Women's Tennis - 16-0 (7-0 MAC Commonwealth League, 13-0 MAC Overall)

Last Week – Defeated \$Lycoming, 6-3; MAC Individual Tournament. \$MAC Championship match Season Complete

With a 6-3 victory over Lycoming College, the Lady Greyhounds won their third straight Middle Atlantic Conference Championship. Earning singles victories for Moravian were seniors Lynne Grzywacz (Blue Bell/Wissahickon HS) and Jessie Coughlin (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS) and freshman Corinne Kleinsmith (Shillington/Governor Mifflin HS) and Katie Copf (Allentown/Salisbury HS). Grzywacz and Coughlin also won in doubles action as did Kleinsmith and partner junior Marnie Heller (Shillington/Governor Mifflin HS).

In the MAC Individual Tournament hosted by Moravian this past weekend, Grzywacz was able to successfully defend her singles title and Heller and Kleinsmith captured the doubles title. Grzywacz was the top seed in the tournament and defeated Drew's Brecken Durham, 6-4, 6-2, in the championship match. Heller and Kleinsmith, the third seed in the tournament, defeated the top seed Megan McGinnis and Amy Himmelberger of Susquehanna in the semifinals and the fifth seed Kristen Marchak and Lisa Fitzgerald of King's in the finals. Senior Lyn Ramsey (Perkasie/Pennridge HS) completed in the singles bracket in her final season. The duo of senior Kate Rose (Hatboro/Hatboro Horsham HS) and sophomore Autumn Zander (Riegelsville/Bethlehem Catholic HS) won their first doubles match in the tournament before falling to Danielle Christ and Erica English of Messiah, the second seed.

Running backs sophomore **P.J. Jankowicz** (Belle Mead, NJ/Hillsborough HS), junior Kirk Harryn (Bethlehem/Freedom HS) and freshman Jim Scott (Bath/Northampton HS) each posted career-highs to lead the Greyhounds to a 32-15 victory over Lebanon Valley College in Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League action this past Saturday. Jankowicz ran for 175 yards on 20 carries with three touchdowns on runs of six, 41 and 26 yards. Harryn had 16 attempts for 90 yards while Scott gained 51 yards on 10 attempts. Moravian ran for a total of 335 yards in the game.

Junior quarterback **Rob Petrosky** (**North Catasauqua/Catasauqua HS**) completed eight of 18 passes for 112 yards and two touchdowns. Petrosky also gained 13 yards on the ground. He connected with freshman wide receiver **Michael Abbate** (**South Plainfield, NJ/Bishop Ahr HS**) on a two yard score with ten and a half minutes in the fourth quarter. Abbate had four catches for 35 yards in the game. Petrosky's final pass of the afternoon was a 59-yard touchdown to senior wide receiver **Vance Szabo** (**Nazareth/Northampton HS**). Szabo had two receptions for 62 yards to move within 28 yards of becoming the 11th player in school history to surpass 1,000 yards in career receiving yardage.

Junior linebacker **Josh Wren** (**Magna, UT/Cypress HS**) continues to lead the Moravian defense, which limited Lebanon Valley to 259 yards of total offense, with ten tackles with eight solo stops. He also had two sacks and two other tackles for loss. Junior defensive end **Kyle Geiger** (**Easton/Easton HS**) had six tackles with two sacks, a fumble caused and a fumble recovery while classmate strong safety **Jason Goldan** (**Neshanic**, **NJ/Hillsborough HS**) had eight tackles and three pass break-ups. The Greyhounds had six sacks and 11 tackles for loss in the contest. Junior defensive end **Corey Berger** (**Nazareth/Pen Argyl HS**), sophomore linebacker **J.D. Rhinehart** (**Washington, NJ/Warren Hill Regional HS**) and junior free safety **Steve DiRenzo** (**Netcong, NJ/Lenape Valley Regional HS**) each had interceptions in the game.

In the Lady Greyhounds only match last week, they defeated Elizabethtown College, 15-10, 15-4, 15-4. The win lifted the Lady 'Hounds record to 21-3 on the season. Moravian moved up to third in last week's NCAA Division III Mid-Atlantic Region poll. The top six teams in the region will make the NCAA Tournament the second week in November.

In the victory, senior middle blocker **Stephanie Rickards** (**Lansdowne/Upper Darby HS**) made 13 kills and three blocks. Junior outside hitter **Amy Sandt** (**Allentown/William Allen HS**) made five kills, four service aces and 11 digs while junior setter **Kaitie Kramer** (**Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS**) had 24 assists and four service aces. Freshman outside hitter **Krystol Kessack** (**Bethlehem/Liberty HS**) made six kills and 12 digs in the match.

The Lady Greyhounds completed their 1998 season in a 3-1 loss to Elizabethtown College this past Saturday. Senior midfielder **Molly McGonigle** (**Maple Shade, NJ/Maple Shade HS**) scored the 14th goal of her career in her final match to give Moravian a short-lived 1-0 lead in the match. Sophomore goalie **Becky Roe** (**Worcester, NY/Worcester Central HS**) had 12 saves in the match.

The Greyhounds split a pair of matches last week, falling to NCAA Division II Bloomsburg University, 5-2, and defeated Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League rival Susquehanna University, 2-1.

In the loss to the Huskies, freshman midfielder **Paul Melniczek** (**Philadelphia/Roman Catholic HS**) gave the Greyhounds a 1-0 lead when he headed home a throw —in by fellow freshman defender **Scott Heydt** (**Boyertown/ Boyertown HS**). Sophomore forward **Matt Kling** (**Chatham, NJ/Oratory Prep**) scored the other goal off a pass by senior midfielder **Nick D'Andrea** (**Bensalem/Holy Ghost Prep HS**). Junior goalie **Ryan Shick** (**Jamison/Central Bucks East HS**) had four saves in the match.

Moravian also jumped out to a 1-0 lead in the victory against Susquehanna on a goal by sophomore midfielder **Billy Boltz** (**Rehrersburg/Tulpehochen HS**) off a pass from senior defender **Alex Jenksi** (**North Haledon/Don Bosco Prep**). Sophomore midfielder **Rich Tate** (**Warrington/LaSalle College HS**) scored in the 51st minute with an assist from D'Andrea to gain the victory. Shick made five saves.

Field Hockey – 7-11 (2-5 MAC Commonwealth League, 3-8 MAC Overall)

Moravian finished the 1998 season with a 1-1 week to post a 7-11 record for the season. The Lady Greyhounds defeated Albright College, 2-0, in their final Middle Atlantic Conference Commonwealth League match of the year, and fell to Delaware Valley, 3-1, in the season's last match. The loss to the Aggies was the only one by Moravian this season that was by more than one goal.

Junior goalie **Tricia Salomonsen** (**Effort/Pleasant Valley HS**) made four saves to post her fifth shutout of the season and the 12th of her career against Albright. The Lady Greyhounds' goals were scored by junior **Nicole Drey** (**Bethlehem/Northampton HS**), the first of her career, and freshman **Suzy Wargo** (**Somerville, NJ/ Hillsborough HS**). Junior **Stacey Laubenheimer** (**Marlton, NJ/Burnt Hills {NY} HS**) and sophomore **Lynda Roney** (**Newtown, NJ/Kittatiny HS**) had assists in the match.

In the season-ending loss, Laubenheimer scored Moravian's only goal in the match to give the Lady Greyhounds a 1-0 lead in the match. Salomonsen made 18 saves as Moravian was outshot 25-12 in the match.
