In the first half, Moravian dominated the game, allowing Susquehanna just 56 yards on offense and gaining 208 yards of its own. The Greyhounds also held the ball for almost 20 minutes but a missed field goal by sophomore **Kevin Smith** (**Collegeville/Methacton HS**), a blocked field goal attempt by freshman **Jim McIntyre** (**Hackettstown, NJ/Hackettstown HS**), an interception by Petrosky at the goal line and a pass knocked away from senior wide receiver **Vance Szabo** (**Nazareth/Northampton HS**) on the final play of the first half kept Susquehanna in the game. Smith did make a 31-yard field goal in the fourth quarter to give Moravian a 16-14 lead with eight and a half minutes to play.

Moravian did have a 7-0 halftime lead on a six-yard touchdown run by sophomore **P.J. Jankowicz** (**Belle Mead, NJ/Hillsborough HS**). Jankowicz had 50 yards on 15 carries while junior **Kirk Harryn** (**Bethlehem/Freedom HS**) had 53 yards on 12 attempts. Harryn and freshman **Michael Abbate** (**South Plainfield, NJ/Bishop Ahr HS**) were Petrosky's top targets on the afternoon with six receptions each for 66 and 76 yards respectively. Sophomore **Scott Farkas** (**Nazareth/Bethlehem Catholic HS**) had two catches for 72 yards including a 34-yard touchdown on a fourth-and-four play. Szabo caught three passes for 47 yards while Jankowicz had four receptions for 45 yards.
