Softball - 25-13 (8-6 MAC Commonwealth League, 12-6 MAC Overall)

Last Week – Haverford postponed until April 28th or 29th at Haverford; Defeated #Delaware Valley, 12-2 (5 inn) & 14-0 (5 inn); Defeated *Lebanon Valley, 4-0 & 3-0. *MAC Commonwealth League game, #MAC game. This Week – Tues., April 27th vs. Dickinson College (DH), 3:00 p.m.; Wed., April 28th or Thurs., April 29th at Haverford College (DH), 3:00 p.m. End of regular season.

The Lady Greyhounds earned victories in all four games last week and the pitching staff allowed just two runs in 24 innings. Junior **Becky Stroup** (**Palmerton/Palmerton Area HS**) was 2-0 last week and allowed seven hits two earned runs, three walks and eight strikeouts. Sophomore **Meg Ryan** (**Edison, NJ/Edison HS**) and freshman **Rachel Mowrey** (**Hellertown/Saucon Valley HS**) each had shutout wins with Mowrey allowing just two hits with one strikeout and Ryan giving up three hits and a strikeout.

At the plate, sophomore **Missy Hummel (Walnutport/Northampton HS)** hit .615 with seven hits in 13 at-bats. She has 53 hits this season, just nine shy of the single season record at Moravian. Hummel added five runs scored, two RBIs, two stolen bases and a double last week. Junior **Ali Harteveld (Lodi, NJ/Immaculate Heart Academy)** was seven for 14 last week for a .500 average. She had three doubles, six RBIs and four runs scored.

Ryan and freshmen Summer Miller (Mt. Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley HS), Laurie Rentschler (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS) and Debbie Noble (Cranford, NJ/Cranford HS) each had four hits last week. Ryan scored four runs and had a triple while Miller had three runs scored and a RBI. Rentschler scored twice and Noble added five RBIs, two runs scored and two doubles.

Senior Heather Bennett (Franklin, NJ/Wallkill Valley HS) and juniors Krysten Mack (Canton, CT/Canton HS) and Zan Azzolino (Lodi, NJ/Immaculate Heart Academy) each had three hits. Azzolino scored three runs and added two RBIs while Bennett scored once and drove in two and Mack scored once and knocked in one. Junior Trish Salomonsen (Effort/Pleasant Valley HS) made her only hit last week count with a three-run homerun at Delaware Valley. It was the second homerun of Salomonsen's career at Moravian.

Moravian placed fourth in a pair of events including the 1999 Middle Atlantic Conference Championships last week played at the Shawnee Country Club in the Poconos. Freshman **Ricky Gower** (**Bath/Bethlehem Catholic HS**) placed seventh at the MAC Tournament with a 54-hole total of 246. He also fired an 87 in the Lehigh Valley Invitational. Senior **Brian Longley** (**Florham Park, NJ/Hanover Park HS**) had a 249 at the MAC Championships, good enough for ninth place and had the Greyhounds best round at the Lehigh Valley Invite with a 77. Junior **Brian Fry** (**Bethlehem/ Bethlehem Catholic HS**) was tied for 29th at the MACs with a 260 and had a 94 in last week's other event. Sophomore **Karl Searing** (**Tamaqua/Tamaqua HS**) was 51st with a 273 total and had an 85 at the Lehigh Valley Invitational. Junior **Geoff Hood** (**Willow Grove/Upper Moreland HS**) placed 53rd of 65 golfers at the MACs with a total of 275 and had a 96 in the Lehigh Valley Invitational.

Senior **Josh Groner (Easton/Wilson HS)** and sophomores **Clay Smith (Bethlehem/Liberty HS)** and **Chris Braun (Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS)** each won singles matches in the 5-4 loss. Braun finished the season with the team's top singles record at 7-4. Smith teamed up with junior **Clay Wagner (Havertown/Haverford HS)** for a win in doubles action.

The Greyhounds won a game over arch-rival Muhlenberg College, 4-3, last week but suffered a pair of Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League losses to Juniata College, 5-2 and 8-0 over the weekend. Freshman pitcher **Randy Woolley** (**Manahawkin, NJ/Southern Regional HS**) won the game over Muhlenberg with a six inning stint. He allowed six hits, three runs, three walks and had a pair of strikeouts. Junior **David Jelleme** (**Pequannock, NJ/Pequannock HS**) earned the save in the game and pitched a total of 5 2/3 innings last week with five strikeouts and just one walk. Senior **Scott Bolasky** (**Germansville/Northwestern Lehigh HS**) and junior **Mark Slavin** (**Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS**) each lost decisions to Juniata. Bolasky went the distance, allowing seven hits, five runs but only two were earned, three walks and four strikeouts. Slavin hurled 4 1/3 innings, allowing four hits, five runs with three of them earned and three walks.

At the plate, sophomore Joe Pochron (Allentown/Salisbury HS) led Moravian with three hits last week. Pochron also had two walks, a stolen base, a run scored and a RBI. Freshman Michael Abbate (South Plainfield, NJ/Bishop Ahr HS) and sophomore Shawn Brown (Quakertown/Quakertown HS) each had a pair of hits last week. Abbate scored a run while Brown drove one in. Junior Jarrett Hughes (Bangor/Bangor Area HS) had one hit last week, a double for the Greyhounds only extra-base hit. He also scored one run. Senior Scott Fritz (Barnesville/Mahoney Area HS), junior Matt Seitzinger (Scranton/Scranton Prep) and freshmen Hank Reifsnyder (Upper Black Eddy/Palisades HS) and Curtis Hoff (Kintersville/Palisades HS) each had singles last week. Reifsnyder and sophomore Mike Gill (Lebanon, NJ/North Hunterdon HS) each drew three walks. Gill added a stolen base.

Men's Track and Field - 0-0 (0-0 MAC Commonwealth League, 0-0 MAC Overall)

Last Week – Penn Relays; Leading Muhlenberg, 76-47, with field events at Moravian on Mon., April 26th. This Week – Fri. April 30th & May 1st at Middle Atlantic Conference Championships hosted by Messiah College.

The Greyhounds 4x400-meter relay team competed at the Penn Relays, finishing eighth of 15 in their heat. Freshmen Josh Heebner (Lansdale/North Penn HS), Scott Heydt (Boyertown/Boyertown HS) and Kevin Bush (Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS) and sophomore Lyle Lentz (Glenolden/Streth Haven HS) posted a time of 3:28.74 in the event. The 4x100-meter relay team of seniors Vance Szabo (Nazareth/Northampton HS) and Jeremy Schoenberger (Lehighton/Lehighton HS), junior Dan Oliynik (Dover, NJ/Morris Knolls HS) and Bush ran a 43.66 at Penn.

In the dual meet with Muhlenberg that will be finished on Monday, Szabo had a pair of first place finishes in the 100-meters with a time of 11.13 seconds and in the 200 meters in 22.49 seconds. Bush placed second in the 100 meters in 11.42 seconds and third in the 200-meters in 22.87 seconds. Heebner was second in the 400 meters in 54-84 seconds. Freshman **Tim McDade** (**Bechtelsville/Boyertown HS**) was second in the 800 meters in 2:02.20 while senior **Nick Murphy** (**South Kent, CT/South Kent School**) was third in 2:04.46.

Junior **Tim Pfluger (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS)** won the 1,500 meters in 4:08.31 while senior **Jeff Minnich (Lehighton/Palmerton Area HS)** won the 3,000 meters in 9:08.02. Senior **Tyler McClimon (Birdsboro/Daniel Boone HS)** was second in the 3,000 with a time of 9:22.59 while senior **Chris Lowthert (Auburn/Pottsville HS)** was third in 9:23.01. Sophomore **Damon Rutherford (Reading/Exeter HS)** won the 3,000-meter steeplechase in 10:20.27 while **Chris DeWalt (Easton/Easton HS)** placed third in 10:38.39.

The Greyhounds won both the 4x100-meter and 4x400-meter relays on the afternoon. In the field events, junior **Jim O'Rourke** (**Park Ridge, NJ/Park Ridge HS**) won the high jump at six feet, two inches while sophomore **Anthony Rediger** (**Sellersville/Pennridge HS**) was second at six feet even. Rediger won both the long jump at 19 feet, four inches and the triple jump at 40 feet, 10 ½ inches. Sophomore **Napo Ghanda** (**Bethlehem/Liberty HS**) was second in both events at 19 feet even in the long jump and 28 feet, five inches in the triple jump. Freshman **Kyle Rehrig** (**Walnutport/Northern Lehigh HS**) was third in the long jump at 17 feet, 4 ½ inches. The shot put, discus and javelin will be completed on Monday at Moravian.

Women's Track and Field-0-0 (0-0 MAC Commonwealth League, 0-0 MAC Overall)

Last Week – Penn Relays; Leading Muhlenberg, 74-46, with field events at Moravian on Mon., April 26th. This Week – Fri. April 30th & May 1st at Middle Atlantic Conference Championships hosted by Messiah College.

The Lady Greyhounds had several competitors at the Penn Relays last week. Senior **Kristie Reccek** (**Hellertown/Wilson HS**) placed 17th of 26 runners in her heat of the 3,000 meters with a time of 10:06.53, just 20 seconds off the lead in a race that included 22 NCAA Division I runners and three NCAA Division II student-athletes. Reccek joined freshmen **Heidi Wolfsberger** (**Moosic/Riverside HS**) and **Erin Boyle** (**Philadelphia/Nazareth Academy**) and sophomore **Hannah Wood** (**Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS**) for a 20th place finish in the distance medley relay with a time of 12:08.94. Wolfsberger, Boyle and Wood ran in the 4x400-meter relay with sophomore **Brooke Dancho** (**Bethlehem/Freedom HS**) to post a 10th place time of 4:20.12.

In the dual meet with Muhlenberg, sophomore **Denele Brozino** (**Lehighton/Lehighton HS**) won the 100 meters in 13.18 seconds. Dancho, who won the 200 meters in 27.83 seconds, was second in the 100 meters with a time of 13.54 seconds. Sophomore **Leah Williams** (**Andreas/Tamaqua HS**) was second in the 400 meters in 1:08.64 while freshman **Tiffany Catalino** (**Bethlehem/Freedom HS**) was third in 1:10.13. Reccek captured the 800 meters in 2:22.82 and was followed by teammates freshman **Kim Jaick** (**Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS**) at 2:26.49 and Boyle in 2:30.27. Wolfsberger was first in the 1,500 meters in 4:49.41 while Jaick was second at 4:54.86 and wood was third in 5:02.82.

Freshman Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS) won the 3,000 meters in 10:48.98 and was followed by senior Amy Cavanaugh (Horseheads, NY/Horseheads HS) in second with a time of 11:04.69 and sophomore Kate Westermann (Milford, CT/Lauralton Hall) third at 11:31.24. Freshman Steph Horne (Sinking Spring/Wilson West Lawn HS) won the 100-meter hurdles in 16.82 seconds and was followed by sophomore Lindsey Foreman (Sharon, MA/Sharon HS) in second at 18.38. Freshman Jen Burkholder (Chalfont/Gwynedd Mercy) was second in the 400-meter hurdles in 1:14.34. The Lady Greyhounds captured first in both the 4x100-meter and 4x400-meter relay races.

In the first events, Dancho placed second in the high jump at four feet, ten inches. Dancho was also second in the long jump with a leap of 16 feet, five and a half inches. Foreman was second in the triple jump at 32 feet, 6 ¾ inches. The shot put, discus and javelin will be completed at Moravian on Monday.
