Softball – 20-4 (Commonwealth Conference 5-1, MAC 5-2)

Last Week – Split with Rowan University, Lost 5-0 & Won 3-1; Defeated *Widener, 11-0 & 6-1. *Commonwealth Conference game

Moravian dropped the first game of a non-conference doubleheader to nationally ranked Rowan University, 5-0. The twinbill matched two of the top teams in the NCAA Division III East Region and in the nation as Rowan is ranked 14th in the nation and Moravian is ranked 21st. The loss snapped Moravian's six-game winning streak and the shutout was just the second time the Greyhounds have been blanked this season. The Profs took a 1-0 lead in the first inning of game on a double and a single. Rowan added two runs in the second inning and single runs on the fifth and sixth innings. For the Greyhounds, senior catcher **Stacy Matuczinski (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** and freshman shortstop **Heather Bortz** (**Allentown, PA/Parkland HS**) were each two-for-three while sophomore outfielder **Melissa Soroka (Newton, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS)** was two-for-four. The team had eight singles in the game. Moravian had runners at second and third in the third inning with one out and the bases loaded in the fifth inning but was unable to score. Senior **Rachel Mowrey** (**Hellertown, PA/Saucon Valley HS**) suffered her second loss of the season on the mound, allowing five runs, two of which were earned, on nine hits with one strikeout.

The Greyhounds took the second contest of a non-conference doubleheader from nationally ranked Rowan University, 3-1. The twinbill matched two of the top teams in the NCAA Division III East Region and in the nation as Rowan is ranked 14th in the nation and Moravian is ranked 21st. **Soroka** led off the top of the first inning by reaching base on an error and she would score on a double to right centerfield by sophomore third baseman **Janelle Brey** (**Allentown, PA/Dieruff HS**). **Brey** moved to third on a single by senior outfielder **Sarah Leiby** (**Fleetwood, PA/ Fleetwood HS**) and **Brey** scored on a passed ball. The Greyhounds would make the lead 3-0 in the fourth inning when **Brey** led off with a triple to the right centerfield gap and a RBI single by **Leiby**. **Brey** was two-for-two while **Leiby** was two-for-three in the contest. Rowan scored its run in the bottom of the fourth inning on a RBI single. Moravian sophomore **Donna Weiner** (**East Hanover, NJ/Hanover Park HS**) improved to 7-2 on the mound this season, allowing just the one run on five hits while walking one batter and hitting one batter.

Moravian won the first game of a Commonwealth Conference doubleheader from Widener University, 11-0 in five innings. The Greyhounds jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the first inning on a Widener error and RBI singles by sophomore outfielder Jessica Esposito (Madison, NJ/Madison HS) and senior designated player Deb Noble (Cranford, NJ/Cranford HS). Moravian added three more runs in the top of the third inning on a RBI single by Esposito, a RBI ground out by Noble and a RBI single by Matuczinski. The Greyhounds finished off the game in the top of the fifth inning with five runs. The first run came in on Noble's second RBI single of the game. Matuczinski plated the second run with a RBI single and she scored on an error. Sophomore Megan Smith (Phillipsburg, NJ/Belvidere HS) hit a sacrifice fly to score senior second baseman Laurie Rentschler (Slatington, PA/Northern Lehigh HS) and freshman infielder Leah Holmes (Clarks Green, PA/Abington heights HS) hit a RBI single to finish out the scoring. Bortz and Esposito were each three-for-three in the game with Esposito contributing two RBIs. Leiby, Noble and Matuczinski were each two-for-three with Noble driving in three and Matuczinski knocking in two runs. Mowrey earned her ninth victory of the season on the mound, allowing just three hits while striking out three for her fourth shutout of the year.

The Greyhounds swept the twinbill from Widener, winning the second game 6-1. The Greyhounds took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning when **Bortz** hit a RBI single to score **Soroka**. Moravian made its lead 2-0 in the third inning when **Brey** led off the inning with a solo homerun, her sixth homer of the season, breaking her own single season record of five and extending her school career record to 11 dingers. The Greyhounds added four runs in the top of the fourth inning with a RBI double by **Soroka** that scored **Rentschler**, an error, a RBI double by **Brey** and a sacrifice fly by **Esposito**. The Greyhounds had 12 hits in the game with two each from **Soroka**, **Brey**, **Leiby** and sophomore first baseman **Jenn Hastings** (**Pottstown**, **PA/Owen J. Roberts HS**). **Weiner** improved to 8-2 on the mound this season, allowing an unearned run on three hits with one walk and two strikeouts.

Sophomore pitcher Brett Porter (Florham Park, NJ/Hanover Park HS) tossed a one-hitter with two strikeouts and just one walk and one hit batter to lead Moravian to a 3-0 victory over Susquehanna University in the first game of a Commonwealth Conference double-header. The Greyhounds gave Porter all the offense he would need in the third inning while junior third baseman Jeff Meila (Bethlehem, PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS) hit a two-run double and junior first baseman Bob Frey (Hellertown, PA/Saucon Valley HS) hit a RBI ground out to give Moravian a 3-0 lead. The Greyhounds had five hits in the contest and senior outfielder Michael Abbate (South Plainfield, NJ/Bishop Ahr HS) was two-for-four with a double.

The Greyhounds swept the three-game series from Susquehanna, winning the second game of the doubleheader, 6-3. Moravian had a 1-0 lead in the first inning when **Meila** hit a RBI single to score **Abbate**. Starting pitcher, senior **Randy Woolley** (**Manahawkin**, **NJ**/ **Southern Regional HS**) allowed three unearned runs in the bottom of the first inning but he settled down to allow three walks while striking out four in five innings of work, earning his first win of the season. Moravian cut the Crusaders' lead to 3-2 in the third inning when freshman outfielder **Chris Clancy** (**Kendall Park**, **NJ/Bishop Ahr HS**) connected on a sacrifice fly to score freshman shortstop **Chris Benigno** (**Howell**, **NJ/St. Rose HS**). **Clancy** would drive in the tying run in the fifth inning when he scored sophomore outfielder **Greg Peters** (**Hellertown**, **PA/Saucon Valley HS**) on a fielder's choice. **Clancy** then got in an intentional rundown to score **Benigno** to give the Greyhounds the lead for good. **Frey** gave the Greyhounds some insurance in the sixth inning with a solo homerun. The Greyhounds final run came in the sixth inning scored when sophomore catcher **Geoffrey Deen** (**Mt. Bethel**, **PA/Bangor HS**) scored on a sacrifice fly by **Peters**. **Peters** came into pitch in the sixth inning and struck out two while walking none to earn his first save.

Peters hit a three-run homerun in the second inning and tossed six innings in relief to lead Moravian to a 13-9 victory over Lebanon Valley College in Commonwealth Conference action. The Greyhounds would take the lead with four runs in the top of the second inning when Frey scored on an error and Peters connected on his homer to score sophomore outfielder Ethan Ordog (Roebling, NJ/Holy Cross HS) and sophomore second baseman Matthew Turtell (Lindenhurst, NY/Lindenhurst HS). Moravian moved into the lead for good in the top of the fourth inning when the Greyhounds scored four runs. Peters led off the inning with a walk and scored on a RBI single by Clancy. Meila hit a RBI single to score Abbate. Clancy would score on a fielder's choice by Ordog and Meila crossed the plate on an error. The Greyhounds gave Peters, who pitched six innings in relief of Clancy, some insurance runs in the fifth, sixth and eighth innings. Moravian scored a pair of runs in the fifth on a two-RBI single by Meila that scored Abbate (the 100th run of Abbate's career and the first Moravian player to ever surpass 100 runs in a career) and Benigno. Moravian added a single run in the sixth inning on a RBI single by Abbate that scored Clancy and the Greyhounds scored two runs in the eighth inning an error and a RBI single by Abbate. Abbate and Meila were each four-for-five with two and three RBIs respectively while Ordog was three-for-six. Clancy allowed six runs on seven hits with two walks in three innings while Peters gave up three runs on seven hits and four walks.

Moravian had its four-game winning streak snapped with a 7-6, nine-inning loss to Lebanon Valley in the first game of a doubleheader. The Greyhounds trailed 1-0 after the first but took a 3-1 lead in the bottom of the second inning on a two-RBI triple by **Peters** that scored **Ordog** and **Deen**, who had singled. **Peters** scored on a sacrifice squeeze bunt by **Benigno**. The Greyhounds tied the game up in the bottom of the fourth at 5-5 when **Abbate** hit a ground out that scored **Peters**, who had singled. **Clancy** followed with a RBI single to right field that scored **Turtell**, who had reached on a single. The Greyhounds got a run back in the bottom of the ninth on a RBI single by **Ordog** the scored **Abbate** but it wasn't enough as the tying run was left at third base. **Peters** was three-for-four with two RBIs while **Abbate** and **Ordog** were each three-for-five. **Abbate** singled in the sixth inning for the 100th hit of his career, the seventh Moravian player to reach 100 hits. **Deen** had two hits. Freshman **Stephen Tomaszewski** (**Bethlehem, PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS**) suffered the loss on the mound, his first of the season, tossing five innings of relief of **Porter**. **Tomaszewski** allowed two unearned runs on three hits and one walk while striking out five batters. **Porter** gave up five runs on seven hits with two walks and one strikeout.

The Greyhounds could muster just three singles, dropping the second game of the doubleheader to Lebanon Valley, 6-0. Clancy, Frey and Turtell had the only hits for the Greyhounds, who gave up six runs in the first three innings. Woolley took the loss on the mound, allowing the six runs on 12 hits with four walks and a strikeout in six innings of action. Senior Bill Quinn (Lebanon, CT/Lyman Memorial HS) tossed the final inning of the game and allowed one hit while striking out two batters.

Moravian snapped a two-game losing streak with a 19-9 victory over the University of Scranton in non-conference action. The Greyhounds jumped out to a 5-0 lead in the top of the first inning and never looked back. Moravian's five runs came on a bases loaded walk to **Ordog** that scored **Abbate** who had doubled to lead off the game. **Peters** followed **Ordog** with a three-RBI triple and **Peters** would score on a delayed steal while **Turtell** was stealing second base after walking. Moravian added two runs in the second inning on a two-run single by **Meila**. The Greyhounds tacked on three more runs in the third inning on RBI singles by **Benigno** and **Meila** and a Scranton error. The Greyhounds added five runs in the top of the fifth inning on two-RBI singles by **Meila** and **Peters** and a Scranton error. Moravian made the score 19-8 with four tallies in the top of the sixth. The Greyhounds scored on a RBI single by **Clancy**, a bases loaded walk to **Turtell** and a pair of Scranton errors. **Peters** was three-for-five with five RBIs while **Meila** and **Benigno** were each three-for-six. **Meila** had three RBIs while **Benigno** and junior third baseman **Ryan Boyle** (**Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS**) each scored three runs. **Abbate** and **Clancy** each crossed the plate four times in the game. Freshman **Andrew Wach** (**Boonton, NJ/Boonton HS**) earned the victory on the mound for Moravian, tossing 4 1/3 innings of hitless relief. **Wach** allowed just one unearned run and had five strikeouts for his first career victory. Sophomore **Andrew Park** (**Harrisburg, PA/Lower Dauphin HS**) started and pitched 4 2/3 innings, allowing eight runs, five of them earned, on ten hits and three walks while striking out one.

Moravian won its third straight match to get back to .500 on the season, defeating Messiah College in Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth action, 6-1. Moravian opened the match by winning two of the three doubles matches to earn the doubles point. Junior David Kurvink (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) and sophomore Mike Helmuth (Bethlehem, PA/Harrisonburg {VA} HS) earned a victory at second doubles while juniors Dan Gorman (Saylorsburg, PA/Pleasant Valley HS) and Todd Edwards (Conyngham, PA/Hazleton HS) had a win at third doubles. Sophomore Jason Toedter (Easton, PA/ Easton HS), freshman Tasch Tinsley (Bangor, PA/Bangor HS), Kurvink, Edwards and Gorman all earned straight set singles wins for the Greyhounds.

The Greyhounds won their fourth straight match and moved over the .500 mark for the first time this season, sweeping DeSales University, 7-0, in non-conference action. Moravian won all six singles matches with victories **Kurvink**, **Edwards**, **Gorman**, **Helmuth**, **Toedter** and **Tinsley**. The Greyhounds also swept the doubles matches with wins from the teams of **Kurvink** and **Helmuth**, **Edwards** and **Gorman** and **Tinsley** and freshman **Cody Hendershot** (**Bangor**, **PA/Bangor HS**).

Moravian won its fifth straight contest and stayed undefeated in the Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth with a 5-2 victory over Elizabethtown College. The Greyhounds won four singles matches in the contest with victories from **Kurvink**, **Gorman**, **Helmuth** and **Tinsley**. Moravian won two of the doubles matches to earn the doubles point. The victories came from the teams of **Kurvink** and **Helmuth** and **Gorman** and **Edwards**.

The Greyhounds ran their winning streak to six straight matches with a 7-0 victory over the University of Scranton in non-conference action. Moravian won all six singles matches with victories from **Kurvink**, **Edwards**, **Gorman**, **Toedter**, **Helmuth** and **Tinsley**. Moravian also swept the doubles matches to earn the doubles point. The Hounds had victories from the teams of **Toedter** and **Tinsley**, **Kurvink** and **Helmuth** and **Edwards** and **Gorman**.

Moravian opened the 2002 portion of its season with a fifth place score of 336 at the Anthracite Golf Association Collegiate Invitational hosted by King's College at the Wilkes-Barre Golf Course. The Greyhounds were in the top half of the 13 schools competing and third among the five Middle Atlantic Conference schools in the field. For Moravian, sophomore Jamison Licausi (Tobyhanna, Pocono Mountain HS) tied for 16th with a round of 82 while senior Sean Carney (Ariel, PA/Wallenpaupack HS) was tied for 21st with an 84. Junior Charles Tice (Manasquan, NJ/Manasquan HS) and junior Jason Pozniak (Tunkhannock, PA/Tunkhannock HS) both tied for 25th with rounds of 85 while sophomore Brian Kurylo (Sparta, NJ/Sparta HS) was tied for 30th with a round of 86.

The Greyhounds' A team placed third and Moravian's B team was 11th of 18 teams at the annual Moravian Spring Invitational played at Southmoore Golf Course. The College of New Jersey won the event with a team score of 314 while Moravian's teams had scores of 323 and 339. **Pozniak** led all Moravian golfers with a round of 79 for the A squad. He was joined on the A team by **Tice**, who tied for 13th with an 80, **Carney** and **Licausi**, who tied for 28th with rounds of 82, and **Kurylo**, tied for 38th with an 83. Freshman **Todd Solecitto (Washington, NJ/Warren Hills Regional HS)** led the B squad with a round of 80 while junior **Sean Alden (Tunkhannock, PA/Tunkhannock HS)** and senior **Ricky Gower (Bath, PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** each had rounds of 82. Junior **Jerry Coveney (Plymouth Meeting, PA/LaSalle College HS)** had a 95 and sophomore **Todd James (Nazareth, PA/Nazareth HS)** fired a 97 for the B team.

Women's Outdoor Track & Field – 0-0 (MAC 0-0) – MAC Indoor Champions (7th straight year)

Senior **Kim Jaick** (**Coopersburg**, **PA/Southern Lehigh HS**) captured first place in the 10,000 meters with an NCAA Division III automatic and Eastern College Athletic Conference qualifying time of 36:32.0 on the first day of the Sam Howell Memorial Invitational hosted by Princeton University. Moravian's only other competitor on day one was freshman **Chelsea Mullins** (**Jim Thorpe**, **PA/Jim Thorpe HS**), who took sixth in the 5,000 meters with a time of 18:17.8.

Moravian had four top eight finishes on the second day of the Sam Howell Memorial Invitational. Freshman **Kirsten Rotzell (Bangor, PA/Bangor HS)** took second in the triple jump with an NCAA Division III provisional and ECAC qualifying leap of 11.26 meters (36 feet, 11 ½ inches). Senior **Sarah Shaneberger (Bethlehem, PA/Southern Lehigh HS)** was sixth in the shot put at 11.87 meters (38 feet, 11 ½ inches) while freshman **Megan Wise (North Wales, PA/North Penn HS)** was fifth in the 3,000 meters in 11:00.08 and sophomore **Angie Morgan (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** was eighth in the 3,000 at 11:08.70. Freshman **Holly Bofinger (Warminster, PA/William Tennent HS)** also ran in the 3,000 meters and placed 17th with a time of 11:43.25. Senior **Erin Boyle (Philadelphia, PA/Nazareth Academy HS)** finished ninth in her heat of the 1,500 meters with a time of 4:47.80.

Junior Jen Wagner (Riegelsville, PA/Wilson HS) won the 800 meters and qualified for the ECAC Championships in the 1,500 meters to lead the Greyhounds at the Muhlenberg College Invitational. Wagner captured the 800 in 2:25.58 and she was third in the 1,500 meters with an ECAC qualifying time of 4:59.51. Senior Steph Horne (Sinking Spring, PA/Wilson West Lawn HS) placed third in the 100-meter hurdles finals with an ECAC qualifying time of 16.37 seconds after running a school record time of 15.47 seconds in the preliminaries and she was fourth in the 400-meter hurdles in 1:10.75. Senior Amanda Samok (Palmerton, PA/Palmerton HS) placed fourth in the 800 meters with a time of 2:29.12 while senior Jen Boberg (Lansford, PA/Panther Valley HS) was seventh in 2:31.32 and freshman Kellie Smith (Perkasie, PA/Pennridge HS) was ninth with a time of 2:35.47. Rounding out the Moravian competitors in the 800 meters were freshman Sarah Krebs (Palmerton, PA/Palmerton HS) in 15th at 2:42.29, sophomore Nicole Sabaliauskas (Butler, NJ/Butler HS) in 18th at 2:43.44, freshman Ann Guzevich (Kenilworth, NJ/David Brearley Regional HS) at 21st in 2:48.65, freshman Britta Jacobsen (Sister Bay, WI/ Gibraltar HS) in 22nd with a time of 2:49.52 and freshman Kim Bushner (Allentown, PA/Dieruff HS) in 28th at 3:01.75.

In the 1,500 meters, senior **Tiffany Catalino (Bethlehem, PA/Freedom HS)** placed ninth with a time of 5:16.80 while freshman **Alison Stoyko (Reading, PA/Governor Mifflin HS)** was 12th in 5:18.70, sophomore **Lauren Laviola (Jersey City, NJ/St. Dominic Academy HS)** was 17th with a time of 5:34.20 and freshman **Robin Edward (Massapequa, NY/Plainedge HS)** was 19th in 5:38.00. Freshman **Marcy Burke (Kintersville, PA/Palisades HS)** placed 18th in the 400 meters in 1:10.40 while freshman **Meghan Krebs (Palmerton, PA/Palmerton HS)** was eighth in the 5,000 meters with a time of 21:01.30. **Sabaliauskas** was seventh in the 100-meter hurdles in 18.07 seconds while **Guzevich** placed 13th with a time of 20.89 seconds.

In the field events, sophomore **Amanda Wynn** (**Hellertown, PA/Saucon Valley HS**) placed third in the pole vault and qualified for the ECAC Championships, clearing a height of 2.75 meters (nine feet, ¼ inch). Junior Wes Zimmerman (Boyertown, PA/Boyertown HS) placed 31st with a time of 33:15.9 in the 10,000 meters in the first day of the Sam Howell Memorial Invitational hosted by Princeton University. Zimmerman was the only Greyhound competitor on the first day of competition.

Sophomore **Joe Moore** (**Andover, NJ/Newton HS**) led the Moravian competitors on the second day of the Sam Howell Memorial Invitational. **Moore** took third in the long jump with an Eastern College Athletic Conference qualifying leap of 6.85 meters (22 feet, 5 ¾ inches) and he teamed up with senior **Kevin Bush** (**Stroudsburg, PA/ Stroudsburg HS**), junior **Brian Mack** (**Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS**) and freshman **Scott Silvoy** (**Bethlehem, PA/ Bethlehem Catholic HS**) to win the team's heat of the 4x100-meter relay in a time of 44.35 seconds. **Bush** was second in his heat of the 400 meters with an ECAC qualifying time of 50.84 seconds. **Senior Josh Heebner** (**Lansdale, PA/North Penn HS**) was third in his heat of the 400 meters in 52.34 seconds. **Bush** and **Heebner** joined **Silvoy** and junior **George Wacker** (**Honesdale, PA/Honesdale HS**) to place third in their heat of the 4x400-meter relay in 3:28.05. Sophomore **Joe Grady** (**Nanticoke, PA/Nanticoke HS**) placed third in his heat of the 1,500 meters with a time of 4:16.02 while **Wacker** was fifth in his heat of the 800 meters in 2:01.35.
