Football - 1-2 (MAC 1-2)

Last Week – Lost to *Susquehanna University, 26-14. *Middle Atlantic Conference game

This Week – Sat., Sept. 27th vs. *Lebanon Valley College, 1:00 p.m. *MAC game

Moravian dropped it second straight game, falling to Susquehanna University, 26-14, in Middle Atlantic Conference action. The Greyhounds allowed the first 26 points of the game while committing four turnovers.

The Greyhounds broke up the shutout with 3:57 remaining in the fourth quarter when sophomore quarterback Jerry Venturino (Hopatcong, NJ/Hopatcong HS) found freshman wide receiver Shawn Martell (Bethlehem, PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS) on a 42-yard scoring strike. Senior Josh Miller (Boyertown, PA/Boyertown HS) connected on the extra-point to cut the Crusader lead to 26-7. The touchdown pass was the first in Venturino's career and capped a 95-yard scoring drive. Martell was Moravian's leading receiver in the game, catching three passes for 68 yards.

Venturino would throw his second touchdown pass with just 12 seconds remaining in the game, finding freshman wide receiver **Josh Kline** (**Reading, PA/Exeter HS**) for a four-yard score after avoiding a sack. **Miller** added the extra-point to set the final score at 26-14. **Venturino** was 11 for 24 in the game for 164 yards, two scores and an interception after coming in to replace senior starter **Will Seng** (**Allentown, PA/Dieruff HS**), who completed four of eight passes for 39 yards but was intercepted twice.

Freshman tailback **Chris Jacoubs** (**Fair Haven, NJ/Rumson-Fair Haven HS**) led the Moravian ground attack with 49 yards on nine carries while senior tailback **David Darmofal** (**Clarks Summit, PA/Abington Heights HS**) added 29 yards on 15 attempts. Senior wide receiver **Jeff Lowry** (**Catawissa, PA/Southern Columbia HS**) and senior fullback **Ray Burgan** (**Egg Harbor, NJ/Oakcrest HS**) each caught two passes for 22 yards. **Burgan** also gained six yards on two carries. Freshman running back **Marc Panepinto** (**Perkiomenville, PA/Boyertown HS**) ran for 17 yards on two carries while junior tailback **Cody Hendershot** (**Bangor, PA/Bangor HS**) added 16 yards on two carries.

Senior safety John Panikiewsky (Carteret, NJ/Carteret HS) led the Greyhound defense with 12 tackles while senior linebacker Steve Maslanek (Stockholm, NJ/Vernon Township HS) and sophomore linebacker Richie Cline (Union Beach, NJ/Keyport HS) each had six tackles with one for loss. Senior defensive lineman Justin Moyer (Allentown, PA/Salisbury HS) and junior defensive lineman Kevin McLaughlin (Philadelphia, PA/Northeast Catholic HS) each had sacks in the game.

Moravian opened its 2003 home season with a 6-0 non-conference victory over local rival DeSales University. The victory kept the Greyhounds unbeaten on the year. Moravian scored four first half goals to put the match away early. Sophomore midfielder Jessica Cordani (Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant Boro HS) scored a pair of goals and added two assists, while sophomore forward Megan Collins (Dover, DE/Caesar Rodney HS) had two goals and one assist. Junior forward Brianne DeVries (Stockton, NJ/Delaware Valley Regional HS) scored her third goal of the season, and it was her third game-winning goal of the year. DeVries also had two assists in the victory. Senior midfielder Justina Bria (Warminster, PA/William Tennent HS) scored her first goal of the year in the match while junior defender Kelly Haymaker (Hellertown, PA/Saucon Valley HS) had an assist. Junior goalie Jill Vaccaro (South Salem, NY/John Jay HS) played 69 minutes to pick-up her third victory of the year. Vaccaro made one save while senior goalie Kelly Wakeman (Easton, PA/Easton HS) did not need to make a save to complete the shutout, Moravian's fourth of the year. The Greyhounds had a 20-2 advantage in shots in the contest.

Senior outside hitter **Kim Zipf (Wyomissing, PA/Holy Name HS)** had 11 kills and 13 digs to lead Moravian to a 30-17, 30-24, 30-20 victory over Susquehanna University to open the 2003 Commonwealth Conference season for both squads. Senior setter **Amy Lawrence (Gettysburg, PA/Delone Catholic HS)** added 30 assists, ten digs and three service aces while senior middle hitter **Shannon McNeil (Reading, PA/Reading Central Catholic HS)** added five service aces, five digs and three kills. Sophomore middle hitter **Lindsey Siracusa (Yardley, PA/Pennsbury HS)** contributed eight kills, five blocks and a pair of service aces while junior outside hitter **Christina Wallace (Bethlehem, PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** had five kills, four digs and three service aces. Senior right side hitter **Mary Kate Cordisco (Bethlehem, PA/Notre Dame HS)** had five kills in the victory.

The Greyhounds earned a 30-24, 30-19, 30-16 sweep of DeSales University in non-conference action. **Siracusa** led Moravian with 11 kills and five blocks while **Wallace** added 11 kills, six digs and three service aces. **McNeil** added eight kills and four digs while **Lawrence** had 40 assists, seven digs and seven service aces. **Cordisco** contributed eight kills and four service aces while senior right side hitter **Sara Hollenbacher** (**Reading, PA/Reading Central Catholic HS**) had six kills. Senior libero **Alissa Bucsi** (**Bethlehem, PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS**) led Moravian with 10 digs.

Moravian captured its fourth straight match, defeating King's College, 30-23, 25-30, 30-16, 30-19, in non-conference action. **Zipf** had 20 kills and 18 digs to lead Moravian. **Siracusa** contributed 15 kills and eight digs in the victory while **Lawrence** (had 50 assists and ten digs. **McNeil** contributed eight kills, five service aces and three blocks while **Wallace** had six service aces, five kills and three blocks. **Hollenbacher** added four kills, eight digs and three blocks.

Freshman keeper **Kyle Keller** (**Coopersburg, PA/Southern Lehigh HS**) played the rest of the match for the Greyhounds, making one save.

Moravian won its second consecutive match by a 9-0 score and its fourth straight contest overall with a 9-0 victory at DeSales University in non-conference action. The Greyhounds jumped out to a 3-0 lead with three doubles victories with wins by the teams of junior Becky Deringer (Allentown, PA/Dieruff HS) and senior Lauren Castagna (Mt. Bethel, PA/Bangor HS), senior Marion Berry (Avon, NJ/St. Rose HS) and junior Jillian Iacovelli (Randolph, NJ/Randolph HS) and sophomores Sara Weller (Pennsburg, PA/Upper Perkiomen HS) and Rachel Vannatta (Gladstone, NJ/Bernards HS). The Greyhounds also won five singles matches with wins by Berry, Deringer, senior Petia Damianova (Haskovo, Bulgaria/ISM HS), and sophomores Nicole Gruber (Lebanon, PA/Lebanon HS) and Katie Cooke (Milford, PA/Delaware Valley HS). Castagna also earned a victory by default.

The Greyhounds captured their third consecutive victory by a 9-0 score with a 9-0 triumph at Widener University in Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth action. Moravian opened the match with doubles wins by the teams of **Deringer** and **Castagna**, **Berry** and **Iacovelli** and freshmen **Courtney Hall (Denver, PA/Cocalico HS)** and **Margo Kokolus (Orefield, PA/Parkland HS)**. The Greyhounds earned six straight sets singles wins from **Deringer**, **Castagna**, **Hall**, **Cooke**, **Gruber** and junior **Julie Anderson (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)**.

Moravian improved its winning streak to six straight victories with a 5-4 win at previously undefeated Susquehanna University in MAC Commonwealth action. The Greyhounds trailed 2-1 after the doubles competition with just a victory by the team of **Damianova** and **Cooke**. Moravian won the match with singles victories by **Damianova**, **Castagna**, **Anderson** and **Gruber**. The match came down to **Anderson's** three-set victory at sixth singles.

Moravian lost a tough 2-1, double-overtime match to Haverford College in non-conference action. The Greyhounds trailed 1-0 until freshman forward **Alyse Moyer** (**Hamburg, PA/Hamburg HS**) found the back of the net for her first career collegiate goal off a pass from senior midfielder **Pam Pike** (**Pennsburg, PA/Upper Perkiomen HS**) with 22:03 remaining in the second half. **Pike** had a chance to win the match for the Greyhounds early in the first overtime on a penalty stroke but the Haverford goalie made the save. Moravian freshman goalie **Amanda Gaun** (**Hatboro, PA/ Hatboro-Horsham HS**) made 11 saves in the contest.

The Greyhounds dropped their Commonwealth Conference opening match to defending Commonwealth Conference champion and national runner-up Messiah College, 9-0. Moravian had just one shot in the game with freshman forward **Elyse Jurgen (York, PA/Red Lion HS)** getting a shot just 45 seconds into the contest. **Gaun** made a school record 33 saves in the match as Messiah out shot Moravian, 54-1.
