THE GAME: Moravian plays its only non-conference game of the 2010 season with a road trip to Lebanon Valley College. Kickoff is slated for 1:00 p.m. at Arnold Field in Annville, Pennsylvania. Saturday will be Lebanon Valley's Take a Kid to the Game day with all children 14 and under receiving free admission.

THE COACHES: Scot Dapp (West Chester '73) is in his 24th season at Moravian, with a career record of 138-100-1 (.579), the winningest football coach in Moravian history. He entered the season in the top 50 in winning percentage among NCAA Division III active coaches. **Dapp**, who served as the president of the American Football Coaches Association in 2005, has earned Coach-of-the-Year honors from the MAC three times including Co-Coach of the Year in 1997 and has led the 'Hounds to two appearances in the NCAA playoffs, the ECAC Southeast Bowl game in 2002, the ECAC Southwest Bowl game in 2004, 2005 and 2008, winning the title in 2005.

Lebanon Valley coach **Jim Monos** (**Shippensburg '72**) returned to Lebanon Valley in 2004. He has a 73-97-2 (.430) record in 18 seasons in Annville with a 44-65-2 record in his first 11 seasons from 1986 to 1996.

THE SERIES: Saturday's meeting will be the 68th in the series with Moravian holding a 34-32-1 lead. Lebanon Valley posted a 32-3 victory in Bethlehem last fall while the Greyhounds earned a 23-16 win in Annville in 2008. Moravian posted a 19-18 victory in Bethlehem in 2007 as the teams met for the first time since the 1940s as non-conference opponents. The Flying Dutchmen snapped a six-game losing streak in the series in 2006 with a 55-21 win in Annville.

CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE HONORS: Sophomore linebacker **Jake Hildebrand (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS)** of Moravian was named to the Centennial Conference Weekly Honor Roll for his performance in the Greyhounds' 13-10 conference loss at McDaniel College Saturday afternoon. **Hildebrand** led the Moravian defense with ten tackles including one for loss, and he had one of the Greyhounds' four interceptions in the game. Moravian allowed the Green Terror just 158 yards on 63 plays that included 35 yards on 32 rushing attempts. The Greyhounds also held McDaniel to one-for-13 on third down

GREYHOUNDS IN THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE: Moravian joined the Centennial Conference as an associate member in the sport of football in 2007. The Greyhounds were selected eighth in the Centennial Conference preseason coaches and sports information directors poll.

BALANCED & EXPERIENCED 'HOUNDS: Of the 83 players on the Moravian roster, 34 are freshmen, 20 are sophomores and 15 are juniors. There are 14 seniors on this season's squad, and the Greyhounds return 42 letterwinners and 14 starters.

ON THE AIRWAVES: For the 14th straight year, the Greyhounds' games will be on the radio. Moravian's games will be aired on WSAN 1470 AM The Fox for the seventh straight year. **Phil May** calls the play-by-play call with color commentary from **Craig Barnes** and technical assistance from **John Elliott**. The pre-game show starts one hour prior to kickoff.

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MILESTONE WATCH: The Greyhounds have one player closing in on milestones for his career. Senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** (**Nazareth, PA/Nazareth HS**) currently has 1,201 yards on 82 career receptions, and he needs just 199 yards to crack the top ten in school history and 18 receptions to become the seventh player in Moravian history to catch 100 career passes. **Sylvainus** is currently tenth in receptions and 15th in receiving yardage.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET: In Bethlehem last fall, Lebanon Valley rolled up 498 yards of total offense on 71 plays including 221 yards on the ground with four rushing touchdowns, two by fullback Bryan Lynch to lead the Flying Dutchmen to a 32-3 non-conference win over Moravian in nonconference at Rocco Calvo Field. Lebanon Valley needed just three plays to get onto the scoreboard in the first quarter. Quarterback Caleb Fick completed a 21-yard pass to wide receiver Joe Brennan on the first play of the game before running back Ben Guiles runs of nine yards and 23 yards, the later for a touchdown. **Brittany Ryan** added the extra-point for a 7-0 lead just 1:15 into the game. The Greyhounds would pick up a first down on their first drive of the game, however; quarterback Steve Panasuk was sacked by Flying Dutchmen defensive end Cory Homer, who forced a fumble and recovered the ball at the Moravian 25-yard line. Lebanon Valley needed just three rushing plays to add to its lead. Running back Blair Ransom scored from a yard out, and Ryan's extra-point put the Flying Dutchmen up 14-0 with 10:05 to play in the first quarter. Moravian's offense would take over at its own 42-yard line for its second drive of the game. Panasuk completed a pass to wide receiver Ray Olivo for ten yards on the first play of the drive, and Panasuk would connect with tight end Brian Dencker on a 22-yard pass to move the Greyhounds to the Lebanon Valley 24-yard line. A Flying Dutchmen penalty would give Moravian a first down at the LVC 17-yard line, but the Greyhounds gained just three yards in three plays. Kicker Ian Heck (Easton, PA/Easton HS) came on an made a 30-yard field goal, the first field goal attempt of his career, to cut the Lebanon Valley lead to 14-3 with 5:02 to go in the first quarter. With the Flying Dutchmen taking over at the Lebanon Valley 45-yard line, Guiles had runs of 13 and 33 yards to move into the red zone, and Lynch scored his first one-yard touchdown with 12:46 to go in the second quarter. Ryan's kick made the lead 21-3. The Greyhounds picked up one first down on its next drive on a 13-yard pass from Panasuk to wide receiver Shawn Sylvainus. Lebanon Valley droved from its own 14-yard line into the red zone after a 55-yard completion from Fick to Brennan and a nine-yard run from running back Mike Scott, but the drive stalled at the Moravian 16-yard line. Flying Dutchman kicker Matt Nawracaj came on for a 33-yard field goal attempt but the kick sailed wide right with 6:02 to play in the first half. Moravian's offense again picked up just one first down, an 11-yard completion from Panasuk to Sylvainus, before punting again. The Flying Dutchmen started at their own 29-yard line and picked up three first downs to move to the Moravian 30-yard line. However, facing a second-and-11, Fick was intercepted by Moravian linebacker Evan Bauer (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) at the Moravian 20-yard line, and Bauer had a 15-yard return. The Greyhound offense was unable to move the ball, punting with 15 seconds left in the first half. Moravian would receive the opening kickoff and pick up a first down on its second play of the half on a 21-yard pass from Panasuk to running back Anthony Falco, but the drive stalled forcing the Greyhounds fifth punt of the game. The Flying Dutchmen started their first possession of the second half at the Moravian 39-yard line. Fick hit wide receiver Sean Donovan with a 20-yard completion on the first play and a Moravian penalty on the play moved the ball to the nine-yard line. On fourth-and-one, Lynch scored again from one-yard out. The snap on the extrapoint rolled to Fick, and he picked up the ball and raced towards the left side of the end zone, diving to hit the pylon with the ball for the two-point conversion giving Lebanon Valley a 29-3 lead with 4:02 left in the third quarter. Moravian's offense continued to struggle, moving just five yards on its next drive before punter Eric Dzingelski (Coatesville, PA/Chestnut Hill Academy) connected on a career long punt of 53 yards, putting the Lebanon Valley offense on its own one-yard line after Greyhound defensive back Travis King (Wilmington, DE/Concord HS) raced to keep the ball from rolling into the end zone. **Dzingelski** punted nine times in the game for Moravian with an average of 36.0 yards while **King** returned three kickoffs for 62 yards. Lebanon Valley would put together a 12-play, 95-yard drive moving down to the Moravian four-yard line with quarterback/punter Colt Zarilla leading the offense. Zarilla had a 28-yard completion to Brennan to move the ball to the Moravian five-yard line. The Flying Dutchmen settled for a 21-yard field goal from kicker Dan DiBona with 12:22 remaining in the game for the final points of the contest. Fick completed 15 of 19 passes for 201 yards with an interception while Zarilla was three-for-five for 76 yards, and Zarilla punted three times for an average of 40.7 yards for the Flying Dutchmen. **Donovan** caught six passes for 57 yards while **Guiles** hauled in four catches for 42 yards to go with a game high 135 yards and a touchdown on 16 carries. **Brennan** added three receptions for 104 yards while Scott had 37 yards on ten carries. Panasuk was 13 of 23 in the game for the Greyhounds for 118 yards while being sacked three times. Sylvainus caught three passes for 33 yards while tight end Mike Zanoni (Bethlehem, PA/Freedom HS) had two catches for 29 yards. Falco added two receptions for 23 yards. Running back Rocco Del Priore (Center Valley, PA/Southern Lehigh HS) led the Moravian rushing attack with 22 yards on nine carries as the Greyhounds were limited to 14 total rushing yards on 25 carries. Running back Langston Ross (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) had ten yards on eight carries, and he added three kickoff returns for 70 yards. Homer led the Lebanon Valley defense with seven tackles including four for loss, one and a half sacks, two forced fumbles and a fumble recovery. Defensive back Dane Eichelberger and junior linebacker Alex Gilchrist each had six tackles including one for loss, and Gilchrist also had two pas break-ups. Defensive back Brad Bodine led the Greyhound defense with ten tackles while Bauer had nine tackles with a half a tackle for loss, an interception and a pass break-up. Defensive back Kyle Krupa and defensive back David Wacker (Parkton, MD/Hereford HS) each added six tackles for Moravian. Defensive lineman Allen Petros (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) had the Greyhounds' only sack among his four tackles.

THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE STATISTICAL RANKINGS:

The Greyhounds are first in the Centennial Conference in total defense, allowing 167.5 yards per game. The squad is third in passing defense at 111.0 yards per game, and the defense is second in rushing yards allowed at 56.5 per game. The Greyhounds are fourth in points allowed at 9.5 per game, and the squad is sixth in points scored per game at 11.0. Offensively, Moravian is seventh in the Centennial Conference at 235.0 yards per game. The Greyhounds are ranked sixth in rushing offense at 92.5 yards per game and sixth in passing offense at 142.5 yards per game. Moravian is tied for third in turnover margin with a +1.0 per game average as the Greyhounds have committed three turnovers while forcing five turnovers. Moravian also leads the Centennial Conference in kickoff returns with an average of 24.5 yards per return and opponent third down conversions at just 13.0 percent (three-for-23). The Greyhounds are also tied for first in point-after kicking, making 100 percent (two-for-two). Individually, freshman quarterback Phil Gardner (Mechanicsville, VA/Lee-Davis HS) is fifth in the Centennial Conference in passing yards per game at 142.5, and he is sixth in total office at 150.0 yards per contest and ninth in pass efficiency with a 100.5 rating. Senior wide receiver Shawn Sylvainus is tied for sixth in the conference in receiving yards per game at 53.0, and he is tied for seventh in reception per contest with 4.0. Senior wide receiver Alex Hersch (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS) is second in the Centennial Conference in punt returns with an average of 10.6 yards per return, and he is 12th in receiving yards per contest at 42.5 and tied for 14th in receptions per game at 3.0. Senior punter Eric Dziengelski is ninth in the conference in punting with an average of 28.5 yards while junior kicker Ian Heck is fifth in kick scoring at 4.0 points per game, tied for second in field goals at 1.0 per contest and fourth in field goal percentage at 66.7 percent (two-forthree). Junior linebacker Phil Bortz (Allentown, PA/Parkland HS) is tied for 18th in the Centennial Conference in tackles with an average of 6.5 per game and tied for sixth in tackles for loss at 1.5 per contest while sophomore linebacker Jake Hildebrand and senior defensive back Daniel Burley (Easton, PA/Easton HS) are both tied for 23rd at 6.0 tackles per game. **Burley** is also tied for second in passes defended at 2.0 per contest, and he is one of four Greyhounds including sophomore defensive back Matt Johnson (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS), sophomore defensive back Travis King and freshman defensive back Zach Szoke (Walnutport, PA/Northampton HS) who are tied for ninth with 0.50 interceptions per contest. Senior defensive lineman Allen Petros is tied for 31st in tackles at 5.5 per game, and he is tied for sixth in tackles for loss with 1.5 per contest. **King** and junior defensive back **David Wacker** are tied for 37th in tackles at 5.0 per game while **Wacker** is tied for sixth in passes defended at 1.0 per contest.

SCOUTING LEBANON VALLEY COLLEGE: The Flying Dutchmen enter the game with a 0-2 record after a 17-14 loss to Grove City College on Saturday. Senior quarterback Caleb Fick has completed 15 of 41 passes for 234 yards with one interception this season, and he has run for 47 yards and a touchdown on 11 carries. Fick's top targets have been senior wide receiver Tim Picerno, who has six receptions for 112 yards, and junior running back Ben Guiles, who has four catches for 58 yards. Guiles leads the Lebanon Valley rushing attack with 312 yards and four touchdowns on 47 carries while senior running back Blair Ransom has 78 yards and a score on 16 attempts. Senior defensive back **Nic Shirev** has returned seven punts for 78 yards, and he has five kickoff returns for 141 yards. Senior kicker Brittany Ryan is four-for-five on extra-points this season and has not attempted a field goal while freshman Sean Fakete is averaging 56.2 yards on eight kickoffs with one touchback. The Flying Dutchmen have had four different players punt the ball this season with sophomore Kevin Greene averaging 37.3 yards on seven punts with two touchbacks and four inside the 20-yard line. Senior linebacker Jason Gigous has the Flying Dutchmen's only interception of the year, which he returned 44 yards. Junior defensive end Cory Homer leads the Lebanon Valley defense with 19 tackles including two tackle for loss and a sack while Gigous has 15 tackles and a total of two passes defended. Senior linebacker Alex Gilchrist has made 14 tackles with ten solo stops, four tackles for loss, a sack, a pass break-up and a fumble recovery while senior linebacker Bryn **Duffield** and senior safety **Dane Eichelberger** each had 13 tackles with one for loss. Senior defensive end Zach Bleiler has 12 tackles this season for Lebanon Valley with two for loss and a blocked kick while sophomore linebacker A.J. Kuhns has made 11 tackles.

THE QUARTERBACKS: Freshman **Phil Gardner** was named the starting quarterback after a strong competition in camp, and he has completed 27 of 48 passes for 285 yards with one touchdown and three interceptions. His longest completion this season is a 45-yard touchdown pass against McDaniel College. **Gardner** has run for 15 yards on 18 carries this season while being sacked three times. Freshman quarterback **Brandon Lesko (Catasauqua, PA/Catasauqua HS)** has seen action on the field but has not thrown a pass this season.

IN THE BACKFIELD: In the backfield, sophomore running back Rocco Del Priore has run for 92 yards and a touchdown on 38 carries while sophomore running back Joe Tegan (Haddonfield, NJ/Haddon Township HS) has 76 yards on 21 attempts. Junior running back Philip Redline gained two yards on his only carry against Susquehanna University while junior running back Langston Ross has a yard on one attempt.

THE WIDE RECEIVERS: The Greyhounds have had seven different players catch a pass through two games led by senior wide receiver Shawn Sylvainus with eight catches for 106 yards. Senior wide receiver Alex Hersch has six receptions for 85 yards including a 45-yard touchdown pass while sophomore wide receiver Ryan Onushco (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS) bas five catches for 45 yards. Junior tight end Mike Zanoni has grabbed three passes for 23 yards before an injury knocked him out of the game at McDaniel College while sophomore running back Rocco Del Priore has three catches for two yards. Sophomore running back Joe Tegan has one reception for 14 yards while senior tight end Jason Pauloski (Bloomington, PA/Butler HS) has one catch for ten yards.

OFFENSIVE LINE: Seniors Daniel Cancelliere (Succasunna, NJ/Roxbury HS), Matthew Washer (Ogdensburg, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS) and Thomas Mulligan (Ardmore, PA/Episcopal Academy) are back on the offensive line. Joining the starting line-up will be junior center Nicholas Guerriero (New Providence, NJ/New Providence HS) and sophomore Billy Viscuso (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS). The Greyhounds' front five has an average size of 6-1, 271. Sophomore Jim Tersigni (Phillipsburg, NJ/Phillipsburg HS) started last week at McDaniel for an injured Mulligan.

DEFENSIVE FRONT: Senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros** leads the Moravian defensive line with 11 tackles including three for loss while junior defensive lineman **Seth Payne** (**Collingswood**, **NJ/Collingswood HS**) has nine tackles with one for loss. Senior defensive lineman **Michael McClarin** (**Bethlehem**, **PA/Liberty HS**) made three tackles with one for loss this season while junior defensive lineman **Patrick Gordon** (**Bethlehem**, **PA/Notre Dame HS**) has one stop.

THE LINEBACKER CORPS: Senior linebacker Philip Bortz leads the linebackers and the Greyhound defense with 13 tackles with three tackles for loss and a pass break-up while sophomore linebacker Jake Hildebrand has 12 tackles with two for loss and an interception. Junior linebacker Evan Bauer has contributed eight tackles while junior linebacker Stephen Kircher (Manasquan, NJ/Manasquan HS) had eight tackles with a half a tackle for loss and a pass break-up before leaving the game against McDaniel with a season-ending injury. Junior linebacker Ryan hartzell (Easton, PA/Easton HS) has seven tackles with one and a half stops for loss in his debut season at Moravian while sophomore linebacker Tyler Potterton (Closter, NJ/NVRHS Demarest HS) has one tackle.

THE DEFENSIVE BACKFIELD: In the defensive backfield, senior defensive back Daniel Burley has 12 tackles with a half a tackle for loss, an interception and three pass break-ups for a total of four passes defended. Sophomore defensive back Travis King had ten tackles with one for loss and an interception before leaving the McDaniel College game with an injury. Junior safety David Wacker has made ten tackles with one for loss and two pass break-ups while sophomore defensive back Matt Johnson has six tackles and an interception he returned 21 yards at McDaniel. Freshman defensive back Zach Szoke came on when King was injured and has four tackles, an interception and a pass break-up while senior defensive back Thomas Dailey (Easton, PA/Notre Dame HS) has two tackles.

KICKING GAME: Junior kicker **Ian Heck** is two-for-three on field goals this season with a long of 25 yards. His only miss was just shy of the crossbar from 45 yard. **Heck** is two-for-two on extra-point attempts, and he is averaging 58.2 yards per kickoff on six attempts with one touchback. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski** has punted ten times for an average of 28.5 yards per punt with a career long of 57 yards at Susquehanna University. **Dziengelski** has had one punt fair caught and one inside the 20-yard line.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has five punt returns for 53 yards including a long of 20 yards against Susquehanna University while sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has returned two kickoffs for 49 yards with a long of 27 yards. Junior running back **Langston Ross** has two kickoff returns for 44 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Ryan Onushco** has two kickoff returns for 54 yards including a team long of 35 yards at McDaniel College.

STARTERS PLAYER OF THE GAME: As part of Moravian's radio contract with Fox Sports Radio 1470 AM WSAN The Fox, the announcers will select the Starters Player of the Game for Moravian during the Post-Game Show. Last week, senior wide receiver Alex Hersch was selected as the Starters Player of the Game for his performance. Hersch caught six passes for 85 yards including a 45-yard touchdown reception in Moravian's 13-10 loss at McDaniel College. Starters Riverport, Starters Pub and Starter

Clubhouse Grille, sponsors of Moravian College Athletics, are located on 2nd Street, Route 378 South of Bethlehem and the Bethlehem Municipal Golf Course.

WINNING WAYS: Moravian had 11 consecutive winning seasons—all under Coach **Scot Dapp**, from 1987 to 1997 and has had 17 winning seasons in **Dapp's** 24 years. The 11-straight winning seasons is the longest in school history. **Dapp** ranks third among Greyhound coaches in winning percentage.

OVERTIME 'HOUNDS: Moravian has played a total of nine overtime games since the NCAA instituted the rule for the 1996 season and is 7-2 all-time in the extra-session. Five of those nine overtime games have been against Juniata College with the Greyhounds going 4-1 in those games. Moravian's contest in Huntingdon in 2008 marked the first time in the Greyhounds' have needed more than one overtime session in a game. The 2008 season also marked the second year that Moravian has played two overtimes games in one season, the other year was 1999.
