# Women's Basketball – 16-9 (Commonwealth Conference 10-4, MAC 12-6)

Last Week – Lost to \*Susquehanna, 74-55; Defeated \*Juniata, 70-65. \*Commonwealth Conference game

Moravian had its first chance to clinch the third seed in the Commonwealth Conference playoffs, but the Greyhounds let it slip away in a 74-55 loss at Susquehanna University, however, Moravian did get the third place spot with Juniata College's loss to Lebanon Valley College. Moravian shot just 31.8 percent in the game and 28.9 percent in the second half while the Crusaders connected on 46.4 percent for the contest and 53.3 percent in the second half when Susquehanna pulled away from a 31-26 halftime lead. The Greyhounds had two players score in double figures with junior forward **Kelly McLean (Allentown, PA/Salisbury HS)** and sophomore guard **Kim Hughes (Manasquan, NJ/St. Rose HS)** each scoring a game high 17 points. **McLean** also led Moravian with six rebounds and four blocked shots. Junior guard/forward **Kristen Sarnocinski (Harleysville, PA/Germantown Academy HS)** and sophomore guard **Kim Smith (Gilbert, PA/Pleasant Valley HS)** each had six points while Moravian's leading scorer junior guard **Tara Wozniak (Roseland, NJ/West Essex Regional HS)** was held to just two points in the loss.

The Greyhounds won their final regular season contest with a 70-65 Commonwealth Conference victory at Juniata College. Moravian, which finished the regular season at 16-9 overall and 10-4 in the Commonwealth Conference, will travel to Messiah College on Wednesday, February 20th for a Commonwealth Conference Semifinal game. Moravian is the third seed while Messiah is the second seed. Lebanon Valley College, a 50-47 winner over Messiah on Saturday, will have the top seed and host fourth seed Juniata. One of the keys for Moravian in the win over the Eagles was free throw shooting as the Greyhounds connected on 28 of 36 attempts while Juniata made just five of 12 attempts. Moravian, which trailed 34-33 at halftime, was down 49-43 with ten minutes remaining in the second half. Wozniak led Moravian in scoring with 17 points Sarnocinski added 16 points. McLean had a double-double for the Greyhounds with 15 points and a game high ten rebounds. Freshman guard Jen Behagg (Hamburg, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS) has nine points and five rebounds while sophomore guard Sarah Onkotz (Catasauqua, PA/Catasauqua HS) had seven points and three rebounds. Senior guard/forward Mary Morgans (Center Valley, PA/Allentown Central Catholic HS) pulled down five rebounds while starting for Hughes who missed the game due to illness. Sophomore forward Tracie Shipman (Philadelphia, PA/Archbishop Ryan HS) also added five rebounds.

## Men's Basketball – 14-11 (Commonwealth Conference 6-8, MAC 9-10)

Last Week – Lost to \*Susquehanna, 79-76; Defeated \*Juniata, 64-60. \*Commonwealth Conference game Season Complete

Moravian was eliminated from the Commonwealth Conference playoffs with a 79-76 loss at Susquehanna University. The Greyhounds led by seven points midway through the first half but trailed 38-32 at halftime. The Crusaders would lead by as many as 14 points early in the second half before Moravian started to get back in the game. The Greyhounds retook the lead with 8:40 left in the contest on a three-pointer by senior guard **Doug Spadt** (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS). Moravian, trailing by three, had a chance to tie the game at the buzzer but sophomore guard **Steve Weiler's** (Edgewater Park, NJ/Burlington City HS) three-pointer bounced off the rim. Junior forward Ken Greb (Mount Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley Regional HS) led Moravian with a career high 22 points while **Spadt** and freshman forward **Brandon Zaleski** (Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown HS) each had ten points. **Greb** also had a team high six rebounds in the contest. **Zaleski**, the Greyhounds' leading scorer, played just 12 minutes in the game due to foul trouble. Sophomore guard **Lucas Malishchak** (Wanamie, PA/Nanticoke HS) had seven points while freshman forward Mike Howell (Floral Park, NY/Holy Cross HS) added eight points.

The Greyhounds snapped a four-game losing streak and finished the 2001-02 season with a 64-60 victory at Juniata College in Commonwealth Conference action. Moravian, ranked second in the nation in free throw percentage, shot 91.7 percent from the line in the game (11 of 12) and 48.1 percent from the floor. The Greyhounds trailed 35-34 at halftime and were down 58-54 with three minutes left in the second half before holding the Eagles to two points the rest of the game. **Zaleski** led all scorers in the game with 25 points. **Zaleski**, who also had six rebounds, four steals and three assists in the victory, finished the season with 477 points, the seventh highest single season total in Moravian history. Sophomore guard **Kevin Wyers** (**Hamilton Square, NJ/Notre Dame HS**) added 11 points for the Greyhounds while **Greb** scored ten points and had a team high nine rebounds. **Weiler** contributed nine points in the win.

Freshman **Julie Anderson** (**Bethlehem**, **PA/Liberty HS**) placed third in the 20-lb weight throw at the Kutztown University Bears Den Invitational with a toss of 11.49 meters (37 feet, 8 1/2 inches).

Sophomore **Christina Scherwin (Denmark)** won the shot put with an NCAA Division III provisional qualifying and Easter College Athletic Conference qualifying toss of 12.94 meters (42 feet, 5 ½ inches) to lead Moravian at the Keogh Invitational hosted by Haverford College. **Scherwin** also competed in the 55-meter dash, winning her heat with an ECAC qualifying time of 7.5 seconds, which tied for third overall.

In the distance events, seniors Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic, PA/Riverside HS) and Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown, PA/Lower Dauphin HS) each took second place in their respective events. Wolfsberger placed second in the 1,500 meters in an NCAA Division III provisional and ECAC qualifying time of 4:44.9 while Shertzer was second in the 3,000 meters with an ECAC qualifying time of 10:24.2. Following Wolfsberger in the 1,500 was senior Kim Jaick (Coopersburg, PA/Southern Lehigh HS) in fifth place with an ECAC qualifying time of 4:51.9 and junior Jen Wagner (Riegelsville, PA/Wilson HS) in tenth place at 5:03.1. Also competing in the 1,500 meters were freshman Ali Stoyko (Reading, PA/Governor Mifflin HS) at 5:16.2, sophomore Lauren Laviola (Jersey City, NJ/St. Dominic Academy HS) at 5:23.2, freshman Kellie Smith (Perkasie, PA/Pennridge HS) with a time of 5:27.9 and senior Tiffany Catalino (Bethlehem, PA/Freedom HS) at 5:28.0. Behind Shertzer in the 3,000 meters were freshman Chelsea Mullins (Jim Thorpe, PA/Jim Thorpe HS) in ninth place with a time of 11:06.2, sophomore Angie Morgan (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) with an 11:08.0, freshman Holly Bofinger (Warminster, PA/William Tennent HS) at 11:16.4 and freshman Megan Krebs (Palmerton, PA/Palmerton HS) with a time of 12:06.0. In the 800 meters, senior Erin Boyle (Philadelphia, PA/Nazareth Academy HS) was eighth in a time of 2:26.7 while senior Jen Boberg (Lansford, PA/Panther Valley HS) finished in 2:30.7. Wagner ran a time of 2:33.1 while Catalino finished in 2:37.0 and Stoyko had a time of 2:38.9. Freshman Sarah Krebs (Palmerton, PA/Palmerton HS) rounded out the Moravian runners in the 800 meters with a time of 2:42.1.

In addition to **Scherwin** in the 55 meters, freshman **Anne Guzevich** (**Kenilworth, NJ/David Brearley Regional HS**) ran a time of 8.2 seconds and sophomore **Nicole Sabaliauskas** (**Butler, NJ/Butler HS**) had a time of 8.3 seconds. **Sabaliauskas** posted a time of 10.0 seconds in the 55-meter hurdles and she had a 29.0 second race in the 200 meters. **Guzevich** ran the 200 meters in 29.9 seconds, winning her heat, and she also won her heat of the 400 meters in 1:06.7. Freshman **Heather McGarvie** (**Medford, NJ/Shawnee HS**) also won her heat of the 400 meters in an ECAC qualifying time of 1:01.3 while senior **Amanda Samok** (**Palmerton, PA/Palmerton HS**) was second in same heat at 1:03.1.

#### Men's Indoor Track & Field - 0-0 (MAC 0-0)

At the Kutztown University Bears Den Invitational last Friday night, junior **Matt Bowers** (**Annville, PA/ Annville-Cleona HS**) placed third in the 35-lb weight throw with a school record toss of 13.50 meters (44 feet, 3 ½ inches).

Senior sprinter **Kevin Bush** (**Stroudsburg**, **PA/Stroudsburg HS**) and freshman sprinter **Scott Silvoy** (**Bethlehem**, **PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS**) each tied for second overall and tied for first in their heat of the 200 meters to lead Moravian at the Keogh Invitational hosted by Haverford College. **Bush** and **Silvoy** posted an Eastern College Athletic Conference qualifying time of 22.7 seconds in the race while junior **Eric Paul** (**Reading**, **PA/Reading Central Catholic HS**) and sophomore **Steve Hartenstine** (**Danielsville**, **PA/Northampton HS**) each had a time of 24.4 seconds and senior **Jim McIntyre** (**Hackettstown**, **PA/Hackettstown HS**) posted a time of 24.5 seconds. **Silvoy** won his heat of the 400 meters in 51.5 seconds while **Paul** had a time of 53.9 seconds and **McIntyre** finished in 54.1 seconds. **Silvoy** ran a time of 6.9 seconds in the 55 meters while **Hartenstine** posted a time of 8.4 seconds in the 55-meter hurdles. **Paul** ran a 9.1 in the 55-meter hurdles. The Greyhounds 4x200-meter relay team of **Hartenstine**, **Paul**, **McIntyre** and senior **Josh Heebner** (**Lansdale/North Penn HS**) posted a time of 1.35.1.

In the distance events, junior **George Wacker (Honesdale, PA/Honesdale HS)** placed sixth in the 800 meters with a time of 2:01.5. Sophomore **Sean McDonnell (Scranton, PA/Scranton Prep HS)** was 12<sup>th</sup> in the 800 with a time of 2:06.1 while freshman **Matt Oertner (Slatington, PA/Northern Lehigh HS)** was 13<sup>th</sup> in 2:06.3. **Heebner** posted a time of 2:16.7 in the race. Sophomore **Joe Grady (Nanticoke, PA/Nanticoke HS)** was 14<sup>th</sup> in the 1,500 meters with a season best time of 4:15.7 while junior **Justin Arnold (Basking Ridge, NJ/Ridge HS)** had a time of 4:32.3. Senior **Chris DeWalt (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** posted a time of 4:33.8 while freshman **Anthony Bisti (Haddonfield, NJ/Haddon Heights HS)** finished the race in 4:49.4. Junior **Wes Zimmerman (Boyertown, PA/Boyertown HS)** ran a time of 9:23.4 in the 3,000 meters.

In the field events, sophomore **John Lesoine** (**East Stroudsburg, PA/East Stroudsburg HS**) was 12<sup>th</sup> in the shot put with a toss of 11.90 meters (39 feet, ½ inch) while sophomore **Scott Williams** (**Bangor, PA/Bangor HS**) had a distance of 10.46 meters (34 feet, four inches) and freshman **Dan Corey** (**Fair Lawn, NJ/Glen Rock HS**) posted a 9.72 meters (31 feet, 10 ½ inches).
