Women's Cross Country – 0-0 (MAC Overall, 0-0 MAC Commonwealth League)

Last Week – 2nd of 9 at Kutztown Maroon & Gold Invitational, Kutztown, PA

The Lady Greyhounds finished second of nine schools at the Kutztown University Maroon and Gold Invitational to open the 1998 season. Of the seven schools behind Moravian, four were NCAA Division II schools.

Leading the Lady Greyhounds on the course was freshman **Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS)** with a fourth place finish in her first race. She completed the 3.1-mile course in 19:17.7. Also finishing the meet in the top ten for the Lady Greyhounds were freshman **Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS)** at seventh in 19:30.6 and senior **Kristie Reccek (Hellertown/Wilson HS)** in ninth in 19:40.6.

Other Moravian finishers included sophomore **Hannah Wood (Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS)** in 16th at 20:12.6, junior **Jen Samson (Tannersville/Pocono Mountain HS)** in 24th with a time of 20:52.6 and senior **Amy Cavanaugh (Horseheads, NY/Horseheads HS)** at 26th in 20:58.5

The Greyhounds opened the 1998 campaign with a third place finish in the Kutztown University Maroon and Gold Invitational. Of the five schools behind Moravian in the meet standings, three were NCAA Division II schools.

Senior **Jeff Minnich (Lehighton/Palmerton Area HS)** was the Greyhounds top finisher in 13th place. He had a time of 27:36.7 over the five-mile course. Sophomore **Damon Rutherford (Reading/Exeter HS)** placed 20th with a time of 28:04.9 while senior **James Hillary (Easton/Easton HS)** was 26th in a time of 28:28.4.

Rounding out Moravian's top five were freshman **Tim McDade (Bechtelsville/Boyertown HS)** in 29th with a time of 28:34.1 and junior **Tim Pfluger (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS)** at 37th in 29:02.2. Senior **Chris Lowthert (Auburn/Pottsville HS)** finished one second behind Pfluger in 39th place.

She scored her second goal with 13:47 left in the second half on a rebound from a shot by freshman **Suzy Wargo (Somerville, NJ/Hillsborough HS)**.

Wargo assisted on the Lady Greyhound's third goal of the afternoon, which was scored by junior **Julie Kalbfleisch (Warminster/William Tennent HS)**. Sophomore **Chelsea Roberts (Philadelphia/St. Basil HS)** scored Moravian's final goal on a pass from freshman **Elissa Gerstel (Warminster/William Tennent HS)**.

Junior goalie **Tricia Salomonsen (Effort/Pleasant Valley HS)** made four saves to post the eighth shutout of her career for the Lady Greyhounds

Freshman **Evan Weller (Sinking Spring/Wilson West Lawn HS)** started the game out right for Moravian, netting his first career goal on the first shot of the season for Moravian 12 and a half minutes into the contest and giving the Greyhounds a 1-0. West Chester tied the match a minute later.

Sophomore **Van Pham (Reading/Reading HS)** added an unassisted goal in the second half. Classmate **Andrew Grezlak (Doylestown/Central Bucks East HS)** had an assist on Weller's goal. Moravian keeper, junior **Ryan Shick (Jamison/Central Bucks East HS)** made four saves in the match.

Earning singles victories were seniors **Jessie Coughlin (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** and **Liz Chamberlain (Pine Bush, NY/Pine Bush Central HS)**, junior **Marnie Heller (Shillington/Governor Mifflin HS)** and freshmen **Katie Copf (Allentown/Salisbury HS)** and **Corinne Kleinsmith (Shillington/Governor Mifflin HS)**. Coughlin now has a career mark of 49-2 in singles action.

Earning victories in doubles for the Lady Greyhounds were the pairings of senior **Lynne Grzywacz (Blue Bell/Wissahickon HS)** and Coughlin, Heller and Kleinsmith and senior **Kate Rose (Hatboro/Hatboro Horsham HS)** and sophomore **Autumn Zander (Reigelsville/Bethlehem Catholic HS)**.
