THE GAME: Moravian looks to snap a two-game losing streak as the Greyhounds host Johns Hopkins University in a Centennial Conference game. Kickoff is slated for 2:00 p.m. at Rocco Calvo Field in Bethlehem for Moravian's annual Family Day game.

COACH TO CURE MD: For the second straight season, the coaching staffs from both schools will be participating in the Coach to Cure MD project. For the third year in a row, college football coaches nationwide will join together in support of the Coach to Cure MD program. The rapidly growing annual effort has raised more than half a million dollars to battle Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy. On September 25th, American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) members will wear a Coach to Cure MD logo patch on the sidelines and college football fans will be asked to donate to research projects supported by Parent Project Muscular Dystrophy, the largest nonprofit organization in the U.S. focused entirely on Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy.

THE COACHES: Scot Dapp (West Chester '73) is in his 24th season at Moravian, with a career record of 138-101-1 (.577), the winningest football coach in Moravian history. He entered the season in the top 50 in winning percentage among NCAA Division III active coaches. Dapp, who served as the president of the American Football Coaches Association in 2005, has earned Coach-of-the-Year honors from the MAC three times including Co-Coach of the Year in 1997 and has led the 'Hounds to two appearances in the NCAA playoffs, the ECAC Southeast Bowl game in 2002, the ECAC Southwest Bowl game in 2004, 2005 and 2008, winning the title in 2005.

Johns Hopkins coach Jim Margraff (Johns Hopkins '82) has a record of 130-76-3 (.629) in his 21st year at the school. Coach Margraff was the Blue Jays starting quarterback in the school's first three wins against Moravian.

THE SERIES: Saturday's meeting will be the 12th in the series with Moravian holding a 7-4 lead. Johns Hopkins posted a 27-0 win last season in Baltimore while the Greyhounds earned a 33-10 win in Bethlehem in 2008. Moravian captured the 2007 game, 44-41 in Baltimore. The Greyhounds won the previous meeting in the series with a 17-7 victory in Bethlehem back in 1982.

40s ARE WILD: When Moravian and Johns Hopkins University each scored over 40 points in the Greyhounds 44-41 win in 2007, it marked the first time in school history for both schools that they had participated in a game in which both teams scored more than 40 points. The closest Moravian had been before was a 45-39 loss to Albright College in 2004. The Greyhounds did it again in 2008 in a 48-41 loss at Gettysburg College.

GREYHOUNDS IN THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE: Moravian joined the Centennial Conference as an associate member in the sport of football in 2007. The Greyhounds were selected eighth in the Centennial Conference preseason coaches and sports information directors poll while Johns Hopkins was selected to repeat as champions with 11 first-place votes.

ON THE AIRWAVES: For the 14th straight year, the Greyhounds' games will be on the radio. Moravian's games will be aired on WSAN 1470 AM The Fox for the seventh straight year. Phil May calls the play-by-play call with color commentary from Craig Barnes and technical assistance from John Elliott. The pre-game show starts one hour prior to kickoff.

Greyhounds are ranked ninth in rushing offense at 57.7 yards per game and ninth in passing offense at 157.7 yards per game. Moravian is tied for third in turnover margin with a +0.67 per game average as the Greyhounds have committed five turnovers while forcing seven turnovers. Moravian also leads the Centennial Conference in pass defense efficiency with an 83.5 rating, fewest penalty yards per game at 37.0 and time of possession, holding onto the ball for 34:15 per game. Individually, freshman quarterback **Phil Gardner (Mechanicsville, VA/Lee-Davis HS)** is ninth in the Centennial Conference in passing yards per game at 157.7, and he is ninth in total offense at 143.0 yards per contest and ninth in pass efficiency with a 105.9 rating. Senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** is tied for tenth in the conference in receptions per game at 4.33, and he 11th in receiving yards per contest at 56.0. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS)** is fifth in the Centennial Conference in punt returns with an average of 8.1 yards per return, and he is 13th in receiving yards per contest at 53.3 and tied for ninth in touchdown scoring at 4.0 points per game. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski (Coatesville, PA/Chestnut Hill Academy)** is ninth in the conference in punting with an average of 30.9 yards while junior kicker **Ian Heck (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** is seventh in kick scoring at 2.7 points per game, sixth in field goals at 0.67 per contest and tied for third in field goal percentage at 66.7 percent (two-for-three). Sophomore linebacker **Jake Hildebrand (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS)** and junior defensive back **David Wacker (Parkton, MD/Hereford HS)** are tied for 22nd in tackles at 6.3 per game while junior linebacker **Phil Bortz (Allentown, PA/Parkland HS)** is tied for 35th in the Centennial Conference in tackles with an average of 5.3 per game. Senior defensive back **Daniel Burley (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** is tied for 37th in tackles at 5.0 per game, and he is tied for seventh in passes defended at 1.33 per contest. **Burley** is one of four Greyhounds including sophomore defensive back **Matt Johnson (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS)**, **Hildebrand** and freshman defensive back **Zach Szoke (Walnutport, PA/Northampton HS)** who are tied for 13th with 0.33 interceptions per contest. Sophomore defensive back **Travis King (Wilmington, DE/Concord HS)** is tied for fourth in interceptions at 0.50 per game, and he is also tied for 37th in tackles at 5.0 per contest. Senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** is tied for eighth in tackles for loss with 1.17 per contest while **Wacker** is tied for ninth in passes defended at 1.0 per contest. Junior defensive lineman **Seth Payne (Collingswood, NJ/Collingswood HS)** is tied for fourth in fumbles recovered at 0.33 per game.

SCOUTING JOHNS HOPKINS UNIVERSITY: The Blue Jays enter Saturday's game with an overall record of 1-1 and a 1-0 slate in Centennial Conference action after defeating Gettysburg College, 29-21, last weekend. Junior quarterback **Hewitt Tomlin** leads Johns Hopkins on the field, having completed 42 of 69 passes for 710 yards with four touchdowns and four interceptions. His top targets have been sophomore wide receiver **Scott Cremens**, who has 13 receptions for 180 yards, senior wide receiver **Tucker Michels**, who has caught 11 passes for 193 yards and a score, and junior wide receiver **Sam Wernick**, who has ten catches for team highs of 248 yards and three touchdowns. Sophomore running back **Jonathan Rigaud** leads the Blue Jays' rushing attack with 148 yards and two touchdowns on 38 carries while junior **Nick Fazio** has 62 yards and a score on 26 attempts. Junior quarterback **Tyler Porco** has contributed 38 yards and a touchdown on 12 rushing attempts. **Wernick** has returned seven punts for 149 yards while four different Johns Hopkins players each have

BALANCED & EXPERIENCED 'HOUNDS: Of the 84 players on the Moravian roster, 35 are freshmen, 20 are sophomores and 15 are juniors. There are 14 seniors on this season's squad, and the Greyhounds return 42 letterwinners and 14 starters.

MILESTONE WATCH: The Greyhounds have one player closing in on milestones for his career. Senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus (Nazareth, PA/Nazareth HS)** currently has 1,263 yards on 87 career receptions, and he needs just 137 yards to crack the top ten in school history and 13 receptions to become the seventh player in Moravian history to catch 100 career passes. **Sylvainus** is currently ninth in receptions, needing four more to move into seventh and tied for 14th in receiving yardage.

THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE STATISTICAL RANKINGS: The Greyhounds are first in the Centennial Conference in total defense, allowing 212.0 yards per game. The squad is second in passing defense at 127.0 yards per game, and the defense is third in rushing yards allowed at 85.0 per game. The Greyhounds are fourth in points allowed at 13.3 per game, and the squad is ninth in points scored per game at 9.3. Offensively, Moravian is ninth in the Centennial Conference at 215.3 yards per game. The

one punt return this fall. Senior kicker **Alex Lachman** has 12 points this season, and he is two-for-three on field goal attempts with a long of 37 yards. **Lachman** is six-for-none on extra-points and averaging 50.5 yards per kickoff. Senior punter **Max Islinger** is averaging 34.1 yards on ten punts with one fair caught and one inside the 20-yard line. Junior linebacker **Ryan Piatek** lead the Blue Jays' defense with 19 tackles including two tackles for loss, an interception and a forced fumble. Junior defensive back **Mike Milano** has 14 tackles with one for loss, an interception and four total passes defended while junior linebacker **Tyler Brown** has 13 tackles with a half sack. Junior linebacker **Kale Sweeney** has 12 stops, a half a sack and a pass break-up for Johns Hopkins while junior defensive lineman **Dan Keenan** has contributed 11 tackles with two for loss, a sack and a pass break-up. Junior defensive back **Sam Eagleson** has nine tackles, one for loss, an interception with a 22-yard return and a total of four passes defended.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET: In Baltimore last fall, quarterback **Hewitt Tomlin** completed 18 of 27 passes for 227 yards with two touchdown passes to wide receiver **Dan Crowley** to lead the Johns Hopkins University to a 27-0 Centennial Conference victory over Moravian at Homewood Field. Moravian received the opening kickoff but turned the ball over immediately when Hopkins defensive back **Mike Milano** intercepted a pass by Moravian quarterback **Steve Panasuk** at the Moravian 29-yard line, and a three-yard return set up the Blue Jays' offense at the Moravian 26-yard line. However, the Greyhound defense would hold, forcing Johns Hopkins to have kicker **Alex Lachman** attempt a 39-yard field goal, which he missed. The Greyhounds picked up a first down on their next possession on a ten-yard pass from **Panasuk** to wide receiver **Alex Hersch**, but Moravian would eventually punt the ball to the Blue Jays. Johns Hopkins took over at its 43-yard line and put together a seven-play, 57-yard drive to take the lead. **Tomlin** found **Crowley** with an 11-yard touchdown pass. **Lachman's** extra-point gave the Blue Jays a 7-0 lead with 6:30 to play in the first quarter. Moravian was able to pick up a first down on its next drive on a one-yard run by running back **Ryan Rempe** but the Greyhounds punted again. The Blue Jays started their next possession at their own 33-yard line, and Johns Hopkins would take 5:15 off of the clock before scoring. Running back **Andrew Kase** finished off the 13-play, 67-yard drive with a seven-yard touchdown. **Lachman's** extra-point gave Johns Hopkins a 14-0 lead with 13:12 left in the second quarter. The Greyhounds would take possession at their own 34-yard line but were unable to pick-up a first down before punter **Eric Dziengelski** came in for his third punt of the game. Johns Hopkins faced a third-and-15 on its next possession when **Tomlin** was intercepted at midfield by Greyhound defensive back **Brad Bodine**, who returned it to 11 yards to the Johns Hopkins 39-yard line. **Rempe** would gain a first down on an option play to move Moravian down the Blue Jay 29-yard line. The Greyhounds faced a fourth-and five when **Panasuk's** attempted shovel pass to **Rempe** was intercepted by Johns Hopkins defensive end **Brian Peters**, who returned it to the Johns Hopkins 36-yard line. The Blue Jays would move right down the field to take a 17-0 lead with 2:38 before the intermission when **Lachman** capped off the drive with a 21-yard field goal, capping off the seven-play, 61-yard drive. During the possession, **Tomlin** connected on an 18-yard pass to wide receiver **Sam Wernick** on a third-and-six play, and a 33-yard completion to **Crowley** on the next play to move inside the Moravian 10-yard line. Moravian lost yardage on its next drive after a 13-

yard sack of **Panasuk** by Johns Hopkins defensive lineman **Jordan Rudolph** and defensive end **Dan Keenan** on second down. Johns Hopkins picked up a first down and was looking to get down for another score before halftime but **Bodine** would intercept **Tomlin** again, this time at the Moravian 11-yard line with 57 seconds left in the first half. Moravian ran out the clock to end the half. The Blue Jays received the opening kickoff of the second half and picked up one first down before punting to the Greyhounds. Moravian ran just three plays before **Dziengelski** punted again, this time getting off a 51-yard punt. Johns Hopkins took over at its own 27-yard line after the punt and moved 67 yards in 12 plays before extending the lead to 20-0 on a 23-yard field goal by **Lachman** with 3:02 to play in the third quarter. Defensive back **Travis King** set up the Moravian offense with a 43-yard kickoff return to the Hopkins 42-yard line. However, the Greyhounds would turn the ball over on downs when a rush by **King** on a fake punt came up short. After a first down, the Blue Jays would punt. Two plays after the punt, Moravian quarterback **Patrick Weiss** was intercepted by Blue Jay linebacker **Ryan Piatek**. Johns Hopkins needed one play to extend the score with **Tomlin** finding **Crowley** with a 24-yard touchdown pass. **Lachman's** made the extra-point for a 27-0 Johns Hopkins lead with 13:57 remaining in the game. The teams traded punts on their next possessions. Moravian would eventually take over at its own nine-yard line. The Greyhounds doubled their first down total on the drive with three first downs on the drive including a pair of fourth-down runs and a 31-yard completion from **Weiss** to wide receiver **Eric Woodruff**. However, Moravian eventually turned the ball over on downs. Johns Hopkins would move the ball down the field on the ground to run out the clock. The Blue Jays finished the game 411 yards on 73 plays with **Kase** leading the ground attack with 90 yards on 21 carries with his one touchdown. **Tomlin** added 36 yards on six carries while running back **Nick Fazio** had 17 yards on three attempts. **Crowley** caught six passes for 124 yards while **Wernick** grabbed four passes for 46 yards while wide receiver **D.J. Hartigan** had three catches for 21 yards. The Moravian offense was held to just 95 yards on 55 plays. **Rempe** had 39 yards on 20 carries in his return to the line-up, moving within 69 yards of 1,000 for his career. **Panasuk** completed six of 15 passes for 37 yards with two interceptions while **Weiss** was four-for-11 for 42 yards. **Hersch** caught two passes for 17 yards while wide receiver **Ray Olivo** had 14 yards on two carries. **Milano** led the Johns Hopkins defense with eight tackles including one for loss to go with his interception while defensive end **Glenn Rocca** had six tackles with two for loss. Linebacker **Philip Bortz** and linebacker **Evan Bauer** (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) each had 12 tackles to lead the Moravian defense with each player adding a tackle for loss. Defensive back **Daniel Burley** added 11 tackles while defensive back **Kyle Krupa** had seven tackles with a half tackle for loss. **Bodine** had four tackles with a tackle for loss to go with his two interceptions.

THE QUARTERBACKS: Freshman **Phil Gardner** was named the starting quarterback after a strong competition in camp, and he has completed 41 of 73 passes for 473 yards with two touchdowns and five interceptions. His longest completion this season is a 53-yard touchdown pass against Lebanon Valley College. **Gardner** has been sacked ten times for negative rushing yards on 28 attempts. Freshman quarterback **Brandon Lesko** (Catasauqua, PA/Catasauqua HS) has seen action on the field but has not thrown a pass this season and he has been sacked once. Junior quarterback **Max Coveleski** (Lewes, DE/Cape Henlopen HS) has also been on the field but has yet to attempt a pass while being sacked once.

IN THE BACKFIELD: In the backfield, sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** (Center Valley, PA/Southern Lehigh HS) has run for 109 yards and a touchdown on 49 carries while sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** (Haddonfield, NJ/Haddon Township HS) has 105 yards on 29 attempts. Junior running back **Philip Redline** (Jim Thorpe, PA/Jim Thorpe HS) has gained five yards on two carries while junior running back **Langston Ross** (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) has 11 yards on three attempts.

THE WIDE RECEIVERS: The Greyhounds have had eight different players catch a pass through three games led by senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** with 13 catches for 168 yards. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has ten receptions for 160 yards including a 45-yard touchdown and

a 53-yard touchdown while sophomore wide receiver **Ryan Onushco** (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS) has five catches for 45 yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Pat Meeres** (Mount Laurel, NJ/Lenape HS) has caught four passes for 51 yards while junior tight end **Mike Zaroni** (Bethlehem, PA/Freedom HS) grabbed three passes for 23 yards before an injury knocked him out of the game at McDaniel College. Sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has four catches for two yards while sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** has one reception for 14 yards. Senior tight end **Jason Pauloski** (Bloomington, PA/Butler HS) has one catch for ten yards.

OFFENSIVE LINE: Seniors **Daniel Cancelliere** (Succasunna, NJ/Roxbury HS), **Matthew Washer** (Ogdensburg, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS) and **Thomas Mulligan** (Ardmore, PA/Episcopal Academy) are back on the offensive line. Joining the starting line-up will be junior center **Nicholas Guerriero** (New Providence, NJ/New Providence HS) and sophomore **Billy Viscuso** (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS). The Greyhounds' front five has an average size of 6-1, 271. Sophomore **Jim Tersigni** (Phillipsburg, NJ/Phillipsburg HS) started last week at McDaniel for an injured Mulligan.

DEFENSIVE FRONT: Senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros** leads the Moravian defensive line with 13 tackles including three and a half for loss while junior defensive lineman **Seth Payne** has 11 tackles with one for loss, a pass break-up and a fumble recovery. Senior defensive lineman **Michael McClarin** (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) has made four tackles with one for loss and a pass break-up this season while junior defensive lineman **Patrick Gordon** (Bethlehem, PA/Notre Dame HS) has two stops.

THE LINEBACKER CORPS: Sophomore linebacker **Jake Hildebrand** leads the linebackers and is tied for the team lead with 19 tackles including two and a half for loss and an interception. Senior linebacker **Philip Bortz** has added 16 tackles with three for loss and on pass break-up while junior linebacker **Evan Bauer** has contributed 12 tackles with two for loss. Junior linebacker **Ryan Hartzell** (Easton, PA/Easton HS) has 11 tackles with one and a half stops for loss and a pass break-up in his debut season at Moravian while junior linebacker **Stephen Kircher** (Manasquan, NJ/Manasquan HS) had eight tackles with a half a tackle for loss and a pass break-up before leaving the game against McDaniel with a season-ending injury. Junior linebacker **Douglas DiMattia** (Cedar Grove, NJ/Cedar Grove HS) has four tackles with one for loss while sophomore linebacker **Tyler Potterton** (Closter, NJ/NVRHS Demarest HS) has three tackles and a pass break-up this fall.

THE DEFENSIVE BACKFIELD: In the defensive backfield, junior defensive back **David Wacker** is tied for the team lead with 19 tackles to go with one tackle for loss, and interception and three passes defended. Senior defensive back **Daniel Burley** has contributed 15 tackles with a half a tackle for loss, an interception and a total of four passes defended while sophomore defensive back **Matt Johnson** has 13 tackles, a half a tackle for loss and three passes defended including an interception he returned 21 yards at McDaniel College. Sophomore defensive back **Travis King** had ten tackles with one for loss and an interception before leaving the McDaniel College game with an injury. Freshman defensive back **Zach Szoke** came on when **King** was injured and has seven tackles, an interception and a pass break-up while senior defensive back **Thomas Dailey** (Easton, PA/Notre Dame HS) has five tackles.

KICKING GAME: Junior kicker **Ian Heck** is two-for-three on field goals this season with a long of 25 yards. His only miss was just shy of the crossbar from 45 yard. **Heck** is two-for-three on extra-point attempts, and he is averaging 58.0 yards per kickoff on eight attempts with one touchback. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski** has punted 16 times for an average of 30.9 yards per punt with a career long of 57 yards at Susquehanna University. **Dziengelski** has had three punts fair caught, two inside the 20-yard line, one touchback and one blocked.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has eight punt returns for 65 yards including a long of 20 yards against Susquehanna University while junior running back **Langston Ross** has five kickoff returns for 99 yards. Sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has returned two kickoffs for 49 yards with a long of 27 yards while sophomore

wide receiver **Ryan Onushco** has two kickoff returns for 54 yards including a team long of 35 yards at McDaniel College.

STARTERS PLAYER OF THE GAME: As part of Moravian's radio contract with Fox Sports Radio 1470 AM WSAN The Fox, the announcers will select the Starters Player of the Game for Moravian during the Post-Game Show. Last week, junior defensive back **David Wacker** was selected as the Starters Player of the Game for his performance. **Wacker** had nine tackles and an interception to lead the Greyhound defense in Moravian's 21-6 loss at Lebanon Valley College. Starters Riverport, Starters Pub and Starters Clubhouse Grille, sponsors of Moravian College Athletics, are located on 2nd Street, Route 378 South of Bethlehem and the Bethlehem Municipal Golf Course.

WINNING WAYS: Moravian had 11 consecutive winning seasons—all under Coach **Scot Dapp**, from 1987 to 1997 and has had 17 winning seasons in **Dapp's** 24 years. The 11-straight winning seasons is the longest

in school history. **Dapp** ranks third among Greyhound coaches in winning percentage.

OVERTIME 'HOUNDS: Moravian has played a total of nine overtime games since the NCAA instituted the rule for the 1996 season and is 7-2 all-time in the extra-session. Five of those nine overtime games have been against Juniata College with the Greyhounds going 4-1 in those games. Moravian's contest in Huntingdon in 2008 marked the first time in the Greyhounds' have needed more than one overtime session in a game. The 2008 season also marked the second year that Moravian has played two overtimes games in one season, the other year was 1999.
