Women's Basketball - 10-14 (Commonwealth Conference 4-10, MAC 6-11)

Last Week – Lost to *Elizabethtown, 69-65; Lost to *Messiah, 74-62. *Commonwealth game Season Complete

The Greyhounds nearly pulled off an upset in their final road game of the season in a 69-65 loss at Elizabethtown College in Commonwealth Conference action. Moravian, which trailed 32-29 at halftime, led 48-44 after a three-pointer by senior guard Jill Kenny (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS) with 15:05 to play and led again, 58-57, with 8:54 after a lay-up by junior forward Mary Morgans (Center Valley/ Allentown Central Catholic HS) but the Greyhounds managed just seven free throws the rest of the game while the Blue Jays put up 12 points. Freshman guard Kim Hughes (Manasquan, NJ/St. Rose HS) led the Greyhound attack with 19 points including a trio of three-pointers early in the second half. Sophomore forward Kelly McLean (Allentown/Salisbury HS) had a double-double with 16 points and ten rebounds. Sophomore guard Tara Wozniak (Roseland, NJ/West Essex Regional HS), the team's leading scorer was held to seven points, all in the second half. Freshman guard Kim Smith (Gilbert/Pleasant Valley HS) added seven points off the bench while freshman forward Tracie Shipman (Philadelphia/Archbishop Ryan HS) had seven rebounds and six points. Hughes contributed five steals in the loss while Kenny had five assists.

Moravian closed out its 2000-01 season with a 74-62 home loss to Commonwealth Conference regular season champion Messiah College. **McLean** led the Greyhounds with 21 points and **Hughes** tossed in 12 points. For the second straight game, **Wozniak** was held to single digits with just seven points in the game. **Shipman** led the Greyhounds with nine rebounds while McLean added five boards. **Kenny** had two points, two rebounds and three assists in her final career game. Moravian shot 91 percent from the foul line on the game (20 of 22) but just 33 percent from the floor (20 of 60).

Men's Basketball – 9-15 (Commonwealth Conference 4-10, MAC 8-12)

Last Week – Defeated *Elizabethtown, 81-78; Lost to *Messiah, 98-91. *Commonwealth Conference game Season Complete

For the second time in two weeks, the Greyhounds defeated a nationally ranked team as the squad traveled to Elizabethtown College and rallied in the second half for an 81-78 over the 23rd ranked Blue Jays. Moravian trailed 38-31 at halftime before outscoring Elizabethtown 50-40 in the second half. The victory also snapped Elizabethtown's 15 game home winning streak. Coming up big in the second half for Moravian was freshman guard **Jon Leader** (**Halifax/Halifax HS**). **Leader**, who had played a total of 50 minutes in the Greyhound's first 22 games, played 15 minutes in the second half and contributed 13 points including three three-pointers that sparked the Greyhound rally. Senior guard **David Jordan** (**Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant Boro HS**) scored 12 of his game high 16 points in the final 2:27 with a pair of three-pointers and a six-of-six performance from the charity stripe in the final 1:02. Senior forward **Chris Hayn** (**Whitehall/Whitehall HS**) had 14 points and seven rebounds in the game while sophomore forward **Ken Greb** (**Mount Holly, NJ/ Rancocas Valley Regional HS**) had 13 points and six boards. Junior forward **Mike Frew** (**Glen Ridge, NJ/Glen Ridge HS**) led the Greyhounds with a career high eight rebounds while sophomore guard **Kevin Hall** (**Mountain Top/Pocono Mountain HS**) added eight points. Freshmen guards **Lucas Malishchak** (**Wanamie/ Nanticoke HS**) and **Jay Leader** (**Halifax/Halifax HS**) each had six points in the win.

The 2000-01 season came to a close for the Greyhounds with a 98-91 loss to Messiah College in Commonwealth Conference action. Moravian trailed at halftime, 50-45, and was out-shot from the floor 59.6 % by Messiah to 45.8 percent. **Hayn** led Moravian with 24 points in his final collegiate game while **Hall** added 20 points. **Jordan** tossed in 15 points to complete his career with 1,059 points, 15th in school history. **Jordan** also made two three-pointers to finish his career with a school record 150 threes. **Greb** had 13 points in the game and six rebounds. **Hayn** led the squad with seven rebounds as Moravian out-rebounded Messiah 36-35. **Malishchak** and freshman guard **Steve Weiler** (**Edgewater Park**, **NJ/Burlington City HS**) each had four assists in the game with **Weiler** adding nine points.

Junior **Heidi Wolfsberger** (**Moosic/Riverside HS**) improved on her NCAA Division III automatic qualifying time in the 1,500 meters and freshman **Christina Scherwin** (**Denmark**) tossed an automatic qualifying distance in the shot put to lead the Greyhounds at the Keogh Invitational hosted by Haverford College on Friday night. **Wolfsberger** placed third in the 1,500 meters with a time of 3:35.6 while **Scherwin** won the shot put with a toss of 13.44 meters (44 feet, 1 ½ inches). **Scherwin** placed second in the long jump at 5.15 meters (16 feet, seven inches) while freshman **Sarah Shatto** (**Marysville/Susquenita HS**) won the pole vault competition at nine feet, six inches.

In the sprint races for the Greyhounds, junior **Steph Horne** (**Sinking Spring/Wilson West Lawn HS**) was second in the 55-meter hurdles in a season best time of 9.0 seconds while freshman **Nicole Sabaliauskas** (**Butler, NJ/Butler HS**) tied for ninth in 9.9 seconds. **Horne** placed 15th in the 200 meters in 28.5 seconds while **Sabaliauskas** was 24th in 30.3 seconds. Freshman **Shannon McNeil** (**Reading/Reading Central Catholic HS**) was 23rd in the 200 meters in 30.1 seconds. In the 400 meters, freshman **Jamie Marks** (**Macungie/Emmaus HS**) ran the best time of the year for the Greyhounds at 1:03.2 while sophomore **Ann Corless** (**Plainsville, CT/Plainsville HS**) was 12th in 1:04.9. Junior **Jen Burkholder** (**Chalfont/Gwynedd Mercy HS**) was 14th in the 400 at 1:06.0.

Sophomore Jen Wagner (Riegelsville/Wilson HS) tied for fifth in the 800 meters at 2:26.9 while junior Jen Boberg (Lansford/Panther Valley HS) was 25th in 2:38.0. Junior Erin Boyle (Philadelphia/Nazareth Academy) was 6th in the 1,500 meters in 4:56.9 while Wagner was 11th in 5:06.2. Junior Amanda Samok (Palmerton/Palmerton Area HS) placed 15th in the 1,500 meters with a time of 5:11.2 while junior Tiffany Catalino (Bethlehem/Freedom HS) was 18th in 5:15.8 and freshman Robin Edward (Massapequa, NY/ Plainedge HS) was 19th with a time of 5:26.9. Rounding out the Greyhound competitors in the 1,500 was freshman Jen Brief (Clark, NJ/Arthur L. Johnson HS) in 30th at 5:49.1. Junior Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS) placed fourth in the 3,000 meters in 10:25.1 while junior Kim Jaick (Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS) was 8th with a time of 10:48.2 and senior Kate Westermann (Milford, CT/Lauralton Hall) was 18th in 12:02.2.

In the relay events, the Greyhounds 4x200-meter relay team placed second in 1:53.4. The "A" team of the 4x400-meter relay was fourth in 4:15.5 while the "B" team was fifth in 4:28.0.

Senior **Leah Williams** (**Andreas/Tamaqua HS**) was fifth in the high jump at four feet, eight inches while senior **Brooke Dancho** (**Bethlehem/Freedom HS**) placed tenth with a height of four feet, six inches. **Dancho** was fourth in the triple jump at 9.98 meters while freshman **Loraine Sanderson** (**Bethlehem/Liberty HS**) was ninth at 9.45 meters and **Williams** was tenth with a leap of 9.39 meters. **Sanderson** placed 12th in the long jump at 4.50 meters while **McNeil** was tenth at 4.53 meters. Junior **Sarah Shaneberger** (**Bethlehem/ Southern Lehigh HS**) placed second to **Scherwin** in the shot put at 11.74 meters.

Junior Josh Heebner (Lansdale/North Penn HS) was fifth in the 800 meters in 1:58.4 while freshman Marty Miller (Bethlehem/Liberty HS) was fourth in the 5,000 meters with a time of 17:29.5 to lead the Greyhounds at the Keogh Invitational hosted by Haverford College Friday night.

Other competitors in the distance events for the Greyhounds included, senior **Damon Rutherford (Reading/Exeter HS)** placing 14th in the 1,500 meters with a time of 4:11.5 and freshman **Joe Grady (Nanticoke/Nanticoke HS)** finishing 17th in 4:12.2. Sophomore **George Wacker (Honesdale/Honesdale HS)** was 15th in the 800 meters with a time of 2:00.8 while sophomore **Matt Plewinski (Hatfield/North Penn HS)** placed 33rd at 2:06.5 and junior **Chris DeWalt (Easton/Easton HS)** was 38th in 2:10.6. Sophomore **Wes Zimmerman (Boyertown/Boyertown HS)** finished 14th in the 3,000 meters with a time of 9:11.8 and sophomore **Justin Arnold (Basking Ridge, NJ/Ridge HS)** was 34th in 9:55.3.

In the sprint races, sophomore **Eric Paul (Reading/Reading Central Catholic HS)** placed 22nd in the 400 meters in 55.7 seconds while sophomore **Chris McGinnis (Brick, NJ/Brick Memorial HS)** was 26th in 56.1 seconds. Junior **Jim McIntyre (Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown HS)** placed 35th in the 200 meters with a time of 28.1 seconds.

The Greyhounds 4x200-meter relay team captured first place with a time of 1:37.0 seconds.

Freshman **Anthony Merz** (**Philadelphia/Archbishop Ryan HS**) placed fourth in the long jump with a leap of 6.32 meters.
