THE GAME: Moravian closes out the 2010 season looking for its fourth straight win in a Centennial Conference game versus rival Muhlenberg College. Kickoff is slated for 1:05 p.m. at Rocco Calvo Field in Bethlehem.

THE COACHES: Scot Dapp (West Chester '73) is in his 24th season at Moravian, with a career record of 142-103-1 (.579), the winningest football coach in Moravian history. He entered the season in the top 50 in winning percentage among NCAA Division III active coaches. Dapp, who served as the president of the American Football Coaches Association in 2005, has earned Coach-of-the-Year honors from the MAC three times including Co-Coach of the Year in 1997 and has led the 'Hounds to two appearances in the NCAA playoffs, the ECAC Southeast Bowl game in 2002, the ECAC Southwest Bowl game in 2004, 2005 and 2008, winning the title in 2005.

Muhlenberg coach Mike Donnelly (Ithaca '75) has a record of 91-56 (.619) in his 14th year at the school.

THE SERIES: Saturday's meeting will be the 59th in the series with Moravian holding a 32-24-2 advantage. The Mules earned a 7-0 win in Allentown last season while Moravian posted a 27-24 overtime win in Bethlehem back in 2008. Muhlenberg earned a 35-7 win in Allentown in 2007 and a 24-10 victory in Bethlehem in 2006. Moravian captured a 24-19 win in 2005 in Allentown to snap a three-game losing streak in the series.

GREYHOUNDS IN THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE: Moravian joined the Centennial Conference as an associate member in the sport of football in 2007. The Greyhounds were selected eighth in the Centennial Conference preseason coaches and sports information directors poll while Muhlenberg was selected to finish sixth. The Mules have clinched the conference's automatic berth to the 2010 NCAA Division III Playoffs and at least a share of the conference championship.

BALANCED & EXPERIENCED 'HOUNDS: Of the 81 players on the Moravian roster, 32 are freshmen, 20 are sophomores and 15 are juniors. There are 14 seniors on this season's squad, and the Greyhounds return 42 letterwinners and 14 starters.

WINNING WAYS: Moravian had 11 consecutive winning seasons—all under Coach Scot Dapp, from 1987 to 1997 and has had 17 winning seasons in Dapp's 24 years. The 11-straight winning seasons is the longest in school history. Dapp ranks third among Greyhound coaches in winning percentage.

ON TELEVISION: Saturday's game is scheduled to be broadcast live on television by Service-Electric TV-2 Sports with play-by-play from sports director Mike Zambelli, color commentary from Jim Wills and sideline reports from Regina Potocnie. This is the second of two Moravian games that will be aired this season. Since the game is being televised live, kickoff will be five minutes later at 1:05 p.m. than originally scheduled.

ON THE AIRWAVES: For the 14th straight year, the Greyhounds' games will be on the radio. Moravian's games will be aired on WSAW 1470 AM The Fox for the seventh straight year. Phil May calls the play-by-play call with color commentary from Craig Barnes and technical assistance from John Elliott. The pre-game show starts one hour prior to kickoff.

defense with 83 yards including four and a half tackles for loss, two sacks and a forced fumble while junior defensive back **Chris Hartzell** has 49 tackles with one and a half for loss, 12 passes defended with two interceptions, a forced fumble and a blocked kick. Senior linebacker **Mark Accomando** also had 49 tackles with five tackles for loss, a half a sack, three passes defended with an interception returned 38 yards for a touchdown, two fumble recoveries and a forced fumble. **Nadell** has 40 tackles with two and a half tackles for loss, five passes defended, two interceptions and a forced fumble while junior defensive end **Kenneth**

MILESTONE WATCH: The Greyhounds have three players closing in on milestones for their careers. Senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** currently has 1,833 yards on 117 career receptions. **Sylvainus** can reach second in school history with 92 yards, and he can become just the second player to 2,000 yards with 167 yards. **Sylvainus** needs just four receptions to move into third in school history. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS)** has moved into fourth in school history in punt returns with 49 returns for 328 yards. **Hersch** needs four more punt returns to move into third, and he needs just 58 yards receiving for 1,000 in his career. Senior defensive end **Allen Petros (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** is second in school history with 37.5 tackles for loss. **Petros** needs seven and a half tackles for loss to break the school record.

THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE STATISTICAL RANKINGS: The Greyhounds are third in the Centennial Conference in total defense, allowing 271.9 yards per game. The squad is second in passing defense at 168.9 yards per game, and the defense is fourth in rushing yards allowed at 103.0 per game. The Greyhounds are tied for fourth in points allowed at 18.2 per game, and the squad is ninth in points scored per game at 18.4. Offensively, Moravian is eighth in the Centennial Conference at 288.3 yards per game. The Greyhounds are ranked eighth in rushing offense at 104.8 yards per game and sixth in passing offense at 183.6 yards per game. Moravian is tied for third in turnover margin with a +0.44 per game average as the Greyhounds have committed 14 turnovers while forcing 18 turnovers. Individually, sophomore quarterback/defensive back **Matt Johnson (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS)** is first in the Centennial Conference in pass efficiency with a 143.7 rating, and he is eighth total offense at 149.4 yards per game and tenth in passing yards per contest at 115.4. Freshman quarterback **Phil Gardner (Mechanicsville, VA/Lee-Davis HS)** is ninth in the Centennial Conference in passing yards per game at 121.8, and he is tenth in total offense at 115.8 yards per contest and tenth in pass efficiency with a 105.6 rating. Sophomore running back **Joe Tegan (Haddonfield, NJ/Haddon Township HS)** is 12th in rushing at 45.7 yards per game while junior running back **Langston Ross (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** is 13th in kickoff returns with an average of 18.6 yards per return. Senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** is fifth in the conference in receptions per game at 4.78, and he fourth in receiving yards per contest at 82.0. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** is fourth in the Centennial Conference in punt returns with an average of 8.3 yards per return, and he is 13th in receiving yards per contest at 49.0 and 15th in all-purpose yardage at 82.6 yards per game. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski (Coatesville, PA/Chestnut Hill Academy)** is seventh in the conference in punting with an average of 35.1 yards per punt while junior kicker **Ian Heck (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** is eighth in kick scoring at 4.0 points per game, tied for seventh in field goals at 0.67 per contest, third in field goal percentage at 66.7 percent (six-for-nine) and first in PAT percentage at 94.7 (18-of-19). Sophomore linebacker **Jake Hildebrand (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS)** is 13th in the conference at 7.6 tackles per game, and he is tied for tenth in interceptions at 0.33 while junior defensive back **David Wacker (Parkton, MD/Hereford HS)** is tied for 20th in tackles at 6.4 per game. Junior linebacker **Phil Bortz (Allentown, PA/Parkland HS)** is tied for 32nd in the Centennial Conference in tackles with an average of 5.4 per game while senior defensive back **Daniel Burley (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** is tied for 40th in tackles at 5.0 per game, tied for fourth in interceptions at 0.44 per contest and tied for sixth in passes defended with 1.00 per outing. Senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros** is tied for 42nd in tackles at 4.9 per game, and he is fourth in tackles for loss with 1.33 per contest and tied for fourth in sacks at 0.61 per outing. Junior linebacker **Ryan Hartzell (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** is 44th in tackles at 4.8 per game while junior linebacker **Evan Bauer (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** is tied for 45th in tackle per contest at 4.7. Sophomore defensive back **Travis King (Wilmington, DE/Concord HS)** is eighth in the Centennial Conference in interceptions at 0.40 per game.

SCOUTING MUHLENBERG COLLEGE: The Mules enter the game with an overall record of 7-2 and a Centennial Conference mark of 7-1 after a 27-20 win over Ursinus College this past Saturday. Muhlenberg is being led on the field by sophomore quarterback **Dan Deighan**, who has completed 121 of 237 passes for 1,389 yards with ten touchdowns and seven interceptions. His top targets have been sophomore wide receiver **Isaiah Vaughn**, who has 30 receptions for 386 yards and three touchdowns, senior wide receiver **Jon Liberty**, who has caught 24 passes for 297 yards and two scores, and senior wide receiver **Bobby Bushong**, who has 23 receptions for 292 yards and a touchdown. Sophomore running back **Terrence Dandridge** leads the Mules rushing attack with 982 yards and nine touchdowns on 176 carries while junior running back **J.T. Merklinger** has added 225 yards and a score on 38 carries. **Deighan** has contributed 224 yards and five touchdowns on 97 rushing attempts. Junior defensive back **Chase Nadell** has returned 16 kickoffs for 487 yards with one touchdown while sophomore wide receiver **John Gruver** has nine punt returns for 42 yards. Senior kicker **Michael Katz** is 22-for-26 on extra-points this season and nine-for-14 on field goal attempts with a long of 46 yards while senior punter **Jason Lipipero** was averaging 35.6 yards on 29 punts before being injured. Junior **Kevin Ryan** is handling the punting duties now with an average of 34.2 yards on 12 punts. The Mules have intercepted 13 passes this season led by **Ryan** with four interceptions. Senior linebacker **Patrick McDonough** leads the Muhlenberg

Cobb leads the Mules with 14 tackles for loss and nine sacks to go with 39 tackles, seven passes defended, two forced fumbles and a fumble recovery.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET: Quarterback **Dan Deighan** threw a six-yard touchdown pass to tight end **Steve Liparini** for the only score as Muhlenberg College posted 7-0 win over rival Moravian College at Scotty Wood Stadium and Rocco Calvo Field to close out the 2009 season. Muhlenberg linebacker **Andy Curley** was named the Bianco Award winner as the Mules' most valuable player while Greyhound defensive lineman **Allen Petros** was named Moravian's MVP. **Curley** had seven tackles with

two and a half sacks for a loss of 18 yards while **Petros** had three tackles, all for loss, with a sack for nine yards and a pass break-up. For Moravian, the shutout was the team's third of the season, the first time since 1986 the Greyhounds were shut out three times in a season. The 1986 squad was shutout four times and finished at 4-5-1. Moravian scored just 66 points this season, the fewest in school history in a ten-game season and the fewest since the 1979 squad scored just 55 points in an 0-9 season. Muhlenberg received the opening kickoff but would punt after three plays. The Greyhounds would get a first down on its first play of the game on an 11-yard pass from quarterback **Steve Panasuk** to wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus**. However, Moravian would be forced to punt after three more plays. The Mules would gain a pair of first downs on their next drive on a pair of pass by **Deighan**, one to wide receiver **Phil Cresta** and the other to **Liparini**. Muhlenberg eventually punted, and the Greyhounds would run just three plays before **Eric Dziengelski** (Coatesville, PA/Chestnut Hill Academy) punted for the second time in the game. On the first play of Moravian's drive, running back **Ryan Rempe** (Mid-Valley, PA/Dickson City HS) picked up two yards to give him 1,501 in his career, the 11th player in Greyhound history to gain over 1,500 yards in a career. Muhlenberg would pick up a pair of first downs to move the ball to the Moravian 39-yard line on a **Deighan** pass to **Liparini** and a **Deighan** run, but a pair of holding penalties and a tackle for loss by Greyhound linebacker **Anthony Carney** would force the Mules to punt from near midfield. Moravian started from its own 18-yard and would punt after just three plays on the final play of the first quarter. The Mules started on the Moravian side of the field and picked up two first downs on a pair of runs by running back **Codie Bender** to move down to the Greyhound 25-yard line but another holding penalty forced **Jason LoPipero** to punt for the fourth time in the game. **LoPipero** pinned the Greyhounds at their own 16-yard line, and Moravian ran just three plays before **Dziengelski's** punt. Defensive back **Steve Nissley** returned the punt 28-yards down to the Moravian 19-yard line. The Mules needed five plays to get on the scoreboard on a six-yard touchdown pass from **Deighan** to **Liparini**. Kicker **Michael Katz** added the extra-point to give Muhlenberg a 7-0 lead with 8:12 to play in the second quarter. Moravian ran just two plays before committing the first turnover of the game. **Rempe** lined up at quarterback, the position he was recruited at when he came to Moravian, and had his first pass intercepted by Mule defensive back **Cameron Ahouse**. The Mules couldn't move the ball and punted after three plays but a roughing the punter call on Moravian kept possession with Muhlenberg. The Greyhound defense would hold and force another punt after three plays that **LoPipero** kicked out of bounds at the Moravian 11-yard line. The Greyhounds would put together their best drive of the half at the end of the second quarter. Moravian picked up three first downs, one on a run by **Rempe**, one on a run from tight end **Mike Zanoni** (Bethlehem, PA/Freedom HS) and one on a completion from **Panasuk** to wide receiver **Alex Hersch** to move out to the Moravian 44-yard line. However, a pair of sacks by **Curley** would force the Greyhounds into a third-and-24, and Moravian would run out the clock to end the first half. Moravian received the opening kickoff of the second half, and the Greyhounds picked up two first downs including a 31-yard pass from **Panasuk** to tight end **Brian Dencker** on a third-and-17 play. Moravian faced a fourth-and-seven at the Muhlenberg 26-yard line, and **Panasuk's** pass to **Sylvainus** down the right side line into the end zone was just out of **Sylvainus'** reach. The Mules picked up a first down on their first play of the half on a pass from **Deighan** to **Cresta**, but Muhlenberg would punt after just three more plays. The Greyhounds picked up a first down on a 26-yard end around run by **Hersch** on the second play of the drive, but two Muhlenberg sacks and a penalty forced Moravian to punt from its own 28-yard line. Muhlenberg gained one first down on its next drive on a pass from **Deighan** to **Bender** before a **LoPipero** punt forced the Greyhounds to start from their own 16-yard line. Moravian would punt again after three plays. The Mules would move into the red zone for the second time in the game on their next drive. **Deighan** hit **Liparini** with a first down pass and **Bender** picked up another first down. Muhlenberg eventually faced a fourth-and-eight at the 14-yard line when **Katz** came on to attempt a 32-yard field goal. **Katz's** attempt hit the right upright, leaving the Muhlenberg lead at 7-0 with 10:10 to play. Moravian moved backwards on its possession on a tackle for loss and a Muhlenberg sack, and the Greyhounds would punt after three plays. The Mules started in Moravian territory at the 44-yard line and got a first down

on a 13-yard pass from **Deighan** to **Bobby Bushong** before having to punt. The Greyhounds started at their own five-yard line and would gain a first down on a 27-yard run by **Rempe**. However, **Panasuk** was intercepted by Muhlenberg defensive back **Chris Hartzell** at the Mule 39-yard line. A penalty on Moravian would give the Mules the ball at the Moravian 46-yard line. The Greyhound defense would hold and forced a punt with 1:18 to play. Moravian started at its own 15-yard line on its final drive. **Panasuk** found **Sylvainus** with a ten-yard completion on the first play of the drive, but a pair of Mule sacks, the final one by linebacker **Frank Emmett** made the Greyhounds turn the ball over at their own 11-yard line with 35 seconds to play. The Mules had 182 yards of total offense on 56 plays with **Deighan** completing 13 of 20 passes for 137 yards and a touchdown while being sacked four times. **Liparini** caught five passes for 56 yards with his touchdown while **Cresta** had three receptions for 41 yards. **Bushong** had two catches for 19 yards while **Bender** grabbed two passes for 14 yards. Muhlenberg had just 45 yards on 36 carries in the game with **Bender** picking up 30 yards on 18 carries. Running back **Terrence Dandridge** added 26 yards on five carries. The 182 yards for the Muhlenberg offense was 74 yards below its season average. The Moravian defense held all but one Centennial Conference offense below its season average, and the Greyhounds kept four teams – Muhlenberg, Dickinson College, Franklin & Marshall College and Gettysburg College – to 74 or more yards below their season average. The only Centennial Conference team to reach its normal offensive output against the Moravian defense was Johns Hopkins University, which only had 48 more yards than its average against the Greyhounds. Moravian had 146 yards of offense on 55 plays with **Rempe** gaining 75 yards on 20 carries to finish his career 11th in school history with 1,570 yards on 425 carries, sixth in school history. **Hersch** had 26 yards on his only rushing attempt, and he caught three passes for 32 yards. **Sylvainus** had four receptions for 33 yards to move into 16th in career receiving yardage at 1,095 yards on 74 receptions, which is also 16th in school history with a year remaining in his career. **Dencker** grabbed three passes for 42 yards in his final collegiate game for the Greyhounds while **Zanoni** had ten yards on four carries. **Panasuk** completed ten of 18 passes for 107 yards with an interception, and he was sacked nine times in the game. On special teams for Moravian, defensive back/kick returner **Travis King** had one kickoff return of 27 yards to give him 26 kickoff returns for the season, a new Moravian single season record, for 615 yards, second in school history. **Dziengelski** finished the game with seven punts for 228 yards giving him 65 punts for 2,192 yards this season, both the second highest in school history. Linebacker **Patrick McDonough** led the Muhlenberg defense with nine tackles including one and a half tackles for loss and a sack while linebacker **Scott Lissner** had seven tackles with a half a sack to go with **Curley's** seven tackles. Defensive lineman **Jake Floyd** had six tackles with three for loss and a sack while **Hartzell** made six stops to go with his interception. Defensive lineman **Michael Kellum** added three tackles with two and a half tackles for loss and two sacks. Linebacker **Jake Hildebrand** led the Greyhound defense with seven tackles including two tackle for loss and a sack. Linebacker **Philip Bortz**, defensive back **David Wacker** and linebacker **Jayson Williams** all had six tackles for Moravian with **Williams** adding a tackle for loss while defensive back **Brad Bodine** had five tackles in his final collegiate game. Defensive back **Daniel Burley** and linebacker **Evan Bauer** each had four tackles with **Bauer** adding a sack while **Petros** had three tackles, all for loss.

THE QUARTERBACKS: Sophomore strong safety **Matt Johnson** has stepped in at quarterback the last five weeks and completed 63 of 111 passes for 1,039 yards with four touchdowns and two interception, and he has been sacked just four times in his first five games at the position since high school. Freshman **Phil Gardner** was named the starting quarterback after a strong competition in camp but missed three games due to injury. **Gardner** has completed 49 of 91 passes for 609 yards with three touchdowns and seven interceptions. His longest completion this season is a 53-yard touchdown pass against Lebanon Valley College. **Gardner** has been sacked 11 times. Freshman quarterback **Brandon Lesko** (Catasauqua, PA/Catasauqua HS), who is now playing in the defensive backfield after missing four games with an injury, has seen action at quarterback but has not thrown a pass this season and he has been sacked once. Junior quarterback **Max Coveleski** (Lewes, DE/Cape Henlopen HS) has also been

on the field, completing one of four passes for four yards and an interception, and **Coveleski** has been sacked twice. Freshman quarterback **Pat Catagnus (Trappe, PA/Perkiomen Valley HS)** saw his first action of the season versus Johns Hopkins University but did not throw a pass.

IN THE BACKFIELD: In the backfield, sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** has 411 yards and two touchdowns on a team high 113 attempts while sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore (Center Valley, PA/Southern Lehigh HS)** has run for 250 yards and two touchdowns on 110 carries. Sophomore quarterback/defensive back **Matt Johnson** has added 306 yards and five touchdowns on 63 carries while junior running back **Langston Ross** has 20 yards on ten attempts. Sophomore punter **Tyler Thompson (Harrisburg, PA/Central Dauphin HS)** has 11 yards on a fake punt at Dickinson College while junior running back **Philip Redline (Jim Thorpe, PA/Jim Thorpe HS)** has gained three yards on three carries. Freshman running back **John Taggart (Wilmington, DE/Wilmington Friends HS)** has added four yards on two carries.

THE WIDE RECEIVERS: The Greyhounds have had 12 different players catch a pass through nine games led by senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** with 43 catches for 738 yards and touchdowns of 68 and 54 yards. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has 28 receptions for 441 yards with three touchdowns including scores of 45 and 53 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Ryan Onushco (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS)** has 13 catches for 158 yards and a touchdown. Sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has ten catches for 65 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Pat Meeres (Mount Laurel, NJ/Lenape HS)** has caught five passes for 59 yards. Junior tight end **Mike Zanoni** grabbed three passes for 23 yards before an injury knocked him out for the season at McDaniel College while sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** has three receptions for 47 yards. Senior tight end **Jason Pauloski (Bloomington, PA/Butler HS)** has one catch for ten yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Chase Zimmik (Milford, PA/Delaware Valley HS)** has one catch for eight yards while junior running back **Langston Ross** has one reception for four yards. Junior linebacker **Evan Bauer** caught a 17-yard pass at Gettysburg while sophomore wide receiver **Albie Moran (Phillipsburg, NJ/Phillipsburg HS)** has four catches for 82 yards.

OFFENSIVE LINE: Seniors **Daniel Cancelliere (Succasunna, NJ/Roxbury HS)**, **Matthew Washer (Ogdensburg, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS)** and **Thomas Mulligan (Ardmore, PA/Episcopal Academy)** are back on the offensive line. Joining the starting line-up will be junior center **Nicholas Guerriero (New Providence, NJ/New Providence HS)** and sophomore **Billy Viscuso (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS)**. The Greyhounds' front five has an average size of 6-1, 271. Sophomore **Jim Tersigni (Phillipsburg, NJ/Phillipsburg HS)** started at McDaniel College for an injured **Mulligan**, and **Tersigni** also started at Gettysburg College for an injured **Cancelliere**.

DEFENSIVE FRONT: Senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros** leads the Moravian defensive line with 44 tackles including 12 for loss, five and a half sack, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery and two pass break-ups while junior defensive lineman **Seth Payne (Collingswood, NJ/Collingswood HS)** has 29 tackles including four and a half tackles for loss, four pass break-ups, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery. Senior defensive lineman **Michael McClarin (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** has made 30 tackles with one and a half for loss, a half a sack and two pass break-ups while junior defensive lineman **Patrick Gordon (Bethlehem, PA/Notre Dame HS)** has 14 stops with two and a half tackles for loss. Sophomore defensive lineman **Zac Cooper (Wall, NJ/Wall HS)** has contributed four tackles with a half a tackle for loss.

THE LINEBACKER CORPS: Sophomore linebacker **Jake Hildebrand**, who has seen action on offense the last few weeks in short yardage situations, leads the linebackers and the Greyhound defense with 68 tackles including six for loss, three interceptions with a 16-yard interception return for a touchdown versus Franklin & Marshall College and six passes defended. Senior linebacker **Philip Bortz**, who saw action on offense versus Franklin & Marshall, has added 49 tackles with four and a half for loss, a sack, and interception with a 40-yard return for a touchdown at Juniata College and four passes defended while junior linebacker **Evan**

Bauer, who has seen action on offensive side of the ball the last five weeks, has contributed 42 tackles with four and a half for loss, two sacks, a forced fumble, an interception and four passes defended. Junior linebacker **Ryan Hartzell** has 43 tackles with four and a half stops for loss and two pass break-ups in his debut season at Moravian while junior linebacker **Stephen Kircher (Manasquan, NJ/Manasquan HS)** had eight tackles with a half a tackle for loss and a pass break-up before leaving the game against McDaniel with a season-ending injury. Junior linebacker **Douglas DiMattia (Cedar Grove, NJ/Cedar Grove HS)**, who made his first collegiate start against Johns Hopkins University, has 30 tackles with three for loss and three pass break-ups while sophomore linebacker **Tyler Potterton (Closter, NJ/NVRHS Demarest HS)** has 14 tackles and a pass break-up this fall.

THE DEFENSIVE BACKFIELD: In the defensive backfield, junior defensive back **David Wacker** has made 58 tackles to go with two tackles for loss, two forced fumbles, a blocked extra-point at Dickinson College, an interception, a fumble recovery and five passes defended. Senior defensive back **Daniel Burley** has contributed 45 tackles with three and a half a tackles for loss, four interceptions with a nine-yard touchdown return at Dickinson and a total of nine passes defended while sophomore defensive back **Matt Johnson**, now the starting quarterback, has 19 tackles, a half a tackle for loss and three passes defended including an interception he returned 21 yards at McDaniel College. Sophomore defensive back **Travis King** has 22 tackles with one for loss, two interceptions including a 30-yard return for a touchdown at Juniata College and four passes defended, and **King**, who missed four games with an injury, returned to the starting line-up at Juniata College. Freshman defensive back **Zach Szoke (Walnutport, PA/Northampton HS)** came on when **King** was injured and has 37 tackles, one tackle for loss, an interception and a total of four passes defended while senior defensive back **Thomas Dailey (Easton, PA/Notre Dame HS)**, who started for **Johnson** except for the Juniata game which he missed with an injury, has 33 tackles, a tackle for loss and a fumble recovery. Senior defensive back **Michael Burke (Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown)** has added nine stops.

KICKING GAME: Junior kicker **Ian Heck** is six-for-nine on field goals this season with a career long of 41 yards versus Johns Hopkins University. **Heck** is 18-for-19 on extra-point attempts, and he is averaging 55.0 yards per kickoff on 36 attempts with one touchback. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski** has punted 40 times for an average of 35.1 yards per punt with a career long of 57 yards at Susquehanna University and again at Dickinson College. **Dziengelski** has had five punts fair caught, 13 inside the 20-yard line, two touchbacks and two blocked. Sophomore **Tyler Thompson (Harrisburg, PA/Central Dauphin HS)** punted for the first time in his collegiate career in the Johns Hopkins University game, and he averaging 28.8 yards per punt on six attempts with a long of 39 yards and two inside the 20-yard line. **Thompson** also made a pair of extra-points in his first two place kicking attempts at Juniata College.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has 22 punt returns for 183 yards including a long of 25 yards versus Franklin & Marshall College while junior running back **Langston Ross** has 13 kickoff returns for 242 yards. **Hersch** also has six kickoff returns for 119 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Pat Meeres** has one kickoff return for ten yards. **Meeres** has also recorded four tackles on special teams while freshman defensive back **Dalton Petit (Sussex, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS)** has five tackles on special teams. Sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has returned three kickoffs for 60 yards with a long of 27 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Ryan Onushco** has two kickoff returns for 54 yards including a team long of 35 yards at McDaniel College. Freshman defensive back **Matt Smith (Moscow, PA/North Pocono HS)** has three kickoff returns for 52 yards while sophomore **Travis King** has three kickoff returns for 54 yards.

STARTERS PLAYER OF THE GAME: As part of Moravian's radio contract with Fox Sports Radio 1470 AM WSAW The Fox, the announcers will select the Starters Player of the Game for Moravian during the Post-Game Show. Against Ursinus College, sophomore quarterback **Matt Johnson** and senior defensive back **Daniel Burley** were named the Co-

Player of the Game in Moravian's 24-17 win over nationally-ranked Ursinus College. **Johnson** completed 14 of 19 passes for 251 yards with a touchdown, and he ran for 39 yards and a touchdown on 16 carries. **Burley** had eight tackles with one for loss and an interception late in the fourth quarter to seal the victory. Starters Riverport, Starters Pub and Starters Clubhouse Grille, sponsors of Moravian College Athletics, are located on 2nd Street, Route 378 South of Bethlehem and the Bethlehem Municipal Golf Course.

OVERTIME 'HOUNDS: Moravian has played a total of nine overtime games since the NCAA instituted the rule for the 1996 season and is 7-2 all-

time in the extra-session. Five of those nine overtime games have been against Juniata College with the Greyhounds going 4-1 in those games. Moravian's contest in Huntingdon in 2008 marked the first time in the Greyhounds' have needed more than one overtime session in a game. The 2008 season also marked the second year that Moravian has played two overtimes games in one season, the other year was 1999.
