#### Women's Basketball – 9-3 (3-2 MAC Commonwealth League, 4-2 MAC Overall)

The Lady Greyhounds extended their winning streak to five games and have won eight of their last nine games with victories over Widener, 56-49, and Juniata, 66-61, in Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League action.

In the victory against Widener, senior forward **Jen Page** (**New Cumberland/Red Land HS**) had the best game of her career, scoring a career best 12 points and pulling down a career high 11 rebounds. Classmate **Lynne Grzywacz** (**Blue Bell/Wissahickon HS**) was the Lady Greyhounds leading scorer in the game with 13 points. Grzywacz, a forward, also added nine rebounds in the victory. Senior guard **Jessie Coughlin** (**Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS**) had five assists to lead Moravian while senior forward **Stephanie Rickards** (**Lansdowne/Upper Darby HS**) had two blocked shots.

Coughlin tied her season high with 21 points in the victory against Juniata. She made six of 21 three-point attempts in the contest, including two that beat the shot clock. Junior forward **LaJona Johnson (Easton/Easton HS)** added 14 points in the triumph on seven of nine shooting from the field. Senior guard **Gina Sebastionelli (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** added seven assists and eight points in the game including a five-for-six performance from the foul line. Grzywacz led the Lady Greyhounds in rebounding with seven boards. Senior center **Leahn Agnew (Lancaster/Conestoga Valley HS)** added five rebounds.

The Greyhounds had a three game winning streak snapped by Widener, 67-61, in the first Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League game of 1999 last Wednesday, but Moravian returned to its winning ways, defeating Juniata, 47-46, on Saturday. The Greyhounds are 4-1 in 1999.

Senior forward **Jason Moran** (**Scranton/West Scranton HS**) led four Greyhounds in double figures in the loss to Widener. He had 16 points and added 14 rebounds and three steals. Moran was a perfect 10-for-10 from the foul line as Moravian connected on 16 of 17 free throw attempts in the game. Senior guard **Matt Getter** (**Broomall/Marple Newtown HS**) and sophomore forward **David Jordan** (**Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant HS**) each scored 12 points in the game while senior forward **Jim Coyle** (**Center Valley/Southern Lehigh HS**) added 10 points. Coyle, Getter and sophomore forward **Chris Hayn** (**Whitehall/Whitehall HS**) each had five rebounds. Junior guard **Rich Whalen** (**East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS**) and Getter both had three assists in the contest.

Getter led the Greyhounds at Juniata with 18 points, all coming on three pointers. He made six of 16 three-point attempts in the game. Moran also scored in double figures with 11 points and led Moravian with seven rebounds and four blocked shots. Whalen was held without a point in the game but had team highs with four assists and three steals. Coyle also had three steals. Junior center **Jim O'Rourke (Park Ridge, NJ/Park Ridge HS)**, who had a career high four rebounds against Widener, set a new career best with six rebounds in the victory at Juniata. O'Rourke also made a career high two blocked shots. Hayn added seven points in the victory.

Senior center **Scott Reslow** (**East Greenwich, RI/East Greenwich HS**) missed both games last week and will miss probably miss the next two weeks with a fractured bone in his hand.
