## Women's Indoor Track & Field 0-0 (Commonwealth Conference 0-0, MAC 0-0)

Last Week – 1st of 10 teams in MAC Championships at Widener University, Chester, PA

# This Week - Fri., Mar. 2<sup>nd</sup> at Haverford College Last Chance Meet, Haverford, PA

For the sixth straight year, the Moravian College women's track & field team has captured first place in the Middle Atlantic Conference Indoor Track & Field Championships. The Greyhounds defeated second place Messiah College, 182 to 81, in the competition hosted by Widener University.

Moravian had six individual champions and three relay squad win titles. Junior **Heidi Wolfsberger** (**Moosic/Riverside HS**), the meet's Most Outstanding Performer for the second straight year, won the 800 meters in a MAC record time of 2:20.90 and she captured the 1,500 meters in a MAC record and NCAA Division III provisional qualifying time of 4:43.97. **Wolfsberger** is already an automatic qualifier in the event. Junior **Emily Shertzer** (**Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS**) won the 5,000 meters with a MAC record time of 18:09.33. Freshman **Christina Scherwin** (**Denmark**) won a pair of MAC titles in her first championship meet, capturing the shot put in a NCAA Division III provisional qualifying distance of 42 feet, 10 ¾ inches and winning the long jump with a leap of 16 feet, 9 ¾ inches. **Scherwin** is already an automatic qualifier in the shot put. Junior **Carrie McCaffery** (**Lebanon/Annville-Cleona HS**) won the 20-lb. weight throw with a toss of 41 feet, 7 ¼ inches.

Wolfsberger teamed up with sophomores Ann Corless (Plainsville, CT/Plainsville HS) and Jennifer Wagner (Riegelsville/Wilson HS) and freshman Jaime Marks (Macungie/Emmaus HS) to win the 4x400-meter relay in 4:21.41. Shertzer was part of Moravian's winning distance medley relay team (12:47.3) with juniors Kim Jaick (Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS) and Jen Boberg (Lansford/Panther Valley HS) and sophomore Gina Lacombe (Andover, CT/Rham HS). The quartet of juniors Tiffany Catalino (Bethlehem/Freedom HS), Amanda Samok (Palmerton/Palmerton Area HS) and Erin Boyle (Philadelphia/Nazareth Academy HS) and freshman Lauren Laviola (Jersey City, NJ/St. Dominic Academy) captured the MAC title in the 4x800-meter relay in a time of 10:19.18.

# **Season Complete**

The Greyhounds completed the 2000-01 season with an overall record of 10-14 and a 4-10 slate in the Commonwealth Conference. The squad improved six games from the 1999-2000 season and returns 14 of 15 players next season with just one senior.

# Men's Basketball – 9-15 (Commonwealth Conference 4-10, MAC 8-12)

## **Season Complete**

The Greyhounds completed the 2000-01 season with an overall record of 9-15 and a 4-10 slate in the Commonwealth Conference after winning five of their last seven games. Moravian completed the regular season ranked 16<sup>th</sup> in the nation in free throw percentage at .735.

# Men's Indoor Track & Field 0-0 (Commonwealth Conference 0-0, MAC 0-0)

Last Week – 3<sup>rd</sup> of 10 teams in MAC Championships at Widener University, Chester, PA

The Moravian College men's track & field team placed third in the 2001 Middle Atlantic Conference Championships with 65 points behind host Widener University (192) and Messiah College (77). Junior Josh Heebner (Lansdale/North Penn HS) was the only individual champion for the men's team, winning the 400 meters in 52.26 seconds. Junior Kevin Bush (Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS) placed second in the 55 meters in 6.70 seconds while freshman Joe Grady (Nanticoke/Nanticoke HS) was third in the 1,500 meters with a time of 4:13.54. Sophomore Matt Bowers (Annville/Annville-Cleona HS) placed fourth in the shot put at 41 feet, 2 1/4 inches while senior Anthony Rediger (Sellersville/Pennridge HS) was second in the high jump at six feet, four inches, fourth in the triple jump at 43 feet, eight inches and sixth in the long jump at 21 feet. Freshman Joe Moore (Andover, NJ/Newtown HS) was fifth in the long jump at 21 feet, 1/2 inch.

Heebner and Bush combined with sophomore George Wacker (Honesdale/Honesdale HS) and freshman Steve Hartenstine (Danielsville/Northampton HS) to place third in the 4x400-meter relay in 3:35.45. Bush and Hartenstine combined with freshman Anthony Merz (Philadelphia/Archbishop Ryan HS) and junior Jim McIntyre (Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown HS) to place fifth in the sprint relay at 1:17.80. Grady, Heebner and Wacker were joined by senior Damon Rutherford (Reading/Exeter HS) in the distance medley relay and the quarter placed second in 10:46.33, just .08 seconds out of first place. Rutherford and Grady ran in the 4x800-meter relay with junior Chris DeWalt (Easton/Easton HS) and sophomore Matt Plewinski (Hatfield/North Penn HS) for a fourth place finish in 8:29.32.
