahill** has five receptions for 60 yards. **Billera** also has five punt returns for 34 yards and one kickoff return for 21 yards. Senior running back **Raymond O'Hara** leads the Green Terror rushing attack with 120 yards on 23 carries while freshman running back **Vince Snarski** has 22 yards on eight attempts. Freshman kicker **Bill Castor** is one-for-two on field goals this season with a long of 27 yards while junior punter **Jake Nichols** has been called on eight times with an average of 36.2 yards, a long of 51 yards, three inside the 20-yard line and two touchbacks. Senior defensive backs **Chris Kolb** and **Aaron Slaughter** each have six tackles to lead the McDaniel defense with **Kolb** adding a pass break-up. Junior defensive lineman **Bill Gerdes** has five tackles with three and a half for loss and a sack while sophomore linebacker **Diego Weiner** has five tackles with a half a tackle for loss. Senior linebacker **Paul Smith** has the Green Terror's only interception this season.

THE QUARTERBACKS: Freshman **Phil Gardner** was named the starting quarterback and completed seven of 12 passes for 72 yards in Moravian's season opening win over Susquehanna. **Gardner** also ran for 32 yards on 11 carries and was not sacked in the game.

IN THE BACKFIELD: In the backfield, sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has 75 yards and a touchdown on 24 carries while sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** (**Haddonfield, NJ/Haddon Township HS**) has 62 yards on 15 attempts. Junior running back **Philip Redline** gained two yards on his only carry against Susquehanna.

THE WIDE RECEIVERS: The Greyhounds have had five different players catch a pass this season led by senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** with two catches for 26 yards. Junior tight end **Mike Zononi** (**Bethlehem, PA/Freedom HS**) has grabbed two passes for 19 yards while sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** has one reception for 14 yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Ryan Onushco** (**Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS**) also has a catch for seven yards while sophomore running back **Roco Del Priore** has added one reception for six yards.

OFFENSIVE LINE: Seniors **Daniel Cancelliere** (**Succasunna, NJ/Roxbury HS**), **Matthew Washer** (**Ogdensburg, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS**) and **Thomas Mulligan** (**Ardmore, PA/Episcopal Academy**) are back on the offensive line. Joining the starting line-up will be junior center **Nicholas Guerriero** (**New Providence, NJ/New Providence HS**) and sophomore **Billy Viscuso** (**Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS**). The Greyhounds' front five has an average size of 6-1, 271.

DEFENSIVE FRONT: Senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros** (**Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS**) leads the Moravian defensive line three

tackles including one for loss while junior defensive lineman **Seth Payne** (**Collingswood, NJ/Collingswood HS**) has tackles. Senior defensive lineman **Michael McClarin** (**Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS**) made one tackles in the season opener.

THE LINEBACKER CORPS: Senior linebacker **Philip Bortz** leads the linebackers with seven tackles with one for loss while junior linebacker **Stephen Kircher** has also made seven tackles with a half a tackle for loss and a pass break-up. Junior linebacker **Evan Bauer** has three tackles while sophomore linebacker **Jake Hildebrand** has two stops with one for loss this season.

THE DEFENSIVE BACKFIELD: In the defensive backfield, junior defensive back **David Wacker** (**Parkton, MD/Hereford HS**) leads the Moravian defense with eight tackles including one for loss while senior defensive back **Daniel Burley** has seven stops and a pair of pass break-ups. Sophomore defensive back **Travis King** also contributed seven tackles with one for loss and an interception while sophomore defensive back **Matt Johnson** has two tackles including a half a tackle for loss and a pass break-up.

KICKING GAME: Junior kicker **Ian Heck** is one-for-one on field goals this season with a long of 25 yards, and he is one-for-one on extra-point attempts. **Heck** is averaging 58.7 yards per kickoff on three attempts with one touchback. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski** (**Coatesville, PA/Chestnut Hill Academy**) has punted four times for an average of 33.0 yards per punt with a career long of 57 yards at Susquehanna University.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has two punt returns for 23 yards including a long of 20 yards while sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has returned two kickoffs for 49 yards with a long of 27 yards.

STARTERS PLAYER OF THE GAME: As part of Moravian's radio contract with Fox Sports Radio 1470 AM WSAW The Fox, the announcers will select the Starters Player of the Game for Moravian during the Post-Game Show. Last week, sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** (**Center Valley, PA/Southern Lehigh HS**) was selected as the Starters Co-Players of the Game for their performances. **Del Priore** had a career high 76 yards and a touchdown on 24 carries, and he caught one pass for six yards. Starters Riverport, Starters Pub and Starter Clubhouse Grille, sponsors of Moravian College Athletics, are located on 2nd Street, Route 378 South of Bethlehem and the Bethlehem Municipal Golf Course.

WINNING WAYS: Moravian had 11 consecutive winning seasons—all under Coach **Scot Dapp**, from 1987 to 1997 and has had 17 winning seasons in **Dapp's** 24 years. The 11-straight winning seasons is the longest in school history. **Dapp** ranks third among Greyhound coaches in winning percentage.

OVERTIME 'HOUNDS: Moravian has played a total of nine overtime games since the NCAA instituted the rule for the 1996 season and is 7-2 all-time in the extra-session. Five of those nine overtime games have been against Juniata College with the Greyhounds going 4-1 in those games. Moravian's contest in Huntingdon in 2008 marked the first time in the Greyhounds' have needed more than one overtime session in a game. The 2008 season also marked the second year that Moravian has played two overtimes games in one season, the other year was 1999.
