Women's Outdoor Track & Field 2-1 (Commonwealth Conference 2-0, MAC 2-0)

Last Week – Tied for 12th of 72 at NCAA Division III Outdoor National Championships hosted by Millikin University, Decatur, IL.

Season Complete

The Greyhounds sent four student-athletes to the 2001 NCAA Division III Outdoor National Championships at Millikin University in Decatur, IL and came home tied for 23rd of 72 schools that scored thanks to a pair of All-American finishes by junior **Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS)**. **Wolfsberger**, now an eight-time All-American, finished fourth in the 1,500 meters in 4:36.07 and fourth in the 3,000 meters in 9:52.51. **Wolfsberger** had won the 1,500-meter indoor national championship and had the best time in the country in the 3,000 meters heading into the meet.

Moravian's other competitors included junior **Jennifer Lohn (Media/Penncrest HS)** placing fourth in her flight and 13th overall with a toss of 126 feet, one inch (38.44 meters) in the javelin, junior **Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS)** placing 15th in the 10,000 meters with a time of 37:06.37 and junior **Kim Jaick (Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS)** taking 16th in the 3,000 meters in 10:15.94.
