The Lady Greyhounds posted a 3-3 record last week but were knocked out of the Middle Atlantic Conference playoff race for the second straight year by a doubleheader loss to Susquehanna University. However, Moravian, which is ranked second in the NCAA Division III East Region, kept its hopes alive for a NCAA Division III Tournament berth with a doubleheader split against national power William Paterson University.

Junior **Zan Azzolino (Lodi, NJ/Immaculate Heart Academy HS)** paced the Lady Greyhounds in hitting last week with eight hits in 11 at-bats for a .533 batting average. She had a triple, scored two runs and drove in three others. Freshman **Laurie Rentschler (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS)** also swung a hot bat with six hits in 14 at-bats for a .429 batting average. She had one double. Classmate **Debbie Noble (Cranford, NJ/Cranford HS)** had the hot bat at Susquehanna, connecting for three hits including a double and a triple in five at-bats. She had two RBIs and scored once.

Freshman **Stacy Matuczinski (Bethlehem/Liberty HS)** had seven hits last week with a double while junior **Ali Harteveld (Lodi, NJ/Immaculate Heart Academy)** and sophomore **Missy Hummel (Walnutport/Northampton HS)** each had six hits. Harteveld had a double, scored twice and added four RBIs while Hummel had two doubles, scored four runs and drove in two. Senior **Heather Bennett (Franklin, NJ/Walkill HS)** had three hits with a double but had the game-winning RBI in each win last week. She totaled five RBIs and five runs scored during the week. Freshmen **Summer Miller (Mt. Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley HS)** and **Rachel Mowrey (Hellertown/Saucon Valley HS)** each had four hits with Miller hitting two doubles and Mowrey one.

On the mound, junior **Becky Stroup (Palmerton/Palmerton Area HS)** picked up two victories to reach double figures in wins for the second straight year. She also had two relief appearances last week and struck out seven batters. Mowrey posted a 1-1 record last week and had five strikeouts while sophomore **Meg Ryan (Edison, NJ/Edison HS)** pitched the other game and had four strikeouts.

Moravian won three tri-matches last week to improve to 8-0 on the season. Leading the Greyhounds last week was freshman **Ricky Gower (Bath/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** who fired rounds of 77, 85 and 85 to have a team low average of 82.3 last week. Junior **Brian Fry (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** average 85 over three rounds with scores of 83, 85 and 87 while sophomore **Kevin Lewis (Gansevoort, NY/Saratoga Springs HS)** placed twice last week and shot 84 both times.

Junior **Mike Quirk (Allentown/Parkland HS)** placed in all three outings with rounds of 78, 90 and 88 while senior **Brian Longley (Florham Park, NJ/Hanover Park HS)** and junior **Geoff Hood (Willow Grove/Upper Moreland HS)** each placed twice. Longley had rounds of 87 and 81 while Hood fired an 86 and a 93.

The Greyhounds, who lost all three games last week, were led by junior **Jarrett Hughes (Bangor/Bangor Area HS)** in hitting last week. Hughes collected five hits in 11 at-bats including three doubles and a homerun. He also had three walks and four RBIs. Hughes' homerun was one of two in an extra-inning loss at Delaware Valley. Sophomore **Joe Pochron (Allentown/Salisbury HS)** had the other homer and leads the Greyhounds with three round-trippers this season. Pochron totaled three hits and three runs scored last week.

Junior **Matt Seitzinger (Scranton/Scranton Prep)** had four hits with a double and scored three times while freshman **Michael Abbate (South Plainfield, NJ/Bishop Ahr HS)** had two hits and scored two runs. On the mound, freshman **Randy Woolley (Manahawkin, NJ/Southern Regional HS)** paced the Greyhounds, allowing just four hits, one run and one walk with three strikeouts over six innings of action. Senior **Scott Bolasky (Germansville/Northwestern Lehigh HS)** went the distance in a nine-inning contest with Widener, suffering the loss. He did strikeout six batters in the game to increase his team lead to 40 for the season. Junior **Mark Slavin (Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS)** also went the distance in the other loss at Widener.

Groner won a doubles match with junior **Justin Biel (Linwood, NJ/Mainland Regional HS)** while Wagner captured a doubles contest with sophomore **Clay Smith (Bethlehem/Liberty HS)**.

Junior **Dan Oliynik (Dover, NJ/Morris Knolls HS)** won first in the 110-meter high hurdles in 15.17 seconds to lead the Greyhounds at the Lafayette College Invitational this past weekend. Sophomore **Damon Rutherford (Reading/Exeter HS)** had Moravian's other top three finish with a third place in the 3,000-meter steeplechase in 10:01.74.

In other events for the 'Hounds, senior **Vance Szabo (Nazareth/Northampton HS)** was fourth in the 200 meters in 23.01 seconds and fifth in the 100 meters in 11.20 seconds. Freshman **Kevin Bush (Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS)** was fifth in the 200 meters with a time of 23.06 seconds. Junior **Tim Pfluger (Slatinton/Northern Lehigh HS)** placed fifth in the 1,500 meters in 4:02.27 while classmate **Jim O'Rourke (Park Ridge, NJ/Park Ridge HS)** was fifth in the high jump at five feet, ten inches. Sophomores **Anthony Rediger (Sellersville/Pennridge HS)** and **Bill Schmidt (Basking Ridge, NJ/Ridge HS)** each had fourth place finishes with Rediger competing in the triple jump at 13.15 meters and Schmidt in the shot put at 13.36 meters. The Greyhounds 4x100 meter relay team placed third at the Lafayette Invitational in 43.3 seconds.

Wolfsberger ran a time of 4:43.55 while senior teammate **Kristie Reccek (Hellertown/Wilson HS)** was second in the event at 4:47.36. Sophomore **Hannah Wood (Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS)** placed fifth in the 1,500 meters in 4:57.73.

In other events for Moravian, freshman **Melissa Webber (Barnegat, NJ/Monsignor Donovan HS)** placed second in the discus with a toss of 37.43 meters while classmate **Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS)** was third in the 5,000 meters in 18:28.14. Freshman **Sarah Shaneberger (Bethlehem/Southern Lehigh HS)** placed fourth in the shot put at 11.54 meters and fifth in the hammer throw at 32.24 meters. Classmate **Steph Horne (Sinking Spring/Wilson West Lawn HS)** was fourth in the 400-meter hurdles in 1:10.37.
