Last Week – Defeated \*Lebanon Valley College, 42-7. \*Middle Atlantic Conference game

Sophomore quarterback **Jerry Venturino** (**Hopatcong, NJ/Hopatcong HS**) completed seven of 14 passes for 158 yards and two touchdowns in his first collegiate start and senior tailback **David Darmofal** (**Clarks Summit, PA/Abington Heights HS**) ran for 70 yards and two scores on 15 carries to lead Moravian team to a 42-7 victory over Lebanon Valley College in Middle Atlantic Conference action at Steel Field. The victory snaps a two-game losing streak for the Greyhounds and evens the team's record at 2-2 overall and in the MAC.

Moravian jumped out to a 7-0 lead with 12:33 to play in the first quarter. The Greyhounds received the opening kickoff but were forced to punt after three plays. However, Lebanon Valley fumbled the punt and Moravian freshman wide receiver **Shawn Martell (Bethlehem, PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** recovered the ball on the Lebanon Valley tenyard line. Two plays later, **Darmofal** scored Moravian's first rushing touchdown of the season on a six-yard run. Senior **Josh Miller (Boyertown, PA/Boyertown HS)** added his first of six extra-points in the game.

Lebanon Valley took the ensuing kickoff and needed just three plays to tie the game. The Greyhounds would score the game's next 35 points beginning with a 17-yard pass from **Venturino** to senior wide receiver **Jeff Lowry** (**Catawissa, PA/Southern Columbia HS**) with 9:38 left to play in the second quarter. The touchdown capped a nineplay, 93-yard drive and the scoring pass was the only pass thrown by **Venturino** on the drive. **Miller's** kick gave the Greyhounds a 14-7 lead. **Venturino** also ran for 28 yards on three carries while **Lowry** had two catches for 26 yards.

**Darmofal** would score his second touchdown of the game on a three-yard run to the right side with 2:26 remaining in the first half. That touchdown finished off a 10-play, 54-yard drive that was set up by a 21-yard punt return by senior wide receiver **Kevin Miltenberger** (Carlisle, PA/Carlisle HS).

The Greyhounds would add one more touchdown before halftime when **Venturino** hooked up with **Martell** on a 77-yard scoring strike with 57 seconds remaining in the second quarter. **Venturino** was nearly sacked on the play but found **Martell**, who had come back into open space. **Martell** made two Flying Dutchmen tacklers miss as he raced down the Lebanon Valley sideline. **Miller's** kick set the halftime score at 28-7, Moravian. The Greyhounds' leading receiver was junior tight end **Chad Opdyke** (**Bath, PA/Northampton HS**) who caught two passes for 38 yards.

The Greyhounds expanded their lead to 35-7 with 9:10 remaining in the third quarter when freshman running back **Chris Jacoubs** (**Fair Haven, NJ/Rumson-Fair Haven HS**) scored on a 19-yard run up the middle to cap a six-play, 61-yard drive. The possession was Moravian's first of the second half. **Jacoubs** finished with 61 yards on ten carries as the Greyhounds had 12 different players run the ball for 251 yards.

Lebanon Valley had a chance to score with 4:16 remaining in the third quarter but Moravian sophomore line-backer **Richie Cline** (**Union Beach, NJ/Keyport HS**) knifed through the right side of the line to block the kick.

Three minutes later, the two schools were pulled off the field when a severe thunderstorm with lightning moved into Bethlehem. On the first play after the delay, Moravian senior safety **John Panikiewsky** (**Carteret, NJ/Carteret HS**) intercepted a pass. Moravian finished off the scoring with 3:49 remaining in the game when freshman running back **Aaron Barnes** (**Media, PA/Penncrest HS**) scored from one-yard out on his first collegiate carry. The score capped just a four-play, 14-yard drive after sophomore wide receiver **John Miles** (**Warriors Mark, PA/Council Rock HS**) had a 38-yard punt return.

Cline led the Moravian defensive with ten tackles, including one for loss and a pass break-up. Freshman defensive back Israel Aguila (Bethlehem, PA/Freedom HS), senior defensive back Nate Pogue (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS) and senior linebacker Josh DiGiacomo (Zionsville, PA/Emmaus HS) each had six tackles in the game. Senior linebacker Steve Maslanek (Stockholm, NJ/Vernon Township HS) had the Greyhounds only sack in the game.

Moravian won its fifth consecutive contest and improved to 2-0 in the Commonwealth Conference with a 30-18, 30-27, 30-27 victory at Widener University in conference action. Senior outside hitter **Kim Zipf** (**Wyomissing**, **PA/Holy Name HS**) led the Greyhounds with 11 kills and 14 digs while senior setter **Amy Lawrence** (**Gettysburg**, **PA/Delone Catholic HS**) contributed 31 assists and 12 digs. Sophomore middle hitter **Lindsey Siracusa** (**Yardley**, **PA/Pennsbury HS**) had six kills and three blocks while senior middle hitter **Shannon McNeil** (**Reading**, **PA/Reading Central Catholic HS**) contributed seven kills, seven digs and three service aces. Junior outside hitter **Christina Wallace** (**Bethlehem**, **PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS**) had five kills and eight digs while senior right side hitter **Sara Hollenbacher** (**Reading**, **PA/Reading Central Catholic HS**) added four kills and four digs.

Moravian remained unbeaten this fall while playing its fourth overtime match in six contests as the Greyhounds earned a 3-2 overtime non-conference win at FDU-Florham on a goal by freshman midfielder **Kristina Adams** (**Belle Mead, NJ/Montgomery HS**) in the 97th minute. The Greyhounds fell behind 1-0 early in the match before tying the contest in the 33rd minute on a penalty kick by sophomore forward **Megan Collins** (**Dover, DE/Caesar Rodney HS**). FDU-Florham would take a 2-1 lead in the 57th minute but the Greyhounds tied the match again. Senior midfielder **Heather Bichler** (**Waverly, PA/Abington Heights HS**) knotted the score in the 65th minute off a pass from senior midfielder **Rachel Davy** (**Oaklyn, NJ/Haddon Township HS**). Moravian was out shot 16-12 in the match with junior goalie **Jill Vaccaro** (**South Salem, NY/John Jay HS**) making 12 saves.

The Greyhounds had their unbeaten streak stopped at six matches as Moravian fell to Messiah College, 3-0, to open the Commonwealth Conference season for both schools. The Falcons had a 28-3 advantage in shots over the Greyhounds and scored a pair of first half goals on the way to the victory. **Vaccaro** made 15 saves in the loss.

The Falcons had a 10-7 advantage in shots but Moravian senior goalie **Vinny Nasuta** (**Mount Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley Regional HS**) made five saves for his second shutout of the season.

The Greyhounds A team took first place with a team score of 308 and the Greyhound B squad was 11th of 19 schools with a total of 332 at the Annual Moravian Fall Invitational on the par 71 Southmoore Golf Course. Leading the Greyhounds individually was junior **Todd Solecitto (Washington, NJ/Warren Hills Regional HS)** with a round of 74, which tied him for fourth in the field of 95 golfers. Freshman **Brian Bergstol (Mt. Bethel, PA/Bangor HS)** and senior **Jamison Licausi (Tobyhanna, PA/Pocono Mountain HS)** tied for 12th with rounds of 77 while senior **Brian Kurylo (Sparta, NJ/Sparta HS)** tied for 21st with an 18-hole total of 80. Sophomore **Dustin McCormick (East Stroudsburg, PA/East Stroudsburg HS)** and freshman **Thad Miller (Emmaus, PA/Emmaus HS)** earned a tie for 28th place with rounds of 81 while freshman **Matt Tomasic (Berlin, NJ/St. Augustine Prep HS)** was tied for 34th with an 82. Sophomore **Elliot Joseph (Center Valley, PA/Parkland HS)** finished with an 84, which tied him for 55th place while sophomore **Larry Abrams (Tunkhannock, PA/Tunkhannock HS)** and **John Donofrio (Easton, PA/Easton HS)** tied for 61st with rounds of 85.

Moravian tied for second with Gettysburg College after posting a team score of 302 at the Susquehanna University Fall Invitational played at the Edgewood-in-the-Pines Golf Club. The host Crusaders won the event with a team score of 296. **Solecitto** led the Greyhounds with a round of 73 on the par 72 course, which tied him for fourth while **McCormick** and **Licausi** each had rounds of 76 to tie for 16<sup>th</sup> place. **Bergstol** was tied for 23<sup>rd</sup> after he fired a 77 while **Kurylo** had an 18-hole total of 78 to finish tied for 35<sup>th</sup> among the 95 golfers.

Moravian ran its winning streak to seven straight matches with a 6-3 non-conference win over rival Muhlenberg College. Moravian led 2-1 after doubles action with wins by the teams of senior Marion Berry (Avon, NJ/St. Rose HS) and junior Jillian Iacovelli (Randolph, NJ/Randolph HS) and junior Becky Deringer (Allentown, PA/Dieruff HS) and senior Lauren Castagna (Mt. Bethel, PA/Bangor HS). Moravian won four of the six singles matches with straight sets victories by Berry, Deringer, Castagna and senior Petia Damianova (Haskovo, Bulgaria/ISM HS).

The Greyhounds extended their winning streak to eight straight matches and moved closer to another Middle Atlantic Conference playoff berth with an 8-1 victory over Albright College in MAC Commonwealth action. The Greyhounds began the match by winning all three doubles matches with victories by the teams of **Berry** and **Iacovelli**, **Damianova** and sophomore **Nicole Gruber (Lebanon, PA/Lebanon HS)** and freshmen **Courtney Hall (Denver, PA/Cocalico HS)** and **Margo Kokolus (Orefield, PA/Parkland HS)**. Moravian earned wins at five of the six singles contests with **Gruber, Castagna** and **Deringer** earning straight set victories and junior **Julie Anderson (Bethlehem, PA/Liberty HS)** and sophomore **Katie Cooke (Milford, PA/Delaware Valley HS)** winning in pro-sets.

**Deringer** and **Castagna** each reached the quarterfinals of the B Draw Singles of the Intercollegiate Tennis Association Southeast Regional Tournament hosted by Mary Washington College while the Greyhounds' doubles tandem of **Berry** and **Iacovelli** made it to the quarterfinals in B Draw Doubles action.

The Greyhounds have a 15-13 advantage in shots with freshman goalie **Amanda Gaun (Hatboro, PA/Hatboro-Horsham HS**) making four saves for the first shutout of her collegiate career.

The Greyhounds dropped a 1-0 non-conference decision at Alvernia College. Moravian was out shot 11-3 in the contest while **Gaun** had six saves. Freshman defender **Kim Gialanella** (**Glenwood, NJ/Vernon Township HS**) also had a defensive save for the Greyhounds.
