The Lady Greyhounds posted a 3-2 record at the Salisbury State University Sea Gull Invitational this past weekend to improve their overall record to 7-3 on the season. Moravian won a pair of games in its final atbat, defeating Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League rival Susquehanna University, 2-1 on a pair of bases loaded walks in the seventh inning, and defeating Chowan College, 8-7 on a four run seventh inning capped by RBI singles by freshman **Stacy Matuczinski** (**Bethlehem/Liberty HS**) and junior **Zan Azzolino** (**Lodi, NJ/Immaculate Heart Academy**). The Lady Greyhounds also defeated Western Maryland College, the school that knocked Moravian from the NCAA Division III Tournament last spring, 4-0. Moravian's losses at the tournament were to Chowan, 3-2, and Salisbury State, 6-3. The Greyhounds have lost to Salisbury State, a NCAA Division III World Series participant last season, twice this year.

Sophomore **Missy Hummel (Walnutport/Northampton HS)** lead Moravian at the Salisbury State Invitational with a .529 batting average on nine hits in 17 at-bats. She also reached base a total of 12 times in 20 plate appearances. Junior **Ali Harteveld (Lodi, NJ/Immaculate Heart Academy)** hit .500 in the five games with eight hits in 16 at-bats. Matuczinski collected four hits in nine at-bats and also drove in four runs while Azzolino went six for 16 at the plate with three RBI. Harteveld knocked in three runs as did freshman **Sarah Leiby (Fleetwood/Fleetwood HS)**. Leiby was four of 11 in five games.

Freshman Rachel Mowrey (Hellertown/Saucon Valley HS) picked up a pair of victories on the mound. She allowed just two earned runs in 14 innings of work and had four strikeouts. Junior Becky Stroup (Palmerton/Palmerton Area HS) had a 1-1 record over the weekend. She had nine strikeouts in 13 innings and allowed just four earned runs. Sophomore Meg Ryan (Edison, NJ/Edison HS) lost her only outing, giving up three earned runs in six innings with three strikeouts.

The Greyhounds posted a 2-1 mark in their first games in Pennsylvania after a 2-4-1 road trip to California to open the season. The Greyhounds posted a 13-5 victory over Alvernia in non-conference action last Thursday. Moravian then split a doubleheader in Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League action with Elizabethtown College, losing the first game, 3-1, and winning the second contest, 4-3.

In the victory against Alvernia, junior **Jarrett Hughes** (**Bangor/Bangor Area HS**) was two for four with two RBI, three runs scored and a stolen base. Sophomore **Joe Pochron** (**Allentown/Salisbury HS**) went three for three in the contest with a double, two RBI and a run scored while freshman **Michael Abbate** (**South Plainfield, NJ/Bishop Ahr HS**) collected two hits in three at-bats with three runs scored, two stolen bases and a pair of walks. Freshman **Randall Woolley** (**Manahawkin, NJ/Southern Regional HS**) picked up the victory on the mound for the Greyhounds.

Hughes hit a RBI double in the first inning of the first game at Elizabethtown to score Moravian's only run of the contest. He was two for three in the game. Freshman Henry Reifsnyder (Upper Black Eddy/Palisades HS) had Moravian's only other hit in the contest.
