#### Men's Basketball – 1-1 (0-0 MAC Commonwealth League, 0-0 MAC Overall)

Last Week – Lost to \$Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology, 64-53; defeated \$Ithaca, 82-62. \$Johns Hopkins Blue Jay Tip-Off Tournament

The Greyhounds opened the season with a 1-1 record in the Johns Hopkins Blue Jay Tip-Off Tournament held at the Baltimore, MD school. Moravian fell to Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology from Indiana, 64-53 on the opening night and defeated Ithaca College, 82-62, in the consolation game.

Senior forward **Jason Moran** (**Scranton/West Scranton HS**), who was named to the All-Tournament Team, picked up right where he left off last season with a double-double against Rose-Hulman. Moran led the Greyhounds with 17 points and 10 rebounds in the contest. Classmate **Scott Reslow** (**East Greenwich, RI/East Greenwich HS**), who missed most of last season with a broken nose, scored a career high ten points in the game and tied his career best with five rebounds. Moravian newcomer, senior **Jim Coyle** (**Center Valley/Southern Lehigh HS**) scored nine points in his first game as a Greyhound.

Moran again led the 'Hounds in scoring against Ithaca with 17 points including nine free throws. He missed his second double-double of the season by two rebounds. Reslow improved on his career high, netting 17 points. He made seven of 12 field goal attempts and drained all three free throws. Reslow also grabbed six rebounds in the game. Coyle scored in double figures with 12 points.

All 14 players on the Moravian roster saw at least two minutes of action in the victory over Ithaca including freshmen **Bruce DeLauder (Reading/Reading Central Catholic HS)** and **Doug Spadt (Emmaus/Emmaus HS)**. DeLauder made his only field goal attempt while Spadt was also perfect from the field, connecting on two attempts.

The Greyhounds made five three-pointers against Ithaca including two from senior **Matt Getter** (**Broomall/Marple Newtown HS**), who led the team last season with 62 three-pointers. Getter had 12 points in the two games while sophomore **David Jordan (Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant HS**) netted 15 points. Junior **Rich Whalen (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS**) had eight points and four assists in the two games. Moran leads the team with six assists.

Freshman **Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS)** led the Lady Greyhounds to a 14<sup>th</sup> place team finish out of 21 schools at the 1998 NCAA Division III National Championships hosted by Dickinson College. This fall was the sixth straight year that Moravian competed for the national championship and the squad has finished in the top 15 each year. Wolfsberger placed 38<sup>th</sup> of 183 individuals with a season best time of 18:53.21 over the 5,000-meter course at Carlisle High School.

Two other Lady 'Hounds placed in the top 60. Senior **Kristie Reccek** (**Hellertown/Wilson HS**) completed her collegiate career with a 46<sup>th</sup> place finish in a time of 18:57.79. Freshman **Emily Shertzer** (**Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS**) ran her third fastest time of the year to place 56<sup>th</sup> at 19:03.28.

Rounding out the top five for Moravian were sophomore **Hannah Wood (Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS)** in 131<sup>st</sup> in 19:49.63 and freshman **Erin Boyle (Philadelphia/Nazareth Academy)** in 174<sup>th</sup> with a time of 20:42.38. The Lady Greyhounds other two runners were senior **Amy Cavanaugh (Horseheads, NY/Horseheads HS)** in 177<sup>th</sup> at 21:03.81 and junior **Maria Grabowski (Churchville/Villa Joseph Marie HS)** at 178<sup>th</sup> in a time of 21:08.66.
