**Women's Basketball – 13-9 (6-6 MAC Commonwealth League, 7-7 MAC Overall)**

The Lady Greyhounds kept their Middle Atlantic Conference playoff hopes alive with a pair of victories in MAC Commonwealth League action last week. Moravian defeated Widener University in Chester, 81-77, and came from behind to defeat Juniata College, 59-48, at home. The Lady 'Hounds also traveled to Collegeville and defeated Ursinus College, 68-57, last Thursday.

Senior guard **Jessie Coughlin (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** paced Moravian in scoring last week with 43 points in the three victories. Coughlin netted 20 points at Widener including making six three-pointers for the second time this season. She also contributed 15 rebounds, 14 assists and five steals during the week. Coughlin moved into seventh on the all-time scoring list with 15 points against Juniata and now has 1,115 points with two games to play. She is also ranked second in career assists with 342 and second in career steals with 308.

Senior forward **Lynne Grzywacz (Blue Bell/Wissahickon HS)** averaged 13.3 points per game last week. She scored seven points in the final four minutes in the victory against Juniata to help the Lady Greyhounds to the victory. Grzywacz also grabbed 15 rebounds last week. Classmate **Stephanie Rickards (Lansdowne/Upper Darby HS)** was Moravian's leading rebounder with 19 boards in three games and she also scored 29 points with 15 against Ursinus, tying her career high.

Senior center **Leahn Agnew (Lancaster/Conestoga Valley HS)** has returned to the starting line-up and scored 22 points and grabbed 10 rebounds while classmate forward **Jen Page (New Cumberland/Red Land HS)** has been inserted into the starting line-up and responded with 18 rebounds and 16 points in three games. Senior guard **Gina Sebastianelli (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** scored 15 points and dished out 15 assists last week while junior forward **LaJona Johnson (Easton/Easton HS)** scored 17 points and had nine rebounds.

Seniors forward **Cathy Huegler (Reading/Muhlenburg HS)** and guard **Susan DeJong (Allentown/Salisbury HS)**, junior guard **Jen Polaha (West Lawn/Holy Name HS)** and sophomore guard **Jill Kenny (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS)** all saw action in each game last week.

At the Robert Kane Invitational hosted by Cornell University this past Saturday, the Lady Greyhounds top individual finisher was freshman **Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS)** with a third place in the mile. Wolfsberger had a time of 5:09.76.

Moravian's only other top three finish at the non-scoring team meet was by the 4x800-meter relay squad of Wolfsberger, senior **Kristie Reccek (Hellertown/Wilson HS)**, sophomore **Hannah Wood (Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS)** and freshman **Erin Boyle (Philadelphia/Nazareth Academy)** with a second place showing in a time of 9:51.23. No other results were available at press time.

The Greyhounds saw their chances of a Middle Atlantic Conference playoff berth slip away in an 83-63 loss at Widener last Monday. In Moravian's only other action last week, the 'Hounds defeated Juniata, 76-57, to give themselves a chance to finish the season at 12-12 with two wins in the final week of the season.

Senior forward **Jason Moran (Scranton/West Scranton HS)** scored 36 points and grabbed 22 rebounds last week including a 24 point, 14 rebound performance in the victory against Juniata. Moran also had five assists and five blocked shots in the two games.

Senior guard **Matt Getter (Broomall/Marple Newtown HS)** netted 35 points last week including seven three-pointers to lift his school career record to 140 with two games to play. Getter connected on four three-pointers against Widener as part of his 22-point effort to surpass his own school record for threes in a single season. He currently has 68 three-pointers during the 1998-99 season.

Junior guard **Rich Whalen (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS)** scored 24 points in two games and dished out a team high 10 assists for the Greyhounds while senior forward **Russ Lowe (Reading/Antietam HS)** has 13 points and six rebounds in two starts. Sophomore guard **David Jordan (Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant HS)** has 12 points and six rebounds in two contests while junior center **Jim O'Rourke (Park Ridge, NJ/Park Ridge HS)** had nine points and seven boards during the week. O'Rourke connected on all three of his field goal attempts in the victory against Juniata.

Sophomore forward **Chris Hayn (Whitehall/Whitehall HS)**, junior guard **Justin Potts (Sparta, NJ/Sparta HS)** and freshman forward **Doug Spadt (Emmaus/Emmaus HS)** saw action in both games last week.

Junior **Tim Pfluger (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS)** and senior **Jeff Minnich (Lehighton/Palmerton Area HS)** each captured first place finishes in their events to lead the Greyhounds at the Robert Kane Invitational hosted by Cornell University on Saturday. There were no team scores kept at the meet.

Pfluger captured the mile race in a time of 4:23.67. It was his second win in the mile this winter. Minnich won the 3,000-meter run in a time of 9:01.15. These were the only two Moravian men's results available at press time.
