#### Softball – 14-4 (Commonwealth Conference 0-0, MAC 2-0)

Last Week – Split with Ursinus, Won 1-0 & Lost 4-3; Defeated Muhlenberg, 8-0 (6 inn) & 10-2 (6 inn); \*Susquehanna postponed until April 17th. \*Commonwealth Conference game.

The Greyhounds split a non-conference doubleheader at Ursinus College, winning the first game, 1-0, and falling in the nightcap, 4-3. Moravian scored on an unearned run in the sixth inning of the first game. Sophomore shortstop Heather Bortz (Allentown, PA/Parkland HS) led off the sixth with a single and would score on an error. The Greyhounds had just five hits in the game with junior designated player Jessica Esposito (Madison, NJ/Madison HS) going 2-for-3 with a double. Junior outfielder Melissa Soroka (Newton, NJ/Pope John XXIII HS) also had a double in the game. Freshman pitcher Meagan Hennessy (Freehold, NJ/Freehold Township HS) improved to 6-2 on the season with her third shutout of the year. Hennessy scattered two hits and walked two batters while striking out five. The Greyhounds let a 2-0 lead slip away in the second game. Moravian jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the top of the first inning on a two-RBI double by junior third baseman Janelle Brey (Allentown, PA/Dieruff HS). The hit was the 100th of Brey's career at Moravian and one of three doubles she hit in the contest. Ursinus would take a 3-2 lead in the sixth inning. Moravian tied the game in the top of the seventh inning on another RBI-double by **Brey** but the Bears pushed a run across in the bottom of the seventh inning to earn a split in the doubleheader. The Greyhounds had nine hits in the game with Brey going 3-for-4. Sophomore outfielder Stephanie Eddinger (Allentown, PA/Parkland HS) also contributed a double in the game. Junior pitcher **Donna Weiner (East Hanover, NJ/Hanover Park HS)** dropped to 6-2 on the season with the loss. She allowed four runs, three of them earned, on eight hits with two walks and two strikeouts in six-plus innings. **Hennessy** tossed a third of an inning and faced four batters in the bottom of the seventh.

Brey went five-for-six with three two-run home runs and eight RBIs to lead Moravian to a doubleheader sweep of rival Muhlenberg College, 8-0 and 10-2, in non-conference action. Hennessy scattered two hits and a walk while striking out five batters to improve to 7-2 on the season with the six-inning win in the first game. The shutout was Hennessy's fourth of the season and she had a no-hitter through five innings. The Greyhounds scored the only run Hennessy would need in the bottom of the third inning when Brey singled to left field to score sophomore outfielder Krissy Cianfichi (Warrington, PA/Central Bucks East HS). Moravian pushed four runs across the plate in the bottom of the fourth inning on a sacrifice fly to center field by Eddinger, RBI-singles by Bortz and junior first baseman Jenn Hastings (Pottstown, PA/Owen J. Roberts HS) and a Muhlenberg error. The Greyhounds would score a single run in the fifth inning on an RBI-double by Eddinger that scored sophomore second baseman Leah Holmes (Clarks Green, PA/Abington Heights HS). Moravian would institute the NCAA's eight-run rule in the bottom of the sixth inning when Brey hit a two-run home run down the left field line. The homer was Brey's second of the season. Moravian finished the first game with 11 hits with Brey going 3-for-3. Bortz and Holmes were both 2-for-3 in the victory. The Mules took a 2-0 lead in the top of the first inning of the second game before Moravian scored ten unanswered runs. The Greyhounds tied the contest in the bottom of the first inning on a two-run home run to left centerfield **Brey**, her first homer of the game and second of the day. Moravian took the lead for good in the bottom of the second inning on a two-RBI double by Bortz that scored freshman catcher Kira Weller (Sinking Spring, PA/Wilson West Lawn HS) and Holmes. Brey would hit her second two-run home run and her third of the doubleheader in the bottom of the fifth inning with a shot to center field. The Greyhounds would institute the NCAA's eight-run rule with four tallies in the bottom of the sixth inning. Brey drove in the first run of the inning with a bases-loaded walk and Hastings also drew a bases loaded walk to score another run. Soroka hit a two-RBI single to right field to finish the scoring. Moravian had 11 hits in the game led by a 3-for-3 performance by Bortz, who added two RBIs. Brey was 2-for-3 in the game with five RBIs. Brey now has 99 RBIs in her career, just three shy of the school record of 102, and she extended her own school record for home runs to 19 with her three dingers in the twinbill. This was the third time in her career that **Brev** has hit two home runs in a single game. Soroka was 2-for-4 in the game, and she drove in two runs. Weiner improved to 7-2 on the mound, allowing two runs on four hits and a walk while striking out three.

Moravian had its Commonwealth Conference season opening doubleheader at Susquehanna University for Saturday, March 29<sup>th</sup> postponed due to rain and poor field conditions. The twinbill will likely be played on Thursday, April 17<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 p.m. in Selinsgrove.

Moravian earned a 7-4 victory over Widener University in Commonwealth Conference action to take two of three games from the Pioneers in the 2003 series between the two schools. The Greyhounds fell behind 1-0 in the top of the first inning but took the lead for good in the bottom of the stanza when freshman Bryan Wolf (Nazareth, PA/Nazareth HS) was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded and sophomore Chris Clancy (Kendall Park, NJ/Bishop Ahr HS) grounded into a fielder's choice to score a run. Moravian, now 6-5 overall and 4-2 in the Commonwealth Conference, added a run in the bottom of the second inning on an RBI-single by junior Matthew Turtell (Lindenhurst, NY/Lindenhurst HS). The Greyhounds extended their lead to 4-1 in the bottom of the sixth inning on an RBI-single by senior Bob Frey (Hellertown, PA/Saucon Valley HS). Moravian tallied three runs in the bottom of the seventh inning on an RBI-double by junior Greg Peters (Hellertown, PA/ Saucon Valley HS) and a two-run single by senior Luke Bricker (Kutztown, PA/Kutztown HS). Widener would score three unearned runs in the top of the ninth inning. Moravian had nine hits in the contest with Bricker going 3-for-4. Clancy was 2-for-4 while Peters was 2-for-3. Junior Brett Porter (Florham Park, NJ/Hanover Park HS) earned his first victory of the season on the mound, allowing an unearned run and five hits while striking out three in six innings. Peters tossed the final three innings of the game, allowing three unearned runs on six hits and three walks with five strikeouts.

The Greyhounds dropped a non-conference game to Alvernia College, 23-8. Moravian scored its first run in the second inning on a bases loaded walk to junior Michael Young (Palmerton, PA/ Palmerton HS). The Greyhounds would add another run in the top of the third inning off an RBI-single by junior outfielder Ethan Ordog (Roebling, NJ/Holy Cross HS). Moravian had a six-run fourth inning. Young led off the fourth with a solo home run. Bricker drove in a run with an RBI-double while Frey grounded into a fielder's choice to score a run. Ordog would add another RBI-single before Peters finished the scoring for the Greyhounds with a two-RBI double. Moravian had 13 hits in the game with Young, Peters, Frey and Clancy each collecting two hits. Freshman Andrew Wayne (Hillsborough, NJ/Hillsborough HS) added a double for Moravian. The Greyhounds used three pitchers in the game with sophomore Zach Dimovitz (Breinigsville, PA/Parkland HS) taking the loss after two innings of work. Freshman Daniel Wright (Reading, PA/Reading HS) pitched three innings while freshman John Howarth (Livingston, NJ/Livingston HS) tossed one-plus innings in the game.

Moravian opened its three-game Commonwealth Conference weekend series with Susquehanna University with a 14-8 victory over Crusaders. The Greyhounds jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the top of the second inning on a solo home run to left field by Clancy to lead off the inning and an RBI-single to right center by freshman Mike Sofka (Westfield, NJ/Westfield HS) that scored Wolf. Moravian would add a run in the third inning on a solo home run to left field by senior Jeff Meila (Bethlehem, PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS) for a 3-0 lead. Susquehanna cut Moravian's lead to 3-2 in the bottom of the third inning. The Greyhounds would get the two runs back in the top of the fourth on a RBI-double by Sofka, which scored Ordog, and a suicide squeeze bunt by Turtell that scored Peters. The Crusaders took their only lead of the game in the bottom of the fourth inning when they scored four runs. Moravian would tie the game at 6-6 in the top of the sixth inning on a sacrifice fly by Sofka that scored Ordog. The Greyhounds would take the lead for good with four runs in the top of the seventh inning. Wolf drove in the first run with a sacrifice fly to score Frey. Ordog hit an RBI-single to left center to score Clancy, and he would score on an RBI-single to center field by Sofka. Turtell hit an infield single that scored **Peters** with the final run of the inning. Moravian added four more runs on t he top of the eighth inning wit a bunt single by Peters scoring Frey with the first run of the inning. Sofka singled to left field to score Wolf and Ordog, and Peters scored the final run of the inning on a Susquehanna error. Moravian had 13 hits in the game, led by Sofka, who was 4-for-4 with six RBIs. Clancy, Ordog and Peters each picked up two hits in the game. Sophomore Stephen Tomaszewski (Bethlehem, PA/ Bethlehem Catholic HS) improved to 3-1 on the season. Tomaszewski tossed seven innings, allowing six runs, five of them earned, on 14 hits and three walks while striking out five batters. **Peters** pitched the final two innings of the game, allowing two earned runs on two hits and a walk.

The Greyhounds won the first game of a Commonwealth Conference doubleheader versus Susquehanna University, 4-2, when the game was called due to rain and poor field conditions in the bottom of the sixth inning. The second game of the twinbill was postponed until Monday, March 31<sup>st</sup> at 3:00 p.m. The Crusaders took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning and extended their lead to 2-0 in the second inning. Moravian, which had a runner thrown out at home in the third inning and didn't have a hit until the fourth inning, scored four times in the bottom of the sixth inning for the victory. **Bricker** led of the inning with a double to center field. **Meila** drew a walk and was pinch run for by **Wayne**. **Frey** followed with a triple down the right field line to score **Bricker** and **Wayne** and tie the score at 2-2. **Ordog** drew a walk to put runners on the corners before **Wolf** tripled to center field to score **Frey** and **Ordog**. The umpires suspended the game for 30 minutes with a 3-2 count on Moravian's next batter, **Peters**, before declaring the game over. **Clancy** improved to 3-1 on the season and allowed two runs, only one was earned, on five hits and three walks while striking out three.

Moravian had its four-match winning streak snapped with a 4-3 loss to FDU-Florham in non-conference action. Moravian's three points came from singles victories by seniors **David Kurvink** (**Bethlehem**, **PA/Liberty HS**) and **Todd Edwards** (**Conyngham**, **PA/Hazleton HS**) and junior **Jason Toedter** (**Easton**, **PA/Easton HS**). The Greyhounds did win one of the three doubles matches with a victory by the duo of **Kurvink** and sophomore **Tasch Tinsley** (**Bangor**, **PA/Bangor HS**).

The Greyhounds team remained undefeated in the MAC Commonwealth this season with a 5-2 victory over Messiah College. Moravian started the contest by winning just one doubles match, a victory by the team of **Kurvink** and senior **Dan Gorman (Saylorsburg, PA/Pleasant Valley HS)**. The Greyhounds would win five singles contests to clinch the match with wins by **Kurvink**, **Gorman**, **Edwards**, **Toedter** and freshman **Sean Lynch (West Chester, PA/Henderson HS)**.

Moravian's final match of the week, a non-conference contest at King's College was postponed due to rain and snow.

## Women's Lacrosse - 0-6 (MAC 0-4)

Moravian dropped its fourth straight varsity match, falling to Alvernia College, 9-6, in a non-conference contest played at East Hills Middle School in Bethlehem. The Greyhounds trailed, 7-2, at halftime after a pair of first half goals by freshman midfielder/defender Jess Cordani (Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant Boro HS). Freshman midfielder Shannon Kelly (Southlake, TX/Carroll HS) added a goal and two assists in the second half while junior attack Lindsay Murphy (Lansdale, PA/North Penn HS), senior midfielder Erica Miller (Tatamy, PA/Nazareth HS) and sophomore attack/midfielder Hayley Zamek (Hillsborough, NJ/ Hillsborough HS) each scored second half goals. Freshman Chelsea Marshall (Hilton Head, SC/Hilton Head Prep HS) made ten saves in goal for the Greyhounds.

The Greyhounds lost a Middle Atlantic Conference match to the University of Scranton, 21-0. Moravian had just three shots in the game while the Royals took 37 shots. **Marshall** had 14 saves in the match for the Greyhounds.

Moravian dropped an 11-5 decision to King's College in Middle Atlantic Conference action. The Greyhounds trailed just 6-5 at halftime. **Zamek** netted two goals for the Greyhounds while **Murphy** had a goal and an assist. **Kelly** and sophomore midfielder **Michelle Dougherty** (**Pottsville, PA/Nativity BVM HS**) scored Moravian's other goals while sophomore defender/midfielder **Kristen Granato** (**Drexel Hill, PA/Haverford HS**) added two assists. **Marshall** made 15 saves in the match.

Men's Indoor Track & Field - 0-0 (Commonwealth Conference 0-0, MAC 0-0)

Last Week – 7th of 7 at Lehigh Valley Championships hosted by Muhlenberg College

This Week – Sat., Apr. 5th at Muhlenberg College Invitational

The Greyhounds placed seventh of seven schools at the 2003 Lehigh Valley Championships hosted by Muhlenberg College. Moravian did have a pair of individual winners in the meet with junior **Joe Moore** (**Andover**, **NJ/Newton HS**) capturing first place in the 100-meter dash in a track record time of 10.97 seconds and senior **Matt Bowers** (**Annville, PA/Annville-Cleona HS**) winning the hammer throw with a toss of 46.96 meters (154 feet, one inch). **Moore** also finished second in the 200-meter dash in a time of 22.42 seconds while sophomore **Scott Silvoy** (**Bethlehem, PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS**) took second in the 400-meter dash in 49.71 seconds and sixth in the 200-meter dash in 22.66 seconds. **Moore** and **Silvoy** teamed up with junior **Anthony Merz** (**Philadelphia, PA/Archbishop Ryan HS**) and freshman **Grant Curry** (**Palmyra, PA/Palmyra HS**) to finish fourth in the 4x100-meter relay in a time of 43.68 seconds. **Curry** was fifth in the 100-meter dash in a time of 11.49 seconds, and he finished second in the long jump with a leap of 6.87 meters (22 feet, 6 3/4 inches). **Merz** finished 11th in the 100-meter dash in 12.17 seconds.

In other running events for the Greyhounds, sophomore **Dan Corey** (**Fair Lawn**, **NJ/Glen Rock HS**) placed 16th in the 200-meter dash in 24.42 seconds, and he was 16th in the 400 meters in 54.07 seconds. Junior **Sean McDonnell** (**Scranton, PA/Scranton Prep HS**) placed 14th in the 800 meters with a time of 2:06.11 while freshman **John Paul Krupka** (**Ashley, PA/Hanover HS**) finished 17th in 2:08.74 and senior **Eric Paul** (**Reading, PA/Reading Central Catholic HS**) was 24th with a time of 2:11.35. Freshman **Greg Rarick** (**Drums, PA/Hazleton HS**) posted a time of 4:14.55 in the 1,500 meters, good enough for eighth place while freshman **Russell Zaleski** (**Hillsborough, NJ/Hillsborough HS**) was in 23rd place in a time of 4:31.88 and sophomore **Anthony Bisti** (**Haddonfield, NJ/Haddon Heights HS**) finished 26th in 4:35.00. Freshman **Ryan Quattrone** (**Warminster, PA/William Tennent HS**) took 12th in the 400-meter intermediate hurdles in a time of 1:05.51.

Junior John Lesoine (East Stroudsburg, PA/East Stroudsburg HS) finished second in the hammer throw with a toss of 45.79 meters (150 feet, three inches), and he placed eighth in the shot put at 11.89 meters (39 feet, 1/4 inches) and 13th in the discus with a toss of 31.43 meters (103 feet, 1 1/2 inches). Junior Scott Williams (Bangor, PA/Bangor HS) was 17th in the hammer throw with a toss of 32.18 meters (105 feet, seven inches) while sophomore Shawn Nelson (Bethlehem, PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS) was 22nd with a distance of 26.64 meters (87 feet, five inches). Freshman Michael Lesoine (East Stroudsburg, PA/East Stroudsburg HS) placed 18th in the shot put with a distance of 8.45 meters (27 feet, nine inches) while Corey was 15th in the discus with a toss of 28.85 meters (94 feet, eight inches). Freshman Dan Waingarten (Madison, NJ/Hanover Park HS) finished 18th in the discus at 27.25 meters (89 feet, five inches).

**Corey** was ninth in the long jump at 6.10 meters (20 feet, 1/4 inches) while **Paul** was 14th at 5.83 meters (19 feet, 1 3/4 inches). Freshman Michael **El Kazzaz** (**Easton, PA/Easton HS**) placed eighth in the pole vault, clearing a height of 3.81 meters (12 feet, six inches) while freshman **Casey Hoffman** (**Kempton, PA/Northwestern Lehigh HS**) was tenth at a height of 3.65 meters (12 feet).

Women's Indoor Track & Field - 0-0 (Commonwealth Conference 0-0, MAC 0-0)

The Greyhound finished fifth of six teams at the 2003 Lehigh Valley Championships hosted by Muhlenberg College. Moravian was led by sophomores **Kirsten Rotzell (Bangor, PA/Bangor HS)** and **Heather McGarvie** (**Medford, NJ/Shawnee HS**), who each had a pair of third place finishes. **Rotzell** took third in the 100-meter dash in 12.80 seconds, and she was third in the 200-meter dash in 26.83 seconds. **McGarvie** placed third in the 800 meters with a time of 2:26.11, and she was third in the 1,500 meters in 4:37.00. Other top finishers for Moravian in the running events were sophomore **Chelsea Mullins (Jim Thorpe, PA/Jim Thorpe HS)** taking second in the 5,000 meters in a time of 19:34.81, freshman **Erica Angell (Poughkeepsie, NY/Spackenkill HS)** placing third in the 3,000-meter steeplechase in 12:07.97 and sophomore **Margaret Benny (Tamaqua, PA/Tamaqua HS)** finishing fifth in the 100-meter high hurdles in 16.27 seconds.

In other running events, freshman Lynsey Boggess (Washington Township, NJ/Immaculate Heart Academy HS) was tenth in the 100-meter dash in 14.62 seconds while freshman Stephanie Beitler (Fogelsville, PA/Northwestern Lehigh HS) took 11th in the 800 meters with a time of 2:32.20. Sophomore Kellie Smith (Perkasie, PA/Pennridge HS) placed 15th in the 800 in a time of 2:33.94 while freshman Deidre Martin (Stroudsburg, PA/Pocono Mountain HS) took tenth in the 1,500 meters in 5:09.07 followed by sophomore Lindsay Stehman (Gilbertsville, PA/Boyertown HS) in 16th place at 5:10.01, freshman Lauren Bahnatka (West Chester, PA/Henderson HS) in 21st with a time of 5:32.03 and sophomore Kim Bushner (Allentown, PA/Dieruff HS) in 22nd at 5:35.93. Sophomore Alison Stoyko (Reading, PA/Governor Mifflin HS) placed sixth in the 3,000-meter steeplechase with a time of 12:38.41 while freshman Alexis Vergalla (Glen Gardner, PA/Voorhees HS) was ninth in 12:50.29. Junior Nicole Sabaliauskas (Butler, NJ/Butler HS) placed 11th in the 400-meter intermediate hurdles in 1:11.08, and she was followed by Benny in 12th place at 1:12.53 and sophomore Ann Guzevich (Kenilworth, NJ/David Brearley Regional HS) in 19th place in a time of 1:16.44.
