Moravian suffered its first loss of the season, falling to local rival DeSales University, 78-56, in non-conference action. The Bulldogs were ranked nationally in several preseason polls. The Greyhounds fell behind after holding a 14-11 lead with 12:20 left in the first half and trailed 49-31 at halftime. Moravian shot just 40 percent (22 of 55) from the field and 58 percent (seven of 12) from the foul line while the Bulldogs connected on 51 percent of their shots (28 of 55) including eight three-pointers. DeSales also had a 47-22 advantage on the boards with a 24-4 advantage in rebounds at halftime. Junior forward **Brandon Zaleski (Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown HS)** led the Greyhounds with 12 points, and he added four rebounds. Sophomore forward **Ed Reid (Pen Argyl, PA/Pen Argyl HS)** netted a career high ten points for the Greyhounds with two blocked shots. Sophomore forward Steve **Wenderfer (Chester, NJ/Mendham HS)** also had career highs with nine points and seven rebounds in the contest. Senior guard **Steve Weiler (Edgewater Park, NJ/Burlington City HS)** tossed in seven points while senior guard **Lucas Malishchak (Wanamie, PA/Nanticoke HS)** and **Kevin Wyers (Hamilton Square, NJ/Notre Dame HS)** and junior forward **Mike Howell (Floral Park, NY/Holy Cross HS)** each had five points. **Weiler** added three steals while **Malishchak** had a team high five assists. Junior guard **Andy Fisher (Hatboro, PA/Hatboro-Horsham HS)** added three assists.

Moravian jumped out to an 11-8 lead over the first four minutes but DeSales University went on a 16-10 run to take the lead and slowly pull away to a 76-60 non-conference victory. The Bulldogs only led 34-32 at halftime but shot 43 percent from the floor (28-65) in the game while the Greyhounds only connected on 16 of 48 field goals (33.3 percent). Moravian sophomore forward **Stephanie Seaman (Bethlehem, PA/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** scored a game and career high 24 points and grabbed a career best 12 rebounds to lead the Greyhounds. Senior guard **Kim Hughes (Manasquan, NJ/St. Rose HS)** became the 15th player in Moravian to reach 1,000 career points on a free throw with 2:25 remaining in the game. **Hughes** finished the contest with 16 points, four rebounds and three three-pointers. Sophomore forward **Lindsay Brase (Bethlehem, PA/Notre Dame HS)** contributed six points on a pair of three-pointers, and she added four rebounds. Freshman forward **Kelly Applegate (Easton, PA/Wilson HS)** grabbed a career high ten rebounds to go with four points while freshman guard **Katie Rizman (Wall, NJ/St. Rose HS)** added five assists, four points and three steals. Freshman forward **Jenny Hackleman (Solvang, CA/Rutgers Prep {NJ} HS)** contributed four points and two rebounds while sophomore guard **Nicole Savino (Macungie, PA/Brandywine Heights HS)** had three rebounds and two points. Senior forward **Tracie Shipman (Philadelphia, PA/Archbishop Ryan HS)** had four rebounds in the game.
