Women's Basketball – 15-8 (Commonwealth Conference 9-3, MAC 11-5)

*Last Week – Defeated *Elizabethtown, 76-57; Defeated *Widener, 65-56. *Commonwealth Conference game*

Moravian clinched its first playoff appearance since the 1997-98 season with a 76-57 victory over Elizabethtown College in Commonwealth Conference action. Moravian, which will play its first round playoff game on the road on February 20th at either Messiah College or Lebanon Valley College, jumped out to a 33-24 halftime lead while shooting a perfect 12-of-12 from the foul line. The Hounds shot 47 percent from the floor in the second half and 41 percent for the game. Junior guard **Tara Wozniak (Roseland, NJ/West Essex Regional HS)** led Moravian with 18 points and nine rebounds and she added four steals. Junior forward **Kelly McLean (Allentown, PA/Salisbury HS)** added 16 points and six rebounds while sophomore guard **Kim Hughes (Manasquan, NJ/St. Rose HS)** had ten points, five rebounds and three steals. Sophomore forward **Tracie Shipman (Philadelphia, PA/Archbishop Ryan HS)** had eight boards for Moravian while junior guard/forward **Kristin Sarnocinski (Harleysville, PA/Germantown Academy HS)** had nine points and a career high five assists in the win.

The Greyhounds won their second straight game and their 15th contest of the season, the first time since 1997-98 Moravian has won at least 15 games in a year, with a 65-56 victory over Widener University in Commonwealth Conference action. Moravian is 9-3 in the Commonwealth and can clinch third place with a victory at Susquehanna University on Tuesday. **Sarnocinski** scored a career high 20 points to lead the Greyhounds in the victory. **McLean** was the only other Moravian player in double figures with ten points. **McLean** tied her career best with 17 rebounds to lead the Greyhounds to a 50-39 advantage on the boards. **Sarnocinski** contributed seven rebounds and three assists. **Wozniak** scored nine points in the game while **Hughes** and senior guard/forward **Mary Morgans (Center Valley, PA/Allentown Central Catholic HS)** each had seven points. Senior forward **Carrie McCaffery (Lebanon, PA/ Annville-Cleona HS)** had two points and a rebound in her final home game.

Men's Basketball – 13-10 (Commonwealth Conference 5-7, MAC 8-9)

Moravian suffered its second straight Commonwealth Conference, falling to #6 Elizabethtown College, 87-73. The Greyhounds, who trailed by three points, 39-36 at halftime, shot just 40.9 percent in the game while the Blue Jays connected on 58.6 percent of their shots. Elizabethtown also held a 42-26 advantage on the boards. Senior guard **Doug Spadt (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS)** led Moravian in scoring with 15 points while freshman forward **Brandon Zaleski (Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown HS)** added 13 points and a team high seven rebounds. Junior forward **Ken Greb (Mount Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley Regional HS)** contributed 12 points while junior guard **Kevin Hall (Mount Pocono, PA/Pocono Mountain HS)** added nine points.

The Greyhounds saw their playoff chances take a hit with an 82-73 loss to Widener University in Commonwealth Conference action. Moravian fell one game behind Susquehanna University for the final playoff spot and must win its final two games and hope Susquehanna losses its last two to earn a playoff berth. The two teams meet in Selinsgrove on Tuesday. Moravian led 39-35 a minute and a half into the second half but did not score for the next 7:22 while Widener went on a 13-0 run to take the lead for good. The Greyhounds shot 50.9 percent in the game but the Pioneers connected on 52.9 percent in the game and 59.3 percent in the second half. **Zaleski** led Moravian with 22 points and he added five rebounds. Sophomore guard **Kevin Wyers (Hamilton Square, NJ/Notre Dame HS)** netted a career high 14 points while **Greb** had 13 points. **Greb** led the Greyhounds with six rebounds while sophomore guard **Lucas Malishchak (Wanamie, PA/Nanticoke HS)** had nine points. Senior forward **Mike Frew (Glen Ridge, NJ/Glen Ridge HS)** scored eight points in his final career home game.

Senior **Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic, PA/Riverside HS)** led the Greyhounds with a pair of first place finishes in at the Robert J. Kane Invitational hosted by Cornell University last weekend. **Wolfsberger** won the mile with a time of 5:10.71, an Eastern College Athletic Conference qualifying time, and she won the 1,000 meters with an ECAC qualifying standard of 3:02.08. Freshman **Megan Wise (North Wales, PA/North Penn HS)** ran a time of 5:33.97 and freshman **Ali Stoyko (Reading, PA/Governor Mifflin HS)** posted a 5:39.16 in the mile race while junior **Jennifer Wagner (Riegelsville, PA/ Wilson HS)**, 3:13.52, freshman **Kellie Smith (Perkasie, PA/Pennridge HS)**, 3:20.45, and senior **Tiffany Catalino (Bethlehem, PA/ Freedom HS)**, 3:28.27, all competed in the 1,000 meters.

In other distance events, senior **Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown, PA/Lower Dauphin HS)** was third in the 5,000 meters with a NCAA Division III provisional qualifying and an ECAC qualifying time of 17:40.98 and senior **Kim Jaick (Coopersburg, PA/Southern Lehigh HS)** was in fourth at 17:42.74, also a NCAA Division III provisional qualifying and an ECAC qualifying standard. Freshman **Holly Bofinger (Warminster, PA/William Tennent HS)** had a time of 19:26.80 while freshman **Chelsea Mullins (Jim Thorpe, PA/Jim Thorpe HS)** posted a 19:36.14 and sophomore **Angie Morgan (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** had a time of 19:52.67 in the 5,000 meters. Senior **Amanda Samok (Palmerton, PA/ Palmerton HS)** had an ECAC qualifying time of 1:23.66 in the 500 meters while freshman **Heather McGarvie (Medford, NJ/Shawnee HS)** ran an ECAC qualifying time of 2:23.06 in the 800 meters. Senior **Jen Boberg (Lansford, PA/Panther Valley HS)** had a time of 2:33.58 in the 800 meters. Sophomore **Jen Brief (Clark, NJ/Arthur L. Johnson HS)** posted a time of 12:03.45 in the 3,000 meters while freshman **Megan Krebs (Palmerton, PA/Palmerton HS)** had a time of 12:07.34.

In the sprint events, freshman **Kirsten Rotzell (Bangor, PA/Bangor HS)** placed second in her heat of the 60-meter dash with a time of 8.38 seconds. Freshman **Sarah Krebs (Palmerton, PA/Palmerton HS)** posted a time of 1:08.90 in the 400 meters. **Rotzell** was second in the triple jump with a leap of 11.34 meters (37 feet, 2 ½ inches), a NCAA Division III provisional qualifying distance and an ECAC qualifying distance, and she was 14th in the long jump with a leap of 4.81 meters (15 feet, 9 ½ inches). Senior **Sarah Shaneberger (Bethlehem, PA/Southern Lehigh HS)** posted a distance of 12.28 meters (40 feet, 3 ½ inches) in the 20 lb. weight throw while sophomore **Alicia Fowler (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** had a distance of 10.34 meters (33 feet, 11 ½ inches).

The Greyhounds had three winners at the Ursinus College Invitational on February 2nd. **Jaick** won the 1,500 meters in a time of 4:45.5, an Eastern College Athletic Conference qualifying standard, while **Shertzer** captured first in the 3,000 meters with a time of 10:29.7, an ECAC qualifying mark. The distance medley relay team of senior **Erin Boyle (Philadelphia, PA/ Nazareth Academy HS)** and **Wolfsberger, Wagner** and **McGarvie** won the event in a time of 12:08.3, the best time in the nation this season at the NCAA Division III level. The time qualifies the team provisionally for the NCAA Division III Championships and for the ECAC Meet. Sophomore **Christina Scherwin (Denmark)** won the shot put with a toss of 12.04 meters (39 feet, 4 ½ inches).

In the sprint events, senior **Steph Horne (Sinking Spring, PA/Wilson West Lawn HS)** and **Rotzell** each ran times of 7.6 seconds in the 55-meter dash trials and both had times of 7.7 seconds in the finals. **Horne** posted a time of 27.4 seconds in the 200 meters while **Rotzell** had a time of 28.1 seconds and freshman **Anne Guzevich (Kenilworth, NJ/David Brearley Regional HS)** ran a time of 30.1 seconds. In the distance events, **Boyle** had the team's best time in the 800 meters with a 2:24.8, an ECAC qualifying mark. **Samok** posted a 2:28.9 while **Wagner** had a 2:30.3 and **Boberg** ran a 2:33.8. **Smith** had a time of 2:33.9 while **Catalino** ran a time of 2:38.7. Rounding out the Greyhounds in the 800 meters were sophomore **Lauren Laviola (Jersey City, NJ/St. Dominic Academy HS)** with a time of 2:44.0 and freshman **Britta Jacobson (Sister Bay, WI/Gibraltar HS)** at 2:47.7. In addition to **Jaick** in the 1,500 meters **Stoyko** ran a 5:14.0 and **Laviola** had a time of 5:26.4. Following **Shertzer** in the 3,000 meters were **Wise** in third at 10:53.2 and in fourth at 10:58.6, both marks qualify for the ECAC Meet. In the 5,000 meters, **Brief** had a time of 20:33.41 and **Megan Krebs** posted a 21:05.59.

In the relays, the Greyhounds "A" team in the 4x400-meter race of **Samok, Jaick, Boberg** and **Smith** had a time of 4:24.4 while the "B" team of **Boyle, Wagner, Megan Krebs** and **Jacobson** posted a time of 4:37.0. In addition to the winning distance medley relay team, Moravian had two other squad compete in the DMR with the "B" team of **Jaick, Shertzer, Boberg** and **Catalino** placing second in 12:49.5 and the "C" team of **Bofinger, Stoyko, Smith** and **Sarah Krebs** in third at 13:32.4. **Rotzell** had Moravian's best finish in the jumps with a third place showing in the long jump at 5.20 meters (17 feet, ¾ inch). Junior **Amanda Wynn (Hellertown, PA/Saucon Valley HS)** was sixth in the pole vault, clearing 2.76 meters (nine feet).

Senior sprinter **Kevin Bush (Stroudsburg, PA/Stroudsburg HS)** won the 400 meters at the Robert J. Kane Invitational hosted by Cornell University last Saturday. **Bush** posted a NCAA Division III provisional qualifying time and an Eastern College Athletic Conference qualifying time of 49.98 seconds to win the race. In other sprint events, **Bush** placed first in his heat with a time of 7.24 seconds in the 60-meter dash while sophomore **Joe Moore (Andover, NJ/Newton HS)** had a time of 7.47 seconds. Sophomore **Steve Hartenstine (Danielsville, PA/Northampton HS)** was second in his heat of the 60-meter high hurdles with a time of 9.03 seconds. Freshman **Scott Silvoy (Bethlehem, PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** had a time of 51.78 second in the 400 meters and he posted Moravian's best time of the season and an ECAC qualifying time of 23.26 seconds in the 200 meters. **Hartenstine** had a 24.51 in the 200 meters.

Freshman **Patrick Grogan (Nazareth, PA/Notre Dame HS)** had his best time of the season in the mile race at 4:39.56 while sophomore **Joe Grady (Nanticoke, PA/Nanticoke HS)** had a time of 4:43.77. Junior **George Wacker (Honesdale, PA/Honesdale HS)** ran a time of 2:01.78 in the 800 meters while sophomore **Sean McDonnell (Scranton, PA/Scranton Prep HS)** posted a 2:06.73. Junior **Justin Arnold (Basking Ridge, NJ/Ridge HS)** had a time of 17:36.84 in the 5,000 meters.

In the relay events, Moravian's 4x400-meter squad of **Bush, Silvoy, Wacker** and junior **Eric Paul (Reading, PA/Reading Central Catholic HS)** had its best time of the season with a 3:31.51, good enough for second place in its heat. The Greyhounds 4x800-meter relay team of **Grogan, Grady, McDonnell** and freshman **Matt Oertner (Slatington, PA/Northern Lehigh HS)** had a time of 8:33.17.

Moore jumped a NCAA Division III provisional qualifying and ECAC qualifying distance of 6.99 meters (22 feet, 11 ¼ inches) in the long jump to lead Moravian in the field events. Junior **Matt Bowers (Annville, PA/Annville-Cleona HS)** and sophomore **John Lesoine (East Stroudsburg, PA/East Stroudsburg HS)** both had a distance of 11.77 meters (38 feet, 7 ½ inches) in the 35-lb. weight throw. **Lesoine** also posted a distance of 11.43 meters (37 feet, six inches) in the shot put while sophomore **Scott Williams (Bangor, PA/Bangor HS)** had a distance of 10.02 meters (32 feet, 10 ½ inches).

Moravian competed at the Ursinus College Invitational on February 2nd. In the sprint events, **Silvoy** was second in his heat of the 55-meter dash in 6.7 seconds. **Paul** was also second in his heat of the 55-meter dash with a time of 7.0 seconds while **Moore** placed third in his heat at 7.1 seconds. **Moore** placed third in his heat of the 200 meters in 24.1 seconds with **Paul** placing just behind him in fourth at 24.4 seconds.

In the distance events, **McDonnell** was seventh in his heat of the 800 meters in 2:05.3 while **Wacker** placed seventh in his heat in 2:06.3. Junior **Matt Plewinski (Hatfield, PA/North Penn HS)** posted a time of 2:14.1 in the 800 meters while freshman **Anthony Bisti (Haddonfield, NJ/Haddon Heights HS)** ran a 2:26.0 in the race. **Wacker** was ninth in the 1,500 meters with a time of 4:20.06 while **Grogan** was tenth in 4:20.56. **Grady** ran a 4:27.13 in the 1,500 meters while **Plewinski** posted a time of 4:41.89 and **Oertner** has a time of 4:44.55. Junior **Wes Zimmerman (Boyertown, PA/Boyertown HS)** placed fifth in the 5,000 meters with a time of 16:34.37.

In the relays, Moravian's 4x400 "A" team of senior **Jim McIntyre (Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown HS)**, **Wacker, Silvoy** and **Grogan** was fifth in its heat in 3:37.4 while the "B" Team of **Bush, Plewinski, Paul** and **McDonnell** was sixth in 3:39.7. In the field events, **Moore** placed fifth in the long jump with a leap of 6.21 meters (20 feet, 4 ½ inches) while **McIntyre** posted a distance of 5.39 meters (17 feet, 8 ¼ inches). **Lesoine** had a toss of 11.33 meters (37 feet, 1 ¼ inches) in the shot put while **Williams** posted a distance of 9.80 meters (32 feet, two inches). Freshman **Dan Corey (Fair Lawn, NJ/Glen Rock HS)** had a toss of 9.15 meters (30 feet, ¼ inch).
