Track & Field at NCAA Division III National Championships:

The women's track and field team currently has four student-athletes qualified for the NCAA Division III Outdoor National Championships at Millikin University in Decatur, IL from May 23rd through May 26th. Junior **Heidi Wolfsberger** (**Moosic/Riverside HS**) is an automatic qualifier in the 1,500 and 3,000 meters and a provisional qualifier in the 800 and 5,000 meters. Wolfsberger has the best time in the country in the 3,000 meters. Junior **Emily Shertzer** (**Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS**) is an automatic qualifier in the 10,000 meters while junior **Kim Jaick** (**Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS**) is a provisional qualifier in the 3,000 meters. Junior **Jennifer Lohn** (**Media/Penncrest HS**) has thrown an automatic qualifying distance in the javelin.

Women's Outdoor Track & Field 2-1 (Commonwealth Conference 2-0, MAC 2-0)

Last Week – Jim Tuppeny Twilight Meet at Villanova University, Villanova, PA; McEligott Memorial Meet at Haverford College, Haverford, PA.

This Week – Thurs.-Sat., May 24th-26th at NCAA Division III Outdoor National Championships, Millikin University, Decatur, IL.

The Greyhounds sent three athletes to the Jim Tuppeny Twilight Meet at Villanova University to compete in a last chance meet. Junior **Heidi Wolfsberger** (**Moosic/Riverside HS**) placed ninth in her heat of the 1,500 meters but improved on her NCAA Division III automatic qualifying time with a race of 4:35.52. Junior **Jennifer Lohn** (**Media/Penncrest HS**), who has already qualified in the javelin, took third in the javelin with a toss of 38.80 meters (127'3"). Junior **Carrie McCaffery** (**Lebanon/Annville-Cleona HS**) was right behind **Lohn** in fourth place with a toss of 37.76 meters (123'11").

Moravian had four athletes at the Seamus McElligott Memorial Meet at Haverford College to compete in a last chance meet to qualify for the upcoming NCAA Division III National Championships. **Wolfsberger** won the 800 meters in a time of 2:18.0 but did not improve on her NCAA Division III National Championships provisional qualifying time. **Wolfsberger** is qualified in four events. Junior **Kim Jaick** (**Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS**) placed third in the 3,000 meters in 10:18.72 while junior **Emily Shertzer** (**Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS**) was fourth in 10:23.79. **Jaick** is a provisional qualifier in the race while **Shertzer** is an automatic qualifier in the 10,000 meters. **McCaffery** placed third in the javelin with a toss of 34.98 meters 34.98 meters (114'9") but came up short of the qualifying distance.

The Greyhounds sent two athletes to the Jim Tuppeny Twilight Meet at Villanova University to try and qualify for the NCAA Division III National Championship but both came up short. Senior **Doug Joseph (Allentown/Parkland HS)** placed sixth in his heat in the 100 meters with a time of 10.99 seconds, his second fastest time of the season. Senior **Anthony Rediger (Sellersville/Pennridge HS)** placed third in the triple jump with a leap of 13.20 meters (43'3 1/4").

Moravian had three athletes in the Seamus McElligott Memorial Meet at Haverford College in a last chance to qualify for the upcoming NCAA Division III National Championship meet but all three Greyhounds fell short. **Joseph** placed fourth in the 100 meters in 11.18 seconds while junior **Kevin Bush** (**Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS**) was fourth in the 400 meters in 49.69 seconds. **Rediger** took fourth in the triple jump with a leap of 13.49 meters (44'3 1/4").
