Women's Basketball – 9-8 (3-6 MAC Commonwealth League, 4-6 MAC Overall)

The Lady Greyhounds had their chance at a 17th straight appearance in the Middle Atlantic Conference playoffs narrowed with a pair of losses last week in MAC Commonwealth League action. The Lady Greyhounds fell to Susquehanna University, 80-77 in overtime, and Lebanon Valley 69-59.

Senior guard **Jessie Coughlin (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** paced Moravian in scoring last week with 17 points, including five three-pointers, in the loss to Susquehanna and 15 points against Lebanon Valley. She was the team's top scorer in both games and had ten steals during the week to move within one steal of becoming just the second player in Lady Greyhound history with 1,000 points, 300 assists and 300 steals. Classmate **Gina Sebastianelli (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** scored 21 points and 11 assists last week including a 10 for 12 performance from the foul line.

Junior forward **LaJona Johnson (Easton/Easton HS)** scored 19 points last week with 12 coming against Susquehanna. Senior forward **Stephanie Rickards (Lansdowne/Upper Darby HS)** had her first career double-double against Lebanon Valley with ten points and ten rebounds in just 14 minutes of action. She finished the week with 16 points and 15 rebounds, 10 of them on the offensive end of the court.

Senior center **Leahn Agnew (Lancaster/Conestoga Valley HS)** made her first two starts of the season last week, contributing eight points and eight rebounds. Classmate **Lynne Grzywacz (Blue Bell/Wissahickon HS)** had 15 points and 13 rebounds during the week.

At the Haverford College Invitational on January 23rd, four different Lady Greyhounds won their event. Freshman **Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS)** was first in the 1,500-meters in a time of 4:48.8 while classmate **Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS)** captured the 5,000-meters with a time of 18:45.1. Shertzer won her race by 38 seconds. Sophomore **Brooke Dancho (Bethlehem/Freedom HS)** leaped 15 feet, three inches to win the long jump while junior **Eric Landes (Reading/Muhlenburg HS)** cleared five feet, two inches to capture the high jump. Dancho was also third in the triple jump with a distance of 31 feet, two inches.

Freshman **Steph Horne (Sinking Spring/Wilson West Lawn HS)** was fourth in the 55 meters in 7.9 seconds while senior **Kristie Reccek (Hellertown/Wilson HS)** placed sixth in the 1,500 meters with a time of 4:59.0. Horne was also sixth in the 55-meter hurdles in 9.2 seconds. Freshman **Kay Horstmann-Panke (Scotia, NY/Scotia-Glenville HS)** was second in the long jump with a leap of 14 feet, one and $\frac{3}{4}$ inches and fourth in the triple jump at 31 feet one and a half inches. Sophomore **Leah Williams (Andreas/Tamaqua HS)** was fifth in both the long jump and the triple jump with distances of 13 feet, five and a half inches and 29 feet, nine inches, respectively.

The Lady Greyhounds 4x400 meter relay team of Dancho, Wolfsberger, sophomore **Hannah Wood (Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS)** and freshman **Jen Burkholder (Chalfont/Gwynedd Mercy)** placed second with a time of 4:27.5.

The Greyhounds split a pair of Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League games last week, defeating Susquehanna, 82-73, and losing to Lebanon Valley, 74-59. Moravian now stands at 3-6 in the MAC Commonwealth League with five games to play.

Senior forward **Jason Moran (Scranton/West Scranton HS)** scored 41 points last week and needs just two more points to become the fifth player in Moravian history to score 1,400 points in a career. With five more points, Moran will pass **Bob Jones '57** for fourth on the all-time scoring list. Moran also grabbed 13 rebounds last week to give him 729 in his career, third in school history. Senior guard **Matt Getter (Broomall/Marple Newtown HS)** scored 31 points last week with seven three-pointers to pull him within three three-pointers of tying **Derek Wright's '96** school-record of 130 three-pointers for a career. Getter also had nine steals last week with six against Susquehanna.

Junior center **Jim O'Rourke (Park Ridge, NJ/Park Ridge HS)** scored back-to-back career highs last week with 12 points against Susquehanna and 14 points against Lebanon Valley. O'Rourke was 10 of 14 from the field including a six-for-six performance in the first half at Lebanon Valley. He also had 12 rebounds during the week. Sophomore guard **David Jordan (Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant HS)** tossed in 16 points and grabbed 12 rebounds last week while junior guard **Rich Whalen (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS)** added 12 points and 11 assists. Senior forward **Russ Lowe (Reading/Antietam HS)** added 11 points and six rebounds off the bench.

Sophomore **Anthony Rediger (Sellersville/Pennridge HS)** had the Greyhounds top finish at the Haverford Invitational on January 23rd with a second place in the triple jump on a try of 41 feet four and $\frac{3}{4}$ inches. Rediger also placed sixth in the long jump at 19 feet, three and a half inches.

Senior **Jeff Minnich (Lehigh/Palmerton Area HS)** and freshman **Josh Heebner (Lansdale/North Penn HS)** each captured sixth place finishes in their events. Minnich ran a 15:55.7 in the 5,000 meters while Heebner had a 1:59.7 in the 800 meters. Senior **Jeremy Schoenberger (Lehigh/Palmerton Area HS)** tied for sixth in the 55 meters with a time of 6.7 seconds.

The men's 4x400 meter relay team of Heebner, junior **Tim Pfluger (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS)** and freshmen **Kevin Bush (Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS)** and **Scott Heydt (Boyertown/Boyertown HS)** placed third with a time of 3:32.9.
