The Lady Greyhounds opened their 1999 season with four straight victories in the Virginia Wesleyan College Lady Marlin Tournament before falling to Salisbury State University, 3-2 in 10 innings, in the championship semifinals. The Seagulls were one of the eight teams that competed in the NCAA Division III World Series last year.

Even though Moravian has played just five games, the Lady Greyhounds have already played two of the top teams in Division III. Moravian, which is ranked third in the East Region poll, defeated North Carolina Wesleyan, 2-1 in eight innings at the tournament. North Carolina Wesleyan is second in the East Region. Salisbury State, which knocked Moravian out of the Virginia Wesleyan Tournament, is ranked first in the Atlantic Region.

Pitching was the key at the tournament for Moravian, which allowed just five runs in 39 innings. Junior **Becky Stroup (Palmerton/Palmerton Area HS)** led Moravian with a 2-0 record and gave up just one run in 15 innings of work. She also had seven strikeouts. Sophomore **Meg Ryan (Edison, NJ/Edison HS)** gave up just one run in seven innings with three strikeouts and no walks for a victory. Freshman **Rachel Mowrey (Hellertown/Saucon Valley HS)** had a 1-1 record, allowing just three runs in 16 innings. She also had a team high eight strikeouts and allowed just one walk. Moravian also turned in an outstanding tournament in the field, committing just three errors in 39 innings.

At the plate, sophomore **Missy Hummel (Walnutport/Northampton HS)** leads the squad with a .471 batting average on eight hits in 17 at-bats. She also has two runs batted in. Junior **Zan Azzolino (Lodi, NJ/Immaculate Heart Academy)** has five hits in 14 at-bats. She has scored four runs and has one RBI on a bases-loaded, two-out suicide squeeze bunt against North Carolina Wesleyan to win the game. Ryan also has five hits in 14 at-bats and two RBI while Stroup has three hits in five at-bats and has scored three runs. Senior **Heather Bennett (Franklin, NJ/Wallkill Valley HS)** had four hits and scored four runs.

The Greyhounds completed their 1999 West Coast road trip on a disappointing note, losing their final three games. Moravian returns home with a 2-4-1 record.

Sophomore **Joe Pochron (Allentown/Salisbury HS)** had 13 hits in 29 at-bats to lead the Greyhounds at the plate. He also had a pair of homeruns and 12 RBI in the seven games. Pochron hit a three-run homerun against Claremont Mudd-Scripps to help the Greyhounds come back from a 12-5 deficit to tie the game 13-13. Junior **Chip Foley (Quakertown/ Quakertown HS)** had the best hitting performance out West with 14 hits in 27 at-bats.

Freshman pitcher **Randy Woolley (Manahawkin, NJ/Southern Regional HS)** had seven strikeouts and just one walk in his first collegiate appearance against Cal. Tech. Woolley pitched the first six innings and left with the game tied. Junior **David Jelleme (Pequannock, NJ/Pequannock HS)** finished the game for the victory. Senior **Scott Bolasky (Germansville/Northwestern Lehigh HS)** pitched 8 and 2/3 innings in the win over Redlands with four strikeouts. Junior **Matt Seitzinger (Scranton/Scranton Prep)** picked up the save in the game.
