Women's Basketball – 4-2 (1-2 MAC Commonwealth League, 2-2 MAC Overall)

The Lady Greyhounds split two games at the Next Level Desert Classic in Las Vegas, Nevada, as Moravian lost to Trinity (TX) University, 53-52, at the buzzer in the opening round and then defeated Eastern Connecticut State College in the consolation game, 61-50..

Senior Lynne Grzywacz (Blue Bell/Wissahickon HS) paced the Lady Greyhounds against Trinity with 15 points and eight rebounds. Classmate Cathy Huegler (Reading/Muhlenberg HS) had a career high 10 points off the bench on five of six shooting. She also grabbed six rebounds. Senior Stephanie Rickards (Lansdowne/Upper Darby HS) led Moravian with nine rebounds and had three steals before leaving the game in the second half with a concussion. The Lady 'Hounds led the contest, 33-18, at the half after shooting 44 percent and limiting Trinity to six field goals. It was the opposite in the second half as Moravian made just seven field goals and Trinity shot 50 percent.

In the second night of the tournament, Moravian faced Eastern Connecticut State for the third time in school history, however, this was the first regular season meeting between the schools. In 1991, the teams met in the round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament, an Eastern win, and in 1992, they played in the Final Four hosted by Moravian, a Greyhound win to advance to the national championship game. Moravian jumped out to a 32-23 half time lead in this year's game and never looked back. Grzywacz and junior **LaJona Johnson (Easton/Easton HS)** each had 12 points while Huegler and senior **Jessie Coughlin (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** scored nine points each. Coughlin hit two three-pointers in the first half to break the game open. She also had six assists and five steals while Huegler led the squad with eight rebounds.
