The Lady Greyhounds freshman **Heidi Wolfsberger** (**Moosic/Riverside HS**) is in the top 25 in the nation in two events headed into this weekend's national championship meet at Northern Ohio. Wolfsberger is 11<sup>th</sup> in the mile run with a time of 5:09.76 and she is 22<sup>nd</sup> in the 1,500 meters in 4:45.3. Senior **Kristie Reccek** (**Hellertown/Wilson HS**) is also ranked in the same events. She is 14<sup>th</sup> in the mile with a time of 5:10.89 and 26<sup>th</sup> in the 1,500 meters in 4:45.9.

Junior **Tim Pfluger** (**Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS**) set a new school record in the 1,500 meters in a last chance qualifier at Haverford College last Wednesday evening. He led the race wire to wire and set the school mark with a time of 3:58.3. Teammate **Scott Heydt** (**Boyertown/Boyertown HS**), a freshman was just one second behind Pfluger in the race. Pfluger's record was nearly a full second faster than the old record set by All-American **Charlie Hoch** in 1989. However, Pfluger's time missed qualifying for the NCAA Championships by 26 one-hundredths of a second.

Earlier in the season, Pfluger set school records in the indoor mile (4:20.8) and the rarely run two-mile race (9:43.5). He also teamed with Heydt, **Kevin Bush (Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS)** and **Josh Heebner** (**Lansdale/North Penn HS**) for an indoor school record in the distance medley relay last month at Delaware, as the quartet ran 10:30 to finish first in their heat.

Senior Scott Fritz (Barnesville/Mahoney Area HS) paced the Greyhounds at the plate with three hits in six at-bats, all singles. Sophomore Joe Pochron (Allentown/Salisbury HS) also had three hits and drove in a pair of runs. Juniors Chip Foley (Quakertown/Quakertown HS) and Jarrett Hughes (Bangor/Bangor HS) and sophomore Shawn Brown (Quakertown/Quakertown HS) each had two hits in the game. Foley had a double with three RBI while Brown had two RBI. Fritz, Hughes, Brown and senior Al Varano (Coal Township/Shamokin HS) each scored two runs in the game.

Junior Mark Slavin (Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS) started the game on the mound and gave up seven hits and six earned runs in six innings. He also had one walk and four strikeouts. Junior David Jelleme (Pequannock, NJ/Pequannock HS) threw one inning and classmate Matt Seitzinger (Scranton/Scranton Prep HS) was on the mound when the winning run scored.
