Women's Basketball – 2-4 (Commonwealth Conference 1-1, MAC 1-2)

*Last Week – Defeated *Widener, 94-56; Lost to Muhlenberg, 74-68; Lost to *Juniata, 93-80. *Commonwealth game*

The Greyhounds won one of three games last week. Moravian used a balanced scoring attack with five players in double figures and a fourth straight game with over 50 rebounds to open the 2000-01 Commonwealth Conference season with a 94-56 victory over Widener University, the Greyhounds first Commonwealth win since February 17, 1999. Sophomore guard **Tara Wozniak (Roseland, NJ/West Essex Regional HS)** led the scoring with 17 points while freshman guard **Kim Hughes (Manasquan, NJ/St. Rose HS)** tossed in 16 points. Hughes was six-for-six from the foul line and has made 15 straight free throws. Freshman guard **Kim Smith (Gilbert/Pleasant Valley HS)** netted a career high 11 points in the win while sophomore forward **Kelly McLean (Allentown/Salisbury HS)** and freshman forward **Tracie Shipman (Philadelphia/Archbishop Ryan HS)** each had ten points. Shipman and sophomore forward **Kristen Sarnocinski (Harleysville/Germantown Academy)** each grabbed seven rebounds in the game with Sarnocinski scoring six points. Freshman guard **Sarah Onkotz (Catasauqua/Catasauqua HS)** had six points and six rebounds as the Greyhounds out-rebounded Widener 54-35. Moravian shot 47.8 percent from the floor in the game and 50 percent in the first half when the team jumped out to a 43-23 lead. Senior guard **Jill Kenny (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS)** led Moravian with five steals and four assists while freshman center **Kristen Rohal (Bethlehem/Liberty HS)** had five rebounds.

Despite a career high 25 points from Wozniak, the Greyhounds were unable to beat rival Muhlenberg College, falling 74-68 in Allentown. The Greyhounds led 36-34 at halftime and had rallied from an 8-2 deficit by making their first 15 free throws of the game. Moravian was 16 of 19 from the free throw stripe in the first half and 30 of 38 in the game but the Greyhounds were out-rebounded for the first time this season, 42-26, the first game Moravian has not had at least 50 rebounds in. Wozniak, who was eight of 17 from the floor and seven of 11 from the foul line also led the Greyhounds with six rebounds. Sarnocinski added nine points and five rebounds in the loss.

Hughes had a career day in Moravian's final game of the week, a 93-80 loss to Juniata College in Commonwealth Conference action. Hughes had career highs with 28 points, ten rebounds and six steals. Moravian trailed by just one point at halftime, 44-43, but the Eagles had the hot hand in the second half, shooting 63.6 percent from the field and 88.9 percent from the foul line. Wozniak added 14 points and four rebounds while Shipman had ten points and five boards. Sarnocinski scored ten points in the game while Kenny had five assists.

The Greyhounds opened their 2000-01 indoor season last weekend at the non-scoring Lafayette College Invitational. Junior **Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS)** won the mile race in a NCAA Division III provisional qualifying time of 5:04.5, just two seconds off the automatic qualifying standard. Junior **Kim Jaick (Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS)** was second in the mile race in 5:07.6, also a provisional qualifying time, while junior **Erin Boyle (Philadelphia/Nazareth Academy)** was fourth in 5:21.1. Jaick placed fourth in the 880-yard run in 2:28.6 while sophomore **Jen Wagner (Riegelsville/Wilson HS)** took fifth in 2:29.7. Junior **Sarah Shaneberger (Bethlehem/Southern Lehigh HS)** had a pair of third place finishes with a toss of 11.58 meters in the shot put and a distance of 12.60 meters in the 20-lb. weight throw. Junior **Carrie McCaffery (Lebanon/Annville-Cleona HS)** was fifth in the 20-lb. weight throw at 10.24 meters. Senior **Brooke Dancho (Bethlehem/Freedom HS)** rounded out the Moravian place winners with a fifth in the long jump at 15 feet, five inches.

The Greyhounds opened their 2000-01 Commonwealth Conference season with a 74-62 loss to preseason favorite Widener University. Moravian did have four players score in double figures with sophomore guard **Kevin Hall (Mountain Top/Pocono Mountain HS)**, senior guard **David Jordan (Point Pleasant, NJ/ Point Pleasant Boro HS)** and senior forward **Chris Hayn (Whitehall/Whitehall HS)** each scoring 12 points and freshman guard **Lucas Malishchak (Wanamie/Nanticoke HS)** netting 10 points. Sophomore forward **Ken Greb (Mount Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley HS)** had a career high 11 rebounds in the game and Hayn added a career best ten rebounds as Moravian won the battle on the boards, 49-44. Jordan added seven rebounds while freshman guard **Steve Weiler (Edgewater Park, NJ/Burlington City HS)** had six boards. The Greyhounds were hampered in the game by poor shooting especially in the second half as the team was 10 of 37 on field goals and one of ten on three-point attempts.

Moravian dropped its second straight Commonwealth Conference game despite a big comeback in the second half. The Greyhounds trailed 38-23 at the half and forced an overtime session at 66-66 before losing 75-72 to the Eagles. Hayn led Moravian in scoring in the game with 19 points while Jordan and Weiler each scored in double figures with 14 and 11 points respectively. Hayn also led the Greyhounds with seven rebounds. Weiler contributed four steals in the game while Greb had a team high four assists in the contest.

The Greyhounds opened their 2000-01 indoor season last weekend at the non-scoring Lafayette College Invitational. Senior **Anthony Rediger (Sellersville/Pennridge HS)** was second in the triple jump at 44 feet, two inches and he placed third in the high jump at six feet, two inches and the long jump with a distance of 20 feet, two inches. Senior **Bill Schmidt (Basking Ridge, NJ/Ridge HS)** finished fourth in the shot put at 12.62 meters while sophomore **Matt Bowers (Annville/Annville-Cleona HS)** was fourth in the 35-lb. weight throw with a toss of 12.16 meters. In the running events, sophomore **George Wacker (Honesdale/Honesdale HS)** was third in the 880-yard run in 2:01.8 while junior **Josh Heebner (Lansdale/North Penn HS)** finished fourth in the 600-yard race in 1:15.8. Sophomore **Wes Zimmerman (Boyertown/Boyertown HS)** rounded out the Moravian place winners with a fourth in the two mile run at 9:54.9.
