Softball – 11-3 (Commonwealth Conference 1-1, MAC 1-2)

Moravian had its first two northern doubleheaders postponed last week due to poor field conditions from the heavy rain. The Greyhounds will now play at Haverford College on Thursday, March 28th and at Muhlenberg College on Tuesday, April 16th.

The Greyhounds opened the 2002 Commonwealth Conference season with a 4-0 victory over Messiah College. Senior pitcher **Rachel Mowrey (Hellertown, PA/Saucon Valley HS)** tossed her second one-hitter of the season, allowing just three base runners while striking out one for her sixth victory of the year. The Greyhounds gave **Mowrey** all the offense she would need with three runs in the third inning on a sacrifice fly by sophomore third baseman **Janelle Brey (Allentown, PA/Dieruff HS)**, a Messiah error and a two-out RBI double by senior first baseman **Sarah Leiby (Fleetwood, PA/Fleetwood HS)**. Moravian scored a single run in the fifth inning on a two-out RBI double by sophomore outfielder **Jessica Esposito (Madison, NJ/Madison HS)** that scored freshman shortstop **Heather Bortz (Allentown, PA/Parkland HS)**.

The Greyhounds dropped the second game of the doubleheader to Messiah, 3-1. Moravian left nine runners on base in the game including five in scoring position. **Bortz** was three-for-three in the contest and scored Moravian's lone run in the fourth inning on a double by **Esposito**. Sophomore **Donna Weiner (East Hanover, NJ/Hanover Park HS)** suffered the loss on the mound, allowing three runs on five hits with four walks and one strikeout in 5 1/3 innings. **Mowrey** allowed one hit and one walk and had one strikeout while pitching the final 1 2/3 innings.

Men's Tennis – 3-5 (MAC Commonwealth 2-0, MAC 3-1)

The Greyhounds had their two-match winning streak snapped with a 6-1 loss to defending MAC Champion Drew University. Moravian received its only point on a 7-6 (7-3), 6-4 singles victory from freshman **Tasch Tinsley (Bangor, PA/Bangor HS)** at second singles. **Tinsley** also combined with sophomore **Jason Toedter (Easton, PA/ Easton HS)** for a 9-8 (7-4) victory at first doubles but the Rangers won the other two doubles matches to claim the doubles point.

Moravian dropped its second straight match, falling to rival Muhlenberg College, 5-2, in non-conference action. The Greyhounds received a singles win from **Toedter** at first singles, 6-2, 6-0, while **Tinsley** and junior **David Kurvink (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** each received 1/2 a point when their matches were called by darkness. The Greyhounds did win one doubles match with **Kurvink** and sophomore **Mike Helmuth (Bethlehem, PA/ Harrisonburg {VA} HS)** winning at second doubles, 8-6.

The Greyhounds snapped a two-game losing streak and won their second straight MAC Commonwealth match of the season, defeating Widener University, 7-0. Moravian won all nine matches in the contest with straight set singles victories from **Toedter**, **Tinsley**, **Helmuth**, **Kurvink** and juniors **Todd Edwards (Conyngham, PA/Hazleton HS)** and **Dan Gorman (Saylorsburg, PA/Pleasant Valley HS)**. **Toedter** and **Tinsley**, **Kurvink** and **Helmuth** and **Edwards** and **Gorman** each teamed up for doubles wins.

Moravian had its opening contest of last week postponed due to rain and there has been no date rescheduled at press time for a make-up game with Haverford College.

The Greyhounds dropped the first game of a Commonwealth Conference twinbill with Widener University, 4-1. Sophomore second baseman **Matthew Turtell (Lindenhurst, NY/Lindenhurst HS)** scored Moravian's only run in the fifth inning on an error. **Turtell**, senior outfielder **Michael Abbate (South Plainfield, NJ/Bishop Ahr HS)** and junior catcher **Jeff Meila (Bethlehem, PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** each had singles for the Greyhounds. Freshman **Chris Clancy (Kendall Park, NJ/Bishop Ahr HS)** went the distance on the mound, allowing the four runs, three of which were unearned, on five hits while walking one and striking out two batters.

Moravian tried to rally from a 5-1 deficit but came up short in the second game of the doubleheader, falling to Widener, 5-4. The Greyhounds had a 1-0 lead in the first inning of the game when **Abbate** scored on a steal of home. With Moravian trailing in the sixth inning, **Abbate** connected on a one-out double that scored a pair of runs and **Clancy** hit a sacrifice fly but it wasn't enough for Moravian. Sophomore catcher **Geoffrey Deen (Mt. Bethel, PA/ Bangor HS)** was two-for-three in the game. Sophomore hurler **Brett Porter (Florham Park, NJ/Hanover Park HS)** suffered his first loss of the season on the mound, allowing five runs on nine hits with four strikeouts.

The Greyhounds closed out their three-game Commonwealth Conference series with a 4-3 loss to Widener in Chester. Moravian took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning on a triple by junior first baseman **Bob Frey (Hellertown, PA/ Saucon Valley HS)** that scored **Meila**. Widener would take the lead in the bottom half of the inning on a two-run homerun. The Greyhounds retook the lead in the third inning with a sacrifice fly by **Frey** to score **Abbate** and an infield grounder by sophomore designated hitter **Ethan Ordog (Roebbing, NJ/Holy Cross HS)** that scored **Clancy**. Widener took the lead for good in the bottom of the third on a homerun and a RBI single. For Moravian, **Meila** was two-for-three in the game while **Clancy** was two-for-five. Senior pitcher **Randy Woolley (Manahawkin, NJ/Southern Regional HS)** went the distance for Moravian, allowing the four runs on ten hits with two walks and four strikeouts for his first complete game of the season.
