Men's Basketball – 9-13 (MAC Commonwealth Conference 5-7, MAC 6-11)

The Greyhounds won one of three games last week but remained in the hunt for a Middle Atlantic Conference playoff spot with a 81-79 victory over Lebanon Valley College in MAC Commonwealth Conference action. Moravian must win its final two games of the 1999-2000 season and have Susquehanna University lose one of its last two games for the Greyhounds to make the playoffs for the first time since the 1996-97 season. Moravian lost to Delaware Valley College, 69-64, and Albright College, 87-76, in its other two games last week.

In the loss to Delaware Valley, the Greyhounds fell behind 11-0 in the first five minutes of the game before scoring. Junior guard/forward **David Jordan (Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant HS)** scored a team high 16 points in the loss. Junior forward **Chris Hayn (Whitehall/Whitehall HS)** contributed 12 points while senior center **Jim O'Rourke (Park Ridge, NJ/Park Ridge HS)** had 11 points. O'Rourke was one of three Greyhounds to pull down six rebounds in the game. Senior guard **Rich Whalen (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS)** had six boards to go along with five assists and five steals while sophomore guard **Doug Spadt (Emmaus/Emmaus HS)** also grabbed six rebounds and scored seven points. Freshman forward **Ken Greb (Mt. Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley HS)** returned to the Moravian lineup in the game after missing five games with an ankle injury. Greb had eight points and two rebounds in 18 minutes.

Jordan netted a career best 27 points at Albright in the loss with 25 points coming in the second half. Spadt tossed in 13 points while Hayn and O'Rourke each scored 11 points. Moravian trailed 13-0 before scoring its first basket with 13:07 remaining in the first half. O'Rourke led the Greyhounds with five rebounds and Jordan added four boards as Moravian was out-rebounded 39-21 in the game. Whalen had three assists and four steals in the game.

Freshman guard **Kevin Hall (Mountain Top/Pocono Mountain HS)** scored a career high 18 points in the victory over Lebanon Valley to lead the Greyhounds. Hall also pulled down a career best four rebounds while O'Rourke had a double-double with 17 points and a team high 11 rebounds. Hayn scored 16 points while Whalen had nine points, seven steals and five assists. Senior guard **Justin Potts (Sparta, NJ/Sparta HS)** also had five assists in the win while Jordan had eight points and six rebounds. Greb tied a career high with eight rebounds and he scored seven points.

The Lady Greyhounds dropped a pair of games in MAC Commonwealth Conference action last week, losing to Albright College, 67-63, and Lebanon Valley College, 72-62. Moravian did earn a 69-55 win at Franklin & Marshall College to snap an 11-game losing streak.

Moravian let a 35-29 halftime lead slip away in the loss to Albright. Freshman guard **Tara Wozniak** (Roseland, NJ/West Essex Regional HS) tied her career high with 19 points in the game, as she was one of four Lady Greyhounds to score in double figures in the game. Freshman center Kelly McLean (Allentown/Salisbury HS) had 14 points, four rebounds and two blocked shots while senior forward LaJona Johnson (Easton/Easton HS) had ten points and a team high nine rebounds. Sophomore forward Mary Morgans (Center Valley/Allentown Central Catholic HS) also scored ten points and pulled down eight rebounds. Senior guard Jen Polaha (Seattle, WA/Holy Name {PA} HS) had five assists in the game.

Morgans scored 12 of her game and career-high 15 points in the first half in the victory at Franklin & Marshall. Morgans added 11 rebounds and three steals. McLean and Wozniak each added 12 points in the game with McLean grabbing a game and career best 17 rebounds including 10 offensive boards. Johnson and Polaha each added seven points while Polaha, McLean and junior guard Jill Kenny (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS) all had three assists in the game. McLean also added three steals and two blocked shots. Kenny and freshman guard Jennifer Tannous (Bethlehem/Liberty HS) each tallied six points.

Wozniak scored a career high 20 points in the loss to Lebanon Valley including four three-pointers in the second half which helped Moravian come back from a 19-point halftime deficit to trail by only seven points several times in the second half. McLean added 16 points and four rebounds while Morgans had eight rebounds and seven points. Polaha led the team with seven assists while junior forward **Becky Roe (Worcester, NY/Worcester Central HS)** had a career high six rebounds.
