THE GAME: Moravian looks for its fifth straight win in the program's fifth ECAC appearance. The Greyhounds will travel to Wilkes University for the 2010 ECAC Division III Southeast Bowl Championship game on Saturday, November 20th. Kickoff is slated for 12:00 p.m. at Ralston Athletic Complex in Edwardsville, Pennsylvania.

THE COACHES: **Scot Dapp** (West Chester '73) is in his 24th season at Moravian, with a career record of 143-103-1 (.581), the winningest football coach in Moravian history. He entered the season in the top 50 in winning percentage among NCAA Division III active coaches. **Dapp**, who served as the president of the American Football Coaches Association in 2005, has earned Coach-of-the-Year honors from the MAC three times including Co-Coach of the Year in 1997 and has led the 'Hounds to two appearances in the NCAA playoffs, the ECAC Southeast Bowl game in 2002 and 2010, the ECAC Southwest Bowl game in 2004, 2005 and 2008, winning the title in 2005.

Wilkes coach **Frank Sheptock** (Bloomsburg '86) has a record of 94-64 (.594) in his 15th year at the school.

THE SERIES: Saturday's meeting will be the 47th in the series with Moravian holding a 29-16-1 advantage. The Colonels have won the last two meetings with a 17-0 victory in Edwardsville in 2006 during Moravian's final season in the Middle Atlantic Conference and a 27-17 win in Bethlehem in 2005. Prior to that, Moravian had won six straight games and 12 of the previous 15 meetings.

ECAC BOWL GAMES: Moravian is playing in the ECAC Bowl Game for the fifth time since 2004, winning the ECAC Southwest Bowl in 2005. Wilkes is making its eighth appearance in the ECAC Championships. The Colonels won the South Atlantic title in 2002 and the Southeast championship in 1994 and 1999.

GREYHOUNDS IN THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE: Moravian joined the Centennial Conference as an associate member in the sport of football in 2007. The Greyhounds were selected eighth in the Centennial Conference preseason coaches and sports information directors poll, and Moravian finished in fourth place, one victory out of a tie for the conference championship.

BALANCED & EXPERIENCED 'HOUNDS: Of the 81 players on the Moravian roster, 32 are freshmen, 20 are sophomores and 15 are juniors. There are 14 seniors on this season's squad, and the Greyhounds return 42 letterwinners and 14 starters.

WINNING WAYS: Moravian had 11 consecutive winning seasons—all under Coach **Scot Dapp**, from 1987 to 1997 and has had 18 winning seasons in **Dapp's** 24 years. The 11-straight winning seasons is the longest in school history. **Dapp** ranks third among Greyhound coaches in winning percentage.

ON THE AIRWAVES: For the 14th straight year, the Greyhounds' games will be on the radio. Moravian's games will be aired on WSAW 1470 AM The Fox for the seventh straight year. **Phil May** calls the play-by-play call with color commentary from **Joel Kowalski** and technical assistance from **John Elliott**. The pre-game show starts one hour prior to kickoff at 11:00 a.m.

SCOUTING WILKES UNIVERSITY: The Colonels enter the game with an overall record of 6-4, and Wilkes was 5-2 in Middle Atlantic Conference action after a 21-17 win over rival King's College last Saturday. Sophomore quarterback **Tyler Berntsen** leads the Colonels on the field, having completed 92 of 176 passes for 1,062 yards with five interceptions and five touchdowns. His top targets have been senior wide receiver **Jordan D'Emilio** with 48 catches for 512 yards and four touchdowns, senior tight end **Anthony Dorunda**, who has 24 catches for 198 yards and a score, junior wide receiver **Todd Eagles** with 22 receptions for 408 yards and three touchdowns and junior running back **Zach Tivald**, who has 22 catches for 297 yards and a score. **Tivald** also leads Wilkes' rushing attack with 786 yards and eight touchdowns on 163 carries while freshman running back **Auxence Wogou** has 48 carries for 337 yards and three scores. **Berntsen** has contributed 296 yards and five touchdowns on the ground in 107 attempts. Sophomore wide receiver **David Kratzer** has 12 kickoff returns for 213 yards and four punt returns for 12 yards while **Wogou** has returned 11 kickoffs for 248 yards. Junior kicker/punter **Chris Horn** is averaging

MILESTONE WATCH: The Greyhounds have four players closing in on milestones for their careers. Senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus (Nazareth, PA/Nazareth HS)** currently has 1,904 yards on 123 career receptions. **Sylvainus** can reach second in school history with 21 yards, and he can become just the second player to 2,000 yards with 96 yards. **Sylvainus** needs 18 receptions to break the school record. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS)** has moved into fourth in school history in punt returns with 50 returns for 339 yards. **Hersch** needs three more punt returns to move into third, and he needs just 37 yards receiving for 1,000 in his career. **Hersch** has caught 65 passes for 963 yards in 40 games. Senior defensive end **Allen Petros (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** is second in school history with 37.5 tackles for loss. **Petros** needs seven and a half tackles for loss to break the school record. Senior defensive back **Daniel Burley (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** reached 200 career tackles in the regular season finale against Muhlenberg College, and **Burley** has made 204 tackles while playing in all 41 career games.

2010 ALL-CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE TEAMS: The Moravian College football team has had seven players named to the 2010 All-Centennial Conference Football Teams announced Tuesday with senior office lineman **Daniel Cancelliere (Succasunna, NJ/Roxbury HS)** and senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros** earning first team honors. The Greyhounds had four All-Centennial Conference Second Team honoree with junior defensive lineman **Seth Payne (Collingswood, NJ/Collingswood HS)**, senior linebacker **Philip Bortz (Allentown, PA/Parkland HS)**, sophomore linebacker **Jake Hildebrand (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS)** and senior defensive back **Daniel Burley** making the defensive squad. Junior defensive back **David Wacker (Parkton, MD/Hereford HS)** earned All-Centennial Conference Honorable Mention.

THE CENTENNIAL CONFERENCE STATISTICAL RANKINGS: The Greyhounds are third in the Centennial Conference in total defense, allowing 267.9 yards per game. The squad is second in passing defense at 166.3 yards per game, and the defense is fourth in rushing yards allowed at 101.6 per game. The Greyhounds are tied for fourth in points allowed at 17.7 per game, and the squad is ninth in points scored per game at 18.0. Offensively, Moravian is eighth in the Centennial Conference at 285.3 yards per game. The Greyhounds are ranked seventh in rushing offense at 110.5 yards per game and sixth in passing offense at 174.8 yards per game. Moravian is tied for second in turnover margin with a +0.60 per game average as the Greyhounds have committed 16 turnovers while forcing 22 turnovers. Individually, sophomore quarterback/defensive back **Matt Johnson (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS)** is fifth in the Centennial Conference in pass efficiency with a 137.3 rating, and he is eighth total offense at 148.4 yards per game and tenth in passing yards per contest at 113.5. Freshman quarterback **Phil Gardner (Mechanicsville, VA/Lee-Davis HS)** is ninth in the Centennial Conference in passing yards per game at 121.8, and he is tenth in total offense at 115.8 yards per contest and 11th in pass efficiency with a 105.6 rating. Sophomore running back **Joe Tegan (Haddonfield, NJ/Haddon Township HS)** is 12th in rushing at 51.2 yards per game while junior running back **Langston Ross (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** is 12^h in kickoff returns with an average of 18.6 yards per return. Senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** is tied for fifth in the conference in receptions per game at 4.90, and he fourth in receiving yards per contest at 80.9. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** is fourth in the Centennial Conference in punt returns with an average of 8.4 yards per return, and he is 15th in receiving yards per contest at 46.2. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski (Coatesville, PA/Chestnut Hill Academy)** is eighth in the conference in punting with an average of 34.7 yards per punt while junior kicker **Ian Heck (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** is tied for eighth in kick scoring at 3.8 points per game, tied for seventh in field goals at 0.60 per contest and first in PAT percentage at 95.2 (20-of-21). Sophomore linebacker **Jake Hildebrand** is tied for 14th in the conference at 7.4 tackles per game, and he is tied for 11th in interceptions at 0.30 while junior defensive back **David Wacker** is tied for 19th in tackles at 6.5 per game. Junior linebacker **Phil Bortz** is tied for 31st in the Centennial Conference in tackles with an average of 5.4 per game while senior defensive back **Daniel Burley** is tied for 41st in tackles at 5.0 per game, tied for second in interceptions at 0.50 per contest and tied for sixth in passes defended with 1.00 per outing. Senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros** is tied for 46th in tackles at 4.8 per game, and he is sixth in tackles for loss with 1.20 per contest and tied for fifth in sacks at 0.55 per outing. Junior linebacker **Ryan Hartzell (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** is tied for 49th in tackles at 4.6 per game while sophomore defensive back **Travis King (Wilmington, DE/Concord HS)** is tied for ninth in the Centennial Conference in interceptions at 0.33 per game.

35.0 yards per punt with a long of 52 yards, one touchback, 14 fair caught, 14 inside the 20-yard line and one blocked. **Horn** is also 27-for-28 on extra-points and 12-for-17 on field goal attempts with a long of 49 yards. He is averaging 57.6 yards per kickoffs. Senior defensive back **Kevin Gerhart** leads the Colonels with five of the team's 15 interceptions with 143 return yards which includes a 100-yard return for a touchdown. Freshman linebacker **Tate Moore-Jacobs** leads the Wilkes defense with 130 tackles, five tackles for loss, half a sack, one interception, two passes defended, four fumble recoveries and a forced fumble while **Gerhart** has 105 stops with one tackle for loss, nine passes defended, two forced fumbles and a pair of fumble recoveries. Senior linebacker **Ryan Clifford** has 69 tackles with five and a half tackle for loss, a sack and an interception while senior defensive back **Greg Nielsen** has 59 tackles, one tackle for loss, two interceptions, eight passes defended, two fumble recoveries and a forced fumble. Freshman linebacker **Tom Calabrese** leads Wilkes with three sacks despite missing three games this season.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET: Quarterback **Al Karaffa** connected on a pair of touchdown passes to wide receiver **Jim Jordan** to lead the Wilkes University football team to a 17-0 victory over Moravian College in Middle Atlantic Conference action at Ralston Field on October 21, 2006. Moravian took the opening kickoff and 34-yard return by **Antuan Dixon**, the Greyhounds started at their own 38-yard line. However, Moravian would punt after picking up nine yards on three plays. Wilkes began its first possession at its own 31-yard line. The Colonels would pickup one first down before Moravian defensive back **Justin Klement** forced Colonel running back **Tom Andreopoulos** to fumble the ball at the Moravian 38-yard line with Greyhound linebacker **Cliff Garr** recovering to give Moravian possession. The Greyhounds moved down to Wilkes-six yard line after three third down completions for first down by Moravian quarterback **Ryan Rempe**. However, **Rempe** was sacked twice moving the ball back to the 14-yard line. Kicker **Brian Reckenbeil** lined up for a 31-yard field goal but senior defensive back **Mike Ferriero** came off the right side of the line to block the kick, keeping the score at 0-0 in the first quarter. Wilkes took over at its own 21-yard line. After a pass completion by **Karaffa**, **Andreopoulos** broke off a 53-yard run to move the ball to the Moravian 11-yard line. The Greyhound defense would stiffen and force a 30-yard field goal attempt by kicker **Ryan Yurewicz**. **Yurewicz** put the ball through the middle of the uprights to give Wilkes a 3-0 lead with 1:59 remaining in the first quarter. **Andreopoulos** finished the game with 128 yards on 20 carries. On the ensuing kickoff, Moravian wide receiver **Sean Hill** had a 57-yard kickoff return to give the Greyhounds the ball at the Wilkes 33-yard line. On the first play of the drive, Moravian tried a flea-flicker but **Rempe** was intercepted by **Ferriero** at the goal line. **Ferriero** returned the ball to the Wilkes 42-yard line. The Colonels would eventually punt on the third play of the second quarter. Moravian would only run three plays before punting again with Wilkes taking over on its own 44-yard line after a fair catch. The Colonels mixed the pass and the run to move down inside the ten-yard line. The Greyhound defense stiffened again including a near interception at the goal line by defensive lineman **Don Maxwell**, forcing Wilkes to attempt a 23-yard field goal. However, Moravian running back **Edward Savoth** blocked **Yurewicz's** kick with defensive back **Brad Bodine** giving the Greyhounds possession at the Wilkes 15-yard line. Moravian would pickup two first downs including a 16-yard run by **Rempe** before attempting punting the ball away to Wilkes. The snap was high forcing Greyhound punter **Michael Voskian** to slow his kick. Wilkes defensive back **Bob Sutjak** blocked the punt that was recovered by quarterback **B.J. Fusco**. On the first play of the drive, **Karaffa** hit **Jordan** with a 29-yard touchdown pass. **Yurewicz** extra-point gave the Colonels a 10-0 lead with 4:35 remaining in the first half. The Greyhounds started their next drive at their own 37-yard line. Moravian moved into Wilkes territory but ended up punting with **Voskian's** punt rolling out of bounds at the two-yard line. Wilkes started the second half with a good kickoff return to place the ball at their 41-yard line. After two plays for no gain and a sack by Moravian defensive end **Nick Feo**, Wilkes punted the ball to the Greyhounds. **Feo** had a pair of sacks among his three tackles in the game. Moravian would take possession at its own 25-yard line. The Greyhounds would get a first down by penalty before **Rempe** fumbled after being hit by defensive lineman **Jason Acquaye**. Defensive lineman **Anthony Serafin** covered the ball at the Moravian 46-yard line, giving Wilkes the ball. The Colonels lost yardage again before punting after three plays. The Greyhounds took possession at their own 24-yard line. Moravian moved into Wilkes territory with a first down by penalty and an 18-yard pass from quarterback **Marc Braxmeier** to wide receiver **Shawn Martell**. However, the Greyhounds would eventually punt. Wilkes did get one first down before punting as well. Moravian moved the ball to midfield with one first down before punting. Wilkes took over at its 28-yard line. The Colonels picked up a first down before punting as both defenses stiffened in the second half. Moravian started at its own 17-yard line. The Greyhounds picked up a pair of first downs, including a completion from **Braxmeier** to **Bisci** before punting. On the first play of the drive, **Karaffa** connected on an 80-yard touchdown pass and run to **Jordan**. **Yurewicz** made the extra-point to give the Colonels a 17-0 lead with 10:09 remaining in the game. Moravian would get one first down on its next possession before punting from midfield. Wilkes would move the ball slowly down the field to run out the clock. **Rempe** completed six of 12 passes for 66 yards with one

interception, and he was sacked four times while **Braxmeier** hit four of 11 passes for 52 yards. Tight end **Kris Bisci** caught four passes for 35 yards for the Greyhounds while **Hill** had two catches for 33 yards and tight end **Brian Dencker** had two receptions for 26 yards. Running back **Tyler McCambridge** led the Greyhounds with 72 yards on 22 carries while fullback **Morgan de Rouen** had seven yards on five carries and one reception for six yards. For the Colonel offense, **Karaffa** completed 13 of 20 passes for 203 yards while being sacked four times. **Jordan** caught five passes for 134 yards while wide receiver **Stephon Burgette** had six catches for 61 yards. **Garr** led the Moravian defense with eight tackles, a tackle for loss, a pass break-up and a fumble recovery while linebacker **Jayson Williams** added seven tackles including two sacks. **Bodine** added six tackles while **Klement** and linebacker **Andrew Morrissey**, defensive back **Erik Brinkerhoff** and linebacker **Kevin McGorry** each made five tackles. Linebacker **Kyle Follweiler** led the Wilkes defense with ten tackles while linebacker **Tyler Henninger** had nine tackles with three for loss and two sacks. Defensive back **Jake Grande** and **Acquaye** each have six stops and a pass break-up with **Acquaye** adding two tackles for loss, a sack and a forced fumble. **Ferriero** had just one tackle but added six pass break-ups to his blocked field goal and interception.

THE QUARTERBACKS: Sophomore strong safety **Matt Johnson** has stepped in at quarterback the last six weeks and completed 74 of 131 passes for 1,135 yards with five touchdowns and three interceptions, and he has been sacked just eight times in his first six games at the position since high school. Freshman **Phil Gardner** was named the starting quarterback after a strong competition in camp but missed three games due to injury. **Gardner** has completed 49 of 91 passes for 609 yards with three touchdowns and seven interceptions. His longest completion this season is a 53-yard touchdown pass against Lebanon Valley College. **Gardner** has been sacked 11 times. Freshman quarterback **Brandon Lesko (Catasauqua, PA/Catasauqua HS)**, who is now playing in the defensive backfield after missing four games with an injury, has seen action at quarterback but has not thrown a pass this season and he has been sacked once. Junior quarterback **Max Coveleski (Lewes, DE/Cape Henlopen HS)** has also been on the field, completing one of four passes for four yards and an interception, and **Coveleski** has been sacked twice. Freshman quarterback **Pat Catagnus (Trappe, PA/Perkiomen Valley HS)** saw his first action of the season versus Johns Hopkins University but did not throw a pass.

IN THE BACKFIELD: In the backfield, sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** has 512 yards and three touchdowns on a team high 136 attempts while sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore (Center Valley, PA/Southern Lehigh HS)** has run for 265 yards and two touchdowns on 116 carries. Sophomore quarterback/defensive back **Matt Johnson** has added 353 yards and five touchdowns on 78 carries while junior running back **Langston Ross** has 20 yards on ten attempts. Sophomore punter **Tyler Thompson (Harrisburg, PA/Central Dauphin HS)** has 11 yards on a fake punt at Dickinson College while junior running back **Philip Redline (Jim Thorpe, PA/Jim Thorpe HS)** has gained three yards on three carries. Freshman running back **John Taggart (Wilmington, DE/Wilmington Friends HS)** has added four yards on two carries.

THE WIDE RECEIVERS: The Greyhounds have had 12 different players catch a pass through nine games led by senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** with 49 catches for 809 yards and three touchdowns including scores of 68 and 54 yards. Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has 29 receptions for 462 yards with three touchdowns including scores of 45 and 53 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Ryan Onushco (Macungie, PA/Emmaus HS)** has 13 catches for 158 yards and a touchdown. Sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has 13 catches for 64 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Pat Meeres (Mount Laurel, NJ/Lenape HS)** has caught five passes for 59 yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Albie Moran (Phillipsburg, NJ/Phillipsburg HS)** has four catches for 82 yards while junior tight end **Mike Zanon** grabbed three passes for 23 yards before an injury knocked him out for the season at McDaniel College. Sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** has four receptions for 52 yards while senior tight end **Jason Pauloski (Bloomington, PA/Butler HS)** has one catch for ten yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Chase Zimmik (Milford, PA/Delaware Valley HS)** has one catch for eight yards while junior running

back **Langston Ross** has one reception for four yards. Junior linebacker **Evan Bauer** caught a 17-yard pass at Gettysburg.

OFFENSIVE LINE: Seniors **Daniel Cancelliere**, **Matthew Washer** (**Ogdensburg, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS**) and **Thomas Mulligan** (**Ardmore, PA/Episcopal Academy**) are back on the offensive line. Joining the starting line-up will be junior center **Nicholas Guerriero** (**New Providence, NJ/New Providence HS**) and sophomore **Billy Viscuso** (**Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS**). The Greyhounds' front five has an average size of 6-1, 271. Sophomore **Jim Tersigni** (**Phillipsburg, NJ/Phillipsburg HS**) has also started four games this season for the Greyhounds.

DEFENSIVE FRONT: Senior defensive lineman **Allen Petros** leads the Moravian defensive line with 48 tackles including 12 for loss, five and a half sack, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery and two pass break-ups while junior defensive lineman **Seth Payne** (has 29 tackles including four and a half tackles for loss, four pass break-ups, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery. Senior defensive lineman **Michael McClarin** (**Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS**) has made 37 tackles with one and a half for loss, a half a sack and three pass break-ups while junior defensive lineman **Patrick Gordon** (**Bethlehem, PA/Notre Dame HS**) has 14 stops with two and a half tackles for loss, a blocked extra-point to seal the victory over rival Muhlenberg College and a fumble recovery. Sophomore defensive lineman **Zac Cooper** (**Wall, NJ/Wall HS**) has contributed four tackles with a half a tackle for loss.

THE LINEBACKER CORPS: Sophomore linebacker **Jake Hildebrand**, who has seen action on offense the last few weeks in short yardage situations, leads the linebackers and the Greyhound defense with 75 tackles including seven for loss, three interceptions with a 16-yard interception return for a touchdown versus Franklin & Marshall College and seven passes defended. Senior linebacker **Philip Bortz**, who saw action on offense versus Franklin & Marshall College, has added 54 tackles with four and a half for loss, a sack, and interception with a 40-yard return for a touchdown at Juniata College and four passes defended while junior linebacker **Evan Bauer**, who has seen action on offensive side of the ball the last five weeks, has contributed 45 tackles with four and a half for loss, two and a half sacks, two forced fumbles, a fumble recovery, an interception and four passes defended. Junior linebacker **Ryan Hartzell** has 46 tackles with five and a half stops for loss and two pass break-ups in his debut season at Moravian while junior linebacker **Stephen Kircher** (**Manasquan, NJ/Manasquan HS**) had eight tackles with a half a tackle for loss and a pass break-up before leaving the game against McDaniel with a season-ending injury. Junior linebacker **Douglas DiMattia** (**Cedar Grove, NJ/Cedar Grove HS**), who made his first collegiate start against Johns Hopkins University, has 32 tackles with three for loss and three pass break-ups while sophomore linebacker **Tyler Potterton** (**Closter, NJ/NVRHS Demarest HS**) has 15 tackles and a pass break-up this fall.

THE DEFENSIVE BACKFIELD: In the defensive backfield, junior defensive back **David Wacker** has made 65 tackles to go with three tackles for loss, two forced fumbles, a blocked extra-point at Dickinson College, a blocked field goal against Muhlenberg College, an interception, a fumble recovery and seven passes defended. Senior defensive back **Daniel Burley** has contributed 50 tackles with three and a half a tackles for loss, five interceptions with a nine-yard touchdown return at Dickinson and a total of ten passes defended while sophomore defensive back **Matt Johnson**, now the starting quarterback, has 19 tackles, a half a tackle for loss and three passes defended including an interception he returned 21 yards at McDaniel College. Sophomore defensive back **Travis King** has 30 tackles with two for loss, two interceptions including a 30-yard return for a touchdown at Juniata College and four passes defended, and **King**, who missed four games with an injury, returned to the starting line-up at Juniata College. Freshman defensive back **Zach Szoke** (**Walnutport, PA/Northampton HS**) came on

when **King** was injured and has 38 tackles, one tackle for loss, an interception and a total of four passes defended while senior defensive back **Thomas Dailey** (**Easton, PA/Notre Dame HS**), who started for **Johnson** except for the Juniata game which he missed with an injury, has 39 tackles, two tackles for loss, a sack, an interception with a 15-yard return and a fumble recovery. Senior defensive back **Michael Burke** (**Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown**) has added nine stops.

KICKING GAME: Junior kicker **Ian Heck** is six-for-nine on field goals this season with a career long of 41 yards versus Johns Hopkins University. **Heck** is 20-for-21 on extra-point attempts, and he is averaging 55.3 yards per kickoff on 39 attempts with one touchback. Senior punter **Eric Dziengelski** has punted 45 times for an average of 34.7 yards per punt with a career long of 57 yards at Susquehanna University and again at Dickinson College. **Dziengelski** has had six punts fair caught, 15 inside the 20-yard line, two touchbacks and one blocked. Sophomore **Tyler Thompson** punted for the first time in his collegiate career in the Johns Hopkins University game, and he averaging 28.8 yards per punt on six attempts with a long of 39 yards and two inside the 20-yard line. **Thompson** also made a pair of extra-points in his first two place kicking attempts at Juniata College.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Senior wide receiver **Alex Hersch** has 23 punt returns for 194 yards including a long of 25 yards versus Franklin & Marshall College while junior running back **Langston Ross** has 13 kickoff returns for 242 yards. **Hersch** also has six kickoff returns for 119 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Pat Meeres** has one kickoff return for ten yards. **Meeres** has also recorded four tackles on special teams while freshman defensive back **Dalton Petit** (**Sussex, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS**) has six tackles on special teams. Sophomore running back **Rocco Del Priore** has returned three kickoffs for 60 yards with a long of 27 yards while sophomore wide receiver **Ryan Onushco** has two kickoff returns for 54 yards including a team long of 35 yards at McDaniel College. Freshman defensive back **Matt Smith** (**Moscow, PA/North Pocono HS**) has three kickoff returns for 52 yards while sophomore **Travis King** has five kickoff returns for 98 yards.

STARTERS PLAYER OF THE GAME: As part of Moravian's radio contract with Fox Sports Radio 1470 AM WSAW The Fox, the announcers will select the Starters Player of the Game for Moravian during the Post-Game Show. Against Muhlenberg College, sophomore running back **Joe Tegan** and senior wide receiver **Shawn Sylvainus** were named the Co-Player of the Game in Moravian's 24-17 win over nationally-ranked Ursinus College. **Tegan** ran for a career high 101 yards and a touchdown on 23 carries, and caught one pass for five yards while being named Moravian's Most Valuable Player by the media. **Sylvainus** caught six passes for 71 yards for 71 yards including the go-ahead 27-yard touchdown in the third quarter. Starters Riverport, Starters Pub and Starters Clubhouse Grille, sponsors of Moravian College Athletics, are located on 2nd Street, Route 378 South of Bethlehem and the Bethlehem Municipal Golf Course.

OVERTIME 'HOUNDS: Moravian has played a total of nine overtime games since the NCAA instituted the rule for the 1996 season and is 7-2 all-time in the extra-session. Five of those nine overtime games have been against Juniata College with the Greyhounds going 4-1 in those games. Moravian's contest in Huntingdon in 2008 marked the first time in the Greyhounds' have needed more than one overtime session in a game. The 2008 season also marked the second year that Moravian has played two overtimes games in one season, the other year was 1999.
