Women's Basketball – 9-6 (3-4 MAC Commonwealth League, 4-4 MAC Overall)

The Lady Greyhounds suffered through a tough week in which they lost all three games to teams that have a combined 41-8 record. Moravian, which was ranked fifth in the first NCAA Division III Middle Atlantic Region poll of the year that was released last week, lost to NAIA power Holy Family, 61-45, Messiah College, the fourth ranked school in the region, 66-57, and Elizabethtown College, the second ranked school in the region, 75-59, last week.

One bright spot for the Lady 'Hounds last week was senior guard **Jessie Coughlin (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** becoming the 12th player in school history to score 1,000 points. She surpasses 1,000 points on a three-pointer with nine minutes remaining in the first half against Elizabethtown. Coughlin finished the game with 18 points. For the week, she averaged 12.3 points per game and added eight rebounds, five assists and five steals.

Senior forward **Lynne Grzywacz (Blue Bell/Wissahickon HS)** averaged 12.0 points per game last week for Moravian and had a team high 19 rebounds. Classmate **Stephanie Rickards (Lansdowne/Upper Darby HS)** also had 19 rebounds and contributed 10 points and three steals. Junior forward **LaJona Johnson (Easton/Easton HS)** scored 29 points and grabbed 16 rebounds during the week. Johnson had 18 points against Elizabethtown.

Senior forward **Jen Page (Red Land/New Cumberland HS)** tied her own career highs with 12 points and 11 rebounds in the loss at Messiah. She finished the week with 20 points and 17 rebounds. Senior guard **Gina Sebastianelli (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** dished out 13 assists last week and added 10 points including an eight for nine performance from the foul line during the week.

The Greyhounds ended the week with a thrilling 89-72 victory over Elizabethtown College after losing their first two games last week to Messiah College, 78-77 in overtime, and Drew University, 62-50. In the victory against the Blue Jays, Moravian led by as many as 16 points early in the second half, but Elizabethtown went on a run and took a 56-55 lead with 11 and a half minutes to play. The Greyhounds responded with a 33-16 spurt to end the game and earn their second Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League victory of the season.

Leading the charge against Elizabethtown was senior guard **Matt Getter (Broomall/Marple Newtown HS)**, who scored a career high 36 points including a school record nine three-pointers. For the week, Getter made 23 of 46 field goal attempts, 16 of 34 three-pointers and five of 11 free throws to score 67 points in three games. Getter had six steals, a career best, against both Drew and Elizabethtown. He finished the week with 14 steals, eight rebounds and three blocked shots.

Senior forward **Jason Moran (Scranton/West Scranton HS)** returned to his scoring form from a year ago with an average of 20.7 points per game this week. He netted 24 points, including 20 in the second half, and grabbed 11 rebounds in the loss at Messiah. Moran made 11 of 13 field goal attempts against Elizabethtown and finished the game with 23 points. For the week, Moran scored 62 points, grabbed 26 rebounds and had seven assists.

Sophomore guard **David Jordan (Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant HS)** also averaged in double figures last week at 13.3 points per contest. Jordan connected on eight three-point attempts. Junior guards **Rich Whalen (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS)** and **Justin Potts (Sparta, NJ/Sparta HS)** each had 10 assists last week while splitting time at the point guard position. The duo also combined for 15 points, 10 steals and five rebounds during the three games.

Junior center **Jim O'Rourke (Park Ridge, NJ/Park Ridge HS)** started two games last week and was the Greyhounds' second leading rebounder with 12 boards in three games. O'Rourke also scored nine points. Sophomore forward **Chris Hayn (Whitehall/Whitehall HS)** also started once last week and had four points and four assists. Senior forward **Russ Lowe (Reading/Antietam HS)** contributed 13 points and eight rebounds off the bench for the Greyhounds.
