Football – 0-2 (0-2 MAC Overall, 0-1 MAC Commonwealth League)

Last Week – Lost to Juniata, 23-20 in overtime. *MAC Commonwealth League game

The Greyhound football team suffered its second straight loss of the season, falling to Juniata, 23-20, in overtime. It was the third consecutive overtime game the two schools have played and the fourth straight year that the game has ended in a regulation tie.

Also, the 0-2 record to start the season is the first since 1986 when Moravian posted a 4-5-1 record. That was the school's last losing season and the last before current head coach **Scot Dapp** was hired.

In the game against Juniata, junior quarterback **Rob Petrosky** (Catasauqua/North Catasauqua **HS**) completed 15 of 37 passes for 207 yards and a touchdown. The scoring pass was to sophomore **Corey Pickel** (Lititz/Warwick **HS**) who caught five passes for 90 yards on the afternoon. Pickel also blocked a Juniata field goal attempt in the fourth quarter as did senior **Ken Gluck** (**Plainsboro**, **NJ/West Windsor Plainsboro HS**).

Sophomore **P.J. Jankowicz (Belle Mead, NJ/Hillsborough HS)** carried the ball 20 times for 94 yards on the afternoon. Classmate **J.D. Rhinehart (Washington, NJ/Warren Hills Regional HS)**, starting at linebacker for the second straight game, made a team-high 13 tackles on the afternoon with one sack. Junior **Steve DiRenzo (Nectong, NJ/Lenape Valley Regional HS)** made his second interception of the year Saturday.

Freshman placekicker **Jim McIntyre** (**Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown HS**) made a pair of long distance field goals on the afternoon. He connected on a 44 yarder in his first attempt, just two yards shy of the school record, and on a 42 yard strike in overtime to give Moravian a short lived 20-17 lead.

Sophomore Matt Kling (Chatham, NJ/Oratory Prep HS) netted his second goal of the season in a 2-1 loss to MAC rival Lycoming College. Senior Nick D'Andrea (Bensalem/Holy Ghost Prep) and sophomore Rich Tate (Warrington/LaSalle College HS) each scored in a 3-2 loss in the Greyhounds MAC Commonwealth League season opener against Messiah.

Junior goalie **Ryan Shick** (**Jamison/Central Bucks East HS**) made 14 saves during the week including a season high 13 versus Messiah.

Freshmen Eilssa Gerstel (Warminster/William Tennent HS) and Suzy Wargo (Somerville, NJ/Hillsborough HS) and sophomores Chelsea Roberts (Philadelphia/ St. Basil HS) and Lynda Roney (Newton, NJ/Kittatinny HS) each scored goals in the win versus King's. The shutout against the Lady Monarchs was the ninth of junior goalie Tricia Salomonsen's (Effort/Pleasant Valley HS) career.

Moravian fell to Marywood, 1-0, last Thursday and managed just six shots on goal during the contest. In the squad's MAC Commonwealth League season opener, sophomore **Jen Cosentino** (**Shohola/Delaware Valley HS**) scored the Lady Greyhounds only goal in a 2-1 loss to nationally ranked Lebanon Valley College.

The Lady Greyhounds won their final two matches of the week as Moravian opened MAC Commonwealth League play. Senior Molly McGonigle (Maple Shade, NJ/Maple Shade HS) scored her first goal of the season off a pass from sophomore Becky Matijasich (Dunwoody, GA/Wilson West Lawn {PA} HS) in Moravian's 2-1 loss at Muhlenberg to open the week.

Last Wednesday, the Lady 'Hounds traveled to Lycoming and received two goals each from junior Carli Miller (Wyomissing/Wilson West Lawn HS) and sophomore Amy Amadio (Temple/Muhlenberg HS) in a 5-1 win. Sophomore Lindsey Foreman (Sharon, MA/Sharon HS) also scored her second goal of the season in the match. Miller netted the team's lone goal in a 1-0 victory in the MAC Commonwealth League opener at Susquehanna. The shutout was the sixth of sophomore goalie Becky Roe's (Worcester, NY/Worcester Central HS) career.

Behind the hitting of senior **Stephanie Rickards** (**Lansdowne/Upper Darby HS**) and junior **Amy Sandt** (**Allentown/William Allen HS**), the Lady Greyhounds posted a 2-1 record last week and defeated two schools ranked in the NCAA Mid-Atlantic Region. During the week, Rickards had 44 kills, 24 digs, eight blocks and four service aces while Sandt had 36 kills, 45 digs and four service aces. Junior setter **Kaitie Kramer** (**Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS**) made 124 assists in 11 games last week.

In last week's first NCAA Mid-Atlantic Region poll of the year, Moravian was ranked fifth behind Juniata, which defeated Moravian, 3-1, last Tuesday, Gettysburg, Franklin & Marshall and Lycoming, which the Lady Greyhounds were victorious, 3-0, this past Saturday. Moravian also defeated Eastern College, 3-1, which was ranked seventh in the region.

The Lady Greyhounds "A" team, led by senior **Kristie Reccek** (**Hellertown/Wilson HS**) competed in the Bloomsburg duals last Friday and defeated two NCAA Division II schools. Moravian defeated West Chester University by one point and host Bloomsburg by five points. Reccek was second overall in the 3.1-mile race in a time of 19:31.88. Freshman **Emily Shertzer** (**Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS**) was the second Lady Greyhound to cross the line in fourth place in a time of 20:02.68

Rounding out Moravian's top five were freshman **Heidi Wolfsberger** (**Moosic/Riverside HS**) in eighth place in 20:33.37, sophomore **Hannah Wood** (**Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS**) one spot behind at 20:34.17 and junior **Jen Samson** (**Tannersville/Pocono Mountain HS**) at 14th in a time of 21:30.42.

Sophomore **Kate Westermann** (**Milford, CT/Lauralton Hall**) led the Moravian "B" team at the Muhlenberg Invitational by earning a medal with a fourth place individual finish in 21:13.

Seniors Lynne Grzywacz (Blue Bell/Wissahickon HS) and Jessie Coughlin (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS) each scored three singles victories last week to lift the Lady Greyhounds, the two-time defending MAC Champions to three more wins. Moravian has now won 20 straight matches.

Junior Marnie Heller (Shillington/Governor Mifflin HS) and freshman Corinne Kleinsmith (Shillington/Governor Mifflin HS) stayed undefeated as a doubles team this fall at 6-0. Kleinsmith in also perfect in singles action in her debut season at 5-0 while Heller has a 5-1 singles mark. Freshman Katie Copf (Allentown/Salisbury HS) also has a 5-1 record in her first year at Moravian.
