THE GAME: Moravian looks for its third straight win and to move over the .500 mark for the first time since the opening week of the season in a Centennial Conference game versus nationally-ranked Ursinus College. Kickoff is slated for 1:00 p.m. at Rocco Calvo Field in Bethlehem as Moravian takes part in the NCAA Take a Kid to the Game and Pink Out for Breast Cancer Awareness.

THE COACHES: Scot Dapp (West Chester '73) is in his 24th season at Moravian, with a career record of 141-103-1 (.578), the winningest football coach in Moravian history. He entered the season in the top 50 in winning percentage among NCAA Division III active coaches. Dapp, who served as the president of the American Football Coaches Association in 2005, has earned Coach-of-the-Year honors from the MAC three times including Co-Coach of the Year in 1997 and has led the 'Hounds to two appearances in the NCAA playoffs, the ECAC Southeast Bowl game in 2002, the ECAC Southwest Bowl game in 2004, 2005 and 2008, winning the title in 2005.

Ursinus coach Peter Gallagher (West Virginia Wesleyan '93) has a record of 47-52 (.475) in his tenth year at the school.

THE SERIES: Saturday's meeting will be the 13th in the series with Moravian leading 8-3-1. Moravian earned a 20-19 win on Halloween last season in Collegeville, keeping Ursinus from eventually winning the Centennial Conference Championship. The Bears posted a 27-0 win in 2007 in Collegeville in the first meeting between the two schools in 25 years while the Greyhounds had a 17-7 win in Bethlehem, in 2008. Ursinus has won two of the last three meetings with a 10-7 back in 1982.

NCAA TAKE A KID TO THE GAME: Moravian invites all area children to attend on Saturday, October 30th against Ursinus College. Children have the opportunity to experience a college football game as the Greyhounds hosts NCAA Football's sixteenth annual "Take A Kid to the Game" (TAKG) program presented by Coca-Cola and sponsored by another Corporate Champion AT&T. Kids, ages fourteen and younger, will receive a free ticket with the purchase of a full-priced adult ticket, to watch the Greyhounds at Rocco Calvo Field. Moravian is one of more than 200 schools across the nation that hosting a game in this campaign focused on allowing youth the opportunity to attend college football games. Moravian's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee has games and activities planned for the afternoon including trick-or-treating for children. There will also be face painting, coloring and a chance to meet the Greyhound mascot.

PINK OUT FOR BREAST CANCER AWARENESS: Zeta Tau Alpha sorority and Sigma Phi Epsilon fraternity of Moravian will be hosting their 2nd annual Pink Out Football game for Breast Cancer Education and Awareness. There will be a raffle with lots of great items from local businesses including gift cards and baskets. Tickets are \$1.00 each or \$5.00 for an arms length. Pink breast cancer t shirts will be for sale near the entrances and will be sold for \$10.00 each. There will also be events for any kids attending the game such as face painting and games. There will also be bake sale with lots of pink goodies! All proceeds go directly to the Zeta Tau Alpha Foundation for breast cancer education and awareness.

ON THE AIRWAVES: For the 14th straight year, the Greyhounds' games will be on the radio. Moravian's games will be aired on WSAN 1470 AM The Fox for the seventh straight year. Phil May calls the play-by-play call with color commentary from Craig Barnes and technical assistance from John Elliott. The pre-game show starts one hour prior to kickoff.

catches for 307 yards and a touchdown in two games at Juniata.

GREYHOUNDS IN THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE: Moravian joined the Centennial Conference as an associate member in the sport of football in 2007. The Greyhounds were selected eighth in the Centennial Conference preseason coaches and sports information directors poll while Ursinus was selected to finish third and received one first-place vote.

BALANCED & EXPERIENCED 'HOUNDS: Of the 82 players on the Moravian roster, 33 are freshmen, 20 are sophomores and 15 are juniors. There are 14 seniors on this season's squad, and the Greyhounds return 42 letterwinners and 14 starters.

MILESTONE WATCH: The Greyhounds have three players closing in on milestones for their careers. Senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** currently has 1,748 yards on 112 career receptions. **Sylvainus** can reach second in school history with 177 yards, and he can become just the second player to 2,000 yards with 252 yards. **Sylvainus** needs just three receptions to move into fourth in school history and nine catches to move into third place. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS)** has moved into fourth in school history in punt returns with 48 returns for 310 yards. **Hersch** needs five more punt returns to move into third. Senior defensive end **Allen Petros (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** is second in school history with 35.5 tackles for loss. **Petros** needs nine and a half tackles for loss to break the school record.

THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE STATISTICAL RANKINGS: The Greyhounds are third in the Centennial Conference in total defense, allowing 268.2 yards per game. The squad is first in passing defense at 155.8 yards per game, and the defense is fourth in rushing yards allowed at 112.5 per game. The Greyhounds are fourth in points allowed at 18.4 per game, and the squad is seventh in points scored per game at 17.8. Offensively, Moravian is eighth in the Centennial Conference at 282.5 yards per game. The Greyhounds are ranked seventh in rushing offense at 107.4 yards per game and eighth in passing offense at 175.1 yards per game. Moravian is sixth in turnover margin with a +0.25 per game average as the Greyhounds have committed 14 turnovers while forcing 16 turnovers. Individually, sophomore quarterback/defensive back **Matt Johnson (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS)** is fifth in pass efficiency with a 131.6 rating, and he is tenth total offense at 131.9 yards per game and 11th in passing yards per contest at 98.5. Freshman quarterback **Phil Gardner (Mechanicsville, VA/Lee-Davis HS)** is ninth in the Centennial Conference in passing yards per game at 121.8, and he is 11th in total offense at 115.8 yards per contest and 11th in pass efficiency with a 105.6 rating. Sophomore running back **Joe Tegan (Haddonfield, NJ/Haddon Township HS)** is 12th in rushing at 46.2 yards per game while junior running back **Langston Ross (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** is 12th in kickoff returns with an average of 18.6 yards per return. Senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** is fifth in the conference in receptions per game at 4.75, and he fourth in receiving yards per contest at 81.6. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** is sixth in the Centennial Conference in punt returns with an average of 7.9 yards per return, and he is tenth in receiving yards per contest at 46.5 and 15th in all-purpose yardage at 82.0 yards per game. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski (Coatesville, PA/Chestnut Hill Academy)** is eighth in the conference in punting with an average of 34.6 yards per punt while junior kicker **Ian Heck** is eighth in kick scoring at 3.8 points per game, eighth in field goals at 0.62 per contest, seventh in field goal percentage at 62.5 percent (five-for-eight) and tied for first in PAT percentage at 93.8 (15-of-16). CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE HONORS: Senior linebacker **Philip Bortz (Allentown, PA/Parkland HS)** of Moravian has been named the Centennial Conference Defensive Player of the Week while senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus (Nazareth, PA/Nazareth HS)** was named to the Weekly Honor Roll for their performances in Moravian's 42-0 win at Juniata College last Saturday. **Bortz** scored his first career touchdown when he returned an interception 40 yards for a score to give Moravian a 28-0 lead in the game. **Bortz** also tied for the team high with six tackles, four of them solo stops, and he had one tackle for loss in the contest. His interception return for a score was Moravian's second of the game and fourth of the season. **Sylvainus** led the Moravian receivers with nine catches for 165 yards, the fourth highest single game total in school history. **Sylvainus** is now fifth in school history with 112 receptions, and his is third in yardage at 1,748. **Sylvainus** likes to play at Knox Stadium in Huntingdon, Pennsylvania, with 20

Hildebrand (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS) is 11th in the conference at 7.6 tackles per game, and he is tied for ninth in interceptions at 0.38 while junior defensive back **David Wacker (Parkton, MD/Hereford HS)** is 18th in tackles at 6.9 per game and tied for eighth in fumbles forced with 0.25 per contest. Junior linebacker **Phil Bortz** is 28th in the Centennial Conference in tackles with an average of 5.9 per game while senior defensive back **Daniel Burley (Easton, PA/Easton HS)**, junior linebacker **Evan Bauer (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** and junior linebacker **Ryan Hartzell (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** are all tied for 44th in tackles at 4.6 per contest. **Burley** is tied for ninth in interceptions with 0.38 per game while sophomore defensive back **Travis King (Wilmington, DE/Concord HS)** is fourth in interceptions at 0.50 per contest. Senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros** is tied for 37th in tackles at 5.0 per game, and he is fourth in tackles for loss with 1.25 per contest and tenth in sacks at 0.44 per outing.

SCOUTING URSINUS COLLEGE: The Bears enter the game with an overall record of 7-0 and a 6-0 mark in Centennial Conference action. Ursinus is currently ranked 21st in the nation in the American Football Coaches Association Top 25 Poll and 24th in the D3football.com Top 25. Senior quarterback **Justin Decristofaro** leads the Bears on the field having completed 116 of 201 passes for 1,517 yards with 16 touchdowns and six interceptions. His top targets have been junior wide receiver **Nick Giarratano**, who has 28 catches for 400 yards and eight touchdowns, junior wide receiver **Storm Miller**, who has 20 receptions for 201 yards and a score, freshman wide receiver **Jerry Rahill**, who has 18 catches for 295 yards, senior tight end **C.J. Yespelkis**, who has 12 receptions for 118 yards, and junior wide receiver **Al Desiderio**, who has ten catches for 365 yards and five touchdowns. Freshman running back **Bryan Ellis** leads the Ursinus rushing attack with 660 yards and two touchdowns on 160 carries while sophomore running back **Terry Conrad** has 181 yards on 49 carries. Junior defensive back **Mike Rissmiller** has 13 punt returns for 172 yards and a touchdowns, and he has added nine kickoff returns for 189 yards while junior running back **Kahlil Pittman** has seven kickoff returns for 126 yards. Sophomore punter **Derek Giannetti** is averaging 37.3 yards on 34 punt attempts with seven touchbacks, four fair caught and 11 inside the 20-yard line. Freshman kicker **Michael Bennett** is 25-for-28 on extra-points, seven-for-11 on field goal attempts with a long of 38 yards and averaging 60.9 yards per kickoff with six touchbacks. Sophomore defensive back **Chris Roundtree** has five interceptions for 56 return yards. Junior linebacker **Greg Martell** leads the Ursinus defense with 41 tackles, five and a half tackles for loss, half a sack and three pass break-ups while junior defensive back **Joe Henry** has 33 tackles with four and a half tackle for loss, two and a half sacks, two interceptions, five passes defended, a pair of forced fumbles and a fumble recovery. Senior defensive lineman **Dave Queroli** has 28 tackles with five and a half tackles for loss, a team high three and a half sacks and two fumble recoveries while senior linebacker **Joe Galie** has 26 tackles with one sack, one interception and two passes defended.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET: In Collegeville last fall, kicker **Ian Heck (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** kicked a 22-yard field goal with 7:33 to play and quarterback **Steve Panasuk** threw a pair of third quarter touchdowns to lead Moravian to a 20-19 come-from-behind win at Ursinus College in Centennial Conference action at Patterson Field. Ursinus received the opening kickoff and moved into Moravian territory, and the Bears picked up a fourth-and-one to put the ball on the Greyhound 30-yard line. On the next play, Greyhound defensive back **David Wacker** intercepted a pass by Ursinus quarterback **Justin Decristofaro** at the Moravian-nine-yard line. The Greyhounds were

unable to move the ball with punter **Eric Dziengelski** punting after three plays. Ursinus would move down into Moravian territory again after the punt but the Greyhounds would force another turnover in the red zone. Defensive back **Travis King** intercepted **Decristofaro** at the Moravian 19-yard line. Moravian would pick up a first down on a run by running back **Ryan Rempe** before punting again. The Bears moved into the red zone at the Moravian 12-yard line. However, **Decristofaro** had a fourth-down pass attempt knocked down by Greyhound defensive lineman **Allen Petros** to give Moravian the ball. The Greyhounds ended up punting after three plays. **Dziengelski's** punt was blocked in the end zone by defensive end **Sean Whalen**; however, the ball bounced right back into **Dziengelski's** hands, and he attempted a pass to **King** that was knocked down. The Bears needed just three plays to get into the end zone on a two-yard run from running back **Teddy Conrad**. Kicker **Keith Baker** added the extra-point to give Ursinus a 7-0 lead with ten minutes remaining in the second quarter. Moravian ran just three plays before a **Dziengelski** punt for the fourth time in the first half. Ursinus once again moved into Greyhound territory but faced a fourth-and-one at the Moravian 31-yard line. **Decristofaro** fumbled the snap on a quarterback sneak, but center **Bob Wise** covered the ball. However, the recovery was shy of the yardage needed for a first down so the Greyhounds took over at their own 31-yard line. Moravian would put together its first sustained drive of the game after the defensive stop. **Rempe** picked up ten yards on first down to move into 11th in school history in career rushing yardage, now with 1,495 yards on 405 carries. The Greyhounds would get a first down on a pass interference penalty, and **Rempe** ran for another first down to move to the Ursinus 27-yard line. Facing third-and-ten, **Panasuk** hit wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** with a screen pass that **Sylvainus** took to the Ursinus six-yard line. On the reception, **Sylvainus** became the 18th player in school history to reach 1,000 career receiving yards. **Rempe** would get the Greyhounds to the two-yard line but a stop on a second down and an incompletion to an open tight end **Brian Dencker** on third down forced a field goal attempt. **Heck** drilled the 19-yard kick to pull Moravian within 7-3 with just 16 seconds left in the first half. Ursinus covered a squib kick at its own 36-yard line, and **Decristofaro** hit wide receiver **Al Desiderio** with a 40-yard reception to set up a scoring chance for the Bears. **Baker** came on and connected on a career long 42-yard field that bounced off of the crossbar for a 10-3 Ursinus lead at the half. To start the second half, each team would lose yardage on its first drive of the half before punting. Moravian would get a first down on a **Rempe** run to move into Ursinus territory but the Greyhounds had to punt. **Dziengelski's** punt bounced off the helmet of Bear linebacker **Joe Galie**. **Desiderio** grabbed the ball at the Ursinus ten-yard line and raced 90 yards for a touchdown. **Baker's** extra-point attempt bounced off the right upright and was no good to give Ursinus a 16-3 lead with 9:08 to play in the third quarter. The Greyhounds picked up a first down but would punt for the seventh time in the game on their next possession. The Moravian defense would force a three and out before taking over at its own 33-yard line. Moravian faced a third-and-three when **Panasuk** hit **Dencker** with a 37-yard reception to the Ursinus 23-yard line. After a **Rempe** run for two yards, **Panasuk** found wide receiver **Albie Moran** (Phillipsburg, NJ/Phillipsburg HS) wide open down the right sideline for a 21-yard touchdown pass. **Heck** made the extra-point to pull Moravian within 16-10 with 3:47 remaining in the third quarter. **Heck** would attempt a short kickoff down the right side of the field, and Greyhound defensive back **Kyle Krupa** covered the ball at the Ursinus 29-yard line to give Moravian possession. The Greyhounds would capitalize after a six-play drive with **Panasuk** finding **Sylvainus** in the front left front corner of the end zone. **Heck's** extra-point gave the Greyhounds a 17-16 lead with 50 seconds remaining in the third quarter. On the drive, Moravian faced a fourth-and-12 but the third pass interference penalty of the game against Ursinus gave the Greyhounds the ball at the Bears' 16-yard line. Ursinus picked up a first down on a 17-yard completion from **Decristofaro** to wide receiver **Nick Giarratano**; however, the Greyhound defense would stiffen and force a punt. Moravian would have to punt after three plays, and a 27-yard punt return by **Desiderio** would put the Bears at the Greyhound 38-yard line. The Bears would need seven plays to retake the lead. Ursinus moved down to the Moravian 11-yard line before settling for a 29-yard field goal by **Baker** to give the Bears a 19-17 lead with 10:30 left in the four quarter. Moravian would go right down the field to retake the lead. **Rempe** started the drive with a 14-yard run, and **Panasuk** found **Sylvainus** with a

43-yard reception on third-and-eight to put the ball at the Ursinus six-yard line. **Heck** came on to make a 22-yard field goal with 7:33 to go, giving Moravian a 20-19 lead. The points in the fourth quarter were the first for the Greyhounds this season in the final 15 minutes of a game. The Bears were forced to start at their own nine-yard line after a holding penalty on the kickoff return. Ursinus would move the ball down to the Moravian 27-yard line but **Decristofaro** threw two incomplete passes before a sack by linebacker **Philip Bortz** and linebacker **Jake Hildebrand** forced a third-and-13. After a Bears' timeout, **Decristofaro** was sacked on a safety blitz by **Wacker** to give Moravian the ball at the Greyhound 40-yard line. Moravian gave the ball to **Rempe** the ball three times to try and run out the clock but **Rempe** lost control of the ball on third down with Ursinus' defensive lineman **Sam Morgan**. Ursinus was unable to move the ball on four incomplete passes by **Decristofaro** with break-ups by **King** on second down and defensive back **Brad Bodine** on fourth down. The Greyhounds kneeled down three times to end the game. The Greyhounds had 251 yards of total offense on 64 plays with **Panasuk** completing six-of-20 passes for 139 yards with two touchdowns, no interceptions and no sacks. **Panasuk** also gained nine yards on two carries. **Sylvainus** grabbed three passes for 80 yards while **Dencker** had two receptions for 38 yards. **Rempe** had his third 100-yard game of the season, running for 105 yards on 37 carries. Ursinus had 313 yards on 72 plays in the game with just 88 yards in the second half on 34 plays. **Decristofaro** was 17 of 34 for 189 yards, but he was intercepted twice and sacked three times, and he ran ten times for 24 yards. **Giarratano** caught a game high six passes for 78 yards while wide receiver **Shea Wisler** had two catches for 25 yards. **Conrad** led the Bears with 74 yards and a touchdown on 22 carries while running back **Travis Evans** had 26 yards on five attempts. **Hildebrand** led the Moravian offense with nine tackles with half a sack while defensive lineman **Seth Payne** (Collingswood, NJ/Collingswood HS) had seven tackles. Defensive back **Daniel Burley** also had seven stops while **Wacker** had five tackles with a sack and an interception. **Bodine**, **King**, **Bortz** and linebacker **Evan Bauer** all had five stops with **King** adding a pass break-up and an interception while **Bortz** had one and a half tackles for loss and half a sack. **Petros** had just three tackles but two were for loss with a sack, and he had two pass break-ups. Linebacker **Nate Mast** led the Ursinus defense with eight tackles while defensive lineman **Tony Stefanoni** and defensive back **Joe Henry** each had six stops. **Henry** added one and a half tackles for loss while **Stefanoni** had one tackle for loss.

THE QUARTERBACKS: Sophomore strong safety **Matt Johnson** has stepped in at quarterback the last four weeks and completed 49 of 92 passes for 788 yards with three touchdowns and two interception, and he has been sacked just three times in his first four games at the position since high school. Freshman **Phil Gardner** was named the starting quarterback after a strong competition in camp but missed three games due to injury. **Gardner** has completed 49 of 91 passes for 609 yards with three touchdowns and seven interceptions. His longest completion this season is a 53-yard touchdown pass against Lebanon Valley College. **Gardner** has been sacked 11 times. Freshman quarterback **Brandon Lesko** (Catasauqua, PA/Catasauqua HS), who is now playing in the defensive backfield after missing four games with an injury, has seen action at quarterback but has not thrown a pass this season and he has been sacked once. Junior quarterback **Max Coveleski** (Lewes, DE/Cape Henlopen HS) has also been on the field, completing one of four passes for four yards and an interception, and **Coveleski** has been sacked twice. Freshman quarterback **Pat Catagnus** (Trappe, PA/Perkiomen Valley HS) saw his first action of the season versus Johns Hopkins University but did not throw a pass.

IN THE BACKFIELD: In the backfield, sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** has 370 yards and two touchdowns on 96 attempts while sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** (Center Valley, PA/Southern Lehigh HS) has run for 245 yards and two touchdowns on a team high 105 carries. Sophomore quarterback/defensive back **Matt Johnson** has added 267 yards and four touchdowns on 47 carries while junior running back **Langston Ross** has 20 yards on ten attempts. Sophomore punter **Tyler Thompson** (Harrisburg, PA/Central Dauphin HS) has 11 yards on a fake punt at Dickinson College while junior running back **Philip Redline** (Jim Thorpe, PA/Jim Thorpe HS) has gained three yards on three carries. Freshman

running back **John Taggart (Wilmington, DE/Wilmington Friends HS)** has added four yards on two carries.

THE WIDE RECEIVERS: The Greyhounds have had 12 different players catch a pass through eight games led by senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** with 38 catches for 653 yards and a 68-yard touchdown. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has 25 receptions for 372 yards with three touchdowns including scores of 45 and 53 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Ryan Onushco (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS)** has 12 catches for 153 yards and a touchdown. Sophomore wide receiver **Pat Meeres (Mount Laurel, NJ/Lenape HS)** has caught five passes for 59 yards while junior tight end **Mike Zanon (Bethlehem, PA/Freedom HS)** grabbed three passes for 23 yards before an injury knocked him out for the season at McDaniel College. Sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has eight catches for 38 yards while sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** has one reception for 14 yards. Senior tight end **Jason Pauloski (Bloomington, PA/Butler HS)** has one catch for ten yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Chase Zimmik (Milford, PA/Delaware Valley HS)** has one catch for eight yards while junior running back **Langston Ross** has one reception for four yards. Junior linebacker **Evan Bauer** caught a 17-yard pass at Gettysburg while sophomore wide receiver **Albie Moran** has three catches for 50 yards.

OFFENSIVE LINE: Seniors **Daniel Cancelliere (Succasunna, NJ/Roxbury HS)**, **Matthew Washer (Ogdensburg, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS)** and **Thomas Mulligan (Ardmore, PA/Episcopal Academy)** are back on the offensive line. Joining the starting line-up will be junior center **Nicholas Guerriero (New Providence, NJ/New Providence HS)** and sophomore **Billy Viscuso (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS)**. The Greyhounds' front five has an average size of 6-1, 271. Sophomore **Jim Tersigni (Phillipsburg, NJ/Phillipsburg HS)** started at McDaniel College for an injured **Mulligan**, and **Tersigni** also started at Gettysburg College for an injured **Cancelliere**.

DEFENSIVE FRONT: Senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros** leads the Moravian defensive line with 40 tackles including ten for loss, three and a half sack, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery and two pass break-ups while junior defensive lineman **Seth Payne** has 28 tackles including four and a half tackles for loss, four pass break-ups, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery. Senior defensive lineman **Michael McClarin (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** has made 29 tackles with one and a half for loss, a half a sack and two pass break-ups while junior defensive lineman **Patrick Gordon (Bethlehem, PA/Notre Dame HS)** has 13 stops with two and a half tackles for loss. Sophomore defensive lineman **Zac Cooper (Wall, NJ/Wall HS)** has contributed four tackles with a half a tackle for loss.

THE LINEBACKER CORPS: Sophomore linebacker **Jake Hildebrand**, who has seen action on offense the last few weeks in short yardage situations, leads the linebackers and the Greyhound defense with 61 tackles including six for loss, three interceptions with a 16-yard interception return for a touchdown versus Franklin & Marshall College and five passes defended. Senior linebacker **Philip Bortz**, who saw action on offense versus Franklin & Marshall, has added 47 tackles with four and a half for loss, a sack, and interception with a 40-yard return for a touchdown at Juniata College and three passes defended while junior linebacker **Evan Bauer**, who has seen action on offensive side of the ball the last four weeks, has contributed 37 tackles with three and a half for loss, a sack, a forced fumble and three pass break-ups. Junior linebacker **Ryan Hartzell** has 37 tackles with four and a half stops for loss and two pass break-ups in his debut season at Moravian while junior linebacker **Stephen Kircher (Manasquan, NJ/Manasquan HS)** had eight tackles with a half a tackle for loss and a pass break-up before leaving the game against McDaniel with a season-ending injury. Junior linebacker **Douglas DiMattia (Cedar Grove, NJ/Cedar Grove HS)**, who made his first collegiate start against Johns Hopkins University, has 29 tackles with three for loss and two pass break-ups while sophomore linebacker **Tyler Potterton (Closter, NJ/NVRHS Demarest HS)** has 11 tackles and a pass break-up this fall.

THE DEFENSIVE BACKFIELD: In the defensive backfield, junior defensive back **David Wacker** has made 55 tackles to go with two tackles for loss, two forced fumbles, a blocked extra-point at Dickinson College, an interception, a fumble recovery and five passes defended. Senior defensive back **Daniel Burley** has contributed 37 tackles with two and a half a tackles

for loss, three interceptions with a nine-yard touchdown return at Dickinson and a total of eight passes defended while sophomore defensive back **Matt Johnson**, now the starting quarterback, has 19 tackles, a half a tackle for loss and three passes defended including an interception he returned 21 yards at McDaniel College. Sophomore defensive back **Travis King** has 13 tackles with one for loss, two interceptions including a 30-yard return for a touchdown at Juniata College and three passes defended, and **King**, who missed four games with an injury, returned to the starting line-up last weekend at Juniata College. Freshman defensive back **Zach Szoke (Walnutport, PA/Northampton HS)** came on when **King** was injured and has 36 tackles, an interception and a total of four passes defended while senior defensive back **Thomas Dailey (Easton, PA/Notre Dame HS)**, who started for **Johnson** until an injury sidelined him last week, has 31 tackles, a tackle for loss and a fumble recovery. Senior defensive back **Michael Burke (Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown)** has added seven stops.

KICKING GAME: Junior kicker **Ian Heck** is five-for-eight on field goals this season with a career long of 41 yards versus Johns Hopkins University. **Heck** is 15-for-16 on extra-point attempts, and he is averaging 55.1 yards per kickoff on 31 attempts with one touchback. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski** has punted 34 times for an average of 34.6 yards per punt with a career long of 57 yards at Susquehanna University and again at Dickinson College. **Dziengelski** has had four punts fair caught, ten inside the 20-yard line, one touchback and two blocked. Sophomore **Tyler Thompson (Harrisburg, PA/Central Dauphin HS)** punted for the first time in his collegiate career in the Johns Hopkins University game, and he averaging 28.8 yards per punt on six attempts with a long of 39 yards and two inside the 20-yard line. **Thompson** also made a pair of extra-points in his first two place kicking attempts at Juniata College.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has 21 punt returns for 165 yards including a long of 25 yards versus Franklin & Marshall College while junior running back **Langston Ross** has 13 kickoff returns for 242 yards. **Hersch** also has six kickoff returns for 119 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Pat Meeres** has one kickoff return for ten yards. **Meeres** has also recorded four tackles on special teams while freshman defensive back **Dalton Petit (Sussex, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS)** has five tackles on special teams. Sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has returned three kickoffs for 60 yards with a long of 27 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Ryan Onushco** has two kickoff returns for 54 yards including a team long of 35 yards at McDaniel College. Freshman defensive back **Matt Smith (Moscow, PA/North Pocono HS)** has three kickoff returns for 52 yards.

STARTERS PLAYER OF THE GAME: As part of Moravian's radio contract with Fox Sports Radio 1470 AM WSAW The Fox, the announcers will select the Starters Player of the Game for Moravian during the Post-Game Show. Last week, senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** was named the Player of the Game in Moravian's 42-0 win at Juniata College. **Sylvainus** caught nine passes for 165 yards to move into fifth in school history with 112 receptions and third in receiving yards at 1,748. Starters Riverport, Starters Pub and Starters Clubhouse Grille, sponsors of Moravian College Athletics, are located on 2nd Street, Route 378 South of Bethlehem and the Bethlehem Municipal Golf Course.

WINNING WAYS: Moravian had 11 consecutive winning seasons—all under Coach **Scot Dapp**, from 1987 to 1997 and has had 17 winning seasons in **Dapp's** 24 years. The 11-straight winning seasons is the longest in school history. **Dapp** ranks third among Greyhound coaches in winning percentage.

OVERTIME 'HOUNDS: Moravian has played a total of nine overtime games since the NCAA instituted the rule for the 1996 season and is 7-2 all-time in the extra-session. Five of those nine overtime games have been against Juniata College with the Greyhounds going 4-1 in those games. Moravian's contest in Huntingdon in 2008 marked the first time in the Greyhounds' have needed more than one overtime session in a game. The 2008 season also marked the second year that Moravian has played two overtimes games in one season, the other year was 1999.
