Moravian split a MAC Commonwealth League doubleheader with Elizabethtown College and dropped a pair of games to nationally ranked Messiah College in MAC Commonwealth League action.

Sophomore **Missy Hummel (Walnutport/Northampton HS)** led Moravian in hitting last week with 14 hits in 28 at-bats for a .500 batting average. She added nine runs scored, four RBIs and three stolen bases during the week. Classmate **Meg Ryan (Edison, NJ/Edison HS)** had 12 hits in 26 at-bats last week for a .462 batting average. She had eight RBIs including one game winning RBI, four runs scored, three doubles and three walks. On the mound, Ryan won two of three outings and posted a 1.31 earned run average in 16 innings of action. Junior **Becky Stroup (Palmerton/Palmerton Area HS)** was also 2-1 on the mound last week with a 1.33 ERA in 21 innings. Stroup struck out 18 batters.

A pair of Lady Greyhounds captured first place finishes at the Lehigh University Games to give Moravian a fourth place finish out of eight schools. Two of the three schools that finished ahead of the Lady Greyhounds compete on the NCAA Division I level. Moravian's first place showings were by freshman **Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS)** in the 5,000 meters in a time of 18:46.46 and by senior **Kristie Reccek (Hellertown/Wilson HS)** in the 1,500 meters in 4:48.90. Shertzer won her race by nearly 30 seconds. Moravian had one other first place finish which was by the 4x800-meter relay team in a time of 9:42.20. Junior **Maria Grabowski (Churchville/Villa Joseph Marie)** was sixth in the 5,000 meters at 20:31.36 while freshman **Kim Jaick (Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS)** was sixth in the 1,500 meters in 5:01.88.

Freshman **Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS)** placed second in the 3,000-meter race with a time of 10:23.43. Freshman **Jennifer Lohn (Media/Penncrest HS)** also had a second place finish in the javelin with a throw of 31.78 meters (104'3"). Classmate **Carrie McCaffery (Lebanon/Annville-Cleona HS)** placed third in the javelin at 31.10 meters (102'0"). Freshman **Melissa Webber (Barnegat, NJ/ Monsignor Donovan HS)** took fourth in the discus throw with a toss of 36.96 meters (121'3") while McCaffery was sixth in the event with a throw of 32.36 meters (106'2").

Sophomore **Hannah Wood** (**Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS**) also had a third place finish in the 800 meters in a time of 2:24.79. Freshman **Erin Boyle** (**Philadelphia/Nazareth Academy**) placed sixth in the 800 with a time of 2:28.97. Freshman **Steph Horne** (**Sinking Spring/Wilson West Lawn HS**) finished fourth in the 400 intermediate hurdles in 1:10.57 while sophomore **Brooke Dancho** (**Bethlehem/Freedom HS**) placed fourth in the triple jump at 10.22 meters (33'6½"). Horne also had a sixth place finish in the 100-meter high hurdles in 16.51 seconds. Freshman **Sarah Shaneberger** (**Bethlehem/Southern Lehigh HS**) placed fourth in the shot put with a distance of 11.62 meters (38'1½").

A trio of Greyhounds captured second place finishes at the Lehigh University Games to give Moravian a third place finish out of eight schools. One of the two schools that finished ahead of the 'Hounds compete on the NCAA Division I level. Moravian's second place showings were by senior **Jeff Minnich** (**Lehighton**/ **Palmerton Area HS**) in the 5,000 meters in 15:30.70, junior **Dan Oliynik** (**Dover, NJ/Morris Knolls HS**) in the 110 meter high hurdles with a time of 15.00 seconds and junior **Jim O'Rourke** (**Park Ridge, NJ/Park Ridge HS**) in the high jump at 1.83 meters (6'0"). The Greyhound's 4x100-meter relay and 4x800-meter relay teams did capture first place finishes in time of 44.58 seconds and 7:56.98 respectively.

Freshman **Kevin Bush** (**Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS**) placed third in the 200 meters in a time of 22.48 seconds while Oliynik was third in the 400 intermediate hurdles in 58.39 seconds. Senior sprinter **Vance Szabo** (**Nazareth/Northampton HS**) took third in the 100 meters in 11.05 seconds while sophomore **Anthony Rediger** (**Sellersville/Pennridge HS**) was third in the long jump at 6.20 meters (20'4¼"). Sophomore **Napo Ghanda** (**Whitehall/Freedom HS**) was sixth in the long jump with a leap of 5.91 meters (19'4¾").

Junior **Tim Pfluger (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS)** was fourth in the 1,500 meters in a time of 4:03.30 while senior **Josh Gold (Northampton/Northampton HS)** placed fourth in the javelin with a throw of 50.76 meters (167'5"). Freshman **Kyle Rehrig (Walnutport/Northern Lehigh HS)** was sixth in the javelin at 47.12 meters (155'8"). Sophomore **Bill Schmidt (Basking Ridge, NJ/Ridge HS)** placed fifth in the shot put with a distance of 12.97 meters (42'634") while junior **Josh Tirado (Weatherly/Weatherly HS)** placed fifth in the discus throw at 38.12 meters (125'1"). Senior **Jeremy Schoenberger (Lehighton/Lehighton HS)** was sixth in the discus with a toss of 37.44 meters (122'10").
