Softball – 9-5 (0-0 MAC Commonwealth League, 0-0 MAC Overall)

Last Week – Defeated Muhlenberg, 6-4 & 3-0; Lost to The College of New Jersey, 8-0; Lost to Mary Washington, 3-0.

The Lady Greyhounds split four games last week, sweeping a doubleheader from rival Muhlenberg College, 6-4 and 3-0, and losing two games at The College of New Jersey Round Robin Tournament to The College of New Jersey, 8-0, and Mary Washington College, 3-0. Moravian opens its 1999 Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League season this week.

In the victories over Muhlenberg, junior **Becky Stroup (Palmerton/Palmerton Area HS)** and freshman **Rachel Mowrey (Hellertown/Saucon Valley HS)** earned the wins on the mound. Stroup had three strikeouts and one walk in the first contest while Mowrey hurled a three-hit shutout in the second game with one strikeout.

At the plate, junior **Krysten Mack (Canton, CT/Canton HS)** was two for three with a triple and two runs scored. Freshman **Laurie Rentschler (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS)** was one for two with a two-RBI single. Senior **Heather Bennett (Franklin, NJ/Wallkill Valley HS)**, junior **Ali Harteveld (Lodi, NJ/Immaculate Heart Academy)** and freshmen **Summer Miller (Mt. Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley HS)** and **Jamie Place (Newton, NJ/Kittatinny HS)** all had RBI singles. In the second game, sophomore **Meg Ryan (Edison, NJ/Edison HS)** was two for three with a triple.

In the tournament at The College of New Jersey, the Lady Greyhounds were shutout for the first time this season. Stroup suffered the loss against the host Lions while Ryan took the loss against Mary Washington. Bennett and Harteveld had Moravian's only hits against The College of New Jersey while Bennett, juniors **Zan Azzolino (Lodi, NJ/Immaculate Heart Academy)** and **Marcia Zangrilli (Douglasville/Daniel Boone HS)** and freshman **Sarah Leiby (Fleetwood/Fleetwood HS)** each had singles in the second game.

Of the 19 events held at the Allentown Invitational this past Saturday, the Lady Greyhounds captured first place in 15 of them. Freshman **Sarah Shaneberger (Bethlehem/Southern Lehigh HS)** won both the hammer throw with a distance of 119 feet, 9 ½ inches and the shot put with a distance of 37 feet, six inches. Classmate **Steph Horne (Sinking Spring/Wilson West Lawn HS)** also won a pair of events, the 100-meter hurdles in 16.5 seconds and the 400 meter intermediate hurdles with a time of 1:13.3.

Other first place finishers were: freshman **Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS)** in the 10,000 meters in 40:22.9, sophomore **Brooke Dancho (Bethlehem/Freedom HS)** in the long jump at 16 feet, four inches, sophomore **Hannah Wood (Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS)** in the 3,000 meters with a time of 11:16.1, freshman **Jen Lohn (Media/Penncrest HS)** won the javelin with a distance of 126 feet, six inches, freshman **Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS)** the 1,500 meters in 4:53.3, sophomore **Denele Brozino (Lehigh/Lighton HS)** in the 100 meters in 12.7 seconds, senior **Kristie Reccek (Hellertown/Wilson HS)** in the 800 meters in 2:20.6, freshman **Melissa Webber (Barnegat, NJ/Monsignor Donovan HS)** in the discus with a distance of 113 feet even, and freshman **Kim Jaick (Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS)** in the 5,000 meters in 19:09.7.

Freshman **Carrie McCaffery (Lebanon/Annville-Cleona HS)** placed second in both the shot put with a distance of 31 feet, six ¼ inches and the discus at a length of 107 feet, nine inches.

The Lady Greyhounds 4x100 meter relay team also captured first place in a time of 52.9 seconds while the 4x400 meter relay teams were second and fourth.

The Greyhounds split four games last week, losing non-conference games to NCAA Division II Kutztown University, 7-1, and Ursinus College, 4-3, and defeating Lebanon Valley College, 3-0 & 8-4 in Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League action.

In the loss to Kutztown, senior **Scott Fritz (Barnesville/Mahoney Area HS)** and sophomores **Mike Gill (Lebanon, NJ/North Hunterdon HS)** and **Dustin Levy (Vineland, NJ/Vineland HS)** each had a hit for Moravian. Sophomore **Joe Pochron (Allentown/Salisbury HS)** suffered the loss on the mound. In the game at Ursinus, Pochron, junior **Jarrett Hughes (Bangor/Bangor Area HS)** and freshmen **Michael Abbate (South Plainfield/Bishop Ahr HS)** and **Henry Reifsnnyder (Upper Black Eddy/Palisades HS)** each had hits in the game. Freshman **Randy Woolley (Manahawkin, NJ/Southern Regional HS)** took the loss on the mound.

In the doubleheader with Lebanon Valley, the Greyhounds used strong pitching performances by senior **Scott Bolasky (Germansville/Northwestern Lehigh HS)** and junior **Mark Slavin (Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS)** to earn the victories. Bolasky hurled a two-hit shutout in the first contest and struck out a season high nine batters while allowing just one walk. Fritz and junior **Chip Foley (Quakertown/Quakertown HS)** were each two for four in the contest with RBI doubles while Gill was two for three in the game. In game two, Slavin allowed four runs on four hits with seven walks and seven strikeouts for his second win of the season. Abbate went three for five in the game with three runs scored and a RBI. Fritz was two for four in the contest with a RBI and two runs scored while Pochron was two for three in the game. Hughes knocked in the winning run with a two-RBI single in the second inning and Foley added a two-RBI single in the fourth inning.

Other Moravian winners were junior **Dylan Coia (Glen Rock, NJ/Notre Dame HS)** in the 3,000-meter steeplechase in a time of 10:18.2, junior **Dan Oliynik (Dover, NJ/Morris Knolls HS)** in the 110-meter hurdles in a time of 15.4 seconds, sophomore **Bill Schmidt (basking Ridge, NJ/Ridge HS)** in the shot put with a throw of 42 feet, 9 ½ inches, freshman **Kevin Bush (Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS)** in the 200 meters in 22.3 seconds and junior **Tim Pfluger (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS)** in the 5,000 meters in 15:30.3.
