Women's Basketball – 1-2 (Commonwealth Conference 0-0, MAC 0-1)

The Greyhounds opened the 2000-01 season with a 62-52 loss at Allentown College after being tied with the Centaurs 29-29 at the half. Freshman forward **Sarah Onkotz** (**Catasauqua/Catasauqua HS**) led the squad with ten points while sophomore guard **Tara Wozniak** (**Roseland, NJ/West Essex Regional HS**), sophomore forward **Kelly McLean** (**Allentown/Salisbury HS**) and freshman guard **Kim Hughes** (**Manasquan, NJ/St. Rose HS**) each had nine points. Freshman guard **Kim Smith** (**Gilbert/Pleasant Valley HS**) had seven points in the balanced scoring attack while freshman forward **Tracie Shipman** (**Philadelphia/Archbishop Ryan HS**) led the team with eight rebounds. McLean added six boards in the loss.

In the first game of the Muskingum College Memorial Tournament, the Greyhounds battled back twice to lose by just eight points, 90-82, to the host school. Moravian was behind 13 points with 10:30 to play in the first half and the team responded to take a two-point lead two and a half minutes into the second half. Moravian would be down by 23 points with six minutes to play before out scoring Muskingum 22-6 during the rest of the game. McLean and Hughes led the Greyhounds with 18 points in the game while Wozniak tossed in 14 points. McLean led Moravian on the boards with 12 rebounds. Sophomore forward **Kristen Sarnocinski (Harleysville/Germantown Academy HS)** added eight rebounds and seven points while senior guard **Jill Kenny (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS)** dished out a career high eight assists. Moravian out-rebounded Muskingum 54-47 in the game.

Moravian would used another balanced scoring attack to earn its first win of the season, an 81-63 triumph over Methodist College in the consolation game of the Muskingum Tournament. McLean, Hughes and Wozniak each scored 12 points in the contest while Sarnocinski had a career best 11 points. Shipman led Moravian on the boards in the game with nine rebounds. Sarnocinski pulled down eight rebounds while McLean and Wozniak each had seven rebounds as Moravian held a 55-34 advantage on the boards. Freshman forward **Kristen Rohal** (**Bethlehem/Liberty HS**) had five rebounds and six points in the game while Kenny had six assists and Hughes, who was named to the All-Tournament Team, added four steals.

The Greyhounds opened their 2000-01 home season with a 65-62 win over Allentown College despite missing 12 free throws in the second half and 14 in the game. Sophomore guard **Kevin Hall (Mountain Top/Pocono Mountain HS)** led Moravian in scoring with a career high 21 points. Sophomore forward **Ken Greb (Mount Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley HS)** and senior guard **David Jordan (Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant Boro HS)** in scored in double-figures with Greb netting 12 points and Jordan adding 11.

Senior forward Chris Hayn (Whitehall/Whitehall HS) grabbed a team high eight rebounds in the win while junior forward Mike Frew (Glen Ridge, NJ/Glen Ridge HS) added seven rebounds and eight points. Freshman guard Lucas Malishchak (Wanamie/Nanticoke HS) had five rebounds, four points, four assists and three steals in the contest.
