THE GAME: Moravian looks to snap a three-game losing streak as the Greyhounds travel to Dickinson College for a Centennial Conference game. Kickoff is slated for 1:00 p.m. at Biddle Field in Carlisle, Pennsylvania.

THE COACHES: Scot Dapp (West Chester '73) is in his 24th season at Moravian, with a career record of 138-102-1 (.575), the winningest football coach in Moravian history. He entered the season in the top 50 in winning percentage among NCAA Division III active coaches. **Dapp**, who served as the president of the American Football Coaches Association in 2005, has earned Coach-of-the-Year honors from the MAC three times including Co-Coach of the Year in 1997 and has led the 'Hounds to two appearances in the NCAA playoffs, the ECAC Southeast Bowl game in 2002, the ECAC Southwest Bowl game in 2004, 2005 and 2008, winning the title in 2005.

Dickinson coach **Darwin Breaux** (West Chester '77) has a record of 111-64-1 (.634) in his 18th year at the school.

THE SERIES: Saturday's meeting will be the 14th in the series with Dickinson holding a 7-4-2 lead. The Red Devils posted a 21-3 win in Bethlehem last fall, and Dickinson earned a 16-7 win in Carlisle in 2008. The Red Devils left Bethlehem with a 24-23 victory in 2007. The schools had not met since 1980 when the Greyhounds earned a 33-12 victory, also in Bethlehem. Moravian has only won once in six trips to Carlisle, a 13-7 win back on September 26, 1936.

GREYHOUNDS IN THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE: Moravian joined the Centennial Conference as an associate member in the sport of football in 2007. The Greyhounds were selected eighth in the Centennial Conference preseason coaches and sports information directors poll while Dickinson was selected to finish fifth.

BALANCED & EXPERIENCED 'HOUNDS: Of the 84 players on the Moravian roster, 35 are freshmen, 20 are sophomores and 15 are juniors. There are 14 seniors on this season's squad, and the Greyhounds return 42 letterwinners and 14 starters.

MILESTONE WATCH: The Greyhounds have three players closing in on milestones for his career. Senior wide receiver Shawn Sylvainus (Nazareth, PA/Nazareth HS) currently has 1,311 yards on 89 career receptions, and he needs just 89 yards to crack the top ten in school history and 11 receptions to become the seventh player in Moravian history to catch 100 career passes. Sylvainus is currently ninth in receptions, needing two more to move into seventh and 11th in receiving yardage. Senior wide receiver Alex Hersch (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS) has moved into fourth in school history in punt returns with 38 returns for 228 yards. Hersch needs 15 more punt returns to move into third. Senior defensive end Allen Petros (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) is third in school history with 30 tackles for loss. Petros needs three tackles for loss to move into second place and 15 tackles for loss to break the school record.

ON THE AIRWAVES: For the 14th straight year, the Greyhounds' games will be on the radio. Moravian's games will be aired on WSAN 1470 AM The Fox for the seventh straight year. **Phil May** calls the play-by-play call with color commentary from **Craig Barnes** and technical assistance from **John Elliott.** The pre-game show starts one hour prior to kickoff.

THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE STATISTICAL RANKINGS: The Greyhounds are third in the Centennial Conference in total defense, allowing 263.2 yards per game. The squad is third in passing defense at 153.8 yards per game, and the defense is fourth in rushing yards allowed at 109.5 per game. The Greyhounds are fifth in points allowed at 20.2 per game, and the squad is ninth in points scored per game at 7.8. Offensively, Moravian is ninth in the Centennial Conference at 207.8 yards per game. The Greyhounds are ranked tenth in rushing offense at 62.0 yards per game and ninth in passing offense at 145.8 yards per game. Moravian is eighth in turnover margin with a -0.75 per game average as the Greyhounds have committed 11 turnovers while forcing eight turnovers. Individually, freshman quarterback Phil Gardner (Mechanicsville, VA/Lee-Davis HS) is ninth in the Centennial Conference in passing yards per game at 144.8, and he is ninth in total office at 137.2 yards per contest and 11th in pass efficiency with a 99.2 rating. Sophomore running back Joe Tegan (Haddonfield, NJ/Haddon Township HS) is 14th in the conference in rushing at 41.2 yards per game. Senior wide receiver Shawn Sylvainus is 14th in the conference in receptions per game at 3.75, and he 11th in receiving yards per contest at 54.0. Senior wide receiver Alex Hersch is fifth in the Centennial Conference in punt returns with an average of 7.5 yards per return, and he is 12th in receiving yards per contest at 50.0. Senior punter Eric Dziengelski (Coatesville, PA/Chestnut Hill Academy) is eighth in the conference in punting with an average of 32.2

yards while junior kicker Ian Heck (Easton, PA/Easton HS) is ninth in kick scoring at 2.8 points per game, tied for fourth in field goals at 0.75 per contest and tied for second in field goal percentage at 75.0 percent (three-Sophomore linebacker Jake Hildebrand (Emmaus, for-four). **PA/Emmaus HS**) is tied for 18th in the conference at 7.0 tackles per game, and he is tied for fourth in interceptions at 0.50 while junior defensive back David Wacker (Parkton, MD/Hereford HS) is tied for 20th in tackles at 6.8 per game. Junior linebacker Phil Bortz (Allentown, PA/Parkland HS) 26th in the Centennial Conference in tackles with an average of 6.2 per game while senior defensive back Daniel Burley (Easton, PA/Easton HS) is tied eighth in passes defended at 1.25 per contest. Sophomore defensive back Travis King (Wilmington, DE/Concord HS) is tied for fourth in interceptions at 0.50 per game, and he is also tied for 36th in tackles at 5.0 per contest. Sophomore defensive back Matt Johnson (Macungie, **PA/Emmaus HS**) is tied for 42nd in the conference in tackles at 4.8 per contest.

SCOUTING DICKINSON COLLEGE: The Red Devils enter Saturday's game with an overall record of 1-2 and a 1-1 slate in Centennial Conference action after defeating McDaniel College, 41-16, last weekend. Junior quarterback Ricky Martz leads Dickinson on the field having completed 46 of 69 passes for 580 yards with five touchdowns and three interceptions. The top targets have been senior wide receiver **Craig Helfer**, who has 16 receptions for 273 yards and three touchdowns, and senior running back Tim Smith, who has 12 catches for 99 yards. Smith also leads the Red Devil rushing attack with 137 yards and a touchdown on 30 carries. Freshman fullback Evan Fink has added 80 yards on 23 carries while Martz has 77 yards and two touchdowns on 28 rushing attempts. Junior running back Mike Shimkin has returned ten kickoffs for 167 yards and five punts for 51 yards. **Helfer** has four kickoff returns for 60 yards while freshman wide receiver Colin Rodgers has four punt returns for 12 yards. Senior kicker Gordon Craig is four-for-six on field goal attempts with a long of 47 yards, and he is averaging 31.9 yards per punt on 12 attempts with a long of 42 yards, two inside the 20-yard line and one blocked. Junior David London is averaging 59.6 yards per kickoff on 14 kicks this season. Junior defensive back Andrew Fink leads the Dickinson defense with 26 tackles including a half a tackle for loss and two pass break-ups. Senior linebacker Jack Connolly has added 21 tackles with three tackles for loss, two sacks and a pair of pass break-ups while junior defensive back Scott Sullivan has 20 tackles and four pass break-ups. Junior linebacker Julian Rosen has contributed 17 tackles with two for loss and a 22-yard fumble return for a touchdown while freshman defensive back Robert Spriggs has 15 tackles. Senior linebacker Pette Hamill has 14 tackles with two saves, two pass break-ups and a fumble recovery this season for the Red Devils.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET: In Bethlehem last fall, quarterback **Ian Mitchell** ran for two touchdowns to lead Dickinson to a 21-3 Centennial Conference win over Moravian at Rocco Calvo Field. **Mitchell**, who entered the game leading the Centennial Conference in rushing at 130 yards per game, was limited to 75 yards on 13 carries but scored twice. He also completed 12 of 21 passes for 124 yards. Dickinson received the opening kickoff but picked up just nine yards on three plays before punting. Moravian didn't fair much better on its opening possession, picking up one first down on a run by tailback **Ryan Rempe** before punting for the first of

seven times in the game. The Red Devils would pick up two first downs on their second drive after starting at their own nine-yard line, but Dickinson would be forced to punt. The Red Devils would need just four plays to get the ball back as defensive back Michael Maxwell intercepted a pass from Moravian quarterback Patrick Weiss at the Dickinson 29-yard line and returning it to the 34. Dickinson wasn't able to capitalize on the turnover as the Red Devils punted after three plays. Moravian would pick up a first down before Rempe fumbled at the Moravian 47-yard line after a hit by Red Devil defensive lineman Jose Rosa. The Red Devils needed just five plays to cover the 52-yards to the end zone after the turnover, Moravian's second of five turnovers in the game. Mitchell hit wide receiver Patrick O'Connor with a pair of first down completions before Mitchell ran in from six yards out for the score. Gordon Craig added the extra-point to put Dickinson up 7-0 with 1:30 left in the first quarter. Moravian was unable to move the ball and punted on the first play of the second quarter. Dickinson also had trouble moving the ball on its first possession of the second quarter, punting after picking up one first down. After another three-and-out by the Greyhound offense, Dickinson would move 27 yards in eight plays, setting Craig up for a 42-yard field goal attempt with 8:08 left in the second quarter. On Craig's attempt, Moravian defensive lineman Jacob Millen pushed through the left side of the line and blocked the attempt, Millen's second blocked kick of the season. On the Greyhound's second play of the drive, Rempe ran for ten yards, pushing him over 1,000 yards for his career, the 20th player in Moravian history to run for 1,000 yards. However, Moravian was unable to capitalize on the block as Weiss was intercepted by Dickinson senior defensive lineman Grav Gish at the Moravian 41-yard line. The interception was the second of three thrown by Weiss in the game as the Greyhounds rotated quarterbacks each possession between Weiss and Steve Panasuk. Mitchell would hit O'Connor with a ten-yard pass to move the Red Devils to the Moravian 30-yard line, two plays later running back Tim Smith would throw a halfback option pass to wide receiver Joe Sandoe for a 25-yard touchdown. Craig's extra-point gave Dickinson a 14-0 lead with 3:23 to go in the second quarter. On the ensuing kickoff, Moravian running back Langston Ross (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) had a 35-yard return to set the Greyhound offense up at its own 42-yard line. On a pair of first down rushes by Rempe including a 19yard run, and a 17-yard completion from Panasuk to wide receiver Alex Hersch, Moravian moved into the red zone for the first time in the game. On third-and-goal from the four-yard line, Panasuk was sacked, one of four times he was sacked in the contest, setting up Ian Heck for a 26-yard field goal attempt that was good to put the Greyhounds on the scoreboard for the first time in nine quarters and cutting the Dickinson lead to 14-3 with eight seconds left in the first half. Moravian received the opening kickoff of the second half but started from its own 16-yard line after a penalty. The Greyhounds picked up a first down on a **Rempe** run but would punt. **Eric** Dziengelski punted to the Dickinson 34-yard line where Smith fumbled a fair catch that Ross recovered for Moravian. The Greyhounds would lose yardage on the drive before Dziengelski punted again, pinning the Red Devils at their own two-yard line. Dickinson was only able to get the ball out to the ten-yard on its first possession of the second half before Craig punted. Moravian defensive back Travis King retuned the punt 29 yards to set the Greyhound offense up at the Dickinson 16-yard line. However, after Weiss was tackled for a loss on a quarterback option on third down, Heck

came on to attempt a 32-yard field goal that ended up wide left. The Red Devils punted after three plays, but King fumbled the punt, setting Dickinson up at the Moravian 39-yard line. The Greyhounds' defense would hold, forcing the Red Devils to turn the ball over on downs at the Moravian 30-yard line. The Greyhounds picked up two first downs on its next drive but had the drive stall just past midfield, punting on the second play of the fourth quarter. Dickinson would get a first down on a 17-yard pass from Mitchell to wide receiver Craig Helfer on its next possession but the Red Devils were eventually forced to punt for the seventh time in the game. Three plays into Moravian's drive, Maxwell would intercept Weiss again to set-up Dickinson offense at the Moravian 45-yard line. Mitchell and Smith would combine to run on six of the seven plays on the drive with Mitchell scoring from three yards out. Craig made the extra-point to give Dickinson a 21-3 lead with 8:54 remaining in the contest. King would take the ensuing kickoff at the Moravian seven-yard line and return it 56 yards to set the Greyhounds up at the Dickinson 36. However, the Greyhounds lost 11 yards in three plays and were forced to punt for the seventh time in the game with **Dziengelski's** punt downed at the Dickinson 12. The Red Devils picked up two first downs on their final possession of the game before punting with 1:42 on the clock. The Greyhounds picked up one first down on a pass from Weiss to tight end Mike Zanoni (Bethlehem, PA/Freedom HS) before the clock ran out to end the game. Dickinson had 340 yards on 65 plays in the game with running back Tim Wells running for 61 yards on ten carries and Smith adding 43 yards on 13 attempts. Gregory Lord added 14 yards on six carries while O'Connor caught five passes for 57 yards, but did not play in the second half. Sandoe grabbed three passes for 44 yards while Helfer had two catches for 23 yards. Moravian had 179 yards on 62 plays while holding the ball for 32:31 in the game. Rempe had his best game of the season, running for 169 yards on 37 carries, and he is now 19th in school history with 1,100 yards on just 289 carries. Fullback Michael Crann had nine yards on two attempts. King had two kickoff returns for 82 yards and five punt returns for 64 yards while Ross returned two kickoffs for 56 yards. Defensive back Pat McNeal led the Dickinson defense with 12 tackles while linebacker Kevin Wood had ten stops with one for loss. Linebacker Pete Hamill added nine tackles with one and a half sacks for the Red Devils while Maxwell had seven tackles with one for loss to go with his two interceptions. Defensive lineman Corwyn Gordon also made seven tackles. Defensive back David Wacker had a team high 12 tackles for the Moravian defense while defensive back Daniel Burley added ten tackles with one and a half for loss. Linebacker Evan Bauer (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) made nine stops while defensive back Brad Bodine added seven tackles and a forced fumble. Linebacker Philip Bortz had six stops with a pass break-up.

THE QUARTERBACKS: Freshman Phil Gardner was named the starting quarterback after a strong competition in camp, and he has completed 48 of 90 passes for 579 yards with two touchdowns and seven interceptions. His longest completion this season is a 53-yard touchdown pass against Lebanon Valley College. Gardner has been sacked 11 times for negative rushing yards on 32 attempts. Freshman quarterback Brandon Lesko (Catasauqua, PA/Catasauqua HS) has seen action on the field but has not thrown a pass this season and he has been sacked once. Junior quarterback Max Coveleski (Lewes, DE/Cape Henlopen HS) has also been on the field, completing one of four passes for four yards and an interception, and Coveleski has been sacked twice. Freshman quarterback Pat Catagnus (Trappe, PA/Perkiomen Valley HS) saw his first action of the season versus Johns Hopkins University but did not throw a pass.

IN THE BACKFIELD: In the backfield, sophomore running back Joe Tegan has 165 yards on 43 attempts while sophomore running back Rocco Del Priore (Center Valley, PA/Southern Lehigh HS) has run for 117 yards and a touchdown on a team high 54 carries. Junior running back Langston Ross has 17 yards on six attempts while junior running back Philip Redline (Jim Thorpe, PA/Jim Thorpe HS) has gained three yards on three carries.

THE WIDE RECEIVERS: The Greyhounds have had ten different players catch a pass through four games led by senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** with 15 catches for 216 yards. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has 12 receptions for 200 yards including a 45-yard touchdown and

a 53-yard touchdown while sophomore wide receiver Ryan Onushco (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS) has five catches for 45 yards. Sophomore wide receiver Pat Meeres (Mount Laurel, NJ/Lenape HS) has caught five passes for 59 yards while junior tight end Mike Zanoni (Bethlehem, PA/Freedom HS) grabbed three passes for 23 yards before an injury knocked him out for the season at McDaniel College. Sophomore running back Rocco Del Priore has five catches for four yards while sophomore running back Joe Tegan has one reception for 14 yards. Senior tight end Jason Pauloski (Bloomington, PA/Butler HS) has one catch for ten yards. Sophomore wide receiver Chase Zimnik (Milford, PA/Delaware Valley HS) has one catch for eight yards while junior running back Langston Ross has one reception for four yards.

OFFENSIVE LINE: Seniors Daniel Cancelliere (Succasunna, NJ/Roxbury HS), Matthew Washer (Ogdensburg, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS) and Thomas Mulligan (Ardmore, PA/Episcopal Academy) are back on the offensive line. Joining the starting line-up will be junior center Nicholas Guerriero (New Providence, NJ/New Providence HS) and sophomore Billy Viscuso (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS). The Greyhounds' front five has an average size of 6-1, 271. Sophomore Jim Tersigni (Phillipsburg, NJ/Phillipsburg HS) started at McDaniel College for an injured Mulligan, and Tersigni also saw action in the Johns Hopkins University contest.

DEFENSIVE FRONT: Senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros** leads the Moravian defensive line with 18 tackles including four and a half for loss while junior defensive lineman **Seth Payne** (Collingswood, NJ/Collingswood HS) has 15 tackles with one for loss, a pass break-up and a fumble recovery. Senior defensive lineman **Michael McClarin** (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) has made 12 tackles with one for loss and two pass break-ups this season while junior defensive lineman **Patrick Gordon** (Bethlehem, PA/Notre Dame HS) has three stops.

THE LINEBACKER CORPS: Sophomore linebacker Jake Hildebrand leads the linebackers and the Greyhound defense with 28 tackles including two and a half for loss and two interceptions. Senior linebacker Philip Bortz has added 25 tackles with three for loss and a pass break-up while junior linebacker Evan Bauer has contributed 16 tackles with two for loss and a pass break-up. Junior linebacker Ryan Hartzell (Easton, PA/Easton HS) has 17 tackles with two and a half stops for loss and a pass break-up in his debut season at Moravian while junior linebacker Stephen Kircher (Manasquan, NJ/Manasquan HS) had eight tackles with a half a tackle for loss and a pass break-up before leaving the game against McDaniel with a season-ending injury. Junior linebacker Douglas DiMattia (Cedar Grove, NJ/Cedar Grove HS), who made his first collegiate start against Johns Hopkins, has 11 tackles with one and a half for loss and a pass break-up while sophomore linebacker Tyler Potterton (Closter, NJ/NVRHS Demarest HS) has three tackles and a pass break-up this fall.

THE DEFENSIVE BACKFIELD: In the defensive backfield, junior defensive back David Wacker has made 27 tackles to go with one tackle for loss, a forced fumble, an interception and three passes defended. Senior defensive back Daniel Burley has contributed 17 tackles with a half a tackle for loss, an interception and a total of five passes defended while sophomore defensive back Matt Johnson has 19 tackles, a half a tackle for loss and three passes defended including an interception he returned 21 yards at McDaniel College. Sophomore defensive back Travis King had ten tackles with one for loss and an interception before leaving the McDaniel College game with an injury. Freshman defensive back Zach Szoke (Walnutport, PA/Northampton HS) came on when King was injured and has 14 tackles, an interception and a pass break-up while senior defensive back Thomas Dailey (Easton, PA/Notre Dame HS) has eight tackles. Senior defensive back Michael Burke (Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown) has added four stops this season.

KICKING GAME: Junior kicker **Ian Heck** is three-for-four on field goals this season with a career long of 41 yards versus Johns Hopkins University. **Heck** is two-for-three on extra-point attempts, and he is averaging 57.4 yards per kickoff on ten attempts with one touchback. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski** has punted 19 times for an average of 32.2 yards per punt with a career long of 57 yards at Susquehanna University. **Dziengelski** has had

three punts fair caught, three inside the 20-yard line, one touchback and one blocked. Sophomore **Tyler Thompson** (**Harrisburg**, **PA/Central Dauphin HS**) punted for the first time in his collegiate career in the Johns Hopkins game, and he averaging 29.0 yards per punt on three attempts with a long of 39 yards and two inside the 20-yard line.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has 11 punt returns for 83 yards including a long of 20 yards against Susquehanna University while junior running back **Langston Ross** has seven kickoff returns for 133 yards. **Hersch** also has three kickoff returns for 62 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Pat Meeres** has one kickoff return for ten yards. Sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has returned two kickoffs for 49 yards with a long of 27 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Ryan Onushco** has two kickoff returns for 54 yards including a team long of 35 yards at McDaniel College.

STARTERS PLAYER OF THE GAME: As part of Moravian's radio contract with Fox Sports Radio 1470 AM WSAN The Fox, the announcers will select the Starters Player of the Game for Moravian during the Post-Game Show. Last week, junior kicker Ian Heck was selected as the Starters Player of the Game for his performance. Heck made a career long 41-yard field goal for the Greyhounds' only points in a 41-3 loss to Johns Hopkins University. He also had two kickoffs for 110 yards. Starters Riverport, Starters Pub and Starters Clubhouse Grille, sponsors of Moravian

College Athletics, are located on 2nd Street, Route 378 South of Bethlehem and the Bethlehem Municipal Golf Course.

WINNING WAYS: Moravian had 11 consecutive winning seasons—all under Coach **Scot Dapp**, from 1987 to 1997 and has had 17 winning seasons in **Dapp's** 24 years. The 11-straight winning seasons is the longest in school history. **Dapp** ranks third among Greyhound coaches in winning percentage.

OVERTIME 'HOUNDS: Moravian has played a total of nine overtime games since the NCAA instituted the rule for the 1996 season and is 7-2 all-time in the extra-session. Five of those nine overtime games have been against Juniata College with the Greyhounds going 4-1 in those games. Moravian's contest in Huntingdon in 2008 marked the first time in the Greyhounds' have needed more than one overtime session in a game. The 2008 season also marked the second year that Moravian has played two overtimes games in one season, the other year was 1999.
