Men's Basketball – 8-11 (MAC Commonwealth Conference 4-6, MAC 5-9)

*Last Week – Defeated *Susquehanna, 80-77 (overtime); Lost to #Wilkes, 79-66. *MAC Commonwealth game, #MAC game.*

The Greyhounds split a pair of games last week, defeating Susquehanna University, 80-77 in overtime, and falling to Wilkes University, 79-66. The win versus Susquehanna, which the Greyhounds had to rally to tie near the end of regulation, kept Moravian in the hunt for a Middle Atlantic Conference playoff berth.

At Susquehanna, junior forward **Chris Hayn (Whitehall/Whitehall HS)** netted a career best 25 points, including a perfect 10-of-10 performance from the foul line, in the victory. Hayn also tied his career high with seven rebounds and added three assists and two steals. Senior center **Jim O'Rourke (Park Ridge, NJ/Park Ridge HS)** also scored a career high 18 points in the win. O'Rourke had six rebounds while senior guard **Justin Potts (Sparta, NJ/Sparta HS)** pulled down a career best six boards. Sophomore guard **Doug Spadt (Emmaus/Emmaus HS)** tossed in 15 points off the bench and added six rebounds. Junior guard/forward **David Jordan (Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant HS)** also scored in double-figures with 12 points. Senior guard **Rich Whalen (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS)** contributed seven assists and three steals.

In the loss at Wilkes, Hayn again led Moravian in scoring with 19 points. Hayn also had six rebounds. Jordan was the only other Greyhound to score in double figures in the game, netting 18 points to go along with a team high eight rebounds. O'Rourke added seven points and six rebounds while freshman guard **Kevin Hall (Mountain Top/Pocono Mountain HS)** added seven points.

The Lady Greyhounds dropped a pair of games last week falling to Susquehanna University, 66-59, and Wilkes University, 65-57. In the game at Susquehanna, the Lady Greyhounds held a lead throughout the first half and the first ten minutes of the second half before the Crusaders rallied for the win. Moravian fell behind Wilkes, 16-0, before scoring with 13:23 left in the first half.

Freshman forward **Kelly McLean (Allentown/Salisbury HS)** tied her career high with 22 points in the loss at Susquehanna. McLean added five rebounds while sophomore **Mary Morgans (Center Valley/Allentown Central Catholic HS)** had a team high nine rebounds. Senior forward **LaJona Johnson (Easton/Easton HS)** contributed 16 points and five rebounds. Freshman guard **Tara Wozniak (Roseland, NJ/West Essex Regional HS)** added nine points and five rebounds while freshman guard **Jennifer Tannous (Bethlehem/Liberty HS)** also had five rebounds.

McLean and Wozniak each scored 16 points against Wilkes. McLean also had seven rebounds while Morgans tied her career best with 12 rebounds. Morgans also scored six points. Johnson had eight points and five rebounds while senior guard **Jen Polaha (Seattle, WA/Holy Name {PA} HS)** had four points and four assists.

Women's Indoor Track & Field 0-0 (MAC Commonwealth Conference 0-0, MAC 0-0)

The Lady Greyhounds hosted the Greyhound Field Challenge last Friday before travelling to the University of Delaware for a weekend invitational.

At the Greyhound Field Challenge, sophomore **Sarah Shaneberger (Bethlehem/Southern Lehigh HS)** won the women's shot put with a toss of 11.68 meters and was second in the 20-pound weight throw at 12.28 meters. Junior **Brooke Dancho (Bethlehem/Freedom HS)** was third in the triple jump at 10.60 meters while senior **Lexie Katchuk (Whitney Point, NY/Whitney Point HS)** was fifth at 10.35 meters and junior **Lindsey Foreman (Sharon, MA/Sharon HS)** was sixth at 10.00 meters. Junior **Leah Williams (Andreas/Tamaqua HS)**, who was seventh in the triple jump at 9.46 meters, tied with Dancho for third in the high jump at four feet, eight inches. Dancho was sixth in the pole vault, clearing seven feet, and was second in the long jump at 5.23 meters. Katchuk placed fourth in the long jump with a leap of 4.75 meters.

At the University of Delaware Invitational, sophomores **Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS)** and **Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS)** each placed third in their races. Wolfsberger was third in the one-mile race in 5:14.67 while Shertzer was third in the 5,000 meters with a time of 18:18.88. Sophomore **Kim Jaick (Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS)** was seventh in the mile run in 5:24.14 while junior **Hannah Wood (Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS)** was 13th at 2:27.00. Sophomore **Steph Horne (Sinking Spring/Wilson West Lawn HS)** was 15th in the 60-meter high hurdles in 10.01 seconds. The Lady Greyhounds distance medley relay team of Wolfsberger, Wood, Jaick and freshman **Ann Corless (Plainsville, CT/Plainsville HS)** was second in 12:31.20.

The Greyhounds hosted the Greyhound Field Challenge last Friday before travelling to the University of Delaware for a weekend invitational.

At the Greyhound Field Challenge, Moravian had a pair of individual winners. Junior **Anthony Rediger (Sellersville/Pennridge HS)** won the high jump at six feet, two inches while freshman **Scott Bertani (West Caldwell, NJ/James Caldwell HS)** won the pole vault with a height of 12 feet. Rediger placed second in the triple jump at 13.49 meters while freshman **Jon Stanko (Lansford/Panther Valley)** was fourth in 12.84 meters. Junior **Bill Schmidt (Basking Ridge, NJ/Ridge HS)** was second in the shot put with a toss of 13.68 meters and fourth in the 35-pound weight throw at 11.60 meters. Senior **Josh Tirado (Weatherly/Weatherly)** was third in the 35-pound weight throw at 11.63 meters. Rediger placed fourth in the long jump with a distance of 6.43 meters while junior **Napo Ghanda (Whitehall/Freedom HS)** was fifth at 6.08 meters.

Senior **Tim Pfluger (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS)** was eighth in the mile race at the University of Delaware Invitational in a time of 4:25.76. Junior **Damon Rutherford (Reading/Exeter HS)** was 12th in the same race at 4:29.47. Senior **Dan Oliynik (Dover, NJ/Morris Knolls HS)** was 18th in the 60-meter high hurdles in 9.00 seconds. The Greyhound distance medley relay team of Pfluger, Rutherford, freshman **George Wacker (Honesdale/Honesdale HS)** and sophomore **Josh Heebner (Lansdale/North Penn HS)** placed third with a time of 10:25.63.
