### Women's Soccer – 6-9 (2-2 MAC Commonwealth League, 5-2 MAC Overall)

Junior Carli Miller (Wyomissing/Wilson West Lawn HS) connected on two goals and added two assists in an 8-0 victory over Alvernia College to highlight the week for the Lady Greyhounds. She now had 42 goals and 18 assists in her career for 102 points, becoming the first player in school history to surpass the 100-point milestone. Miller and the rest of the team were held scoreless against nationally ranked Gettysburg.

Other goal scorers in the win against Alvernia were junior Jen Polaha (West Lawn/Holy Name HS) and sophomore Amy Amadio (Temple/Muhlenberg HS) with two tallies each and senior Molly McGonigle (Maple Shade, NJ/Maple Shade HS) and Stevie Ochse (Bethlehem/Saucon Valley HS) with a goal each. Senior Meghan McGowan Toms River, NJ/Toms River North HS), sophomores Marisa Confuorto (Neshanic Station, NJ/Hillsborough HS) and Mary Beth Walsh (Mahwah, NJ/Mahwah HS) and freshman Nicole Kalogeras (Hatfield/Lansdale Catholic HS) all had assists. Sophomore goalie Becky Roe (Worcester, NY/Worcester Central HS) made 12 saves during the week.

Senior Stephanie Rickards (Lansdowne/Upper Darby HS) made 14 kills, nine digs and eight blocks in the win over Allentown. Junior Amy Sandt (Allentown/William Allen HS) added 12 kills and eight digs. Junior Kaitie Kramer (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS) had 30 assists and 13 digs in the win while sophomores Natalie Balaziuk (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS) and Sara Young (Tunkhannock/Tunkhannock HS) contributed 11 digs and eight kills respectively.

Rickards and Sandt each had 12 kills in the win versus Richard Stockton. Sandt also had 10 digs while Kramer had 35 assists. Sophomore **Rebecca Falk** (**Allentown/Dieruff HS**) had ten kills in the match while Young contributed five service aces.

If Moravian wins the match on Monday with Messiah, the Lady Greyhounds will capture their third Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League title in four years.

In the win at Widener, seniors Jessie Coughlin (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS) and Lynne Grzywacz (Blue Bell/Wissahickon HS) each won their singles matches and combined for a victory in doubles. Junior Marnie Heller (Shillington/Governor Mifflin HS) and freshman Corinne Kleinsmith (Shillington/Governor Mifflin HS) earn a win at doubles and Kleinsmith also remained undefeated in singles with a victory. Freshman Katie Copf (Allentown/Salisbury HS) won in singles play while senior Kate Rose (Hatboro/Hatboro Horsham HS) and sophomore Autumn Zander (Riegelsville/Bethlehem Catholic HS) combined for a triumph in doubles.

The Lady Greyhounds dropped a pair of one-goal losses last week in Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League action. Moravian fell to Widener 3-2 on Friday and lost to nationally ranked Messiah, 2-1, on Saturday.

In the loss at Widener, sophomore **Chelsea Roberts** (**Philadelphia/St. Basil HS**) and junior **Tricia Salomonsen** (**Effort/Pleasant Valley HS**) each had goals in the contest. The goal for Salomonsen, the Moravian goalkeeper, was her second of the season on a penalty stroke. She also made nine saves in goal. Salomonsen had 19 saves against Messiah and junior **Stacey Laubenheimer** (**Marlton, NJ/Burnt Hills {NY} HS**) scored the first goal of the game for Moravian but Messiah scored twice before the end of the first half to earn the win.

The Greyhounds improved their Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League record to 3-1 with a victory at Widener, 2-1, last Wednesday, but were shutout for the first time this season in a non-league contest with Drew, 3-0.

Sophomore Van Pham (Reading/Reading HS) scored his 12<sup>th</sup> goal of the season and his fourth game-winning tally of the year against Widener. Freshman Scott Heydt (Boyertown/Boyertown HS) netted his first career goal in the first half of the contest. Junior goalie Ryan Shick (Jamison/Central Bucks East HS) made seven saves in the two matches.

The Greyhounds fell to 1-4 overall on the season with a 45-13 loss to Widener University in Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League action. Moravian's last 1-4 start in a season was 1982.

Freshman running back **Jim Scott (Bath/Northampton HS)** was one of the bright spots for the Greyhounds on the afternoon. He blocked a Widener punt in the second quarter and fell on it in the endzone for one the Moravian's two touchdowns. He also had two carries for 25 yards and caught one pass for seven yards.

Junior quarterback **Rob Petrosky** (**North Catasauqua/Catasauqua HS**) completed just 11 of 24 passes for 121 yards, however, he was intercepted one time and sacked seven times for a loss of 60 yards. Petrosky did connect on a touchdown pass with junior tight end **Kevin McHale** (**Dunmore/Dunmore HS**). McHale had two catches for 15 yards. Petrosky's top target was sophomore running back **P.J. Jankowicz** (**Belle Mead, NJ/Hillsborough HS**) with four receptions for 50 yards. Jankowicz was held to seven yards rushing on 13 attempts while starting backfield mate **Kirk Harryn** (**Bethlehem/Freedom HS**) rushed for a team-high 51 yards on 12 attempts.

Freshman **Michael Abbate** (**South Plainfield, NJ/Bishop Ahr HS**) made his first start at wide receiver and had three catches for 35 yards. Sophomore wide receiver **Corey Pickel** (**Lititz/Warwick HS**) also had three receptions for 32 yards. Abbate, who also returns kicks for Moravian, had three punt returns for 17 yards and four kickoff returns for 68 yards.

On defense, junior safety **Jason Goldan (Neshanic, NJ/Hillsborough HS)** made a team leading 13 tackles and also intercepted a pass. Juniors **Josh Wren (Magna, UT/Cypress HS)** and **Chris Buzas (Sinking Spring/Wilson West Lawn HS)** each had sacks in the game.
