Women's Basketball – 2-6 (Commonwealth Conference 1-2, MAC 1-3)

Last Week – Lost to *Susquehanna, 64-52; Lost to Marymount (VA), 70-49. *Commonwealth game

The Greyhounds were able to snap a four-game losing streak in their first contest of the new year, defeating Dickinson College, 72-64. Moravian held several leads in the game with its biggest of 12 points coming with just under five minutes left to play in the game. Sophomore **Tara Wozniak** (**Roseland**, **NJ/West Essex Regional HS**) had one of the best games of her career for the Greyhounds with 19 points and career bests 12 rebounds, six steals and four blocked shots. Sophomore forward **Kelly McLean** (**Allentown/Salisbury HS**) led the team with 21 points and she added seven rebounds, four steals and three blocked shots. Freshman guard **Kim Hughes** (**Manasquan**, **NJ/St. Rose HS**) chipped in 11 points and five steals in the win while freshman forward **Kristen Rohal** (**Bethlehem/Liberty HS**) added a career high nine points and a career best seven rebounds in just 12 minutes. Sophomore forward **Kristen Sarnocinski** (**Harleysville/Germantown Academy**) had six points and six boards for Moravian while freshman forward **Tracie Shipman** (**Philadelphia/Archbishop Ryan HS**) pulled down seven rebounds.

McLean and Hughes combined to shoot 17 of 28 from the floor and score 37 points in the Greyhounds 64-52 victory over Ursinus College in just the team's second home game of the season. McLean added 13 rebounds and three blocked shots while Hughes had two assists and two steals. After McLean and Hughes, the rest of the Greyhounds were nine of 42 from the floor. Wozniak had 16 points in the game and she added seven rebounds, three assists and two blocked shots. Moravian received just five points from its eight bench players in the game. Junior forward Mary Morgans (Center Valley/Allentown Central Catholic HS) returned to the Moravian line-up after sitting out the first nine games after off-season surgery to grabbed five rebounds and blocked a shot in ten minutes. Sarnocinski added six rebounds in the game.

Moravian had three runners compete in the Haverford College First Chance Meet with junior **Josh Heebner** (**Lansdale/North Penn HS**) placing second in the 400 meters with a time of 52 seconds to lead the team. Sophomore **Wes Zimmerman (Boyertown/Boyertown HS**) placed eighth in the 5,000 meters in 15:57.4 while sophomore **George Wacker (Honesdale/Honesdale HS**) was 18th in the 1,500 meters in 4:22.3.

The Greyhounds sent just three competitors to the Haverford College First Chance Meet but came home with two first place finishes and four top three finishes. Junior **Heidi Wolfsberger** (**Moosic/Riverside HS**) won the 1,500 meters in a NCAA Division III automatic qualifying time of 4:39.1 and she also won the 800 meters in 2:27.2. Junior **Erin Boyle** (**Philadelphia/Nazareth Academy**) placed second to Wolfsberger in the 1,500 meters at 4:56.1 while junior **Kim Jaick** (**Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS**) was third in the 5,000 meters with a time of 17:50.0.

The Greyhounds won their first game of the new year, defeating Centenary (NJ) College, 78-47, in the first round of the Greyhound Nike Classic. Moravian used a balanced scoring attack led by senior forward **Chris Hayn (Whitehall/Whitehall HS)** with 13 points. Sophomore forward **Ken Greb (Mount Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley Regional HS)** had 12 points while freshman guard **Lucas Malischak (Wanamie/ Nanticoke HS)** added 11 points. Hayn also led the Greyhounds on the boards with seven rebounds while Greb and junior forward **Mike Frew (Glen Ridge, NJ/Glen Ridge HS)** had six rebounds each. The Greyhounds had 19 offensive rebounds in the game with 12 in the first half as Moravian built a 45-20 halftime lead. Sophomore **Kevin Hall (Mountain Top/Pocono Mountain HS)** added eight points in the game while freshman guard **Jon Leader (Halifax/Halifax HS)** led the Greyhounds with four assists and three steals.

The Greyhounds jumped out to a 14-point halftime lead, 35-21, over rival Muhlenberg College in the champion-ship game of the 23rd Annual Greyhound Nike Classic but Moravian couldn't hold on for its 11th tournament champion-ship as the Mules out scored Moravian 54-34 in the second half to earn a 75-69 win. Muhlenberg picked up its fourth title when playing Moravian for the championship in ten tries and the fifth title overall for the Mules. Hall, an All-Tournament selection, led Moravian with 19 points. Greb was also named to the All-Tournament team after a 10-point, career best 13-rebound performance. Senior guard **David Jordan (Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant Boro HS)** scored 13 points and had six rebounds while Malischak added ten points. Hayn had eight rebounds in the loss.
