## Women's Basketball – 10-9 (4-6 MAC Commonwealth League, 5-7 MAC Overall)

The Lady Greyhounds split a pair of games last week, defeating Albright College, 56-50, in Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League action and losing to Wilkes University, 60-56, in MAC non-league action. Moravian must win its last four games in MAC Commonwealth League action to earn a trip to the MAC playoffs for the 17<sup>th</sup> straight season.

Senior guard **Jessie Coughlin (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** led Moravian in scoring last week with 23 points. She also had 10 rebounds, seven assists and five steals during the week. Coughlin had three steals against Albright to join **Sue Zimmerman '95** as the only two players in school history with 1,000 points, 300 assists and 300 steals.

Senior forward **Lynne Grzywacz** (**Blue Bell/Wissahickon HS**) scored 21 points last week and was Moravian's top rebounder with 16 boards. Classmate **Jen Page** (**New Cumberland/Red Land HS**) added 18 points and 14 rebounds during the week including a career best performance of 14 points and 12 rebounds against Albright. Seniors **Stephanie Rickards** (**Lansdowne/Upper Darby HS**) and **Leahn Agnew** (**Lancaster/Conestoga Valley HS**) each scored 14 points last week with Agnew leading the Lady Greyhounds with five blocked shots.

At the Delaware Invitational, freshman **Emily Shertzer** (**Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS**) and **Heidi Wolfsberger** (**Moosic/Riverside HS**) paced the Lady Greyhounds with top five finishes. Shertzer was second in the 5,000 meters in 18:43.70 while Wolfsberger placed third in the mile with a time of 5:14.85.

Senior Amy Cavanaugh (Horseheads, NY/Horseheads HS) was sixth in the 5,000 meters in 19:36.27. Five Lady Greyhounds competed in the mile in addition to Wolfsberger with senior Kristie Reccek (Hellertown/ Wilson HS) in sixth at 5:17.97. Freshman Kim Jaick (Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS) finished 18<sup>th</sup> with a time of 5:27.26 while sophomore Hannah Wood (Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS) was 30<sup>th</sup> in 5:37.06. Junior Maria Grabowski (Churchville/Villa Joseph Marie) was 40<sup>th</sup> in 5:47.94 in the mile while freshman Erin Boyle (Philadelphia/Nazareth Academy) placed 44<sup>th</sup> in 5:55.54.

Other results from the Delaware Invitational included freshman **Sara Shaneberger (Bethlehem/Southern Lehigh HS)** 16<sup>th</sup> in the shot put with a distance of 35 feet, two and a half inches and sophomore **Brooke Dancho (Bethlehem/Freedom HS)** at 19<sup>th</sup> in the long jump at 15 feet, 11 ¾ inches. Jaick placed 12<sup>th</sup> in the 3,000 meters in 11:07.02. Two of Moravian's relay teams finished in the top ten against mostly NCAA Division I and II competition. The 4x800 meter relay was fifth in 9:44.81 while the distance was 7<sup>th</sup> in 12:40.87.

The Greyhounds split a pair of Middle Atlantic Conference games last week, defeating nationally ranked Wilkes University, 71-65, in non-league action but falling out of the MAC playoff race with a 66-59 loss to Albright in MAC Commonwealth League play. Wilkes entered the game ranked 19<sup>th</sup> in the nation but the Greyhounds jumped out to a 12-0 lead and held the Colonels scoreless for the first 6:19 of the game.

Senior guard **Matt Getter (Broomall/Marple Newtown HS)** became the Greyhounds all-time leader in three-pointers last week with six. Getter now has 133 treys in his career, surpassing **Derek Wright's '96** record of 130. Getter led the Greyhounds in scoring last week with 35 points and added seven rebounds, five steals and four assists. He now has 61 three-pointers this season, just one shy of his school record set last season. Senior forward **Jason Moran (Scranton/West Scranton HS)** scored 34 points last week and topped Moravian with 13 rebounds.

Junior forward **Jim O'Rourke** (**Park Ridge, NJ/Park Ridge HS**) scored 14 points, all against Wilkes, and contributed ten rebounds and a team high four blocked shots during the week. Sophomore **David Jordan** (**Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant HS**) also scored 14 points last week. Junior guard **Rich Whalen** (**East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS**) and senior forward **Russ Lowe** (**Reading/Antietam HS**) each scored 11 points during the week while Lowe grabbed 12 rebounds.

Three other Greyhounds competed in the mile. Sophomore **Damon Rutherford** (**Reading/Exeter HS**) was first in his heat and 41<sup>st</sup> overall with a time of 4:41.15. Freshman **Tim McDade** (**Bechtelsville/Boyertown HS**) and senior **Nick Murphy** (**South Kent, CT/South Kent School**) were in the same heat as Rutherford and placed 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> in the heat with times of 4:41.15 and 4:43.28 respectively.

Senior **Jeff Minnich** (**Lehighton/Palmerton Area HS**) was seventh in the 5,000 meters in 15:34.20. Classmate **Tyler McClimon** (**Birdsboro/Daniel Boone HS**) finished 18<sup>th</sup> in the 5,000 meters with a time of 16:57.18. Sophomore **Anthony Rediger** (**Sellersville/Pennridge HS**) placed 12<sup>th</sup> in the triple jump with a distance of 41 feet, seven and a quarter inches.

The Greyhounds two relay teams ran well against mostly NCAA Division I and II competition. The distance medley relay team placed  $10^{th}$  overall and first in its heat with a time of 10:30.53 while the 4x800 meter relay squad was  $11^{th}$  in 8:14.19.
