Moravian opened its 2002 season with a 7-3 victory over Carlow College during the team's trip to Myrtle Beach. Senior Sarah Leiby (Fleetwood, PA/Fleetwood HS) and senior Deb Noble (Cranford, NJ/Cranford HS) each went two-for-three with a RBI while sophomore Melissa Soroka (Newton, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS) was two-for-four with a RBI. Sophomore Janelle Brey (Allentown, PA/Dieruff HS) had one hit with a two-run double. Senior Summer Miller (Mount Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley Regional HS) also had a two-run single. Senior Rachel Mowrey (Hellertown, PA/Saucon Valley HS) picked up the win on the mound, allowing seven hits with five strikeouts.

The Greyhounds erupted for ten runs in the top seventh inning to open a 12-run lead in a 17-5 victory over NCAA Division II University of Charleston (WV). Moravian led 2-0 on a one-out, two-run homerun by **Brey**. **Brey** finished two-for-four with seven RBIs, breaking her own school record, and she had two homeruns, tying her own school record, including a grand slam. **Leiby** was three-for-five with three RBIs, a double and a solo homerun. **Soroka** was two-for-four with a RBI and a double while sophomore **Jessica Esposito** (**Madison, NJ/Madison HS**) was two-for-two with three RBIs and a triple. Sophomore **Donna Weiner** (**East Hanover, NJ/Hanover Park HS**) earned the victory on the mound, allowing five earned runs on nine hits with two walks and three strikeouts.

Mowrey tossed a one-hitter and Brey hit a solo homerun in the first inning to lead the Greyhounds to a 1-0 victory over Bridgewater (VA) College. Mowrey had a perfect game through 6 2/3 innings before giving up a base hit. Mowrey forced the next batter into a pop fly to end the game. Moravian had just four hits in the game with one being Brey's homerun, the eighth of her career and one shy of the Moravian record. Leiby, Esposito and senior Laurie Rentschler (Slatington, PA/ Northern Lehigh HS) each had singles in the victory.

Weiner and freshman hurler Ashley Hughes (Slatington, PA/Northern Lehigh HS) combined to toss a no-hitter as Moravian closed out its trip to Myrtle Beach, South Carolina with a 10-0, six-inning victory over Becker (MA) College. Weiner tossed five perfect innings with three strikeouts and Hughes threw one inning with two strikeouts and a walk in her first college action. At the plate, Moravian pounded out 17 hits with freshman Leah Holmes (Clarks Green, PA/Abington Heights HS) and sophomore Jenn Hastings (Pottstown, PA/Owen J. Roberts HS) each collecting three hits. Leiby, Esposito and freshman Krissy Cianfichi (Warminster, PA/William Tennent HS) each had two hits in the contest. Hastings and Leiby each drove in three runs while Noble connected on a solo homerun. Senior Stacy Matuczinski (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) hit a two-out single in the sixth inning to become the tenth player in Moravian history to collect 100 hits in a career. Junior Kim Gehman (Topton, PA/Brandywine Heights HS) had two RBIs in the victory.

The Greyhounds opened the Virginia Wesleyan Challenge with a 7-2 victory over Christopher Newport (VA) University. Moravian jumped out to a 4-0 lead in the third inning on a RBI single by **Brey**, a two-run single by **Noble** and a RBI double by **Esposito**. **Esposito** provided the Greyhounds with a three-run homerun in the fifth inning. **Brey** was four-for-four in the game while **Esposito** went three-for-three. **Noble** connected for two hits in the game including the 100th of her career, making her the 11th all-time. **Mowrey** allowed five hits and had one strikeout on the mound.

Moravian earned an 11-0 victory over Randolph-Macon (VA) College at the Virginia Wesleyan Challenge. The Greyhounds ripped out 13 hits in the game with three hits from **Cianfichi** and two hits from **Gehman** and **Soroka**. **Gehman** and **Soroka** each had doubles in the win while **Brey** and **Holmes** each had two RBIs. Sophomore **Megan Smith** (**Phillipsburg**, **NJ/Belvidere HS**) drove in four runs in the game with three coming on a homerun in the fourth inning. **Smith's** homer was Moravian's seventh of the season in six games. Sophomore **Jessica Naugle** (**Mohrsville**, **PA/Schuylkill Valley HS**) picked up her first win of the year on the mound, tossing three innings and allowing one hit while striking out three. **Hughes** threw two innings of hitless relief for the shutout.

The Greyhounds opened the second day of the Virginia Wesleyan College Challenge with a 4-0 victory over Chowan (NC) College. Moravian jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the third inning on a two-RBI double by **Noble**. **Esposito** and **Soroka** each drove in a run with a RBI single. **Esposito** was two-for-four in the game with a double. **Weiner** tossed a two-hit shutout in the game with seven strikeouts for her third win of the season.

Moravian finished its spring break trip with an 8-0 record after a 10-1, five-inning victory over host Virginia Wesleyan College at the Virginia Wesleyan Challenge. Moravian trailed 1-0 after the top of the first inning but the Greyhounds responded with four runs in the bottom of the inning. **Esposito** had a two-RBI single in the first and **Rentschler** added a two-run ground rule double. **Hastings** had a two-RBI double to end the game. **Mowrey** earned her fourth victory of the season on the mound, allowing five hits while striking out three batters.

Moravian opened its 2002 season and Commonwealth Conference campaign with a 15-9 loss to Juniata College at the Eastern Mennonite Sarasota Spring Break Classic. The Eagles jumped out to an 11-0 lead in the first three innings, chasing Moravian starter senior Randy Woolley (Manahawkin, NJ/Southern Regional HS) off the mound. At the plate, sophomore Geoffrey Deen (Mt. Bethel, PA/Bangor HS) and freshman Chris Clancy (Kendall Park, NJ/Bishop Ahr HS) each went two-for-two with Deen hitting a homerun and driving in three runs and Clancy adding two RBIs. Senior Michael Abbate (South Plainfield, NJ/Bishop Ahr HS) and junior Bob Frey (Hellertown, PA/Saucon Valley HS) each went two-for-three in the game. Sophomore Andrew Park (Harrisburg, PA/Lower Dauphin HS) had the Greyhounds longest stint on the mound, going 4 2/3 innings.

The Greyhounds dropped the first game of a Commonwealth Conference doubleheader to Juniata College, 10-3. Moravian had just two hits in the game with a two-run homerun by **Frey** and a RBI-double by **Clancy**. Sophomore **Greg Peters** (**Hellertown**, **PA/Saucon Valley HS**) suffered the loss on the mound for the Greyhounds, tossing three innings. Junior **Ryan Boyle** (**Bethlehem**, **PA/Liberty HS**) also pitched three innings in the game. Moravian won the second game of the twinbill over Juniata, 7-3. Sophomore **Brett Porter** (**Florham Park**, **NJ/Hanover Park HS**) earned the victory on the mound, tossing 5 1/3 innings while **Clancy** earned the save with 1 2/3 innings of action. **Clancy** was two-for-three at the plate with two doubles and two RBIs while junior **Jeff Meila** (**Bethlehem**, **PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS**) was three-for-four with two doubles and two runs scored in the victory. **Abbate** and sophomores **Andy Capo** (**Little Falls**, **NJ/Passaic Valley HS**) and **Peters** each had RBI singles in the game.

The Greyhounds tried to rally from a 14-9 deficit but came up short with the tying run thrown out at the plate to end the game in a 14-13 loss to Kenyon (OH) College at the Sarasota Spring Break Classic. Frey and Capo, who each had two hits including doubles, led Moravian at the plate. Frey also had three RBIs and four walks in the contest while Capo, Abbate, Meila and senior Bill Quinn (Lebanon, CT/Lyman Memorial HS) each had two RBIs. Quinn suffered the loss on the mound in relief of freshman Stephen Tomaszewski (Bethlehem, PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS), who was making his first collegiate start.

Moravian rallied from a 7-2 deficit with seven runs over the final two innings to earn a 9-7 victory over Bluffton (OH) College. The Greyhounds had just six hits in the game but **Meila** and **Peters** each had homeruns in the game. **Meila** had three RBIs while **Peters** drove in a pair of runs. Sophomore **Matthew Turtell (Lindenhurst, NY/Lindenhurst HS)** also drove in two runs for Moravian. Freshman **Chris Benigno** (**Howell, NJ/St. Rose HS**) earned the victory on the mound for the Greyhounds after tossing 3 2/3 innings. **Benigno** allowed an unearned run on two hits in his relief of freshman starter **Andrew Wach (Boonton, NJ/Boonton HS)**, who had six strikeouts in 3 1/3 innings of action.

The Greyhounds dropped the first game, 10-3, of a doubleheader with Eastern Mennonite (VA) University. **Frey** led the Greyhounds at the plate with a two-for-three performance with three RBIs and a homerun. **Clancy** suffered the loss, allowing ten runs, six of them earned in six innings of work. Moravian gave up a pair of runs in the bottom of the eighth inning to drop a 7-6 decision in the second game of a doubleheader with Eastern Mennonite. **Abbate** was two-for-three in the game while **Turtell** finished two-for-four. **Peters** had a solo homerun for the Greyhounds while **Turtell** had two RBIs. **Quinn** and **Meila** each had doubles. **Boyle** suffered the loss on the mound with 2 1/3 innings of action in relief of **Park**, who had five strikeouts in the game while **Boyle** struck out two.

Moravian snapped a two game losing streak with a 14-5 victory over Kenyon (OH) College. **Frey** had a perfect game at the plate with a five-for-five performance. **Frey** also added five RBIs, a homerun, a double and two runs scored. **Clancy** was three-for-four in the contest while **Benigno** was two-for-three with three runs scored, a double and a homerun. Sophomore **Ethan Ordog (Roebling, NJ/Holy Cross HS)** had a two-run homer in the game while **Quinn** and added a homerun. **Porter** tossed a complete game victory on the mound.

The Greyhounds closed out their spring trip to the Eastern Mennonite Sarasota Spring Classic with a 7-2 victory over Bluffton (OH) College. Moravian finished the trip with a 4-5 record including a 1-2 record in the Commonwealth Conference. **Frey** hit his fourth homerun of the tournament, a two-run shot, to lead the Greyhounds to the victory. **Boyle** also had two RBIs on a single. **Peters** earned the victory on the mound, tossing six innings with four hits, no runs and six strikeouts. **Woolley** tossed one inning of relief in the victory.

Season Complete

The Greyhounds tied for 51st of 59 schools that scored points at the 2002 NCAA Division III Indoor Track & Field National Championships hosted by Ohio Northern University. Moravian received its two points from the distance medley relay team of seniors Erin Boyle (Philadelphia, PA/Nazareth Academy HS) and Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic, PA/Riverside HS), junior Jennifer Wagner (Riegelsville, PA/Wilson HS) and freshman Heather McGarvie (Medford, NJ/Shawnee HS), which earned All-American honors with a seventh place finish in a time of 12:16.46. It is the second straight year that Moravian's distance medley relay team has received All-American accolades. The Greyhounds' only other competitor was senior sprinter Steph Horne (Sinking Spring, PA/Wilson West Lawn HS), who placed sixth in her heat of the 55-meter hurdle preliminaries with a time of 9.26 seconds.

The Moravian College men's tennis team opened its 2002 season with a 4-3 loss to NCAA Division II Wabash College during the team's spring break trip to Orlando, Florida. Moravian had singles victories from juniors **Todd Edwards (Conyngham, PA/Hazleton HS)** and **Dan Gorman (Saylorsburg, PA/Pleasant Valley HS)**. The Greyhounds received doubles victories from the teams of **Edwards** and freshman **Tasch Tinsley (Bangor, PA/ Bangor HS)** and **Gorman** and sophomore **Mike Helmuth (Bethlehem, PA/Harrisonburg {VA} HS)**.

The Greyhounds dropped their second match of the season to NCAA Division II Aquinas College from Michigan, 7-0. Moravian's closest match came at third singles with a 6-1, 7-5 loss by junior **David Kurvink** (**Bethlehem**, **PA/Liberty HS**).

Moravian closed out its spring break trip to Orlando, Florida with a 4-3 loss to Springfield (MA) College. The Greyhounds had singles wins from **Helmuth**, **Tinley** and sophomore **Jason Toedter** (**Easton**, **PA/Easton HS**). The doubles team of **Toedter** and **Tinley** also earned a victory in the match.
