Men's Basketball – 10-14 (MAC Commonwealth Conference 6-8, MAC 7-12)

Last Week – Defeated *Elizabethtown, 76-68; Lost to *Messiah, 82-68. *MAC Commonwealth game.

Season Complete

The Greyhounds kept their Middle Atlantic Conference playoffs hopes alive with a 76-68 win over Elizabethtown College in the final home game of the 1999-2000 season only to see them slip away with a 82-68 loss at Messiah College in the final regular season game of the year.

Senior center Jim O'Rourke (Park Ridge, NJ/Park Ridge HS) led a balanced scoring attack in the win over Elizabethtown with 14 points. O'Rourke also had six rebounds as did junior forward Chris Hayn (Whitehall/ Whitehall HS), who tallied 11 points. Junior guard forward David Jordan (Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant HS) had 12 points in the game while freshman guard Kevin Hall (Mountain Top/Pocono Mountain HS) added 11 points including eight in a row in the second half that put Moravian ahead for good. Senior guard Rich Whalen (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS) had nine points, seven steals, five assists and four rebounds in his final game while senior guard Pete Bilinsky (Pennsauken, NJ/Camden Catholic HS) tied a career high with six points. Senior guard Justin Potts (Sparta, NJ/Sparta HS) had five assists, two steals and two points in the contest.

Hayn paced the Greyhounds at Messiah with 16 points and nine rebounds while Jordan had 14 points and seven boards. Hall added 11 points and connected on two three-pointers as did Jordan. O'Rourke tossed in eight points while freshman forward **Ken Greb (Mt. Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley HS)** had eight points and eight rebounds. Whalen scored seven points in his final career game for Moravian.

The Greyhounds competed at the Keogh Invitational hosted by Haverford College on Sunday and there were no team scores kept at the meet. In the field events, junior **Anthony Rediger (Sellersville/Pennridge HS)** won the high jump at six feet, two inches while freshman **Scott Bertani (West Caldwell, NJ/James Caldwell HS)** was second in the pole vault with a height of 12 feet, six inches. Rediger also ran a 25.6 in the 200 meters. Freshman **John Stanko (Lansford/Panther Valley HS)** placed fifth in the triple jump at 12.21 meters and seventh in the long jump at 5.54 meters.

In the track events, senior **Dan Oliynik (Dover, NJ/Morris Knolls HS)** was second in the 55-meter hurdles in 7.9 seconds and tied for 11th in the 55 meters in 6.9 seconds. Sophomore **Kevin Bush (Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS)** tied for second in the 55 meters at 6.6 seconds and Bush also tied for second in the 200 meters at 23.2 seconds. Senior **Tim Pfluger (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS)** was third in the 1,500 meters at 4:01.4 while junior **Damon Rutherford (Reading/Exeter HS)** placed eighth in the 1,500 meters with a time of 4:07.1. Sophomore **Josh Heebner (Lansdale/North Penn HS)** won his heat and was seventh overall in the 800 meters in a time of 2:00.7.

Freshman **Wes Zimmerman** (**Boyertown/Boyertown HS**) placed second in his heat in the 3,000 meters with a time of 9:27.1 while sophomore **Chris Colley** (**Easton/Easton HS**) was second in his heat of the 200 meters in 24.1 seconds. Freshman **Chris McGinnis** (**Brick, NJ/Brick Memorial HS**) won his heat of the 200 meters in 24.7 seconds. Colley and McGinnis each ran in the 55 meters with times of 6.9 and 7.1 seconds. Junior **Doug Joseph** (**Allentown/Parkland HS**) also ran in the 55 meters with a time of 6.7 seconds. Freshman **George Wacker** (**Honesdale/Honesdale HS**) had a time of 4:13.4 in the 1,500 meters.

Season Complete

The Lady Greyhounds dropped their final two games of the season in MAC Commonwealth Conference action, losing to Elizabethtown College, 76-57, and falling to Messiah College. 67-54. Moravian finishes the 1999-2000 season with a 4-20 overall record, the squad's first losing season since the 1979-80 season.

Moravian's loss to Elizabethtown was the final home game of the season for the Lady Greyhounds. Freshman center Kelly McLean (Allentown/Salisbury HS) had her fifth career double-double to lead Moravian with 17 points and 11 rebounds. Senior forward LaJona Johnson (Easton/Easton HS) scored 15 points in her final game in Johnston Hall while freshman guard Tara Wozniak (Roseland, NJ/West Essex Regional HS) had ten points with three three-pointers. Johnson had five rebounds as did sophomore forward Mary Morgans (Center Valley/Allentown Central Catholic HS). Senior guard Jen Polaha (Seattle, WA/Holy Name {PA} HS) had three rebounds, two assists and two steals in her final home game while senior guard Erin Kennedy (Bangor/Pius X HS) added three points.

McLean led the Lady Greyhounds at Messiah with 15 points. McLean also had six rebounds and three assists in the game. Wozniak scored 13 points with three three-pointers and seven rebounds while Polaha reached double-figures in her final career game with ten points. Morgans led Moravian on the boards with nine rebounds and she also scored nine points.

The Lady Greyhounds competed at the Keogh Invitational hosted by Haverford College on Sunday and there were no team scores kept at the meet. Sophomore Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS) won the 1,500 meters in 4:41.3 while classmate Kim Jaick (Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS) was second at 5:01.6. Wolfsberger's time provisionally qualified her for the NCAA Division III Indoor Track & Field Championships. Junior Hannah Wood (Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS) won her heat of the 1,500 meters and was sixth overall at 5:11.6 while senior Maria Grabowski (Churchville/Villa Joseph Maria HS) ran a 5:15.7 in the 1,500 meters.

Sophomore Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS) placed second in the 3,000 meters in 10:30.2 while sophomore Steph Horne (Sinking Spring/Wilson West Lawn HS) tied for fourth in the 55-meter hurdles at 9.4 seconds. Freshman Jen Ketz (Canadensis/Pocono Mountain HS) was tied for second in the 55-meters at 7.7 seconds and she ran a race of 9.7 seconds in the 55-meter hurdles. Ketz also ran in the 200 meters with a time of 29.6 seconds. Freshman Ann Corless (Plainsville, CT/Plainsville HS) was third in the 400 meters in 1:04.0 and she posted a time of 9.9 seconds in the 55-meter hurdles. Sophomore Jen Burkholder (Chalfont/Gwynedd Mercy HS) had a 1:06.4 in the 400 meters while freshman Jen Wagner (Riegelsville/Wilson HS) won her heat of the 800 meters in 2:27.8. Sophomore Amanda Samok (Palmerton/Palmerton HS) was second in her heat of the 800 meters in 2:29.7 while sophomore Erin Boyle (Philadelphia/Nazareth Academy) was second in to Wagner in 2:30 0.

The Lady Greyhounds had three other runners in the 800 meters with sophomore **Tiffany Catalino** (Bethlehem/Freedom HS) posting a 2:36.5, sophomore **Jen Boberg** (Lansford/Panther Valley HS) finishing the race in 2:41.8 and freshman **Gina Lacombe** (Andover, CT/Rham HS) running a time of 2:42.7.

In the field events, sophomore **Sarah Shaneberger (Bethlehem/Southern Lehigh HS)** won the shot put with a toss of 11.27 meters. Senior **Alexis Katchuk (Whitney Point, NY/Whitney Point HS)** was second in the long jump at 4.73 meters and she won the triple jump with a leap of 10.35 meters. Corless placed third in the long jump at 4.69 meters while junior **Lindsey Forman (Sharon, MA/Sharon HS)** placed third in the triple jump at 9.50 meters and sixth in the long jump at 4.37 meters. Forman also ran in the 55-meter hurdles with a time of 9.8 seconds. Freshman **Brooke Dawson (Emmaus/Emmaus HS)** was seventh in the long jump at 4.28 meters and she placed eighth in high jump, clearing a height of four feet, eight inches.
