**THE GAME:** Moravian looks to get back to .500 in a Centennial Conference game at Gettysburg College. Kickoff is slated for 1:00 p.m. at Shirk Field at Musselman Stadium in Gettysburg, Pennsylvania.

**THE COACHES:** Scot Dapp (West Chester '73) is in his 24<sup>th</sup> season at Moravian, with a career record of 139-102-1 (.576), the winningest football coach in Moravian history. He entered the season in the top 50 in winning percentage among NCAA Division III active coaches. Dapp, who served as the president of the American Football Coaches Association in 2005, has earned Coach-of-the-Year honors from the MAC three times including Co-Coach of the Year in 1997 and has led the 'Hounds to two appearances in the NCAA playoffs, the ECAC Southeast Bowl game in 2002, the ECAC Southwest Bowl game in 2004, 2005 and 2008, winning the title in 2005.

Gettysburg coach Barry Streeter (Lebanon Valley '71) has a record of 156-157-5 (.498) in his 32<sup>nd</sup> year at the school.

**THE SERIES:** Saturday's meeting will be the ninth in the series with Gettysburg owning a 7-1 advantage. Moravian's only win in the series was the first in the series, a 17-7 win in 1978. Gettysburg won last season's meeting, 34-3, in Bethlehem, and the Bullets posted a wild 48-41 win in Gettysburg in 2008. The Bullets earned a 27-20 win in 2007 after the schools had not met since 1982. The Greyhounds have made just three trips to Shirk Field at Musselman Stadium and have lost all three games contests.

**CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE HONORS:** Junior kicker Ian Heck (Easton, PA/Easton HS) of Moravian has been named to Centennial Conference Co-Special Teams Player of the Week while sophomore defensive back/quarterback Matt Johnson (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS) and junior defensive lineman Seth Payne (Collingswood, NJ/Collingswood HS) were named to the Weekly Honor Roll for their performances in Moravian's 24-16 win at Dickinson College on last Saturday. Heck scored the game-winning field goal, a 39-yard boot in Moravian's win, and he scored six points including three extra-points. Heck had a 43-yard attempt blocked, and he missed from 46 yards, both would have been career longs. Heck kicked off five times for an average of 59.2 yards. Johnson, Moravian's starting strong safety for the first four games of the year, flipped to the offensive side of the ball to start at quarterback at Dickinson. Johnson, a high school quarterback who has been on defense since arriving at Moravian, completed ten of 23 passes for 174 yards with one interception, a ball that bounced out of the hands of a Moravian receiver. Johnson was also the leading rusher for the Greyhounds with 61 yards on 15 carries including a four-yard touchdown run. The Greyhounds' 320 yards of offense was the highest of the season for Moravian. Payne registered eight tackles in the game with three and a half tackles for loss. Payne also forced a fumble, one of two Moravian takeaways in the contest.

**ON THE AIRWAVES:** For the 14th straight year, the Greyhounds' games will be on the radio. Moravian's games will be aired on WSAN 1470 AM The Fox for the seventh straight year. Phil May calls the play-by-play call with color commentary from Craig Barnes and technical assistance from John Elliott. The pre-game show starts one hour prior to kickoff.

**Sylvainus** needs just five receptions to become the seventh player in Moravian history to catch 100 career passes. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS)** has moved into fourth in school history in punt returns with 43 returns for 262 yards. **Hersch** needs ten more punt returns to move into third. Senior defensive end **Allen Petros (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** is third in school history with 31 tackles for loss. **Petros** needs two tackles for loss to move into second place and 14 tackles for loss to break the school record.

#### THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE STATISTICAL RANKINGS:

The Greyhounds are third in the Centennial Conference in total defense, allowing 260.8 yards per game. The squad is second in passing defense at 160.8 yards per game, and the defense is third in rushing yards allowed at 100.0 per game. The Greyhounds are fourth in points allowed at 19.4 per game, and the squad is ninth in points scored per game at 11.0. Offensively, Moravian is ninth in the Centennial Conference at 230.2 yards per game. The Greyhounds are ranked eighth in rushing offense at 78.8 yards per game and ninth in passing offense at 151.4 yards per game. Moravian is eighth in turnover margin with a -0.40 per game average as the Greyhounds have committed 12 turnovers while forcing ten turnovers. Individually, freshman quarterback **Phil Gardner (Mechanicsville, VA/Lee-Davis HS)** is ninth in the Centennial Conference in passing yards per game at 144.8, and he is ninth in total office at 137.2 yards per contest and 11th in pass efficiency with a 99.2 rating. Sophomore quarterback/defensive back **Matt Johnson** is 12<sup>th</sup> in pass efficiency with a 98.3 rating, and he is 12<sup>th</sup> in passing yards per game at 34.8. Sophomore running back **Joe Tegan (Haddonfield, NJ/Haddon Township HS)** is 14<sup>th</sup> in the conference in rushing at 41.4 yards per game. Senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** is tenth in the conference in receptions per game at 4.20, and he fifth in receiving yards per contest at 71.6. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** is fourth in the Centennial Conference in punt returns with an average of 7.3 yards per return, and he is 13<sup>th</sup> in receiving yards per contest at 46.4. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski (Coatesville, PA/Chestnut Hill Academy)** is eighth in the conference in punting with an average of 34.0 yards per punt while junior kicker **Ian Heck** is tied for eighth in kick scoring at 3.4 points per game, tied for sixth in field goals at 0.80 per contest and tied for seventh in field goal percentage at 57.1 percent (four-for-seven). Sophomore linebacker **Jake Hildebrand (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS)** is 16<sup>th</sup> in the conference at 7.8 tackles per game, and he is tied for tenth in interceptions at 0.40 while junior defensive back **David Wacker (Parkton, MD/Hereford HS)** is 29<sup>th</sup> in tackles at 5.8 per game. Junior linebacker **Phil Bortz (Allentown, PA/Parkland HS)** is 28<sup>th</sup> in the Centennial Conference in tackles with an average of 6.2 per game while senior defensive back **Daniel Burley (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** is seventh in passes defended at 1.40 per contest and tied for tenth in interceptions at 0.40 per game. Junior linebacker **Ryan Hartzell (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** is tied for 38<sup>th</sup> in the conference at 5.0 tackles per contest.

**SCOUTING GETTYSBURG COLLEGE:** The Bullets enter the game with an overall record of 1-3 and 0-3 in Centennial Conference action after falling Ursinus College, 49-39, last weekend. Junior quarterback **Kyle Whitmoyer** leads Gettysburg on the field, having completed 61 of 105 passes for 739 yards with three touchdowns and four interceptions. **Whitmoyer's** top targets have been senior running back **Charles Curcio**, who has 16 catches for 190 yards and a touchdown, and sophomore tight end **Matt Brophy**, who has ten receptions for 179 yards. Senior running back **Jamel Mutunga** leads the Bullets rushing attack with 306 yards and four touchdowns on 75 carries while **Whitmoyer** has added 223 yards and

**GREYHOUNDS IN THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE:** Moravian joined the Centennial Conference as an associate member in the sport of football in 2007. The Greyhounds were selected eighth in the Centennial Conference preseason coaches and sports information directors poll while Gettysburg was selected to finish ninth.

**BALANCED & EXPERIENCED 'HOUNDS:** Of the 84 players on the Moravian roster, 35 are freshmen, 20 are sophomores and 15 are juniors. There are 14 seniors on this season's squad, and the Greyhounds return 42 letterwinners and 14 starters.

**MILESTONE WATCH:** The Greyhounds have three players closing in on milestones for his career. Senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus (Nazareth, PA/Nazareth HS)** currently has 1,453 yards on 95 career receptions, and he needs 125 yards to move into sixth in yardage and 133 yards to move into fifth.

Senior running back **Anthony DeSalva** has added 173 yards and two touchdowns on 53 carries while **Curcio** has 106 yards on 14 attempts. **DeSalva** has returned 13 kickoffs for 315 yards while **Curcio** has ten punt returns for 41 yards. Senior punter **Brian Betley** is averaging 36.9 yards per punt on 18 attempts with a long of 54 yards, two fair caught and five inside the 20-yard line. The Bullets have had three punts blocked this season. Senior kicker **Mike Barrett** is four-for-five on field goal attempts with a long of 44 yards, and he is averaging 60.6 yards per kickoff. Junior defensive back **Joe Delaney** leads the Gettysburg defense with 46 tackles including one and a half tackles for loss, one forced fumble and one of the team's four interceptions with a 46-yard return. Sophomore linebacker **Larry DelViscio** has contributed 43 tackles with four tackles for loss, one sack, two forced fumbles and one fumble recovery while junior linebacker **Peter Hak** has 43 tackles with one for loss, one pass break-up and a pair of blocked kicks. Junior linebacker **Marc Graziano** has 32 tackles, one interception and two total passes defended.

**THE LAST TIME THEY MET:** In Bethlehem last fall, tailback **Jamel Mutunga** ran for a career high 149 yards on 18 carries with two touchdowns including a 60-yard scoring run on the second play of the game to lead Gettysburg College to a 34-3 Centennial Conference victory over Moravian College at Rocco Calvo field. Gettysburg received the opening kickoff and needed just two plays to cover 69 yards with **Mutunga** running for nine yards on first down and 60 yards down the left side line on second down. Kicker **Mike Barrett** added the extra-point for a 7-0 Bullet lead just 29 seconds into the contest. Moravian picked up a first down on its initial drive on six straight runs from tailback **Ryan Rempe** but the Greyhounds would punt for the first of eight times in the game. The Bullets took over at their own 13-yard line and went 87 yards in 11 plays with quarterback **Matt Flynn** finding running back **Charles Curcio** with an eight-yard touchdown pass. **Barrett's** kick gave Gettysburg a 14-0 lead with 7:27 left in the first quarter. After a three-and-out by the Greyhounds, the Bullets offense would move down to the Moravian 29-yard line before turning the ball over on downs. Moravian would get a first down on a 12-yard run by **Rempe** but eventually punted. Gettysburg would start from its own 41-yard line and put together a 10-play, 59-yard drive capped off with a 20-yard touchdown pass from **Flynn** to tight end **A.J. Perrotti** on third-and-18. **Barrett's** extra-point attempt was wide to the right leaving the score 20-0 with 13:41 left in the second quarter. Moravian defensive back/kick returner **Travis King (Wilmington, DE/Concord HS)** returned the ensuing kickoff 37-yards to the Moravian 46-yard line and a penalty on the Bullets sent the Greyhound offense up that the Gettysburg 39-yard line. **Rempe** would pick up a first down on three straight runs, and quarterback **Andy Polony** found wide receiver **Alex Hersch** with a 21-yard reception to the Gettysburg four-yard line. However, Moravian would lose five yards on its next three plays with the Greyhounds eventually settling for a 26-yard field goal by kicker **Ian Heck** to cut Gettysburg's lead to 20-3 with 9:22 left in the first half. The Greyhound defense forced Gettysburg to a three-and-out on its next drive but a 51-yard punt from wide receiver/punter **Brian Betley** put Moravian at its own 35-yard line. Moravian would also punt after three plays. The Bullets started their next drive at their own 23-yard line and moved down into the red zone. Facing a third-and-six at the Moravian 19-yard line, **Flynn** was intercepted by Greyhound linebacker **Philip Bortz**, who returned the ball to the Moravian ten-yard line. The Greyhounds picked up a first down but eventually punted. A bad punt set the Gettysburg offense up at the Moravian 42-yard line with 2:07 to play until halftime. The Bullets ran eight plays to cover the 42 yards to the end zone with **Mutunga** scoring from four-yard out with 49 seconds remaining in the

second quarter. **Barrett's** extra-point would give Gettysburg a 27-3 lead. Moravian would runs just three plays before punter **Eric Dziengelski** connected on a 51-yard punt to force Gettysburg to take a knee to end the half. The Greyhounds received the opening kickoff of the second half and put together a 15-play, 69-yard drive that took over half of the quarter, milking 8:29 off of the clock; however, Moravian would come up empty on the drive. **Rempe** picked up a fourth-and-one at the Gettysburg nine-yard line to give Moravian a fresh set of downs. The Greyhounds moved to the three-yard line but faced fourth-and-goal. **Polony's** pass to tight end **Brian Dencker** on fourth down was knocked away in the end zone by Gettysburg defensive back **Bryan DiSabato**. The Bullets picked up one first down on their first drive of the second half before punting. **King's** punt return set the Moravian offense up at its own 45-yard line but the Greyhounds lost yardage on the drive and were forced to punt. Gettysburg would get one first down before punting on the next to last play of a scoreless third quarter. The teams would then trade 14-yard punts with Moravian eventually taking over on its own 20-yard line. On the second play of the drive, **Rempe** took a direct snap for a season long 50-yard run to go over 100 yards rushing for the second straight week. However, the Greyhounds would turn the ball over on downs at the Gettysburg 24-yard line. After the Bullets punted for the fifth time in the game, Moravian took over at its own 39-yard line. On the second play of the drive, **Polony** threw a pass to wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus**, but the ball bounced off of **Sylvainus'** hands and into the hands of Gettysburg defensive back **Rob Pennella**, who returned it 54 yards for a touchdown. **Barrett's** extra-point gave Gettysburg a 34-3 lead with just 2:24 to play in the game. Moravian picked up a pair of first downs including one on fourth down before turning the ball over on downs with 1:13 to play. Gettysburg ran two plays to run out the close. The Bullets finished with 444 yards on 75 plays, but Gettysburg was held to just 79 yards on 22 plays in the second half. **Flynn** completed 17 of 26 passes for 144 yard with two scores, and he wasn't sacked while gaining 57 yards on ten carries. Tailback **Anthony DeSalva** had a career high 76 yards on ten carries for the Bullets while **Perotti** caught six passes for 62 yards with his touchdown. **Betley** added three catches for 33 yards while averaging 34.8 yards on five punts while **Curcio** grabbed three passes for 24 yards with his touchdowns. Running back **Ricky Manigat** had three catches for 14 yards and nine yards on two carries. The Moravian offense had a season high 240 yards on 72 plays with **Polony** completing 15 of 31 passes for 125 yards in his second start of the season, but he was sacked three times and threw one interception. **Hersch** caught three passes for 45 yards while **Sylvainus** had three catches for 22 yards for the Greyhounds. **Rempe** had 141 yards on 35 carries to move into 16<sup>th</sup> in school history with 1,241 yards on 324 carries, which is eighth in school history, and **Rempe** caught three passes for 12 yards. **King** returned six kickoffs for 140 yards to move into fourth in school history in a single season with 502 yards on 21 returns, which is sixth in a single season. Linebacker **Tim Widdoes** led the Gettysburg defense with 12 tackles including a half a sack while linebacker **Wes Taylor** had ten tackles with a half a tackle for loss. Defensive back **Peter Hak** made nine tackles with a pass break-up while defensive lineman **Sean Beirne** had six stops with one and a half for loss. Defensive back **Thomas Dailey (Easton, PA/Notre Dame HS)** led the Greyhound defense with a game high 14 tackles to go with one pass break-up while **Bortz** had 13 tackles with one and a half tackles for loss to go with his interception. Linebacker **Anthony Carney** had ten tackles while defensive back **Brad Bodine** added six stops and three pass break-ups. Defensive back **Daniel Burley** also had six tackles with one and a half for loss for Moravian.

**THE QUARTERBACKS:** Sophomore strong safety **Matt Johnson** stepped in a quarterback last weekend at Dickinson College and completed ten of 23 passes for 174 yards with an interception, and he was not sacked in his first action in the position since high school. Freshman **Phil Gardner** was named the starting quarterback after a strong competition in camp but is out of the lineup due to illness. **Gardner** has completed 48 of 90 passes for 579 yards with two touchdowns and seven interceptions. His longest completion this season is a 53-yard touchdown pass against Lebanon Valley College. **Gardner** has been sacked 11 times for negative rushing yards on 32 attempts. Freshman quarterback **Brandon Lesko (Catasauqua, PA/Catasauqua HS)**, who is also out of the line-up with an injury, has seen

action on the field but has not thrown a pass this season and he has been sacked once. Junior quarterback **Max Coveleski (Lewes, DE/Cape Henlopen HS)** has also been on the field, completing one of four passes for four yards and an interception, and **Coveleski** has been sacked twice. Freshman quarterback **Pat Catagnus (Trappe, PA/Perkiomen Valley HS)** saw his first action of the season versus Johns Hopkins University but did not throw a pass.

**IN THE BACKFIELD:** In the backfield, sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** has 207 yards and a touchdown on 59 attempts while sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore (Center Valley, PA/Southern Lehigh HS)** has run for 152 yards and a touchdown on a team high 72 carries. Sophomore quarterback/defensive back **Matt Johnson** has added 61 yards and a touchdown on 15 carries while junior running back **Langston Ross (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** has 17 yards on six attempts. Sophomore punter **Tyler Thompson (Harrisburg, PA/Central Dauphin HS)** has 11 yards on a fake punt at Dickinson College while junior running back **Philip Redline (Jim Thorpe, PA/Jim Thorpe HS)** has gained three yards on three carries.

**THE WIDE RECEIVERS:** The Greyhounds have had ten different players catch a pass through four games led by senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** with 21 catches for 358 yards. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has 16 receptions for 232 yards including a 45-yard touchdown and a 53-yard touchdown while sophomore wide receiver **Ryan Onushco (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS)** has five catches for 45 yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Pat Meeres (Mount Laurel, NJ/Lenape HS)** has caught five passes for 59 yards while junior tight end **Mike Zaroni (Bethlehem, PA/Freedom HS)** grabbed three passes for 23 yards before an injury knocked him out for the season at McDaniel College. Sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has five catches for four yards while sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** has one reception for 14 yards. Senior tight end **Jason Pauloski (Bloomington, PA/Butler HS)** has one catch for ten yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Chase Zimmik (Milford, PA/Delaware Valley HS)** has one catch for eight yards while junior running back **Langston Ross** has one reception for four yards.

**OFFENSIVE LINE:** Seniors **Daniel Cancelliere (Succasunna, NJ/Roxbury HS)**, **Matthew Washer (Ogdensburg, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS)** and **Thomas Mulligan (Ardmore, PA/Episcopal Academy)** are back on the offensive line. Joining the starting line-up will be junior center **Nicholas Guerriero (New Providence, NJ/New Providence HS)** and sophomore **Billy Viscuso (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS)**. The Greyhounds' front five has an average size of 6-1, 271. Sophomore **Jim Tersigni (Phillipsburg, NJ/Phillipsburg HS)** started at McDaniel College for an injured **Mulligan**, and **Tersigni** also saw action in the Johns Hopkins University contest.

**DEFENSIVE FRONT:** Junior defensive lineman **Seth Payne** leads the Moravian defensive line with 23 tackles including four and a half tackles for loss, a pass break-up a forced fumble and a fumble recovery while senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros** has 20 tackles including five and a half for loss, the team's only sack, a forced fumble and a pass break-up. Senior defensive lineman **Michael McClarin (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** has made 18 tackles with one for loss and two pass break-ups this season while junior defensive lineman **Patrick Gordon (Bethlehem, PA/Notre Dame HS)** has four stops.

**THE LINEBACKER CORPS:** Sophomore linebacker **Jake Hildebrand** leads the linebackers and the Greyhound defense with 39 tackles including three and a half for loss, two interceptions and three passes defended. Senior linebacker **Philip Bortz** has added 31 tackles with three for loss and a pass break-up while junior linebacker **Evan Bauer (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)**, who also saw action on offense at Dickinson College, has contributed 21 tackles with two and a half for loss and two pass break-ups. Junior linebacker **Ryan Hartzell (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** has 25 tackles with four stops for loss and two pass break-ups in his debut season at Moravian while junior linebacker **Stephen Kircher (Manasquan, NJ/Manasquan HS)** had eight tackles with a half a tackle for loss and a pass break-up before leaving the game against McDaniel with a season-ending injury. Junior linebacker **Douglas DiMattia (Cedar Grove,**

**NJ/Cedar Grove HS**), who made his first collegiate start against Johns Hopkins University, has 14 tackles with two for loss and two pass break-ups while sophomore linebacker **Tyler Potterton (Closter, NJ/NVRHS Demarest HS)** has four tackles and a pass break-up this fall.

**THE DEFENSIVE BACKFIELD:** In the defensive backfield, junior defensive back **David Wacker** has made 29 tackles to go with one tackle for loss, a forced fumble, a blocked extra-point at Dickinson College, an interception and three passes defended. Senior defensive back **Daniel Burley** has contributed 21 tackles with one and a half a tackles for loss, two interceptions with a nine-yard touchdown return at Dickinson and a total of seven passes defended while sophomore defensive back **Matt Johnson**, now the starting quarterback, has 19 tackles, a half a tackle for loss and three passes defended including an interception he returned 21 yards at McDaniel College. Sophomore defensive back **Travis King** had ten tackles with one for loss and an interception before leaving the McDaniel College game with an injury. Freshman defensive back **Zach Szoke (Walnutport, PA/Northampton HS)** came on when **King** was injured and has 18 tackles, an interception and a total of three passes defended while senior defensive back **Thomas Dailey**, who is starting for **Johnson**, has 12 tackles and a fumble recovery. Senior defensive back **Michael Burke (Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown)** has added five stops this season.

**KICKING GAME:** Junior kicker **Ian Heck** is four-for-seven on field goals this season with a career long of 41 yards versus Johns Hopkins University. **Heck** is five-for-six on extra-point attempts, and he is averaging 58.0 yards per kickoff on 15 attempts with one touchback. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski** has punted 23 times for an average of 34.0 yards per punt with a career long of 57 yards at Susquehanna University and again at Dickinson College. **Dziengelski** has had three punts fair caught, four inside the 20-yard line, one touchback and one blocked. Sophomore **Tyler Thompson (Harrisburg, PA/Central Dauphin HS)** punted for the first time in his collegiate career in the Johns Hopkins University game, and he averaging 28.8 yards per punt on six attempts with a long of 39 yards and two inside the 20-yard line.

**SPECIAL TEAMS:** Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has 16 punt returns for 117 yards including a long of 23 yards against McDaniel College while junior running back **Langston Ross** has nine kickoff returns for 159 yards. **Hersch** also has four kickoff returns for 83 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Pat Meeres** has one kickoff return for ten yards. **Meeres** has also recorded four tackles on special teams. Sophomore running back **Rocco**

**Del Priore** has returned two kickoffs for 49 yards with a long of 27 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Ryan Onushco** has two kickoff returns for 54 yards including a team long of 35 yards at McDaniel College.

**STARTERS PLAYER OF THE GAME:** As part of Moravian's radio contract with Fox Sports Radio 1470 AM WSAN The Fox, the announcers will select the Starters Player of the Game for Moravian during the Post-Game Show. Last week, senior defensive back **Daniel Burley**, senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** and sophomore quarterback **Matt Johnson** were named the Co-Players of the Game in Moravian's 24-16 win at Dickinson College. **Burley** started the scoring with a nine-yard interception return for a touchdown, and he finished the game with four tackles, a tackle for loss and two passes defended. **Sylvainus** caught six passes for 142 yards, the eighth highest single game total in school history. **Johnson** moved from starting strong safety to starting quarterback and completed ten-of-23 passes for 174 yards with one interception, and he ran for a team high 61 yards and a touchdown on 15 carries. Starters Riverport, Starters Pub and Starters Clubhouse Grille, sponsors of Moravian College Athletics, are located on 2nd Street, Route 378 South of Bethlehem and the Bethlehem Municipal Golf Course.

**WINNING WAYS:** Moravian had 11 consecutive winning seasons—all under Coach **Scot Dapp**, from 1987 to 1997 and has had 17 winning seasons in **Dapp's** 24 years. The 11-straight winning seasons is the longest in school history. **Dapp** ranks third among Greyhound coaches in winning percentage.

**OVERTIME 'HOUNDS:** Moravian has played a total of nine overtime games since the NCAA instituted the rule for the 1996 season and is 7-2 all-time in the extra-session. Five of those nine overtime games have been against Juniata College with the Greyhounds going 4-1 in those games. Moravian's contest in Huntingdon in 2008 marked the first time in the Greyhounds' have needed more than one overtime session in a game. The 2008 season also marked the second year that Moravian has played two overtimes games in one season, the other year was 1999.
