THE GAME: Moravian hosts its annual Homecoming game as the Greyhounds play Franklin & Marshall College in a Centennial Conference game. Kickoff is slated for 1:05 p.m. at Rocco Calvo Field in Bethlehem, Pennsylvania.

THE COACHES: Scot Dapp (West Chester '73) is in his 24th season at Moravian, with a career record of 139-103-1 (.574), the winningest football coach in Moravian history. He entered the season in the top 50 in winning percentage among NCAA Division III active coaches. Dapp, who served as the president of the American Football Coaches Association in 2005, has earned Coach-of-the-Year honors from the MAC three times including Co-Coach of the Year in 1997 and has led the 'Hounds to two appearances in the NCAA playoffs, the ECAC Southeast Bowl game in 2002, the ECAC Southwest Bowl game in 2004, 2005 and 2008, winning the title in 2005.

Franklin & Marshall coach John Troxell (Lafayette '94) has a record of 24-22 (.522) in his fifth year at the school.

THE SERIES: Saturday's meeting will be the 23rd in the series with Franklin & Marshall owning a 17-5 advantage. Moravian posted a 38-24 win in Lancaster back in 2007 when the schools renewed their rivalry as Centennial Conference opponents, and the Greyhounds posted a 23-20 victory in Bethlehem in 2008. Franklin & Marshall posted a 29-13 win in Lancaster last fall, and the Diplomats' previous win in the series was 37-20 victory in the 2004 ECAC Southwest Bowl in Lancaster. Franklin & Marshall won the first eight games between the schools and 15 of the first 16 contests.

GREYHOUNDS IN THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE: Moravian joined the Centennial Conference as an associate member in the sport of football in 2007. The Greyhounds were selected eighth in the Centennial Conference preseason coaches and sports information directors poll while Franklin & Marshall was selected to finish seventh, and the Diplomats received seven first-place votes..

BALANCED & EXPERIENCED 'HOUNDS: Of the 84 players on the Moravian roster, 35 are freshmen, 20 are sophomores and 15 are juniors. There are 14 seniors on this season's squad, and the Greyhounds return 42 letterwinners and 14 starters.

ON TELEVISION: Saturday's game is scheduled to be broadcast live on television by Service-Electric TV-2 Sports with play-by-play from Doug Heater, color commentary from Jim Wills and sideline reports from Courtney Molinaro. This is the first of two Moravian games that will be aired this season. Since the game is being televised live, kickoff will be five minutes later at 1:05 p.m. than originally scheduled.

ON THE AIRWAVES: For the 14th straight year, the Greyhounds' games will be on the radio. Moravian's games will be aired on WSAN 1470 AM The Fox for the seventh straight year. Phil May calls the play-by-play call with color commentary from Craig Barnes and technical assistance from John Elliott. The pre-game show starts one hour prior to kickoff.

average of 7.3 yards per return, and he is ninth in receiving yards per contest at 52.7 and 11th in all-purpose yardage at 92.0 yards per game. Junior running back **Langston Ross** (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) is fourth in kickoff returns with an average return of 18.6 yards. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski** (Coatesville, PA/Chestnut Hill Academy) is eighth in the conference in punting with an average of 34.0 yards per punt while junior kicker **Ian Heck** (Easton, PA/Easton HS) is ninth in kick scoring at 3.3 points per game, ninth in field goals at 0.67 per contest and tied for sixth in field goal percentage at 57.1 percent (four-for-seven). Sophomore linebacker **Jake Hildebrand** (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS) is 12th in the conference at 7.8 tackles per game, and he is tied for 12th in interceptions at 0.33 while junior defensive back **David Wacker** (Parkton, MD/Hereford HS) is 23rd in tackles at 6.7 per game. Junior linebacker **Phil Bortz** (Allentown, PA/Parkland HS) is 29th in the Centennial Conference in tackles with an average of 5.8 per game while senior defensive back **Daniel Burley** (Easton, PA/Easton HS) is 12th for tenth in interceptions at 0.33 per game and 48th in tackles at 4.5 per contest. Junior linebacker **Ryan Hartzell** (Easton, PA/Easton HS) is 39th in the conference at 5.2 tackles per contest while senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros** is 40th at 5.0 tackles per game. Junior linebacker **Evan Bauer** (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) is 46th in the Centennial Conference at 4.7 tackles per contest.

SCOUTING FRANKLIN & MARSHALL COLLEGE: The Diplomats enter the game with an overall record of 4-1 and a 3-1 slate in Centennial Conference action after a 41-20 win at Susquehanna University two weeks ago. Franklin & Marshall had its bye week last Saturday. Junior quarterback **John Harrison** has completed 95 of 144 passes for 1,207 yards with 13 touchdowns and four interceptions this season. His top targets have been senior wide receiver **Jay Ridinger**, who has 31 catches for 491 yards and five touchdowns, junior wide receiver **Jarrell Diggs**, who has caught 22 passes for 236 yards and four scores, and junior running back **John Kaschak**, who has 22 receptions for 195 yards. **Kaschak** also leads the Diplomats rushing attack with 346 yards and four touchdowns on 79 carries. Junior running back **Alan Williams** has added 104 yards and two touchdowns on 33 carries. **Williams** also has nine kickoff returns for 175 yards while sophomore defensive back **Jonathan Strauss** has seven kickoff returns for 173 yards. **Diggs** has returned nine punts for 135 yards. Freshman kicker **Chris DeStefano** is 14-for-16 on extra-points this season, and he has made his only field goal attempt of 28 yards while sophomore **Devin Hunter** has punted 13 times for an average of 35.8 yards. **Hunter** has had three touchbacks, two fair caught, one inside the 20-yard line and one blocked this season and a long punt of 50 yards. Sophomore linebacker **Sam Massaro** has three interceptions for F&M with one touchdown this

MILESTONE WATCH: The Greyhounds have three players closing in on milestones for his career. Senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** (Nazareth, PA/Nazareth HS) currently has 1,548 yards on 98 career receptions, and he needs 35 yards to move into sixth in yardage, 38 yards to move into fifth and 74 yards to reach fourth. **Sylvainus** can reach third in school history with 131 yards. **Sylvainus** needs just two receptions to become the seventh player in Moravian history to catch 100 career passes can four catches to move into sixth. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS) has moved into fourth in school history in punt returns with 43 returns for 262 yards. **Hersch** needs ten more punt returns to move into third. Senior defensive end **Allen Petros** (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) is third in school history with 32 tackles for loss. **Petros** needs one tackle for loss to move into second place and 13 tackles for loss to break the school record.

THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE STATISTICAL RANKINGS: The Greyhounds are fifth in the Centennial Conference in total defense, allowing 285.5 yards per game. The squad is second in passing defense at 157.2 yards per game, and the defense is sixth in rushing yards allowed at 128.3 per game. The Greyhounds are sixth in points allowed at 21.7 per game, and the squad is ninth in points scored per game at 12.7. Offensively, Moravian is ninth in the Centennial Conference at 258.5 yards per game. The Greyhounds are ranked eighth in rushing offense at 87.3 yards per game and eighth in passing offense at 171.2 yards per game. Moravian is seventh in turnover margin with a -0.17 per game average as the Greyhounds have committed 12 turnovers while forcing 11 turnovers. Individually, freshman quarterback **Phil Gardner** (Mechanicsville, VA/Lee-Davis HS) is ninth in the Centennial Conference in passing yards per game at 144.8, and he is ninth in total offense at 137.2 yards per contest and 12th in pass efficiency with a 99.2 rating. Sophomore quarterback/defensive back **Matt Johnson** (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS) is seventh in pass efficiency with a 129.2 rating, and he is tenth in passing yards per game at 74.0 and tenth in total offense at 94.8 yards per game. Senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** is tied for tenth in the conference in receptions per game at 4.00, and he fourth in receiving yards per contest at 75.5. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** is fourth in the Centennial Conference in punt returns with an

season. He also leads the Diplomats with 41 tackles including four tackles for loss, two sacks, four passes defended, two forced fumbles and a fumble recovery. Junior defensive lineman **C.T. Marsh** has contributed 26 tackles with 12 for loss, five saves, a pass break-up, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery and a blocked kick while junior defensive back **Kurt Rogers** also has 26 tackles with two for loss, one sack and four pass break-ups. Senior linebacker **Drew Hutcheon** and sophomore linebacker **Nick Barbieri** each had 24 tackles this fall with **Hutcheon** adding a half a tackle for loss and **Barbieri** contributing an interception and two passes defended.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET: In Lancaster last fall, quarterback **John Harrison** completed 23 of 39 passes for 241 yards with three touchdowns to lead Franklin & Marshall College to a 29-13 victory over visiting Moravian College in Centennial Conference action at a rainy Sponaugle-Williamson Field. Moravian received the opening kickoff and started from its own 29-yard line. On the first play, running back **Ryan Rempe** was hit after a three-yard gain and fumbled. F&M defensive back **Barry Lovett** scooped up the ball and returned it to the Moravian 11-yard line. **Harrison** threw a pair of incompletions around a rush for no gain by running back **John Kaschak**. **Mike Shin** connected on a 28-yard field goal with 13:52 left in the first quarter for a 3-0 Diplomat lead. Moravian would answer on its next drive with its first touchdown in since the second quarter of week two against McDaniel College, a span of 18 quarters. The seven-play, 66-yard drive had **Rempe** carry the ball five times for 50 yards including a five-yard touchdown, his first of the season. Facing a third-and-seven at their own 37-yard line, **Rempe** broke a tackle in the backfield and bounced an inside run to the left sideline gaining 34 yards, and a penalty on the play moved the ball into the redzone. Kicker **Ian Heck** made the extra-point to give the Greyhounds a 7-3 lead with 10:42 remaining in the first quarter. F&M would run just three plays before turning the ball over. Moravian linebacker **Jayson Williams** intercepted a **Harrison** pass at the Greyhound 40-yard line. The Greyhounds picked up a first down on a pass from quarterback **Andy Polony** to wide receiver **Alex Hersch**. However, Moravian would have to punt with punter **Eric Dziengelski** pinning the Diplomats at their own four-yard line. Franklin & Marshall would drive the entire field on the ground and through the air to retake the lead. **Harrison** capped the ten-play, 96-yard drive with a seven-yard touchdown pass to tight end **Michael Deutch**. **Shin's** extra-point gave the Diplomats a 10-7 lead with 1:46 left in the first quarter. Moravian picked up a first down on the first play of its drive on a 31-yard completion from **Polony** to wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** but the squad would end up punting from near midfield. The Diplomats would get two first downs before punting for the first time in the game; however, the Greyhounds were unable to get a first

down and punted for the third time in the first half. After a quick first down, F&M would punt again. The Diplomats would get the ball right back as defensive back **Jeff Kellar** intercepted a **Polony** pass at the F&M 45-yard line. Franklin & Marshall would capitalize on the turnover with **Harrison** hit wide receiver **Jay Ridinger** with a six-yard touchdown pass, capping off the nine-play, 55-yard drive. **Shin's** extra-point was wide left leaving the Diplomat lead at 16-7 with 2:10 left in the second quarter. Moravian would get a long kickoff return from running back **Langston Ross** to start their next drive at midfield; however, the Greyhounds couldn't move the ball, punting after three plays. F&M would run out the clock to head to the locker room with a 16-7 lead. F&M needed just 12 seconds to add to its lead to start the third quarter when wide receiver **George Eager** returned the opening kickoff 80 yards for a touchdown, his second kickoff return for a score this season. **Shin** added the extra-point for a 23-7 Diplomat lead. **Ross** followed with another long return for the Greyhounds, setting up the Moravian offense at the F&M 48-yard line to start Moravian's first possession of the second half. However, the Greyhounds would punt after three plays. The Diplomats picked up three first downs on their first drive of the second half before a punt. A penalty for kick catch interference gave Moravian possession at its own 30-yard line. The Greyhounds needed seven plays to get on the scoreboard. **Polony** capped the 70-yard drive with a 35-yard touchdown pass to **Sylvainus**. A bad snap on the extra-point attempt forced quarterback/holder **Steve Panasuk** to attempt a two-point conversion pass to tight end **Mike Zanon** (**Bethlehem, PA/Freedom HS**) that was low to leave the score at 23-13 F&M with 4:37 to play in the third quarter. Franklin & Marshall would go three-and-punt on its next possession. A penalty would force the Greyhounds into long yardage and a punt after three plays as well. The Diplomats weren't able to pick up a first down, punting back to Moravian. Moravian would punt three plays into the fourth quarter. F&M picked up a first down before a short punt but the Diplomats would get the ball back at the Moravian 29-yard line after a fake punt by the Greyhounds failed. After a first down, F&M would turn the ball over on downs at the Moravian nine-yard line. Three plays later, F&M linebacker **Sam Massaro** intercepted a **Polony** pass and returned it to the Moravian 14-yard line. Facing fourth-and-nine at the Moravian 13, **Harrison** found **Ridinger** with a 13-yard touchdown pass. **Shin's** extra-point attempt was wide to the right giving the Diplomats a 29-13 lead with 4:06 left in the game. Moravian would get a first down before defensive back **Ty Savastio** intercepted **Polony**. The Diplomats would run out the clock to end the game. F&M had 321 total yards, 92 yards below its season average, on 77 plays. Running back **Alan Williams** led the Diplomats with 85 yards on 19 carries while **Kaschak** had 19 yards on ten carries. **Eager** caught five passes for 58 yards while **Ridinger** had five receptions for 46 yards. Wide receiver **Jarrell Digs** caught four passes for 51 yards while **Kaschak** had four receptions for 40 yards. **Deutch** added three receptions for 32 yards while **Williams** had two catches for 14 yards. Moravian ran 53 plays for 219 yards with **Polony** completing ten of 24 passes for 131 yards. **Sylvainus** caught four passes for 80 yards and is now 43 yards shy of 1,000 receiving yards in his career while **Zanon** had three receptions for 27 yards. Wide receiver **Max Coveleski** (**Lewes, DE/Cape Henlopen HS**) had two receptions for 11 yards. **Rempe** ran for a game high 89 yards on 23 carries with his first touchdown of the year, and **Rempe** is now 13th in school history with 1,330 yards. **Massaro** led the F&M defense with 11 tackles to go with his interception while linebacker **Drew Hutcheon** added eight tackles with two tackles for loss, one and a half sacks, a forced fumble and a pass break-up while linebacker **Frank DiMattia** had six tackles. **Savastio** had five tackles and a pass break-up to go with his interception. Defensive back **Daniel Burley** (**Easton, PA/Easton HS**) led Moravian's defense with nine tackles including one and a half for loss and three pass break-ups while **Williams** had eight tackles with one for loss. Defensive lineman **Allen Petros** contributed seven stops with two tackles for loss and a sack while linebacker **Evan Bauer** had seven stops. Defensive back **Kyle Krupa** contributed six tackles while linebacker **Anthony Carney** had five tackles with two sacks. Defensive lineman **Seth Payne** (**Collingswood, NJ/Collingswood HS**) also had five tackles with one sack and one and a half tackles for loss.

THE QUARTERBACKS: Sophomore strong safety **Matt Johnson** has stepped in at quarterback the last two weeks and completed 24 of 51 passes

for 444 yards with two touchdowns and one interception, and he has been sacked just once in his first two games at the position since high school. Freshman **Phil Gardner** was named the starting quarterback after a strong competition in camp but is out of the lineup due to injury. **Gardner** has completed 48 of 90 passes for 579 yards with two touchdowns and seven interceptions. His longest completion this season is a 53-yard touchdown pass against Lebanon Valley College. **Gardner** has been sacked 11 times. Freshman quarterback **Brandon Lesko** (**Catasauqua, PA/Catasauqua HS**), who is also out of the line-up with an injury, has seen action on the field but has not thrown a pass this season and he has been sacked once. Junior quarterback **Max Coveleski** has also been on the field, completing one of four passes for four yards and an interception, and **Coveleski** has been sacked twice. Freshman quarterback **Pat Catagnus** (**Trappe, PA/Perkiomen Valley HS**) saw his first action of the season versus Johns Hopkins University but did not throw a pass.

IN THE BACKFIELD: In the backfield, sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** has 239 yards and a touchdown on 71 attempts while sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** (**Center Valley, PA/Southern Lehigh HS**) has run for 187 yards and a touchdown on a team high 85 carries. Sophomore quarterback/defensive back **Matt Johnson** has added 125 yards and two touchdowns on 26 carries while junior running back **Langston Ross** has 17 yards on six attempts. Sophomore punter **Tyler Thompson** (**Harrisburg, PA/Central Dauphin HS**) has 11 yards on a fake punt at Dickinson College while junior running back **Philip Redline** (**Jim Thorpe, PA/Jim Thorpe HS**) has gained three yards on three carries.

THE WIDE RECEIVERS: The Greyhounds have had 12 different players catch a pass through four games led by senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** with 24 catches for 453 yards and a 68-yard touchdown. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has 21 receptions for 316 yards including touchdowns of 45 and 53 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Ryan Onushco** (**Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS**) has eight catches for 91 yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Pat Meeres** (**Mount Laurel, NJ/Lenape HS**) has caught five passes for 59 yards while junior tight end **Mike Zanon** grabbed three passes for 23 yards before an injury knocked him out for the season at McDaniel College. Sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has six catches for 13 yards while sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** has one reception for 14 yards. Senior tight end **Jason Pauloski** (**Bloomington, PA/Butler HS**) has one catch for ten yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Chase Zimmnik** (**Milford, PA/Delaware Valley HS**) has one catch for eight yards while junior running back **Langston Ross** has one reception for four yards. Junior linebacker **Evan Bauer** caught a 17-yard pass at Gettysburg College while sophomore wide receiver **Albie Moran** (**Phillipsburg, NJ/Phillipsburg HS**) has one catch for 19 yards.

OFFENSIVE LINE: Seniors **Daniel Cancelliere** (**Succasunna, NJ/Roxbury HS**), **Matthew Washer** (**Ogdensburg, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS**) and **Thomas Mulligan** (**Ardmore, PA/Episcopal Academy**) are back on the offensive line. Joining the starting line-up will be junior center **Nicholas Guerriero** (**New Providence, NJ/New Providence HS**) and sophomore **Billy Viscuso** (**Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS**). The Greyhounds' front five has an average size of 6-1, 271. Sophomore **Jim Tersigni** (**Phillipsburg, NJ/Phillipsburg HS**) started at McDaniel College for an injured **Mulligan**, and **Tersigni** also started at Gettysburg College for an injured **Cancelliere**.

DEFENSIVE FRONT: Senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros** leads the Moravian defensive line with 30 tackles including six and a half for loss, one sack, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery and a pass break-up while junior defensive lineman **Seth Payne** has 23 tackles including four and a half tackles for loss, a pass break-up a forced fumble and a fumble recovery. Senior defensive lineman **Michael McClarin** (**Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS**) has made 21 tackles with one for loss and two pass break-ups this season while junior defensive lineman **Patrick Gordon** (**Bethlehem, PA/Notre Dame HS**) has ten stops with one for loss.

THE LINEBACKER CORPS: Sophomore linebacker **Jake Hildebrand** leads the linebackers and the Greyhound defense with 47 tackles including five for loss, two interceptions and three passes defended. Senior linebacker **Philip Bortz** has added 35 tackles with three for loss and a pass

break-up while junior linebacker **Evan Bauer**, who has seen action on offensive side of the ball the last two weeks, has contributed 28 tackles with three and a half for loss, a sack, a forced fumble and two pass break-ups. Junior linebacker **Ryan Hartzell** has 31 tackles with four stops for loss and two pass break-ups in his debut season at Moravian while junior linebacker **Stephen Kircher (Manasquan, NJ/Manasquan HS)** had eight tackles with a half a tackle for loss and a pass break-up before leaving the game against McDaniel with a season-ending injury. Junior linebacker **Douglas DiMattia (Cedar Grove, NJ/Cedar Grove HS)**, who made his first collegiate start against Johns Hopkins University, has 15 tackles with three for loss and two pass break-ups while sophomore linebacker **Tyler Potterton (Closter, NJ/NVRHS Demarest HS)** has seven tackles and a pass break-up this fall.

THE DEFENSIVE BACKFIELD: In the defensive backfield, junior defensive back **David Wacker** has made 40 tackles to go with one tackle for loss, a forced fumble, a blocked extra-point at Dickinson College, an interception and three passes defended. Senior defensive back **Daniel Burley** has contributed 27 tackles with one and a half a tackles for loss, two interceptions with a nine-yard touchdown return at Dickinson and a total of seven passes defended while sophomore defensive back **Matt Johnson**, now the starting quarterback, has 19 tackles, a half a tackle for loss and three passes defended including an interception he returned 21 yards at McDaniel College. Sophomore defensive back **Travis King (Wilmington, DE/Concord HS)** had ten tackles with one for loss and an interception before leaving the McDaniel College game with an injury. Freshman defensive back **Zach Szoke (Walnutport, PA/Northampton HS)** came on when **King** was injured and has 24 tackles, an interception and a total of three passes defended while senior defensive back **Thomas Dailey (Easton, PA/Notre Dame HS)**, who is starting for **Johnson**, has 22 tackles and a fumble recovery. Senior defensive back **Michael Burke (Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown)** has added five stops this season.

KICKING GAME: Junior kicker **Ian Heck** is four-for-seven on field goals this season with a career long of 41 yards versus Johns Hopkins University. **Heck** is eight-for-nine on extra-point attempts, and he is averaging 57.0 yards per kickoff on 19 attempts with one touchback. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski** has punted 28 times for an average of 34.0 yards per punt with a career long of 57 yards at Susquehanna University and again at Dickinson College. **Dziengelski** has had three punts fair caught, seven inside the 20-yard line, one touchback and two blocked. Sophomore **Tyler Thompson (Harrisburg, PA/Central Dauphin HS)** punted for the first time in his collegiate career in the Johns Hopkins University game, and he averaging

28.8 yards per punt on six attempts with a long of 39 yards and two inside the 20-yard line.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has 16 punt returns for 117 yards including a long of 23 yards against McDaniel College while junior running back **Langston Ross** has 13 kickoff returns for 242 yards. **Hersch** also has six kickoff returns for 119 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Pat Meeres** has one kickoff return for ten yards. **Meeres** has also recorded four tackles on special teams. Sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has returned two kickoffs for 49 yards with a long of 27 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Ryan Onushco** has two kickoff returns for 54 yards including a team long of 35 yards at McDaniel College.

STARTERS PLAYER OF THE GAME: As part of Moravian's radio contract with Fox Sports Radio 1470 AM WSAW The Fox, the announcers will select the Starters Player of the Game for Moravian during the Post-Game Show. Last week, sophomore quarterback **Matt Johnson** was named the Player of the Game in Moravian's 33-21 loss at Gettysburg College. **Johnson**, making just his second career start at quarterback, completed 14 of 28 passes for 270 yards and two touchdowns, and he added 64 yards and a touchdown on 11 carries. Starters Riverport, Starters Pub and Starters Clubhouse Grille, sponsors of Moravian College Athletics, are located on 2nd Street, Route 378 South of Bethlehem and the Bethlehem Municipal Golf Course.

WINNING WAYS: Moravian had 11 consecutive winning seasons—all under Coach **Scot Dapp**, from 1987 to 1997 and has had 17 winning seasons in **Dapp's** 24 years. The 11-straight winning seasons is the longest in school history. **Dapp** ranks third among Greyhound coaches in winning percentage.

OVERTIME 'HOUNDS: Moravian has played a total of nine overtime games since the NCAA instituted the rule for the 1996 season and is 7-2 all-time in the extra-session. Five of those nine overtime games have been against Juniata College with the Greyhounds going 4-1 in those games. Moravian's contest in Huntingdon in 2008 marked the first time in the Greyhounds' have needed more than one overtime session in a game. The 2008 season also marked the second year that Moravian has played two overtimes games in one season, the other year was 1999.
