Moravian had its non-conference doubleheader at Haverford College postponed until Sunday, April 4<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 p.m. due to snow covering the field at Haverford.

Sophomore pitcher **Meagan Hennessy (Freehold, NJ/Freehold Township HS)** of the Moravian College softball team has been named the National Fastpitch Coaches Association Division III Player of the Week for her performance last week, March 8th to 14th. **Hennessy** was named the Most Valuable Player of the NFCA Division III Leadoff Classic after leading Moravian to a 6-0 record and the tournament title. **Hennessy**, who also earned the Commonwealth Conference Pitcher of the Week honors on Monday for the second consecutive week, posted a 4-0 record, a 0.75 ERA, 21 strikeouts and shutouts of three of the top 21 teams in the country over the weekend. **Hennessy** began the tournament with 3-0 shutout of Central (IA). She allowed just two hits and a walk while striking out three batters. **Hennessy** then defeated Capital (OH), 4-0, with a three-hit shutout. She did not allow any walks to the Crusaders and struck out six batters. **Hennessy** earned her third straight shutout with a 2-0 victory versus Alma (MI) in the semifinal game. She allowed five hits and two walks while striking out nine batters. **Hennessy** completed the NFCA Leadoff Classic by defeating East Texas Baptist, 7-3, in the championship game. She allowed three runs on seven hits and two walks while striking out three batters. **Hennessy** also had one putout and nine assists in ten chances last week.

Junior **goalie Hayley Zamek (Hillsborough, NJ/Hillsborough HS)** made a career high 15 saves in goal for the Greyhounds.
