Women's Basketball – 13-8 (Commonwealth Conference 7-3, MAC 9-5)

Moravian jumped out to a 20-2 lead and never looked back in a 65-46 Commonwealth Conference victory over Albright College. The Greyhounds led 42-18 at halftime. Junior guard **Tara Wozniak** (**Roseland, NJ/West Essex Regional HS**) led three Greyhounds in double figures with 15 points. Sophomore guard **Kim Hughes** (**Manasquan, NJ/St. Rose HS**) had 14 points in the game as well as career highs nine steals and five assists to go with four rebounds. Junior forward **Kelly McLean** (**Allentown, PA/Salisbury HS**) added ten points and six rebounds while sophomore forward **Tracie Shipman** (**Philadelphia, PA/Archbishop Ryan HS**) led Moravian with eight boards in the game. Freshman guard **Jen Behagg** (**Hamburg, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS**) contributed three assists, four points and three rebounds in the victory.

The Greyhounds fell behind early and trailed the entire game in a 97-73 loss at Messiah College in Commonwealth Conference action. Moravian fell to 7-3 in Commonwealth Conference action and will play on the road for the playoffs should the team win one of its final four games to qualify for the playoffs. Moravian can clinch its first playoff berth since the 1997-98 season on Wednesday night in a home game versus Elizabethtown College. **Wozniak** led the Greyhounds with 18 points and she added five rebounds while **McLean** had 14 points and six boards. **Shipman** led Moravian on the boards with seven rebounds and she added seven points. Sophomore guard **Kim Smith** (**Gilbert, PA/Pleasant Valley HS**) added nine points off the bench.

Senior **Kevin Bush** (**Stroudsburg, PA/Stroudsburg HS**) had an outstanding day to lead the Greyhounds at the Potomac Valley USATF Collegiate Invitational at the Prince George's Sports Complex in Landover, Maryland on Sunday, January 27th. **Bush** won his heat of the 400 meters and finished fourth overall in an Eastern College Athletic Conference qualifying time of 50.39 seconds. **Bush** also posted season best times in the 200 meters in 23.63 seconds and the 60-meter high hurdles in 7.16 seconds. Freshman **Patrick Grogan** (**Nazareth, PA/Notre Dame HS**) had a time of 4:40.01 in the mile race while sophomore **Steve Hartenstine** (**Danielsville, PA/Northampton HS**) had a 55.27-second race in the 400 meters. Sophomore **John Lesoine** (**East Stroudsburg, PA/East Stroudsburg HS**) was seventh in the 35-lb. weight throw with a toss of 12.54 meters (41 feet, 1 3/4 inches) and he had a distance of 11.17 meters (36 feet, 7 3/4 inches) in the shot put. Junior **Matt Bowers** (**Annville, PA/Annville-Cleona HS**) had a distance of 12.38 meters (40 feet, 7 1/2 inches) in the weight throw while sophomore **Joe Moore** (**Andover, NJ/Newtown HS**) finished eighth in the long jump with a leap of 6.20 meters (20 feet, 1 1/4 inches).

Moravian head coach **Jim Walker** earned his 300th victory at the school with an 86-74 victory over Albright College in Commonwealth Conference action last Wednesday. **Walker** has a record of 300-246 in 22 seasons at Moravian and he has an overall record of 315-256 over 23 years. Only legendary Moravian baseball coach **Harvey Gillespie** has move victories in one sport at Moravian than **Walker** (352 wins from 1935 to 1974). The Greyhounds trailed 28-21 with just under eight minutes left in the first half before going on a 24-12 run to end the half with a 45-40 advantage. Moravian led by as many as 12 points in the second half (66-54 with 8:50 remaining). One of the keys in the game for Moravian was its free throw shooting. The Greyhounds, ranked fifth in the nation at 77.9 percent coming into the game, made their first 19 free throws of the contest before finishing 20 of 22. The first miss came with just 50 seconds left in the game.

Freshman forward **Brandon Zaleski** (**Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown HS**) led five Moravian scorers in double figures with a game high 25 points. Sophomore guard **Steve Weiler** (**Edgewater Park, NJ/Burlington City HS**) added 12 points while senior guard/forward **Doug Spadt** (**Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS**) added 11 points and a game and career high 10 rebounds. Sophomore guard **Lucas Malishchak** (**Wanamie, PA/Nanticoke HS**) added 11 points, four assists and three steals while junior guard **Kevin Hall** (**Mount Pocono, PA/Pocono Mountain HS**) had ten points. **Zaleski** pulled down eight rebounds and added three steals in the victory while senior forward **Mike Frew** (**Glen Ridge, NJ/Glen Ridge HS**) had a career high nine rebounds and six points. Junior forward **Ken Greb** (**Mount Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley Regional HS**) added five rebounds to help Moravian post a 39-35 advantage on the board.

The Greyhounds went cold from the field in the last six and a half minutes of the first half in a 79-72 Commonwealth Conference loss at Messiah College. Moravian had a 31-28 lead with 6:27 to play in the first half but netted just two free throws, falling behind 40-33 at the half. The Greyhounds, ranked in the top five nationally in free throw percentage, had their best game of the season at the charity stripe, a perfect 13 of 13 in the contest. The loss means the Greyhounds have to win at least three of their last four games with a win over Susquehanna University to make the Commonwealth Conference playoffs. **Zaleski** led all scorers in the game with 28 points and he pulled down a game and career high 12 rebounds. **Zaleski** has 407 points so far in his freshman season, tying him for 11th all-time at Moravian in a single season with four games left to play. **Greb** was the only other Moravian player in double figures with ten points and he added five rebounds. **Hall, Spadt** and **Weiler** each had eight points for the Greyhounds.

Women's Indoor Track & Field - 0-0 (MAC 0-0)

The Greyhounds had four first place finishes in the Potomac Valley USATF Collegiate Invitational at the Prince George's Sports Complex in Landover, Maryland on Sunday, January 27th. Senior Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic, PA/Riverside HS) captured first place in the 800 meters with a time of 2:20.08, which is a qualifying time for the Eastern College Athletic Conference Championships, while senior Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown, PA/Lower Dauphin HS) won the 5,000 meters in 17:58.33, which is an NCAA Division III provisional qualifying time and an ECAC qualifying time. Freshman Kristen Rotzell (Bangor, PA/Bangor HS) won the triple jump with a distance of 11.02 meters (36 feet, two inches), which qualifies her for the ECAC Championships. Seniors Erin Boyle (Philadelphia, PA/Nazareth Academy HS) and Amanda Samok (Palmerton, PA/Palmerton HS), junior Jen Wagner (Riegelsville, PA/Wilson HS) and freshman Megan Wise (North Wales, PA/North Penn HS) made up the Greyhounds winning distance medley relay team, which posted an ECAC qualifying time of 12:48.58.

Wolfsberger also won her heat of the mile in an ECAC qualifying time of 5:20.52 and she was sixth overall. Wise ran a 5:37.19 in the mile and won her heat as well. Boyle was first in her heat and fourth overall in the 800 meters with an ECAC qualifying time of 2:25.08 while senior Jen Boberg (Lansford, PA/Panther Valley HS) ran a 2:33.09 in the race and Samok posted a 2:33.56 in the contest. Senior Kim Jaick (Coopersburg, PA/Southern Lehigh HS) placed second to Shertzer in the 5,000 meters with an ECAC qualifying time of 18:13.98. Freshman Holly Bofinger (Warminster, PA/William Tennent HS) placed ninth in the 5,000 meters in 19:25.22 while freshman Alison Stoyko (Reading, PA/Governor Mifflin HS) was tenth in 20:27.66.

Senior **Steph Horne** (**Sinking Spring, PA/Wilson West Lawn HS**) had an outstanding day for Moravian. She placed third in the 60-meter high hurdles in a school record time of 9.42 seconds and **Horne** posted a 1:05.27 in the 400 meters. In the field events, senior **Sarah Shaneberger** (**Bethlehem, PA/Southern Lehigh HS**) placed second in the shot put at 11.86 meters (38 feet, 11 inches) and she was third in the 20-lb. weight throw at 13.26 meters (43 feet, six inches), an ECAC qualifying distance. Sophomore **Alicia Fowler** (**Easton, PA/Easton HS**) was seventh in the weight throw at 11.13 meters (365 feet, 6 3/4 inches) and sophomore **Amanda Wynn** (**Hellertown, PA/Saucon Valley HS**) posted a height of 2.59 meters (eight feet, six inches) in the pole vault.
