The Greyhounds used a balanced scoring attack to defeated visiting Albright College, 73-45, in Commonwealth Conference action and to earn their tenth win of the season. Freshman guard **Kim Hughes (Manasquan, NJ/St. Rose HS)** scored 16 points while sophomore forward **Kelly McLean (Allentown/ Salisbury HS)** had 15 points and sophomore guard **Tara Wozniak (Roseland, NJ/West Essex Regional HS)**, last week's Commonwealth Conference Player of the Week, had 14 points. Moravian out-rebounded the Lions, 45-28, led by ten rebounds from freshman forward **Tracie Shipman (Philadelphia/Archbishop Ryan HS)**. **McLean** pulled down seven rebounds while **Hughes** and sophomore forward **Sue Creelman (Mount Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley Regional HS)** each had six boards. **Shipman** added five steals while **Hughes** had three assists.

Hughes tossed in 24 points and **Wozniak** had 23 points but it wasn't enough as the Greyhounds fell to Lebanon Valley College, 80-75. The two teams were tied at the half, 35-35, but the Flying Dutchmen led by as many as 14 points in the second half. **Shipman** had a career day with a career high 11 points and a career best 13 rebounds as Moravian out-rebounded Lebanon Valley, 44-41. **McLean** had 12 points in the game and she added seven rebounds. Moravian was 12 of 17 at the free throw line in the game while the Flying Dutchmen were 24 of 38.

Men's Indoor Track & Field 0-0 (Commonwealth Conference 0-0, MAC 0-0)

Sophomore **Wes Zimmerman (Boyertown/Boyertown HS)** led the way for the Greyhounds at the Marc Deneault Memorial Invitational hosted by Cornell University this weekend with a seventh place finish in the 5,000 meters in a season best time of 15:56.10. Freshman **Steve Hartenstine (Danielsville/Northampton HS)** ran a 9.33 in the 60-meter high hurdles and he teamed with juniors **Josh Heebner (Lansdale/North Penn HS)** and **Kevin Bush (Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS)** and sophomore **George Wacker (Honesdale/ Honesdale HS)** to place fourth in the 4x400-meter relay in 3:31.60. **Bush** was sixth in the first heat of the 400 meters in 53.53 and **Heebner** followed him in seventh at 57.96. **Wacker** placed seventh in his section of the 800 meters in 2:02.61. **Hartenstine** posted a 24.73 in the 200 meters while freshman **Anthony Merz (Philadelphia/Archbishop Ryan HS)** had a 26.61.

Freshman **Joe Grady (Nanticoke/Nanticoke HS)** ran the Greyhounds best time in the mile at 4:33.96 and he was second in his heat. Also running in the mile were junior **Chris DeWalt (Easton/Easton HS)** at 4:55.07 and sophomore **Matt Plewinski (Hatfield/North Penn HS)** in 4:55.88. Junior **Chris Colley (Easton/Easton HS)** ran a 55.86 in the 400 meters while sophomore **Chris McGinnis (Brick, NJ/Brick Memorial HS)** ran a 57.14 and junior **Jim McIntyre (Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown HS)** had a 57.99. The trio joined sophomore **Eric Paul (Reading/Reading Central Catholic HS)** to post a 3:47.61 in the 4x400-meter relay.

Sophomore **Matt Bowers (Annville/Annville-Cleona HS)** placed fourth in his section of the 35-lb. weight throw with a toss of 13.15 meters (43'1 ¾"). Freshman **Joe Moore (Andover, NJ/Newtown HS)** placed second in his flight of the long jump at 6.45 meters (21'2").

The Greyhounds forced visiting Albright College into 30 turnovers and outscored the Lions 39-25 in the second half to earn their fourth straight victory with a 63-50 triumph in Commonwealth Conference action. Senior forward **Chris Hayn (Whitehall/Whitehall HS)** led the way for Moravian with 16 points while sophomore guard **Kevin Hall (Mountain Top/Pocono Mountain HS)** had ten points. Sophomore forward **Ken Greb (Mount Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley Regional HS)** had nine points while senior guard **David Jordan (Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant Boro HS)** was held to three points just one game after surpassing the 1,000-point career plateau. **Hayn** had a team best five rebounds in the game as Albright out-rebounded Moravian 43-31. In addition to the turnover difference 30-9 in Moravian's favor, the Greyhounds were 19 of 24 from the foul line while Albright was just 6 of 13 at the charity stripe.

Jordan tossed in 20 points and made four three-pointers to break the school career record of 143 but it wasn't enough as the Greyhounds fell to Lebanon Valley College, 82-72 in Commonwealth Conference action. **Jordan** has made 146 three-pointers in his career, breaking **Matt Getter's** two-year old record. Junior forward **Mike Frew (Glen Ridge, NJ/Glen Ridge HS)** had a career high 15 points in the game with four rebounds while **Greb** had 12 points, a team high eight rebounds and four assists. Moravian was just five of 11 from the foul line in the second half while Lebanon Valley was 29 of 39 at the charity stripe.

The Greyhounds had several winners at the Marc Deneault Memorial Invitational hosted by Cornell University with weekend. Junior **Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS)** won the 5,000 meters in 18:07.90 while junior **Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS)** captured first place in the mile run at 5:02.11. **Wolfsberger** joined juniors **Erin Boyle (Philadelphia/Nazareth Academy)** and **Amanda Samok (Palmerton/Palmerton Area HS)** and sophomore **Jennifer Wagner (Riegelsville/Wilson HS)** to win the 4x800-meter relay in 9:43.98. **Wagner** won her heat of the 800 meters in 2:24.85 and **Samok** followed her in second at 2:26.05. **Boyle** placed sixth in the 1,000 meters in 3:06.06

Junior **Steph Horne (Sinking Spring/Wilson West Lawn HS)** was third in her heat of the 60-meter hurdles in 9.83 seconds while freshman **Nicole Sabalianskas (Butler, NJ/Butler HS)** was seventh in 11.04 seconds. **Horne** ran the 60 meters in 8.65 and the 200 meters in 28.73 seconds while **Sabalianskas** ran a 9.47 in the 60 meters and 30.81 in the 200 meters. Sophomore **Ann Corless (Plainsville, CT/Plainsville HS)** posted a 29.92 in the 200 meters while senior **Brooke Dancho (Bethlehem/Freedom HS)** had a 28.19 in the 200 meters. **Corless** ran the 500 meters in 1:23.65 while junior **Jen Burkholder (Chalfont/Gwynedd Mercy)** posted a 1:27.78 in the 500 meters, winning her heat.

Junior **Kim Jaick (Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS)** was ninth in the mile run in 5:26.78 while freshman **Robin Edward (Massapequa, NY/Plainedge HS)** ran a 5:57.26 in the race. Sophomore **Regina Lacombe (Andover, CT/Rham HS)** posted a 1:10.59 in the 400 meters for the Greyhounds. Competing in the 800 meters for Moravian were junior **Jen Boberg (Lansford/Panther Valley HS)** in a time of 2:36.01 and freshman **Lauren Laviola (Jersey City, NJ/St. Dominic Academy)** with a time of 2:41.26. Junior **Tiffany Catalino (Bethlehem/Freedom HS)** had a time of 3:19.51 in the 1,000 meters and she joined **Jaick, Shertzer** and **Boberg** to run a 10:16.09 and place sixth in the 4x800-meter relay.

Junior **Sarah Shaneberger (Bethlehem/Southern Lehigh HS)** had her best toss of the season in the 20-lb. weight throw at 12.61 meters (41'5") and she was eighth in the shot put at 11.49 meters (37'8 1/2"). Junior **Carrie McCaffery (Lebanon/Annville-Cleona HS)** had a throw of 12.18 meters (39'11 1/2") in the weight throw and a distance of 10.88 meters (35'8 1/2") in the shot put. Freshman **Alicia Fowler (Easton/Easton HS)** competed in the weight throw for the first time this season and had a toss of 10.90 meters (35'9 1/4"). **Dancho** participated in the triple jump at placed seventh with a leap of 10.65 meters (34'11 1/4").
